This Little Thing May Help You Find Your Keys

No more fumbling around looking for your wallet or keys before leaving the house, if [something called Tile](#) and its accompanying app work as promised.

Rolling out this winter, a waterproof, stamp-size adhesive square may help locate lost valuables. Users can attach it to key chains, place them in wallets or purses and even stick them on laptops or books. Using the free Tile iPhone app, users can pinpoint the location of the Tile and the lost item. If all else fails, users can activate a sound alarm on the Tile to help find it.

"It's a common problem that's affected everyone," says Tile co-creator Nick Evans.

"When you're looking for your keys on your way out the door, you're already frustrated. Because of that, the product that you're building needs to be dead simple."

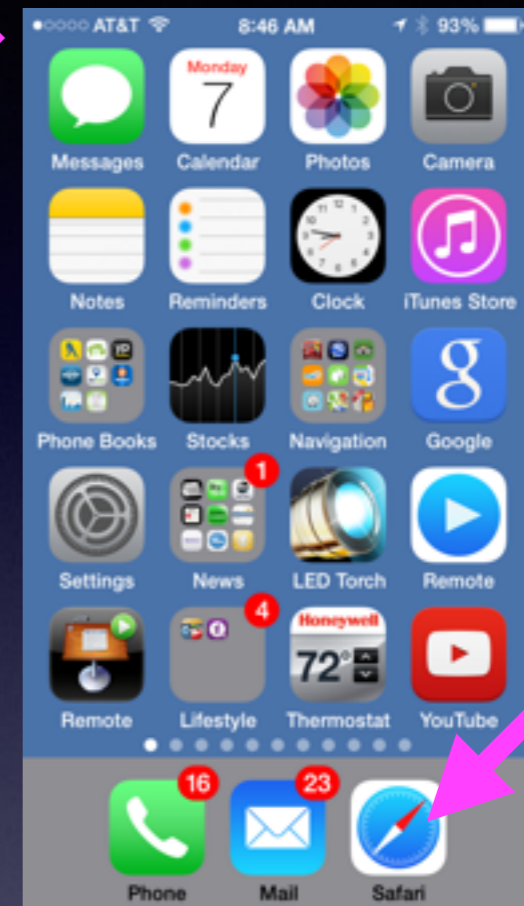
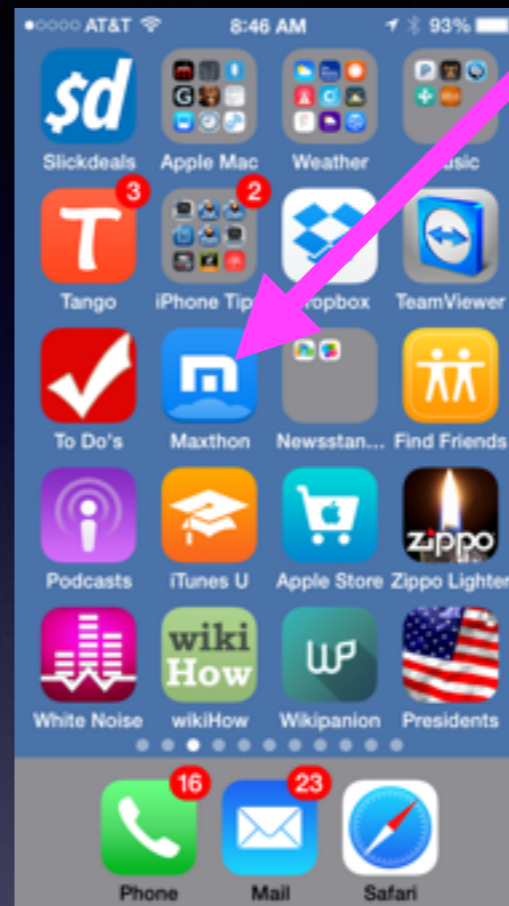
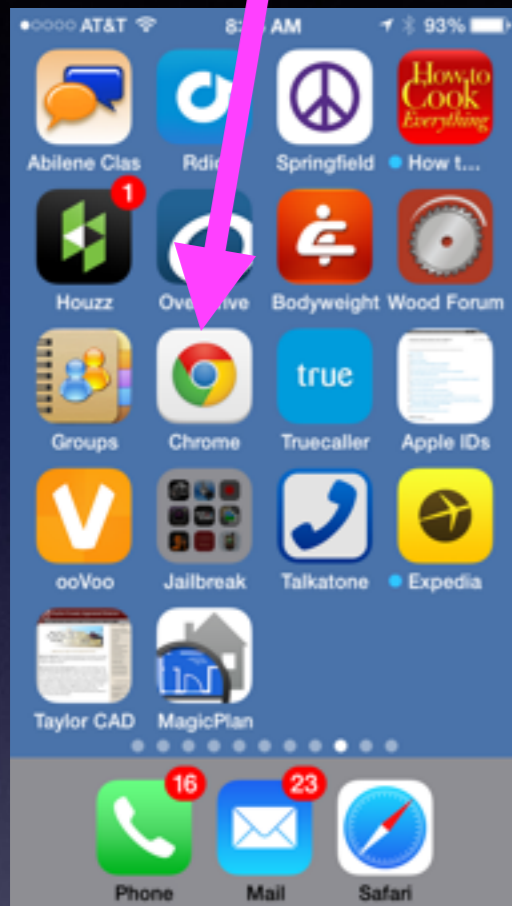

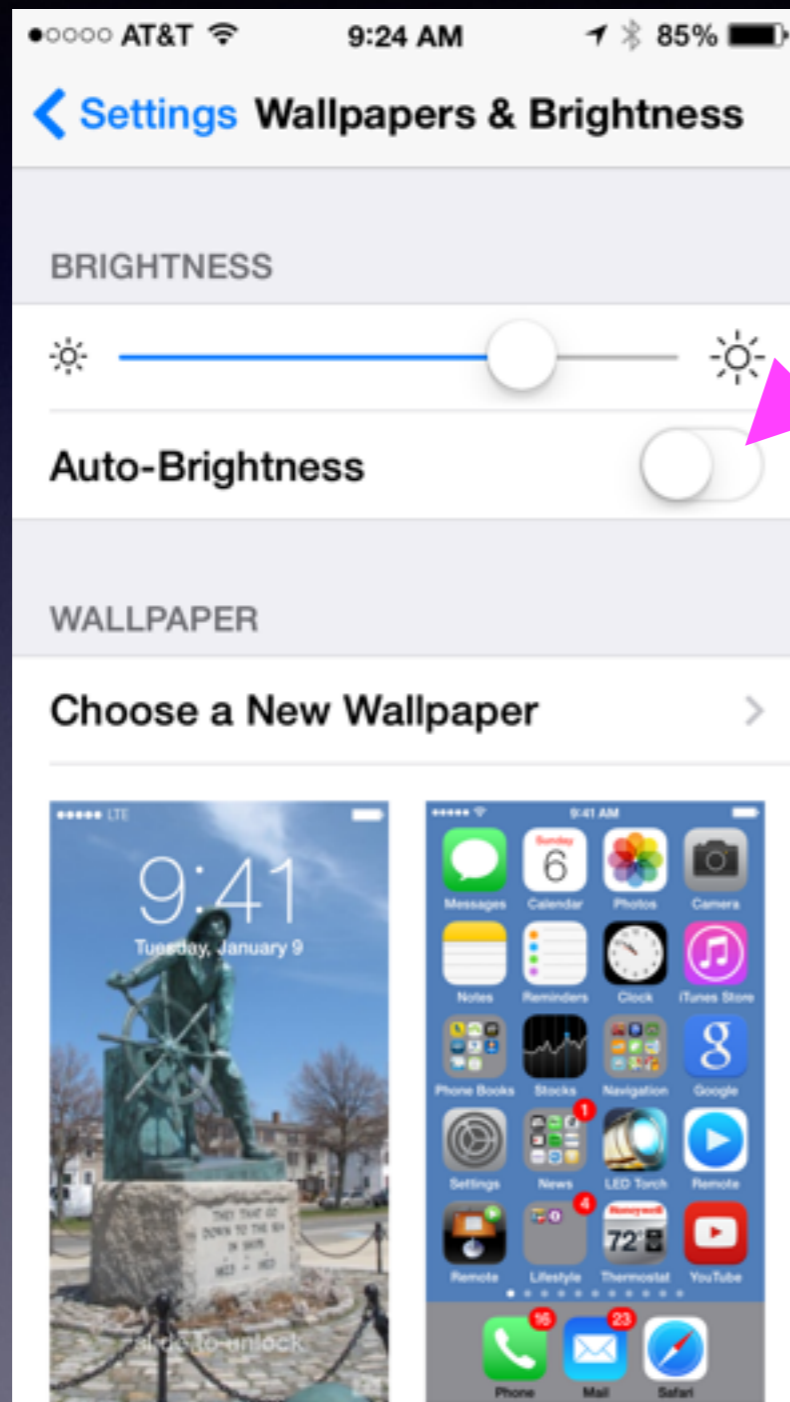
