They all allow you to play games

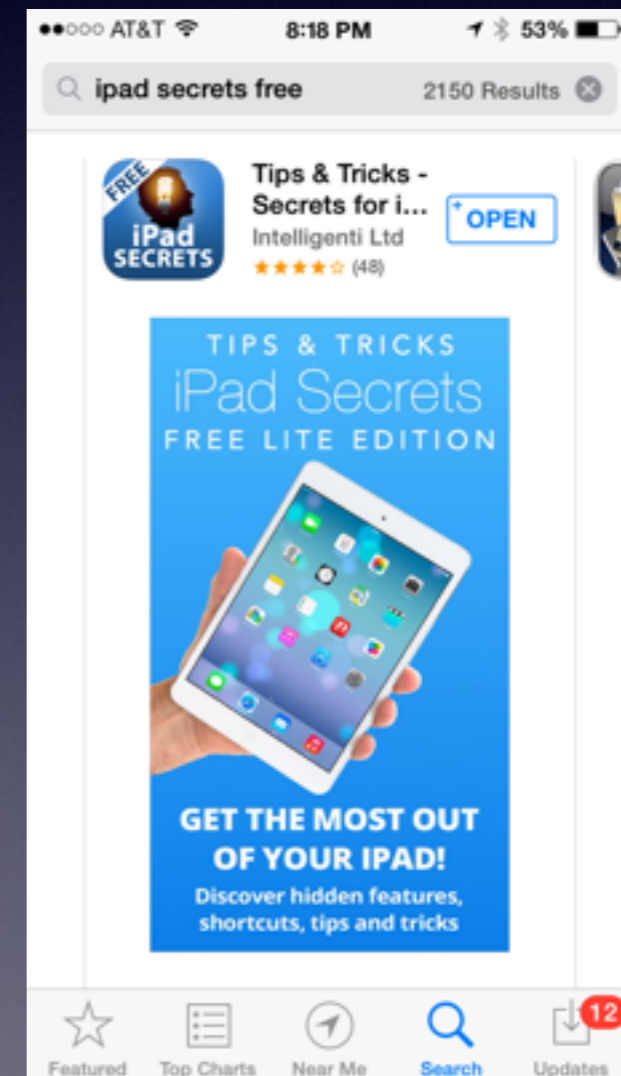
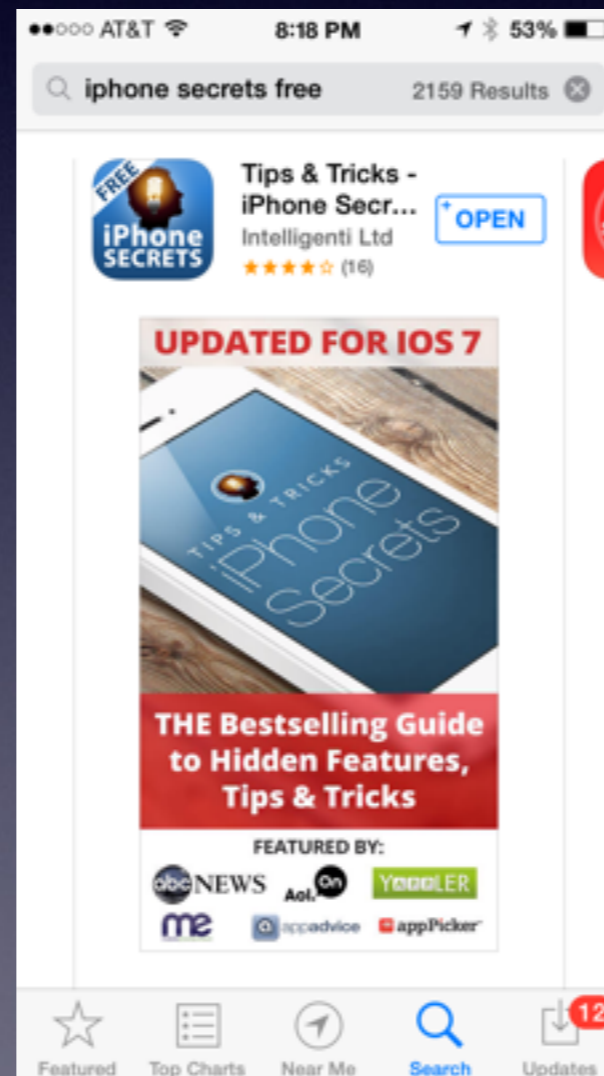

You are unable to delete Apple Apps

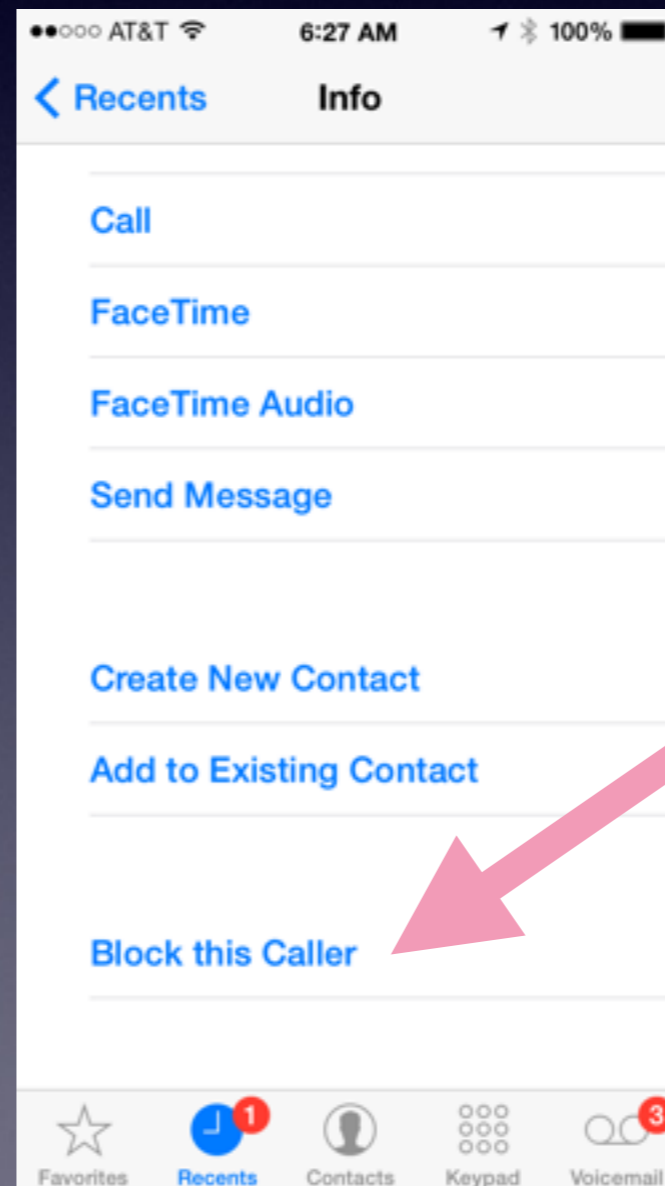
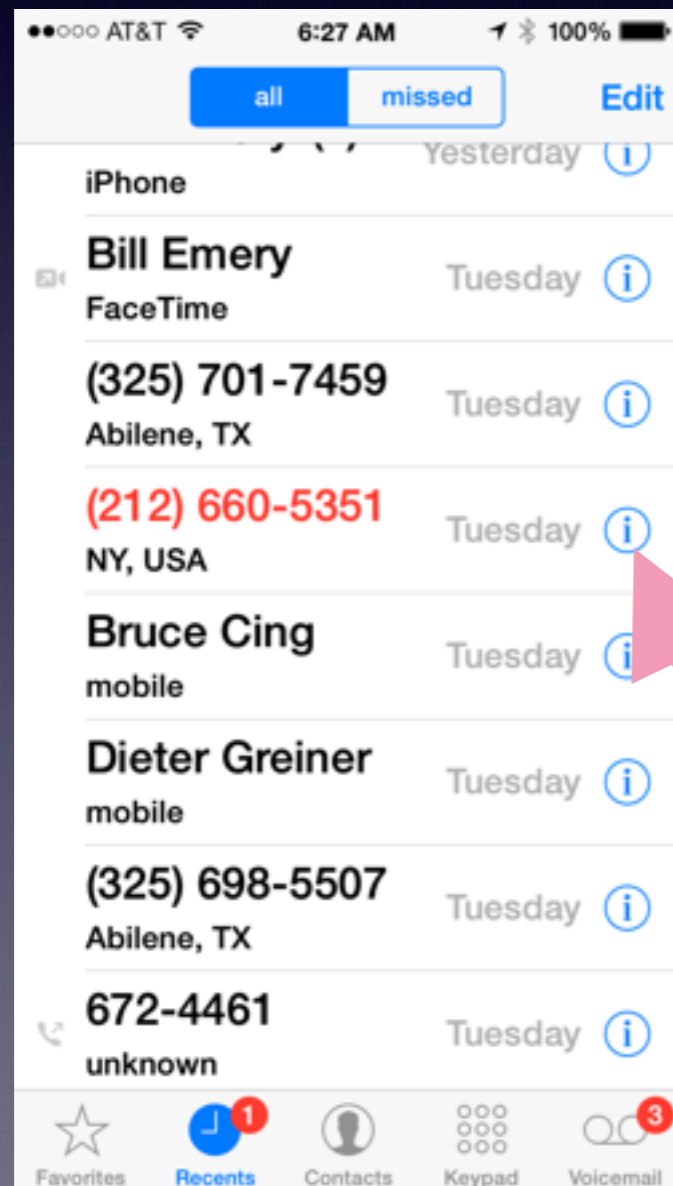
Hold your finger on an app until it wiggles and a “X” appears!

Press your finger on the “X”

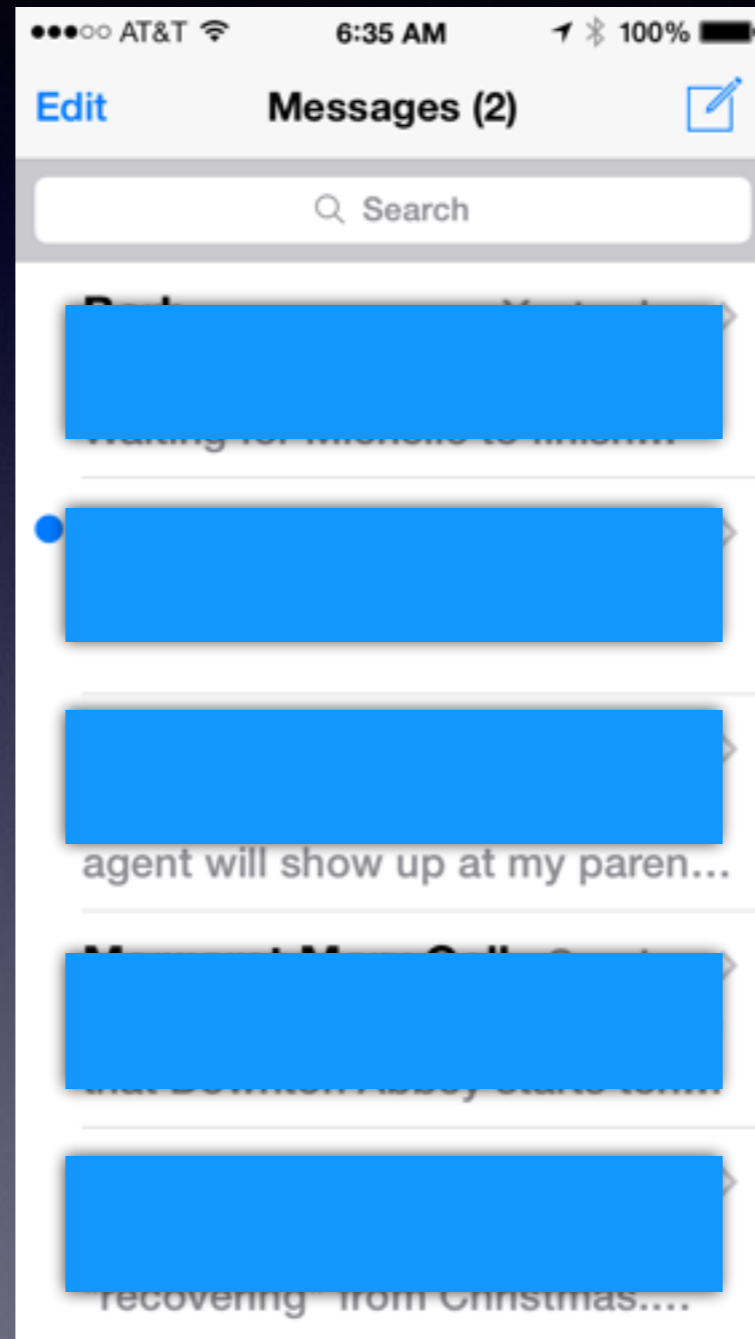

In the first year, the baby learned our voices and saw our faces often. When we met again, it was like we'd always been there. -- COMPUTER GRANNY

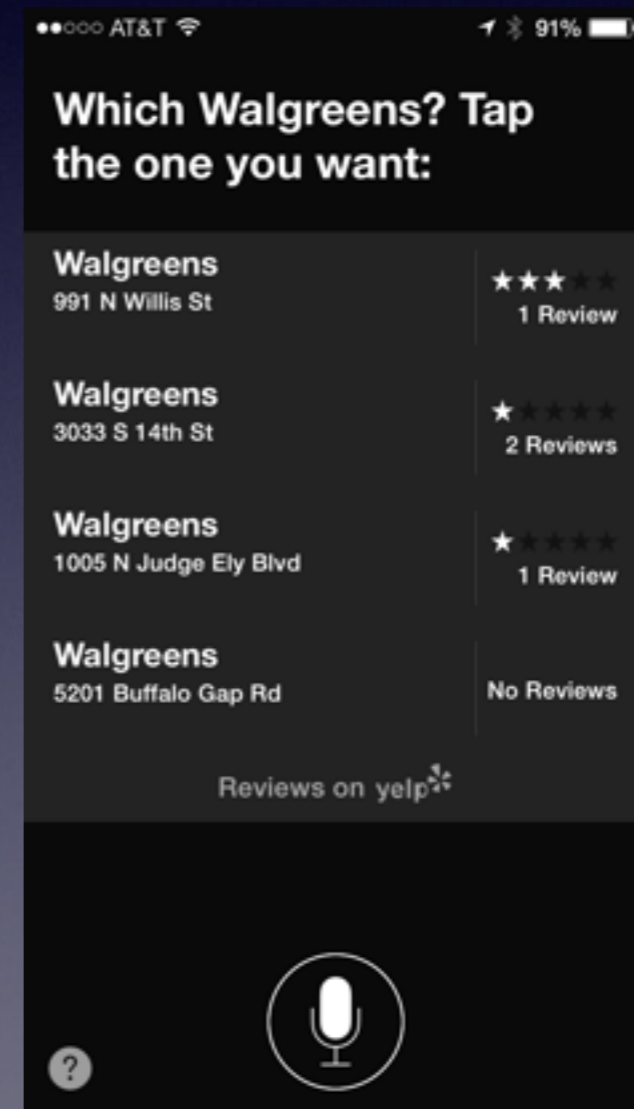
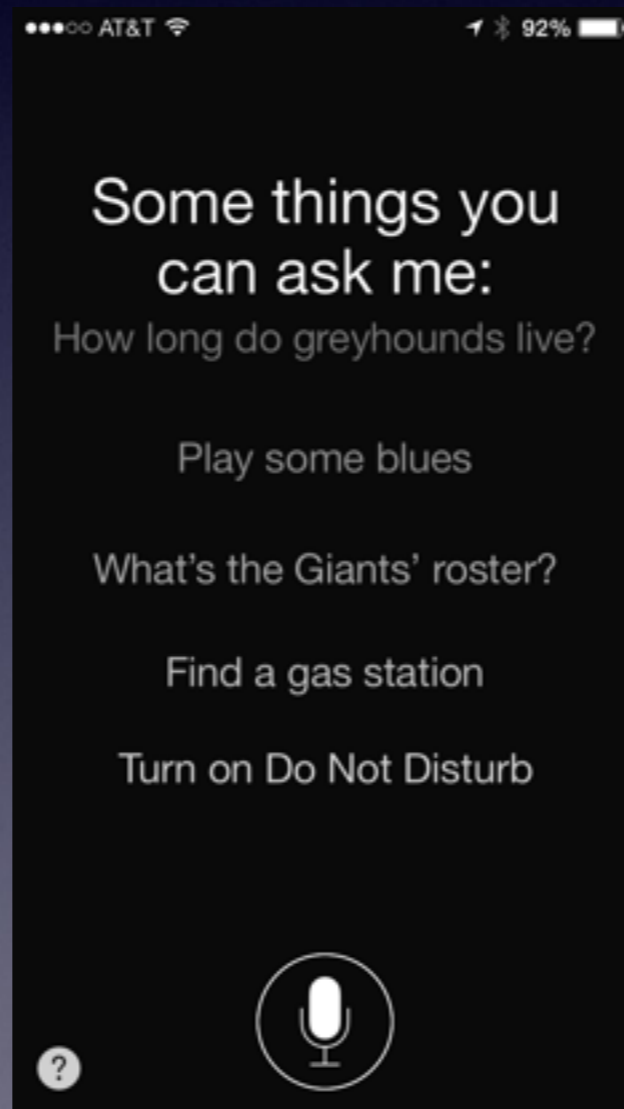
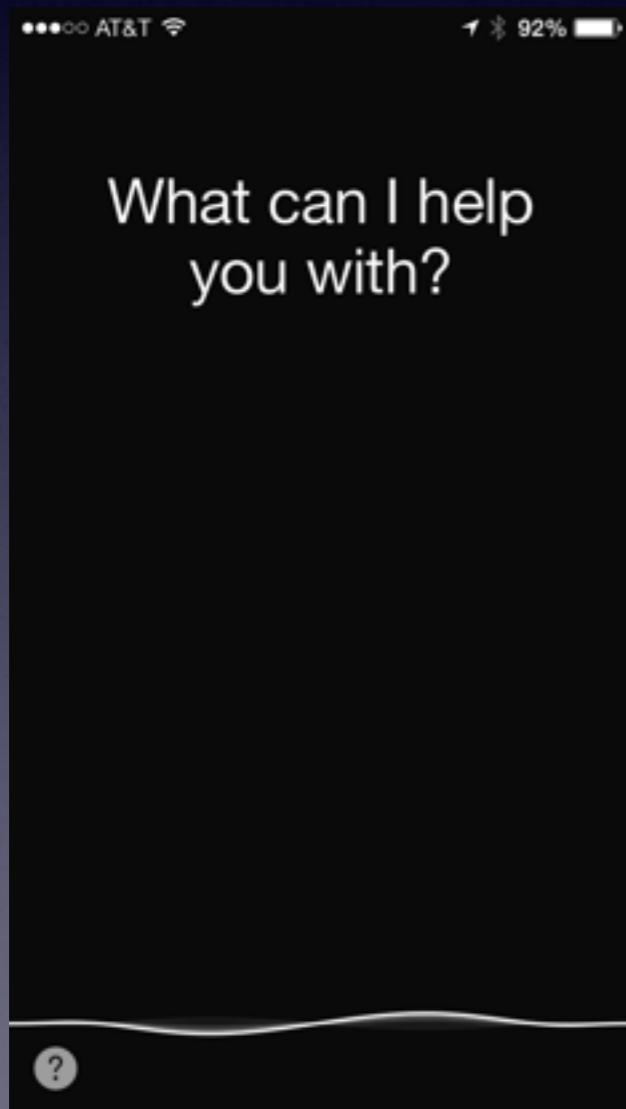

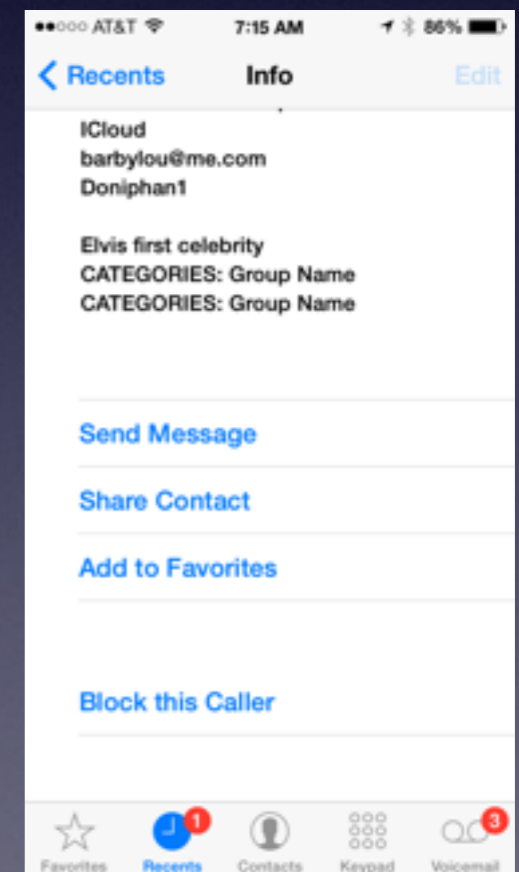
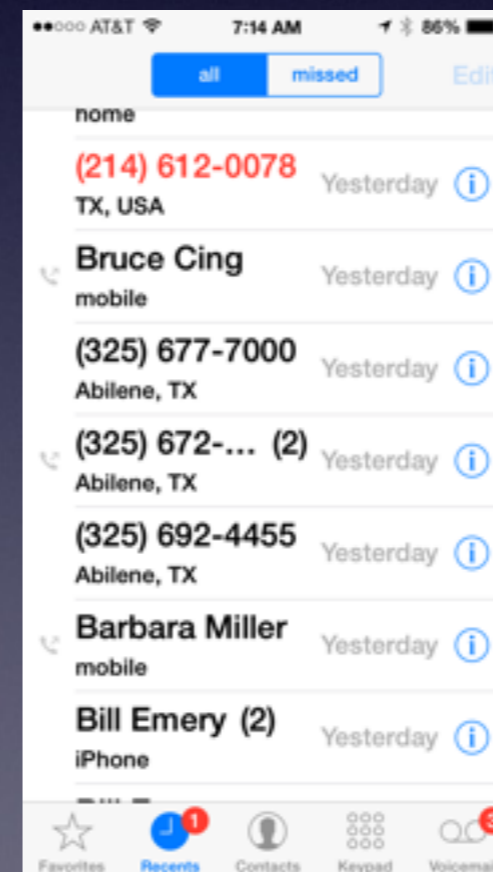
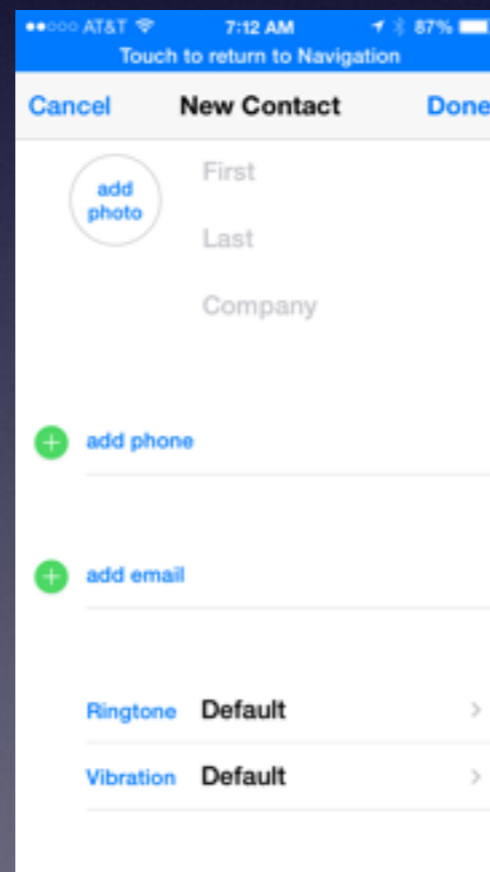
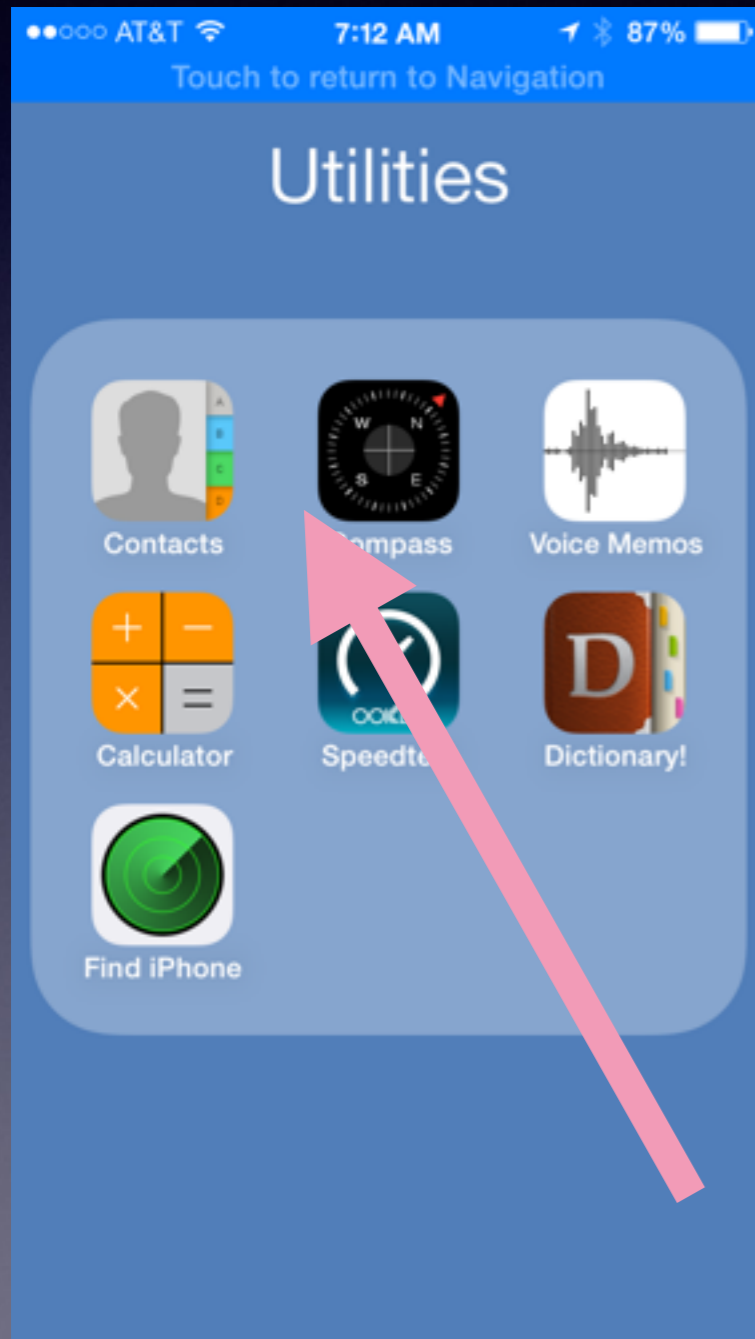
Using Siri to Find An Address
