6. **Use the Camera App to photograph everything.**



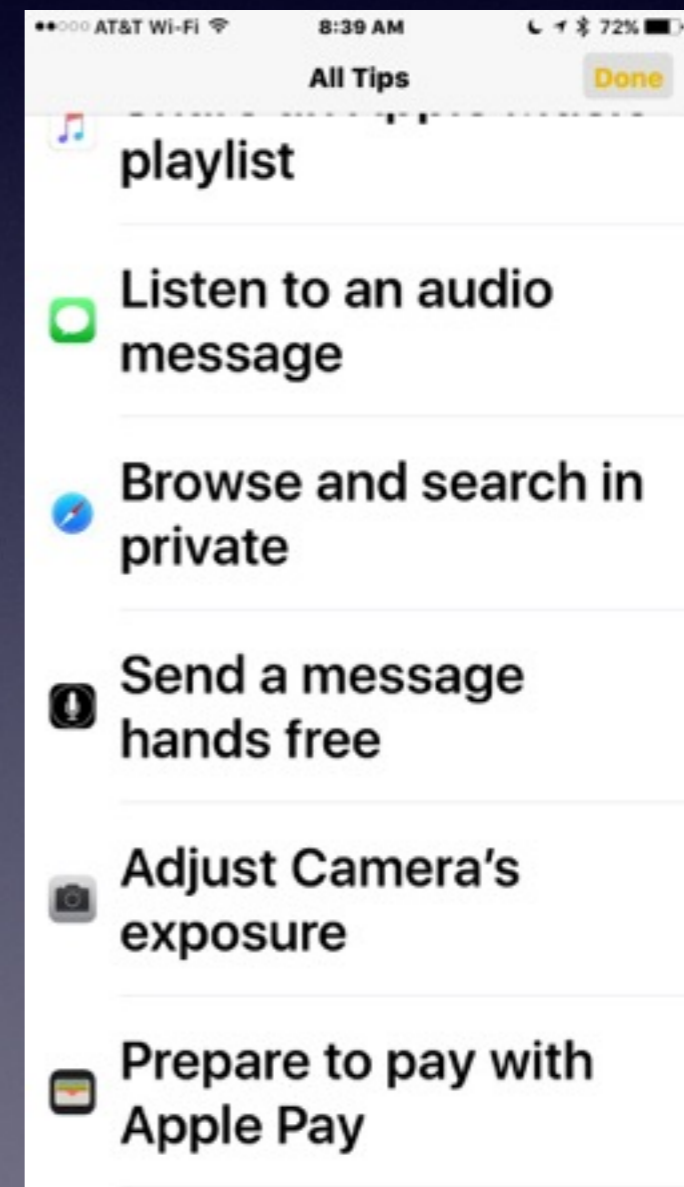
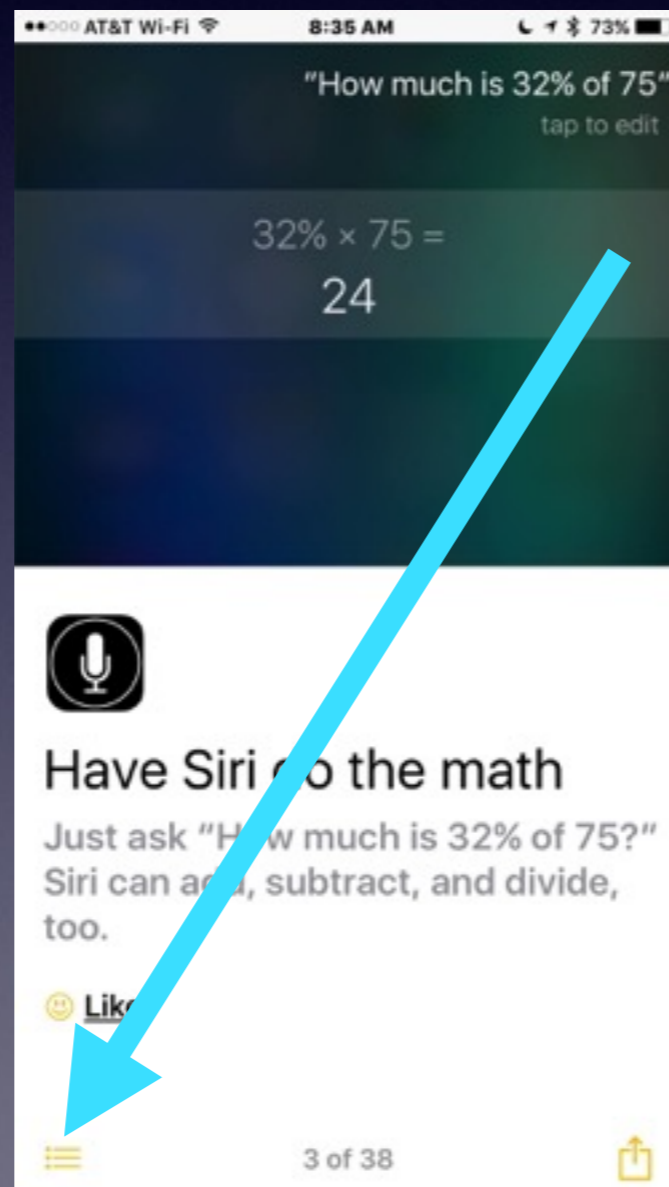
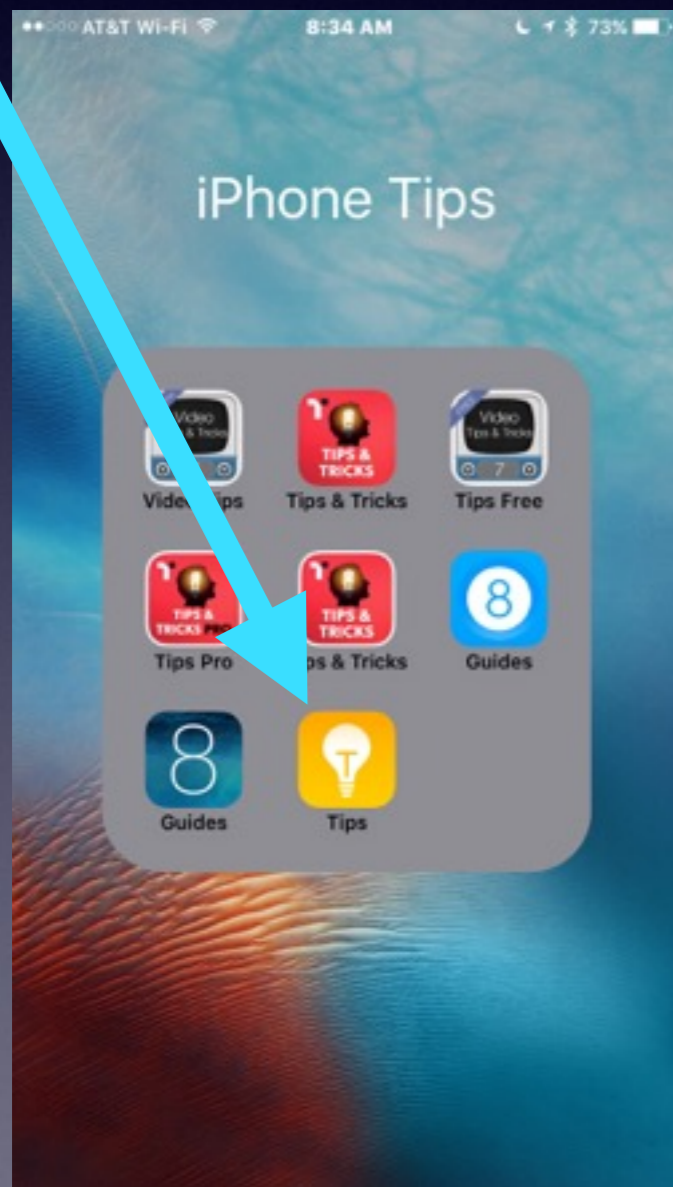

**From Lock Screen: Finger print will unlock iPhone**

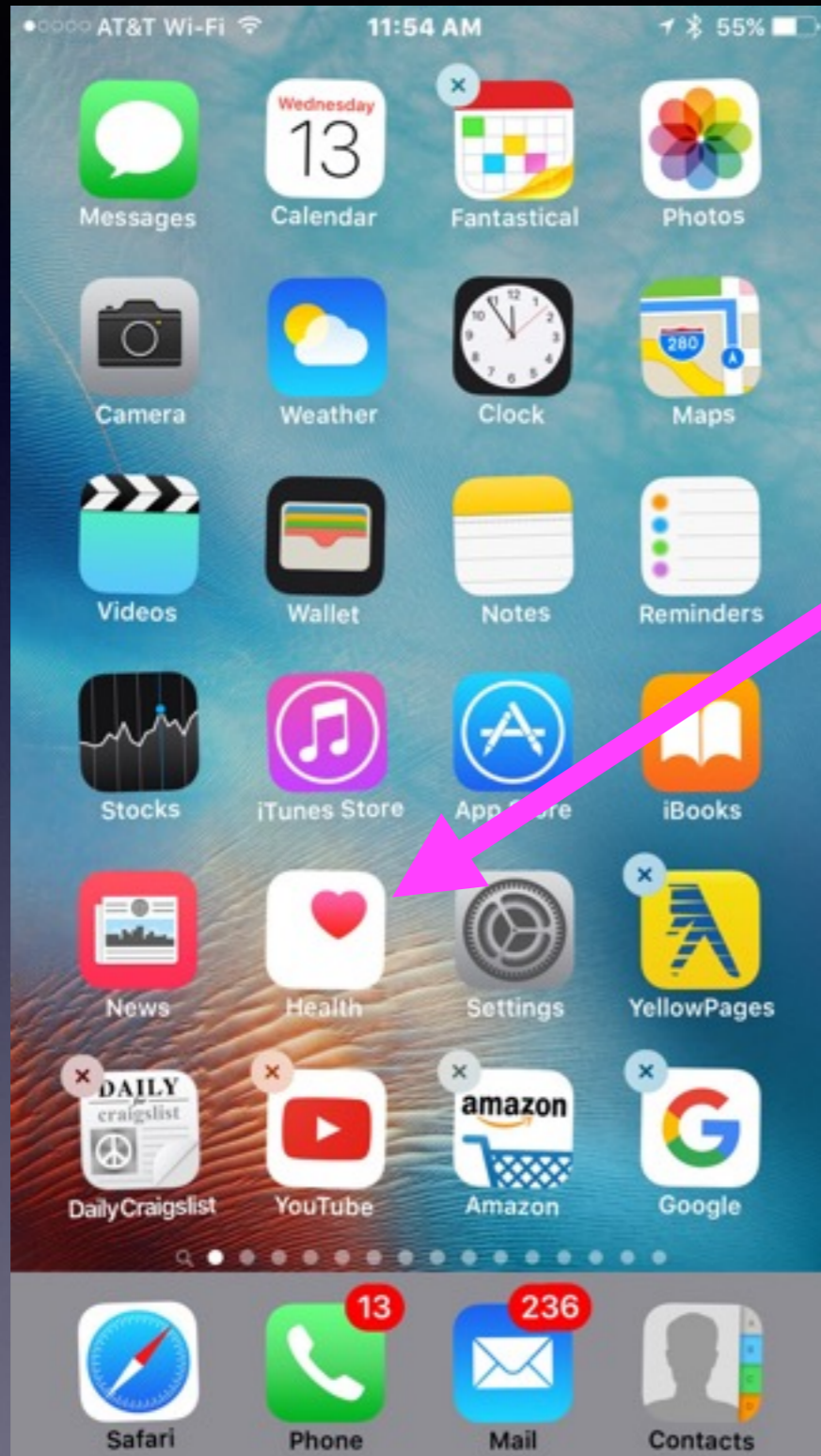
**Resizes Home Screen: Reachability**

**Double Tap while on Lock Screen will bring up iPod Controls**

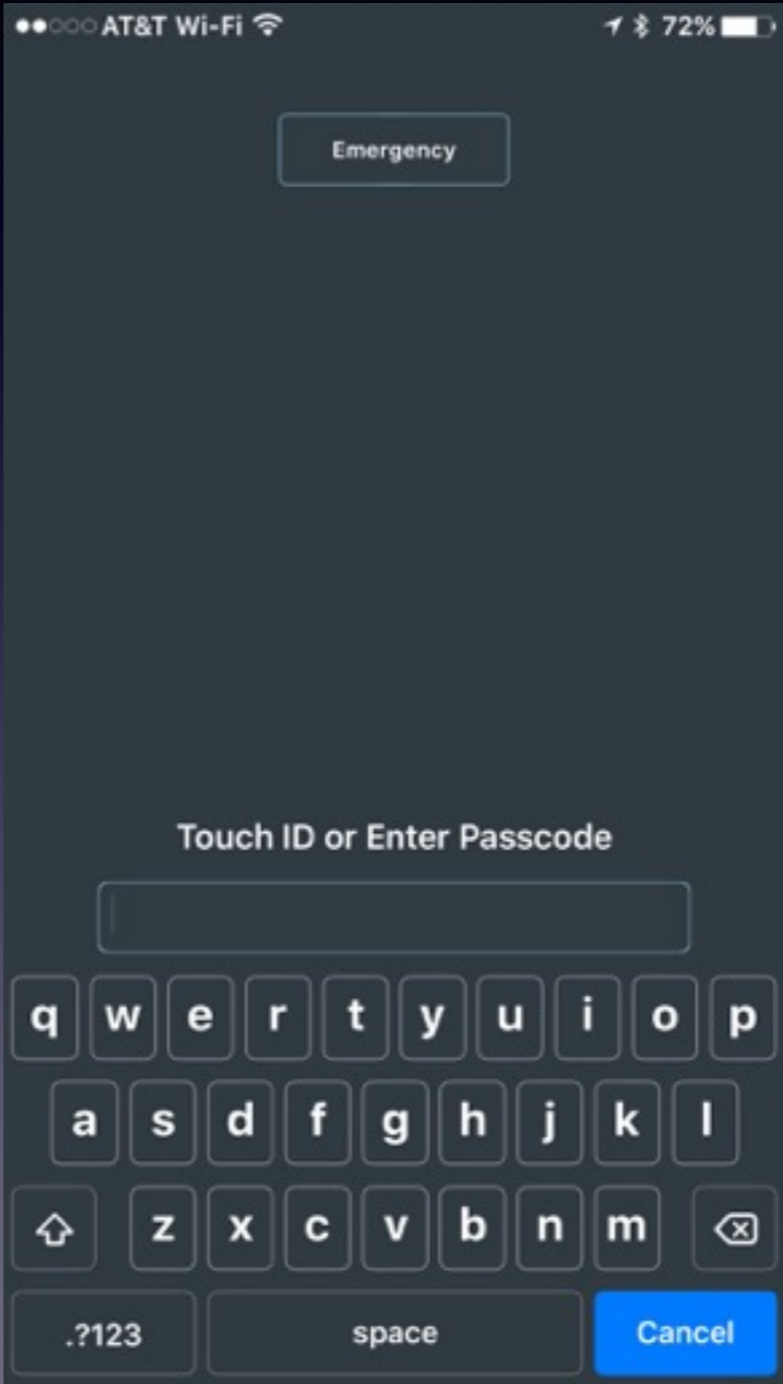

# How to Move Apps!

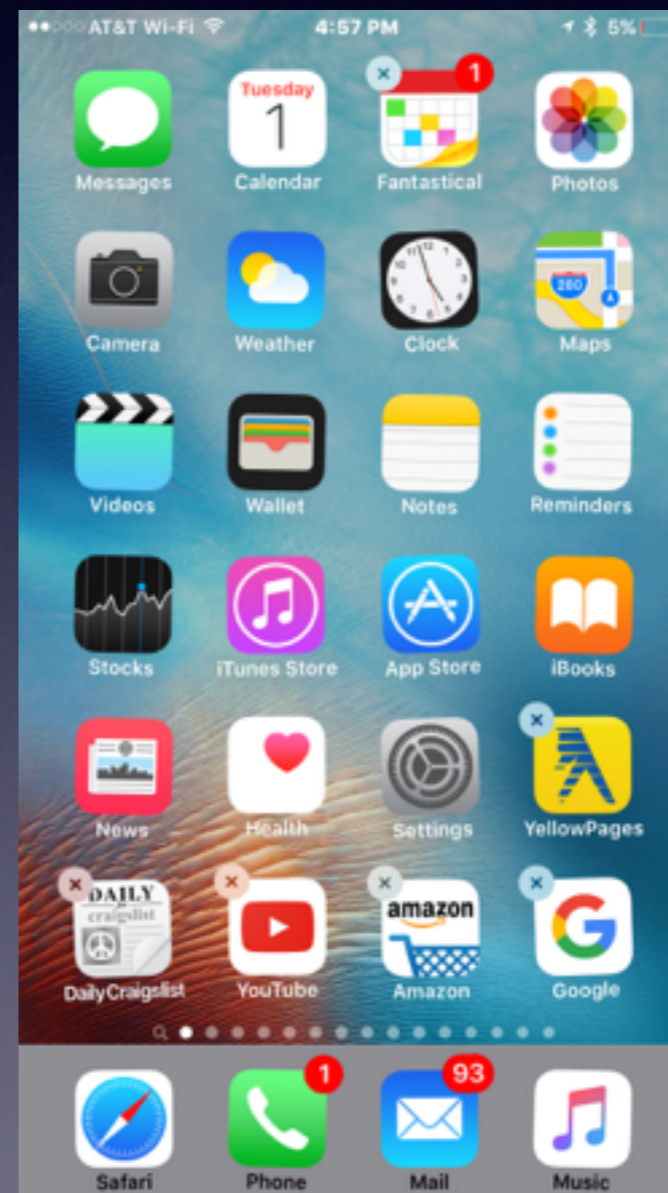
Hold [press] any app until all the apps “wiggle.”

This is the normal mode.

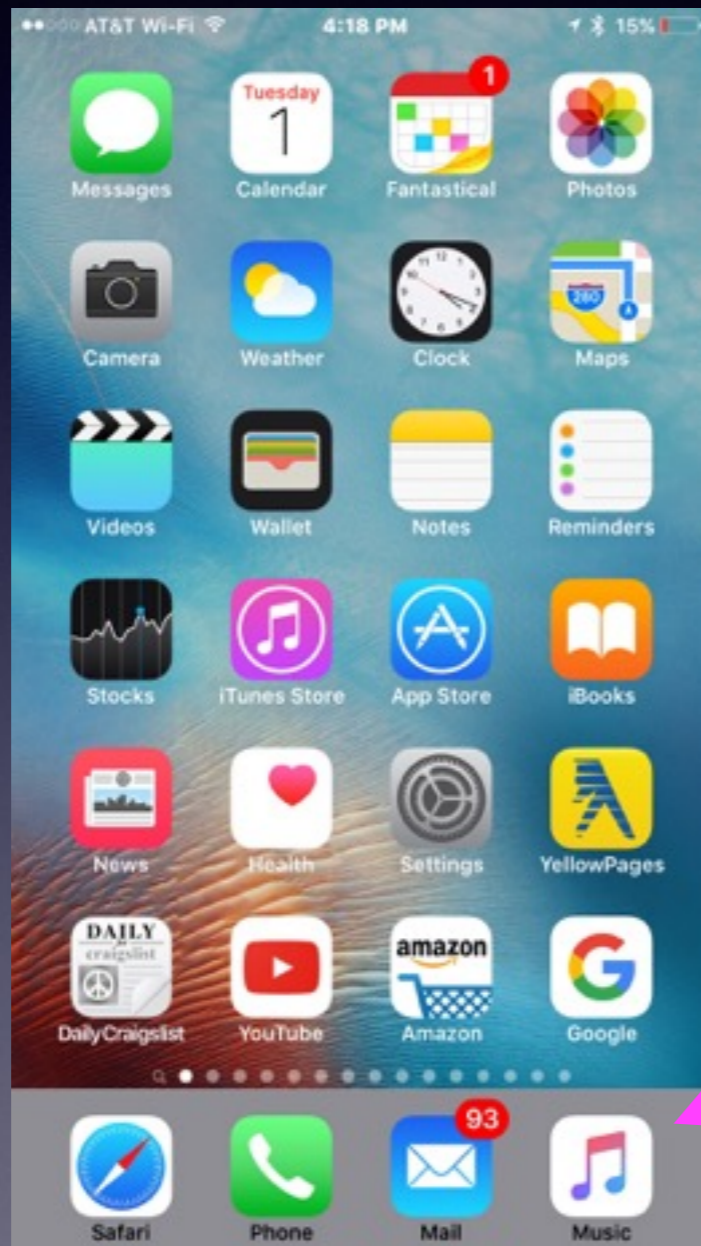


Notice the “Xs” and the “wiggle”

You can move apps that wiggle.



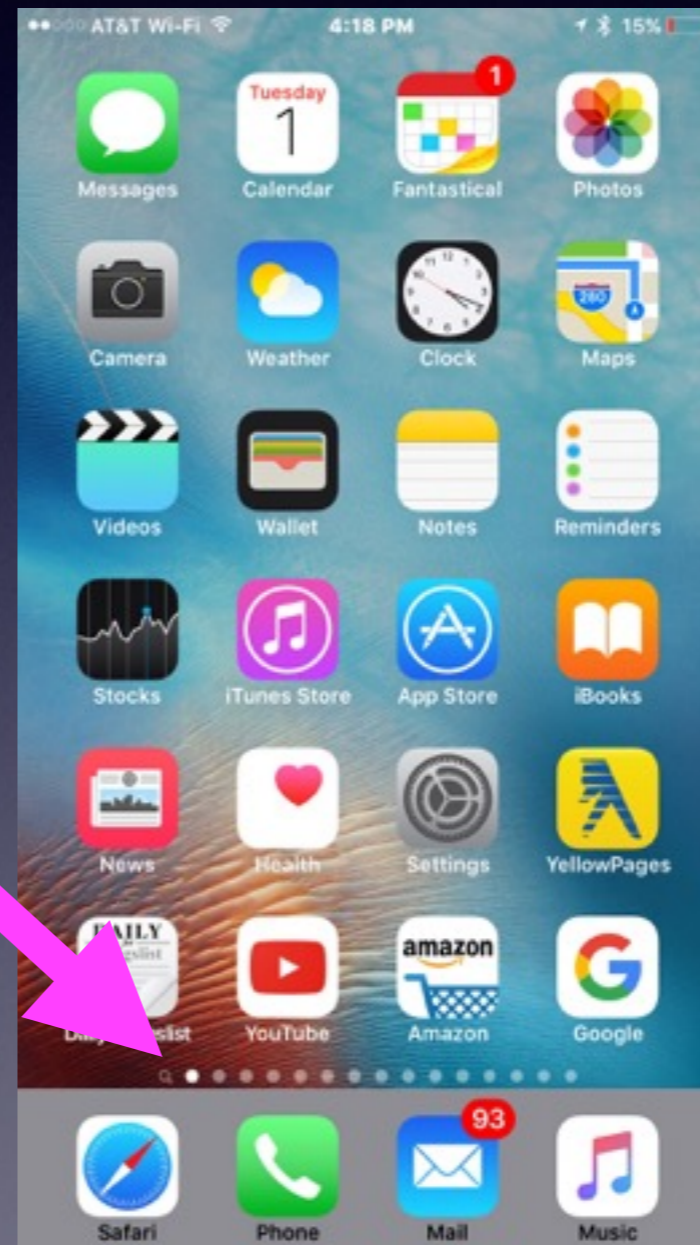


