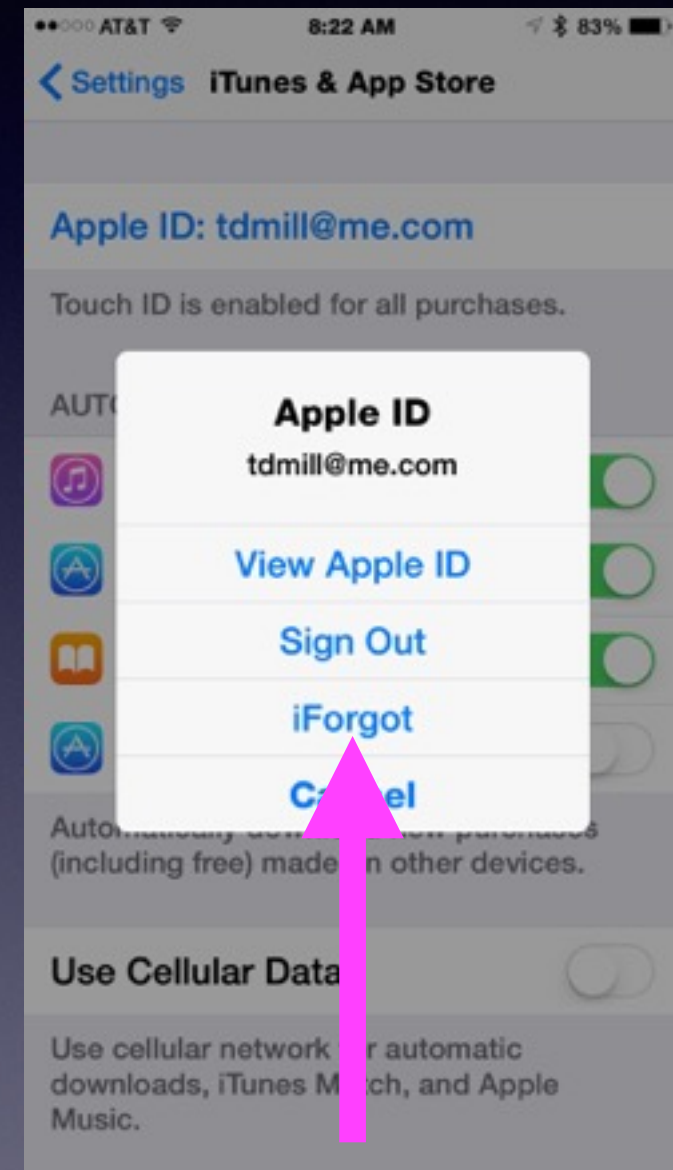
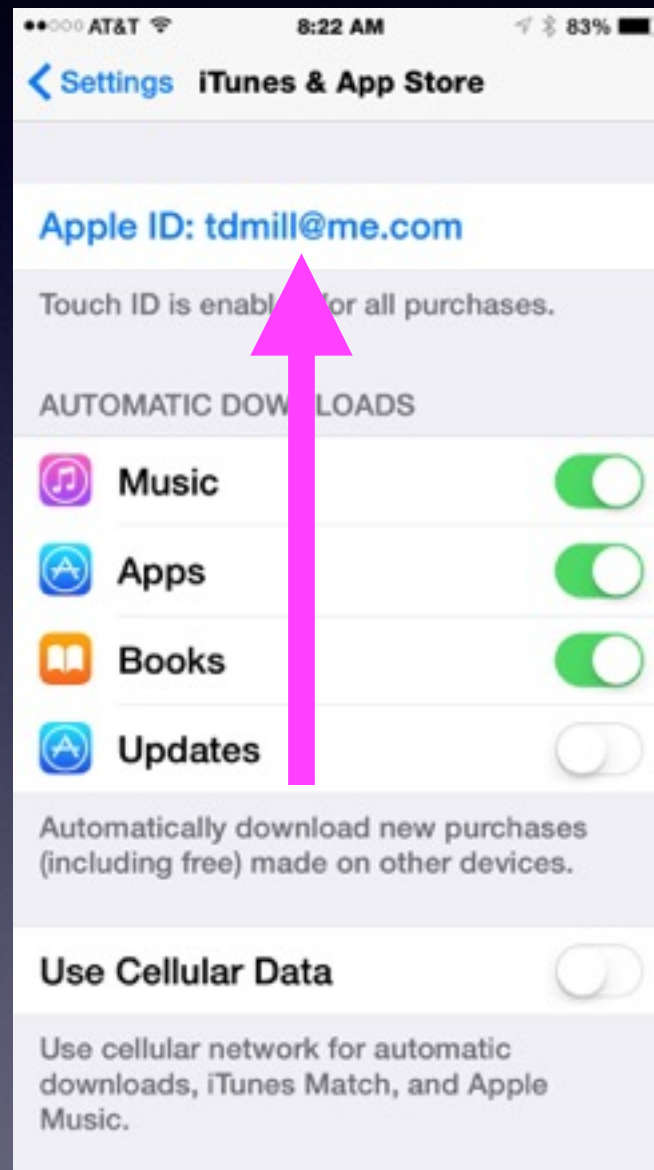


Keep Your iPad or iPhone Screen From Going Black!

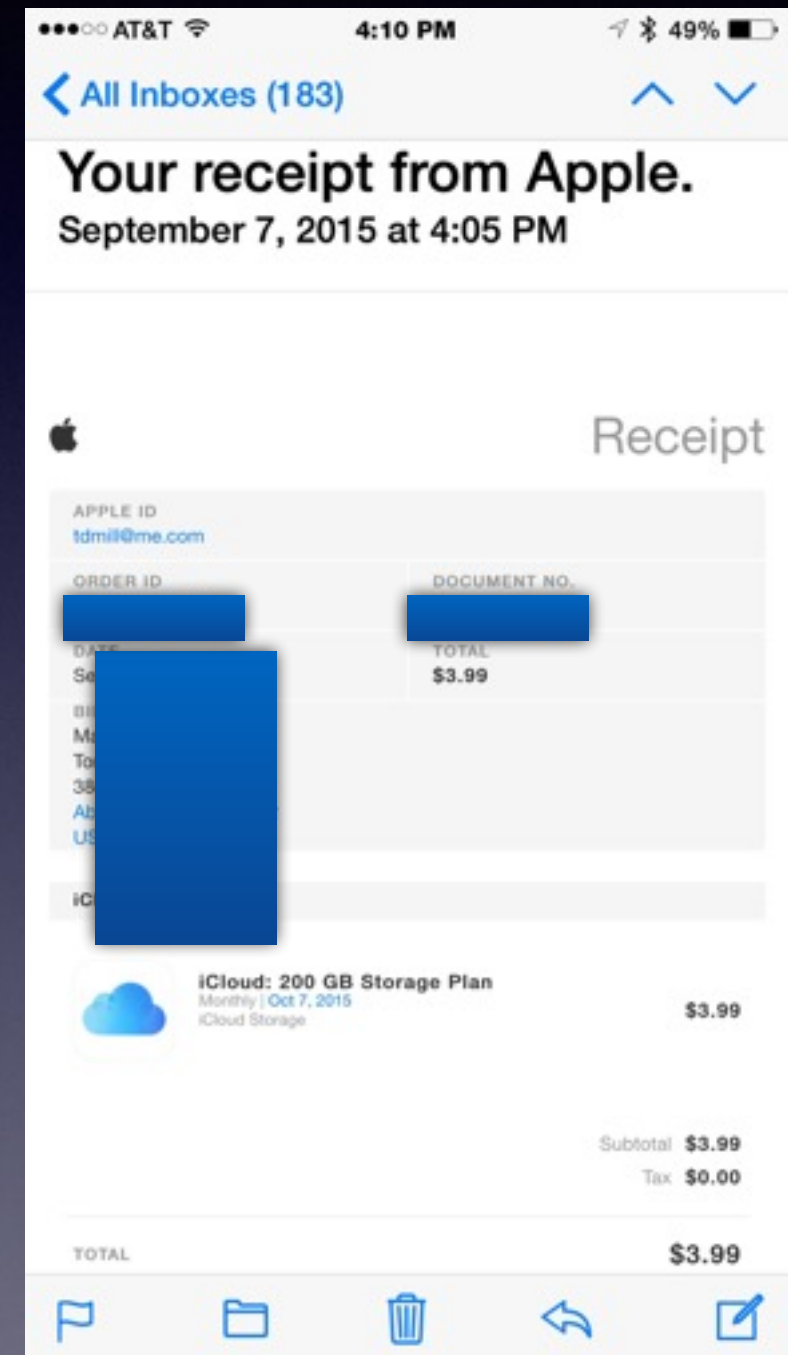
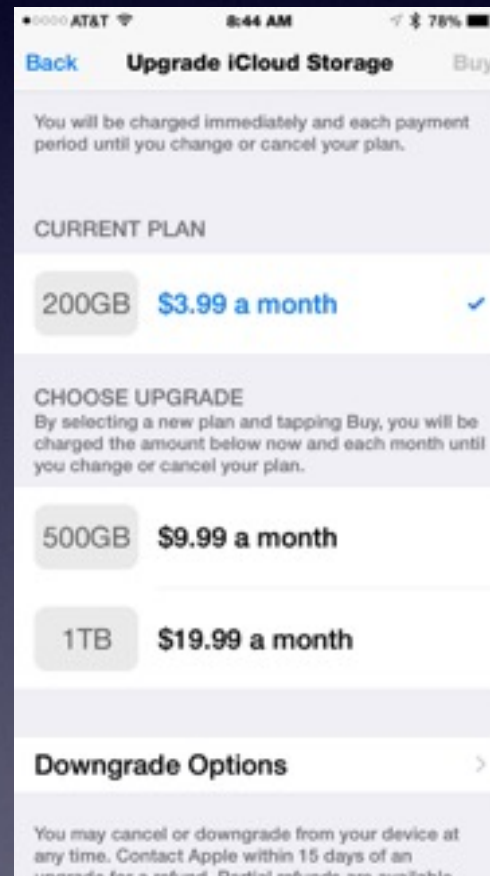
Storage Is Almost Full!

The Mailbox Is Full!

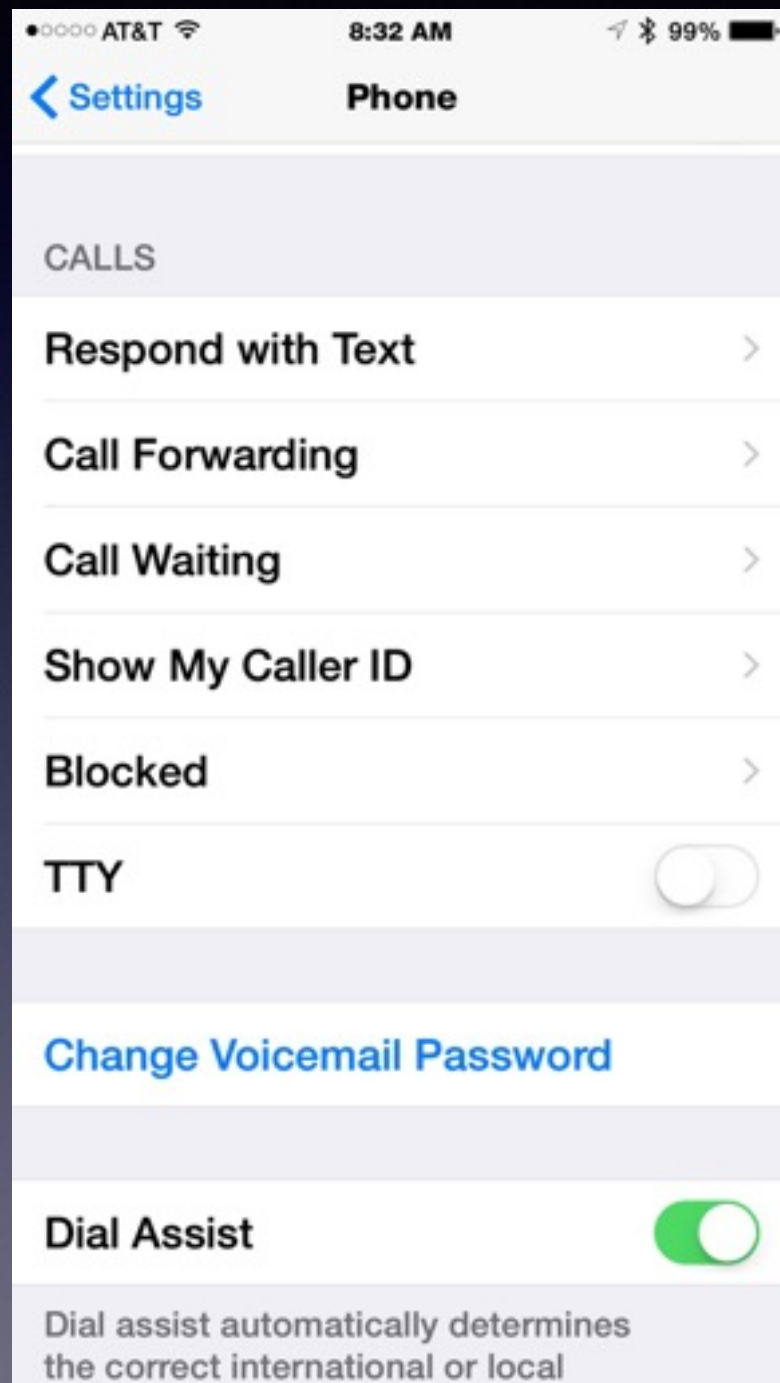
Or the “Person has not set up his or her mailbox!”

Set Up Your Voicemail!



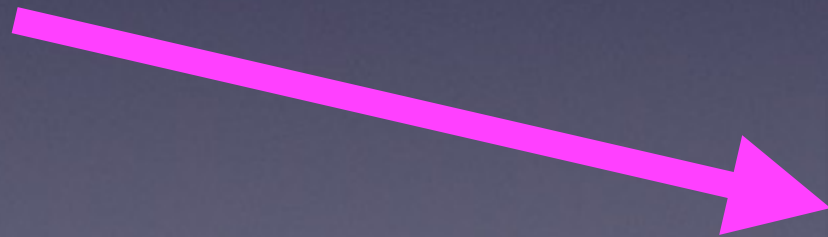
**From your wireless phone,

Why Own an iPhone and/or iPad?

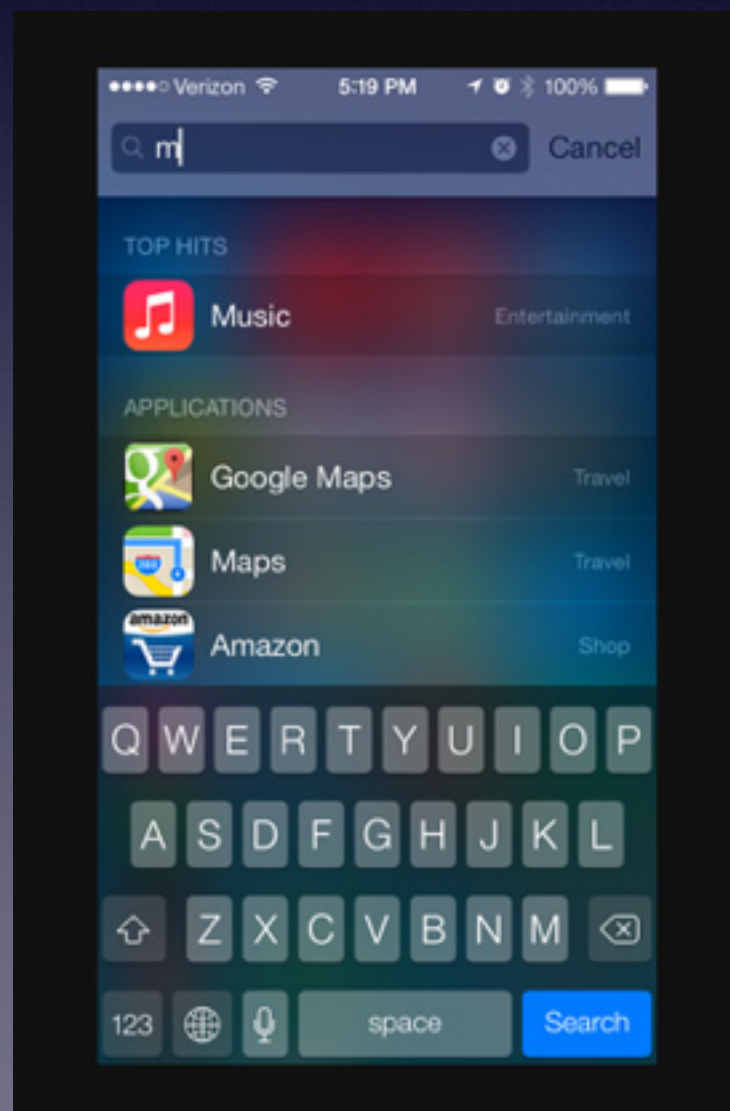
Communication: calling, texting, emailing

It will do things for me: take pictures, guide you to a location, see family members with FaceTime. It is an alarm clock.

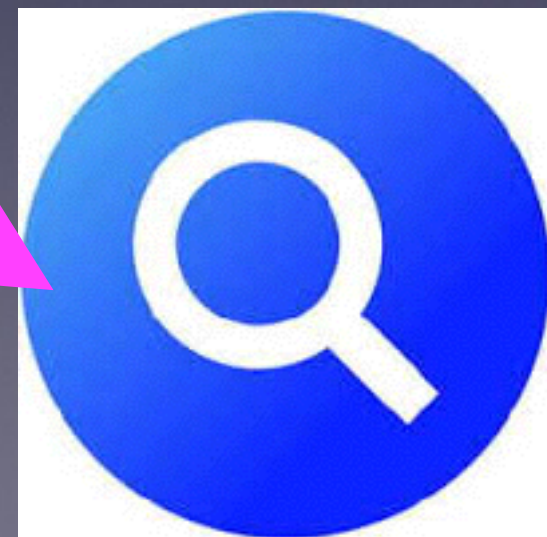
Information: Internet, Google searching

Search with Spotlight!

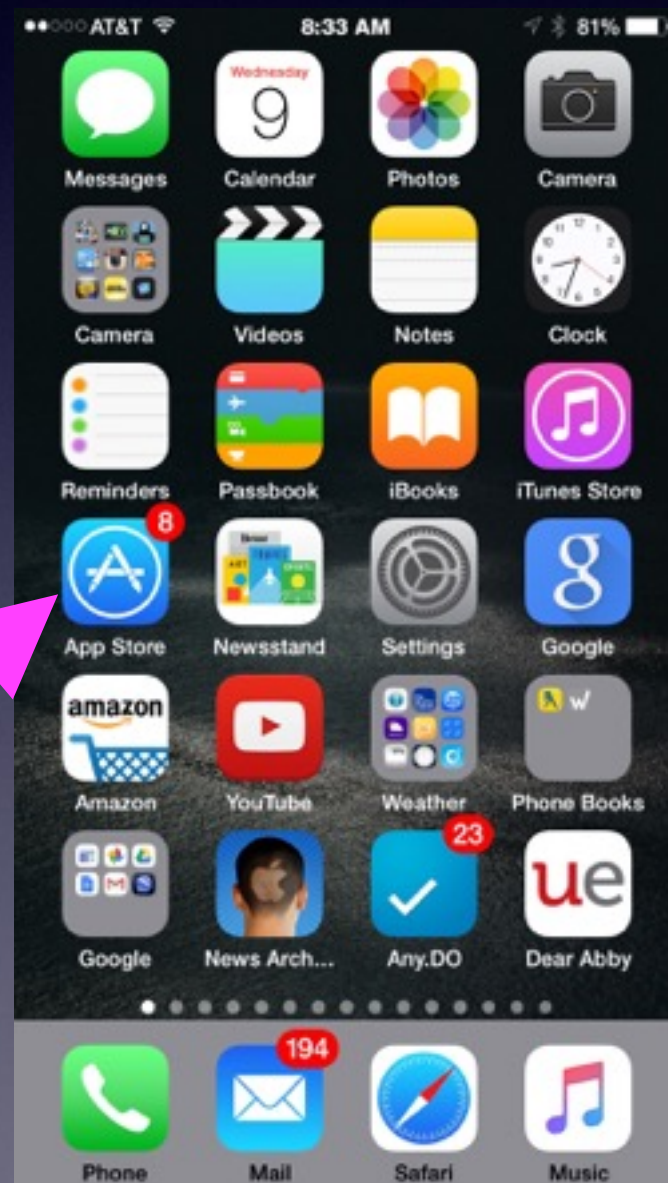
Search for anything: contacts, apps, mail, messages, music, pictures, etc.
