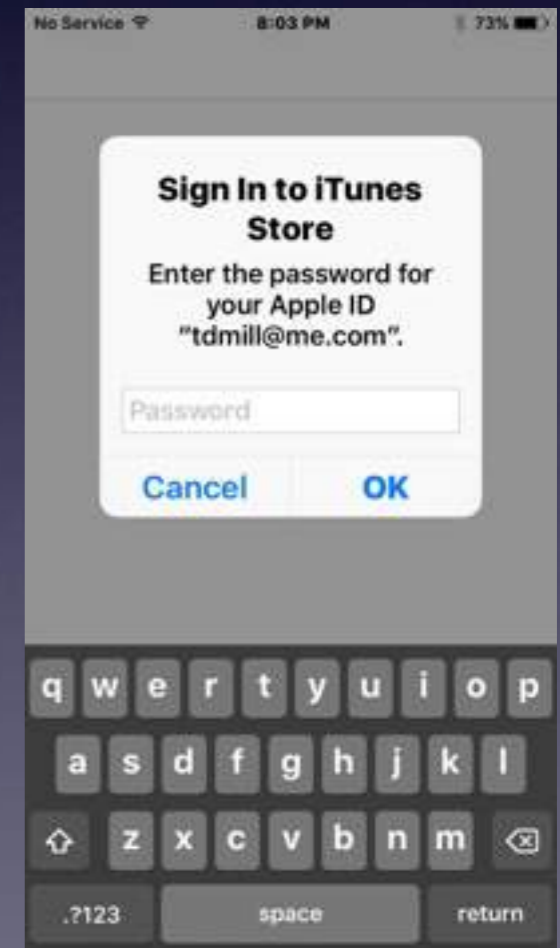
# How To Be An Annoying Cellphone User!
