SamMote revealed today that its popular iPhone TV remote app now includes Apple Watch integration. The iPhone and Apple Watch don't come with the infrared sensor you'd normally need to beam signals to your TV, so the app uses Wi-Fi to send commands instead.

The Apple Watch TV remote is free, but only works on Samsung smart TVs made after 2011 (hence the name "Sam" in the app's name). If you do have a Samsung TV you'll now be able to flick through channels, boost the volume and navigate menus without having to dive through the couch cushions to find the clicker.

That alone sounds like a fine reason to throw down for Jony Ive's smartwatch.

Allow the **Apple Watch** to be your only **TV Remote** Control.



Glances

Double click the Digital Crown to switch between two most recently opened Apps.

Reset voicemail password

If you forget your voicemail password, you won't be able to set up your voicemail when you upgrade to a new phone or manage certain features. You must reset your voicemail password to regain access to your voicemail.




If you know your existing voicemail password, you can change it in the voicemail system. Follow these steps to change your voicemail password:

- 1. Call the voicemail system:
 - From your wireless phone, press and hold 1 or the Voicemail key.
 - For your AT&T Wireless Home Phone, dial 1 from your connected home phone.
- 2. If prompted, enter your voicemail password.
- If you have new messages, press the * key to skip to the Main Menu.
- 4. In the Main Menu, press 4 for Personal Options.
- 5. Press 2 for Administrative Options.
- Press 1 to Change Password.
- 7. Follow the prompts to enter a 4- to 15-digit password, and then press the # key. You may now end the call.
- If you have Visual Voicemail, access your Visual Voicemail screen and, when prompted, enter the new voicemail password you created.


