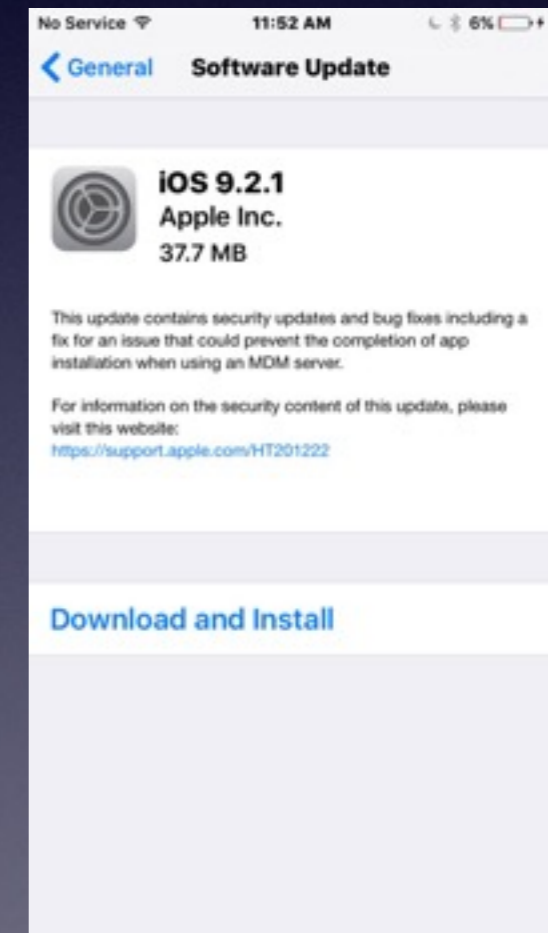
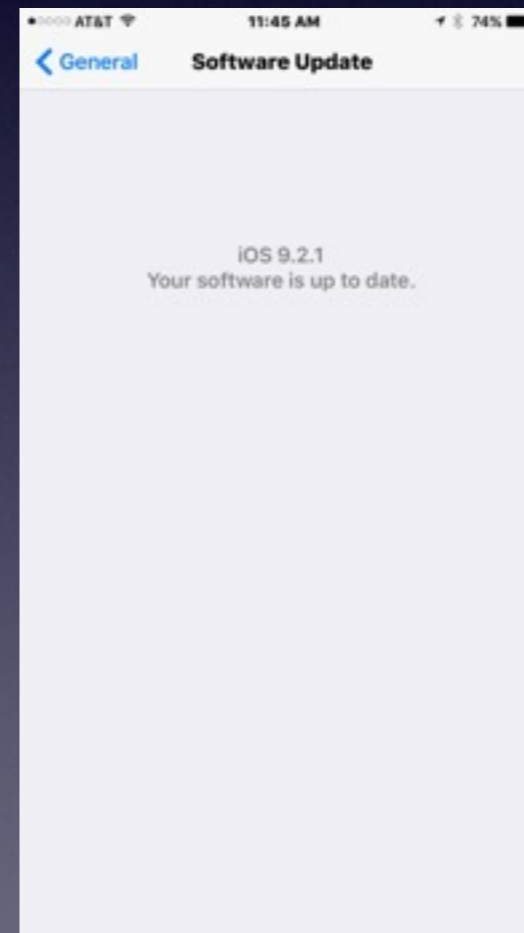
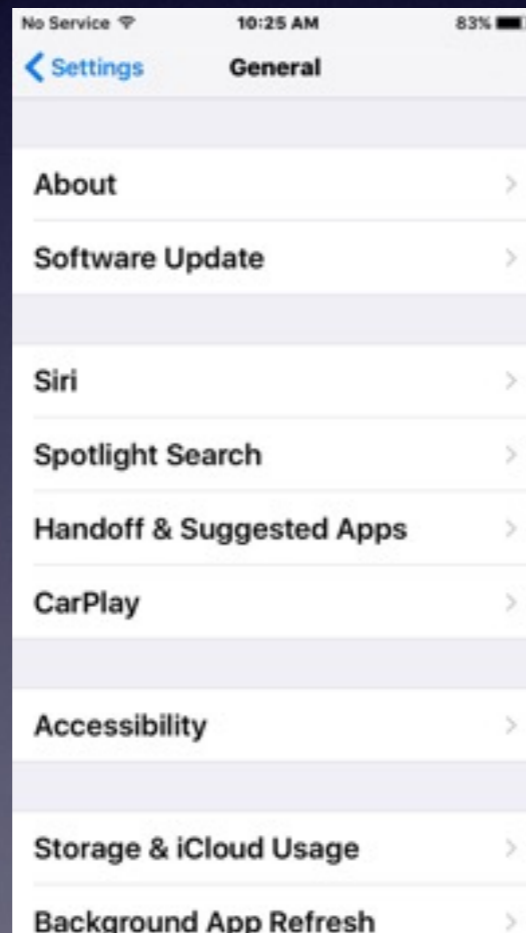


# Software Update

Don't do an update at the library!

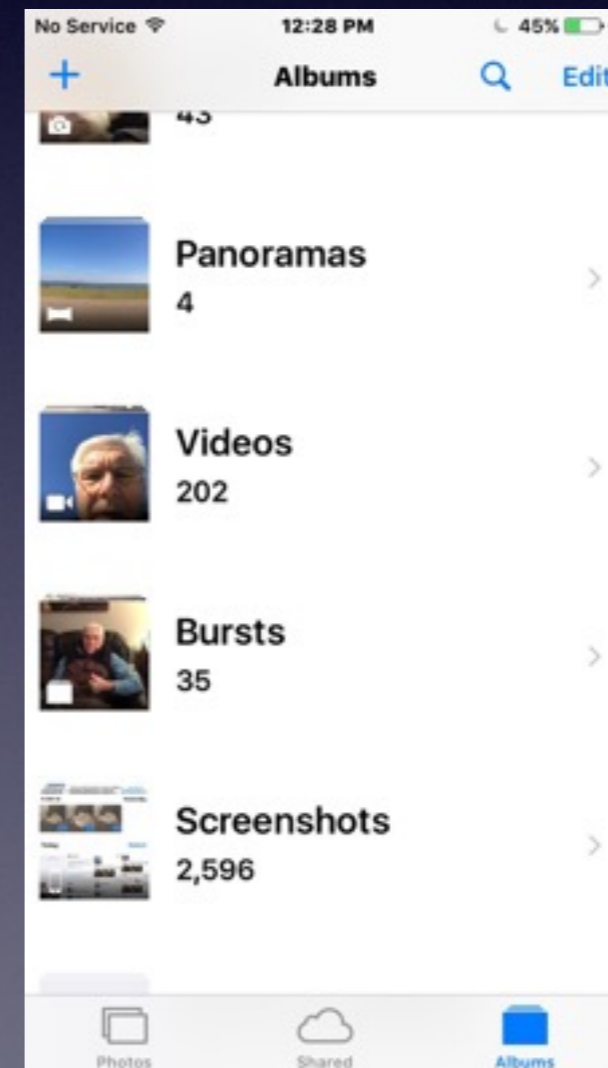
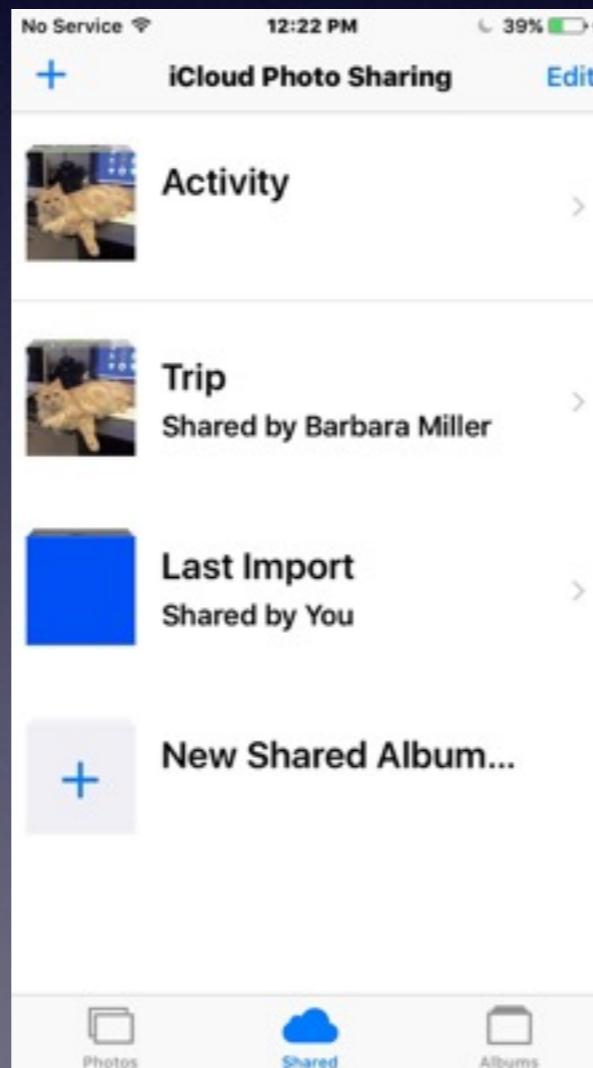
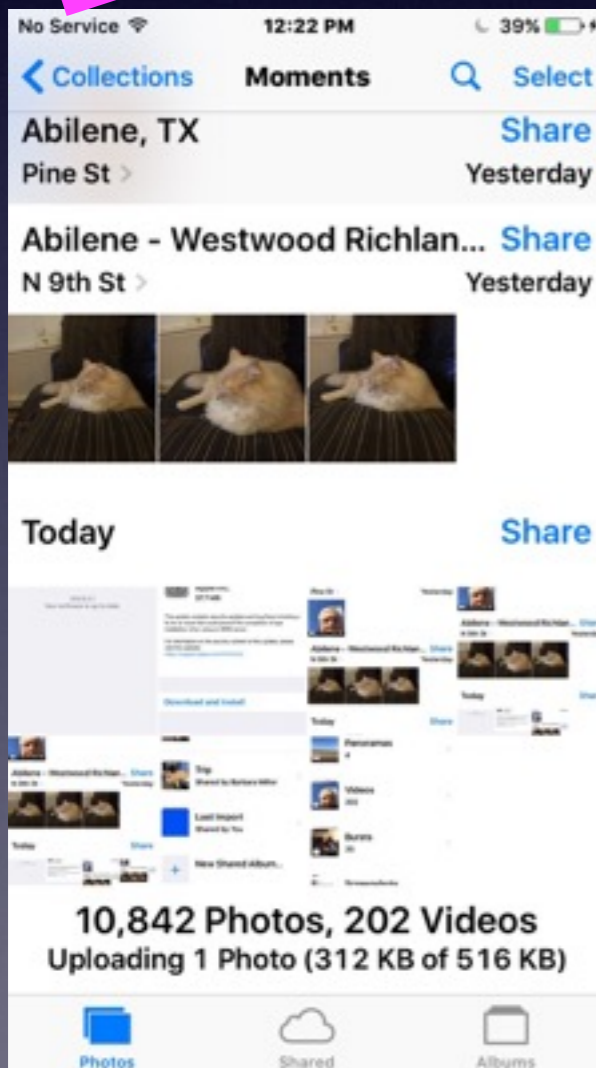

**But must be done for each app individually.**

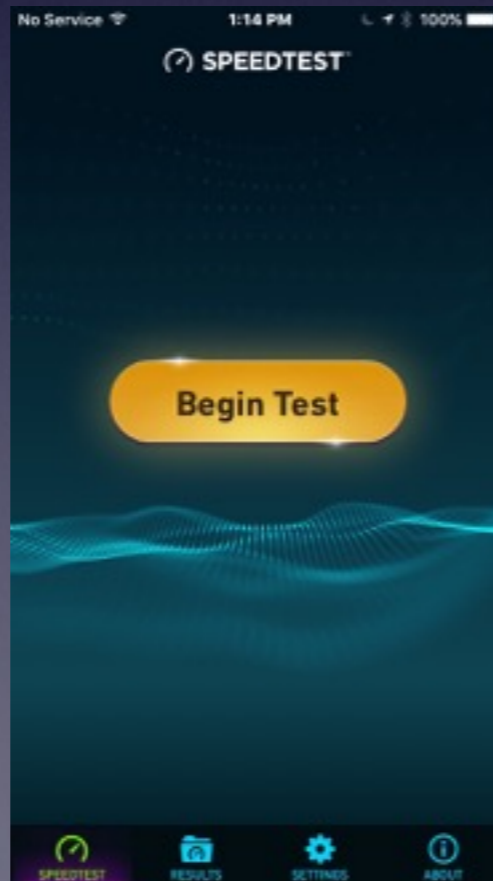


# SpeedTest App

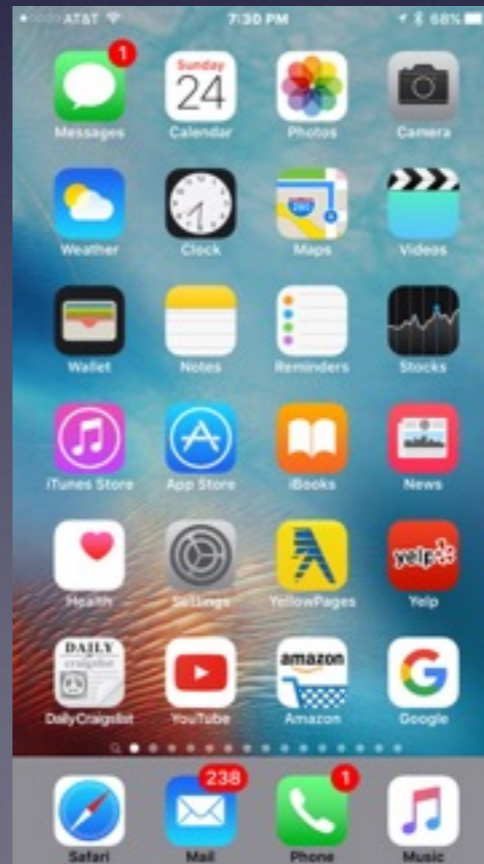
