Asking websites not to track you

Some websites keep track of your browsing activities when they serve you content, which enables them to tailor what they present to you. Safari can ask sites and their third party content providers (including advertisers) not to track you.

With this setting enabled, each time Safari fetches content from a website, Safari adds a request not to track you but it's up to the website to honor this request.


Block cookies and other website data

Handoff


New iPhone 6 owners who also have a late model iPad should set up Handoff. This allows phone calls to the iPhone 6 appear on the iPad. Calls can be answered on the iPad either as a speakerphone or with headphones.

In addition to phone calls, in the next few weeks text messages will appear on the iPad, too. Once OS X Yosemite ships, calls and text messages will also appear on Macs that have been upgraded to that version of OS X.


To enable Handoff, there's a process in Settings to make sure it works.

- 1. On the iPhone 6, in Settings tap on FaceTime.
- 2. Toggle FaceTime off and on, leaving it on.
- 3. Toggle iPhone Cellular Calls off and on, also leaving it on.
- 4. Go back to General settings and tap "Handoff & Suggested Apps".
- 5. Toggle Handoff off and on, leaving it on.
- Reboot the iPhone.
- 7. Repeat for every iPad you wish to use with Handoff.

To use Handoff, make sure both devices are on the same Wi-Fi network (LTE doesn't work). They should both be logged into the same Apple ID, too.





"Hey Siri"

Users of Siri are used to long-pressing the Home screen to get her attention before asking a question. It's turned off by default (at least it was on my iPhone 6 Plus) but you can set Siri to listen for the phrase "Hey Siri".

Once configured that's all you need to do to ask Siri a question.

To turn on Hey Siri:

- 1: Got to Settings > General > Siri
- Turn on "Allow Hey Siri"

Speak the phrase or question for Siri as usual.

Note that Hey Siri only works when the iPhone is plugged in. This is to prevent excess battery drain that would be caused by always listening for "Hey Siri" on battery power.

Save Battery

- 1. Settings > Wi-Fi > Off.
- Settings > Bluetooth > Off.
- Settings > Privacy > Location Services > Off.
- 4. Settings > General > Cellular > Enable 3G > Off.
- Settings > General > Cellular > Enable LTE > Off.
- 6. Settings > Sounds > Vibrate on Ring & Silent > Off.
- 7. Settings > Brightness & Wallpaper > Auto-Brightness > Off.
- 8. Settings > Mail, Contacts, Calendars > Fetch New Data > Off.






Want to know if your best friend is calling without ever looking at the phone? Buried in the contact settings, a fun option lets you create custom vibration patterns for your contacts.


To do it, go to **Contacts**, choose a contact, and tap **Edit** in the upper-right corner.


