



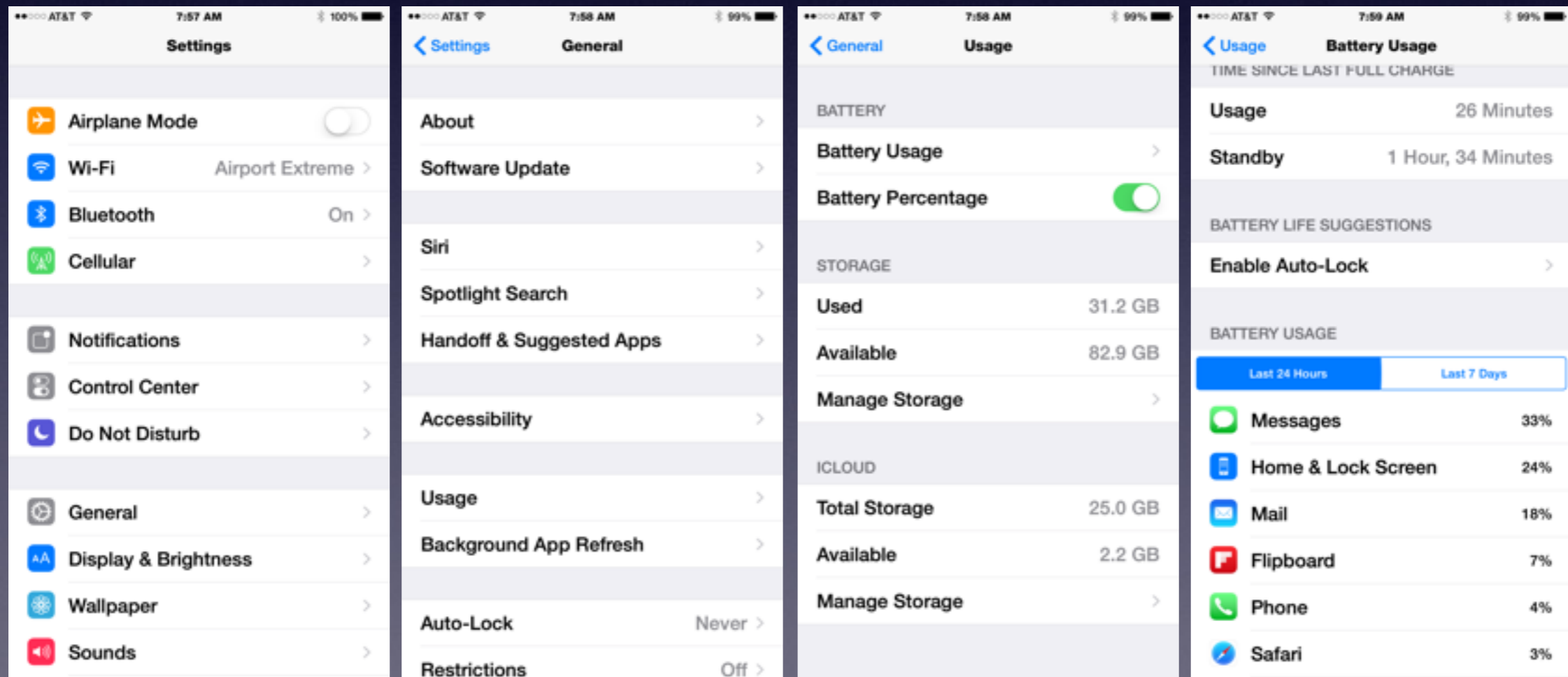

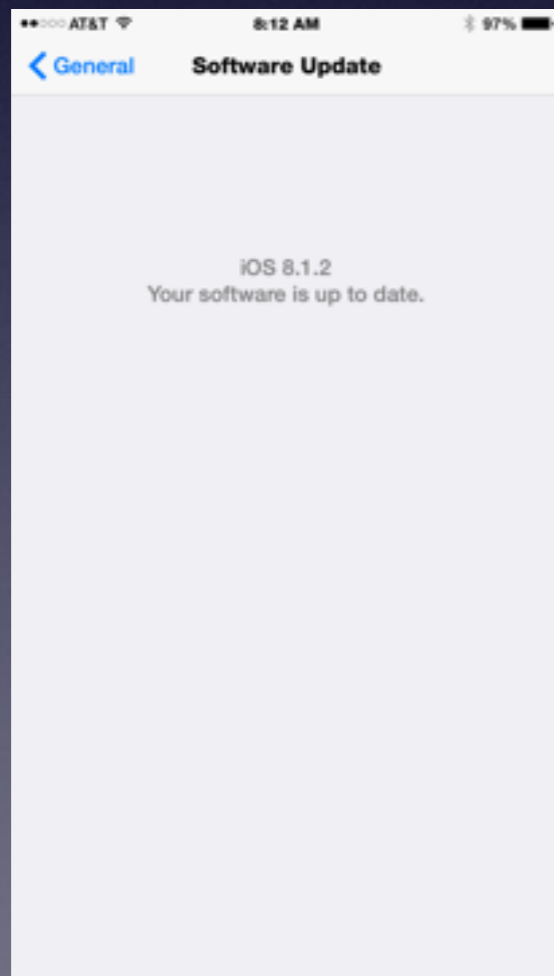

What is using my battery?




What's Using My Battery? [Laptops]

How to fix OS X Yosemite Battery Life Problems

Soon after the release we heard [complaints about OS X Yosemite battery life](#) problems. The battery life drains much faster than normal for some users. For many, this is likely due to spotlight indexing after the update and using the battery faster. Typically this will resolve itself after a day or two.

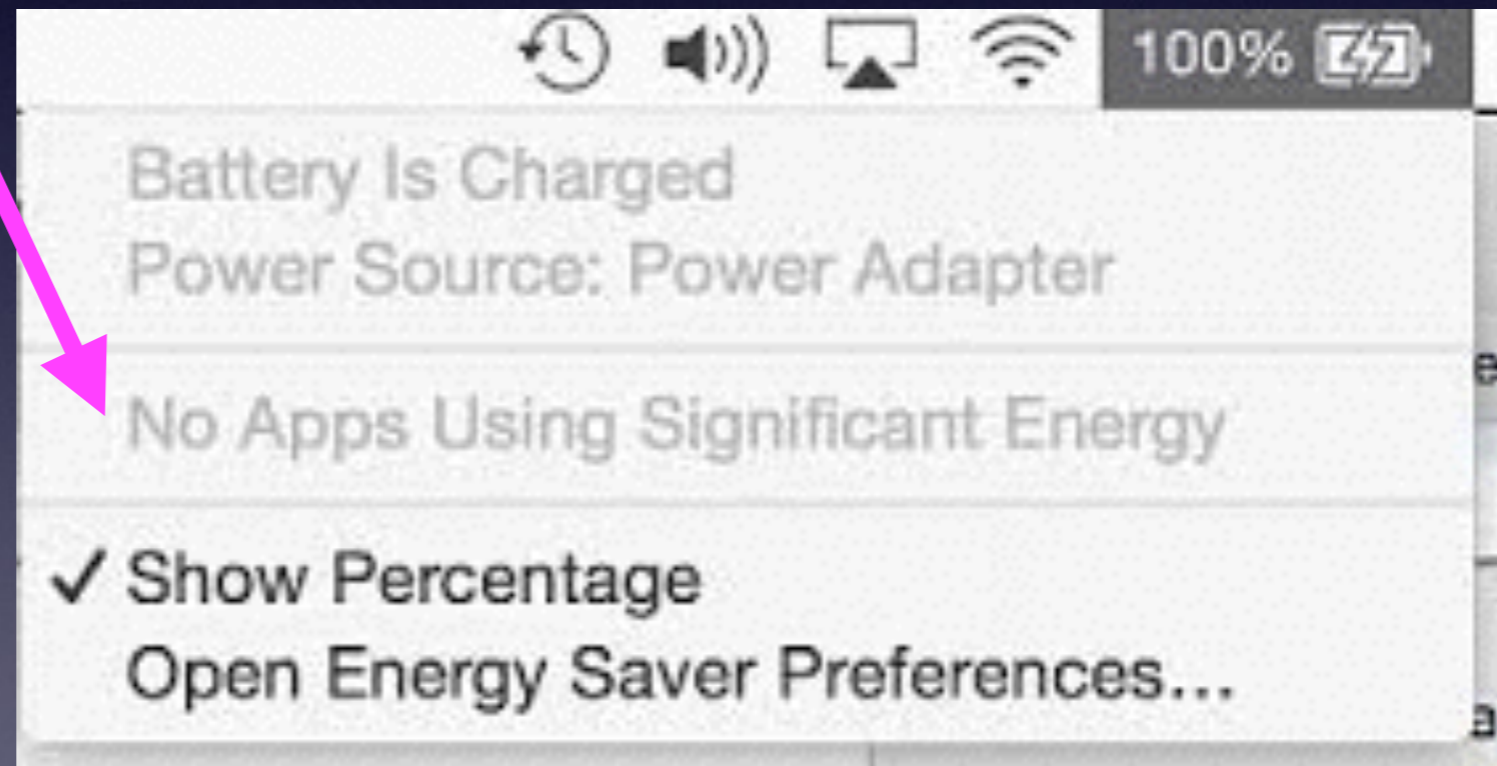
Find OS X Yosemite battery life hogs.

If the battery problems continue, **press space and command at the same time and type Activity Monitor** to open a built-in system monitor. **Click on Energy** and see if there are any specific apps using too much energy. This will help you find any apps that are behaving badly.

With Recent Iterations of the OS Mac has moved away from a Computer centric OS to a “Stuff-Centric” OS.

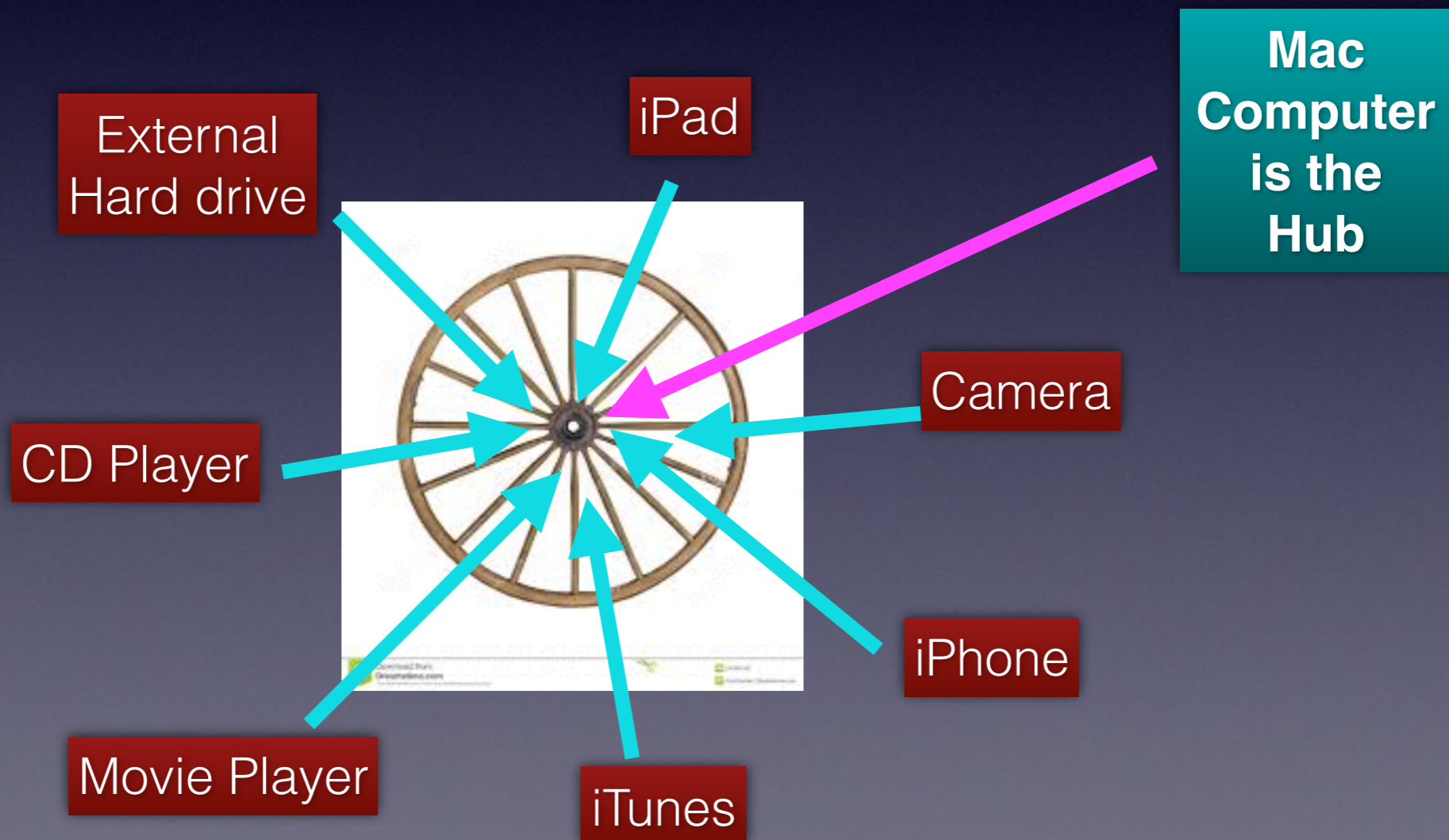
Previous OS insured the computer was the hub and everything plugged into it!

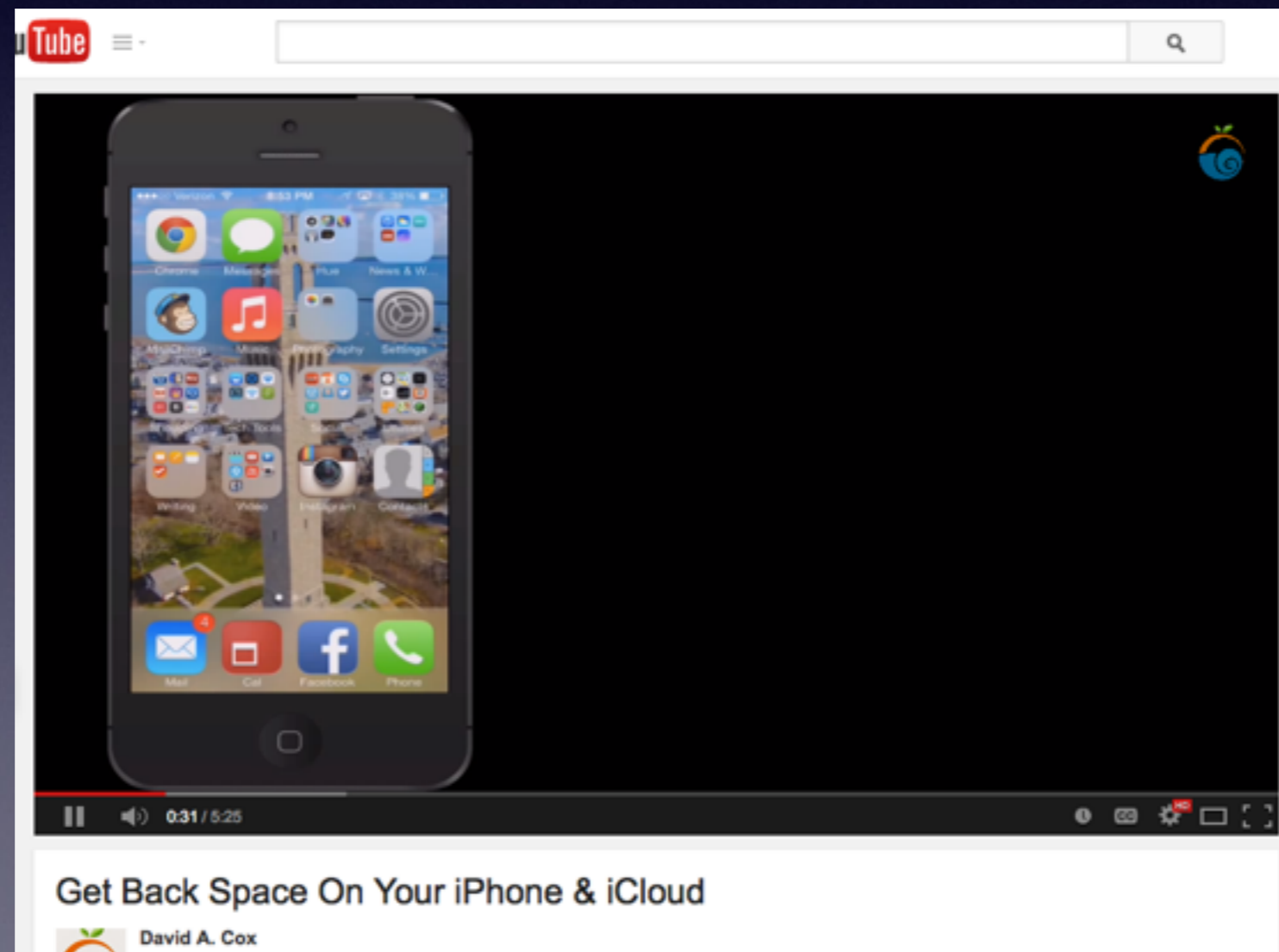

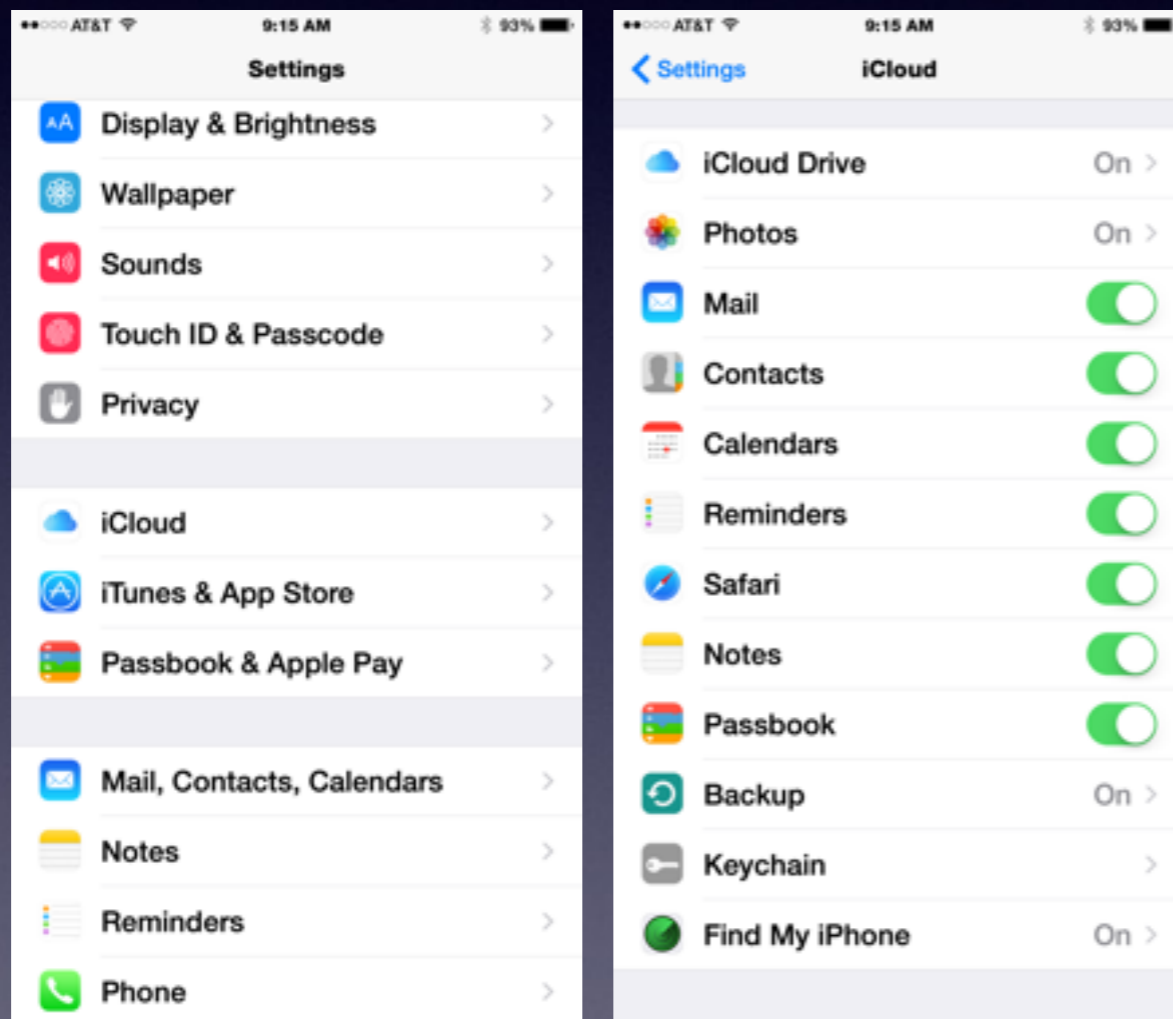

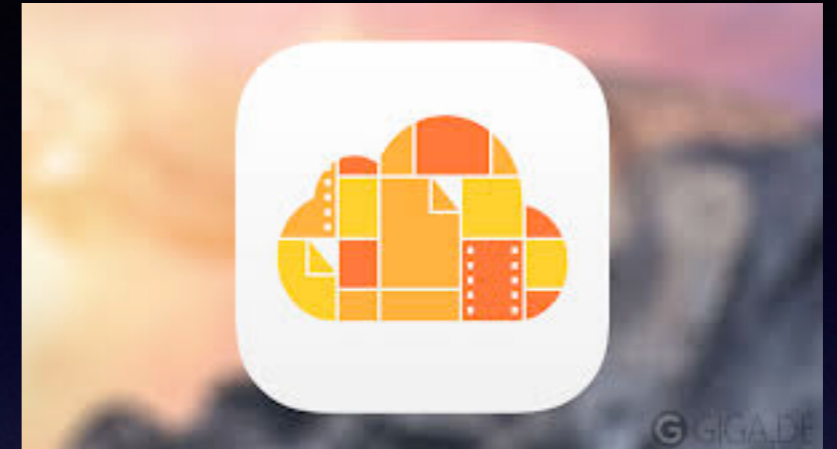
Why should I have a password on my iPhone or iPad?
