Two Ways To Delete Apps


We need to clean our devices of unused “stuff”!



You cannot delete Apple Apps that were installed by Apple when you received your iPhone or iPad.

If upon pressing an app for two seconds it doesn't have an “X” next to it... You cannot delete it!

Delete By “Usage”





Manage the iPhone or iPad storage!

What Is “Find My iPhone?”

It's two things: An App and a Setting.

You Won't Have To Download These Two Apps!



Find Your Missing iPhone or iPad.

You can use someone's app!





Use The Camera & Photos App

Photograph all your personal info.
Save all personal data in an album in the Photos App.

Is My Personal Info Safe On My iPhone / iPad?

Your passwords and important notes are safe in the Notes App.

Why?

The notes are locked behind a door which is locked with your iPhone / iPad passcode.

You can add a second lock!

Apple knows you will want a double amount of protection!
