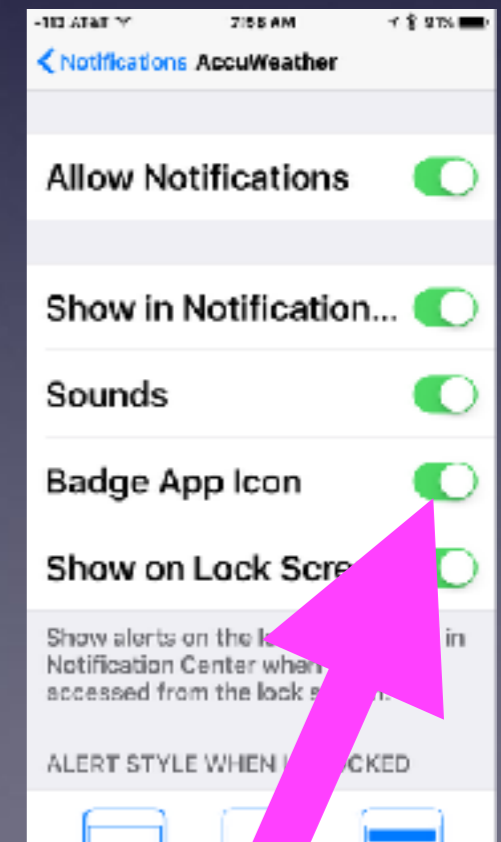
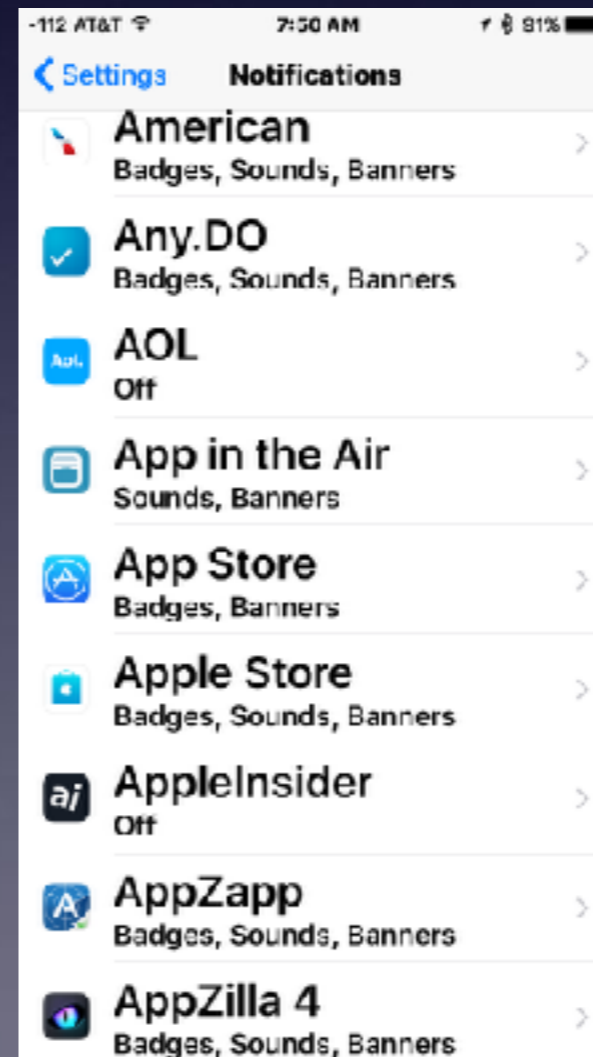
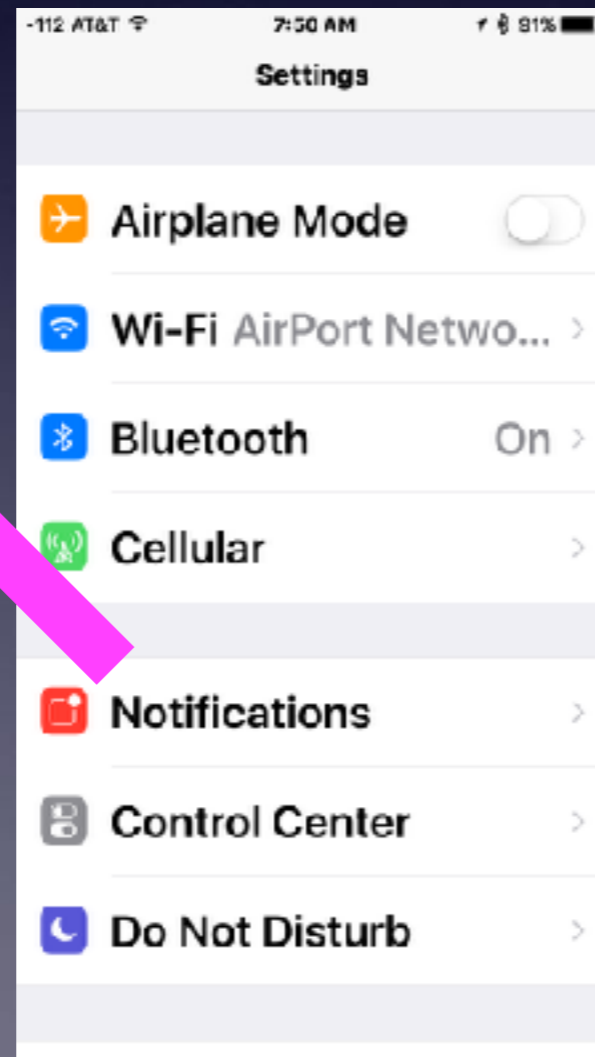
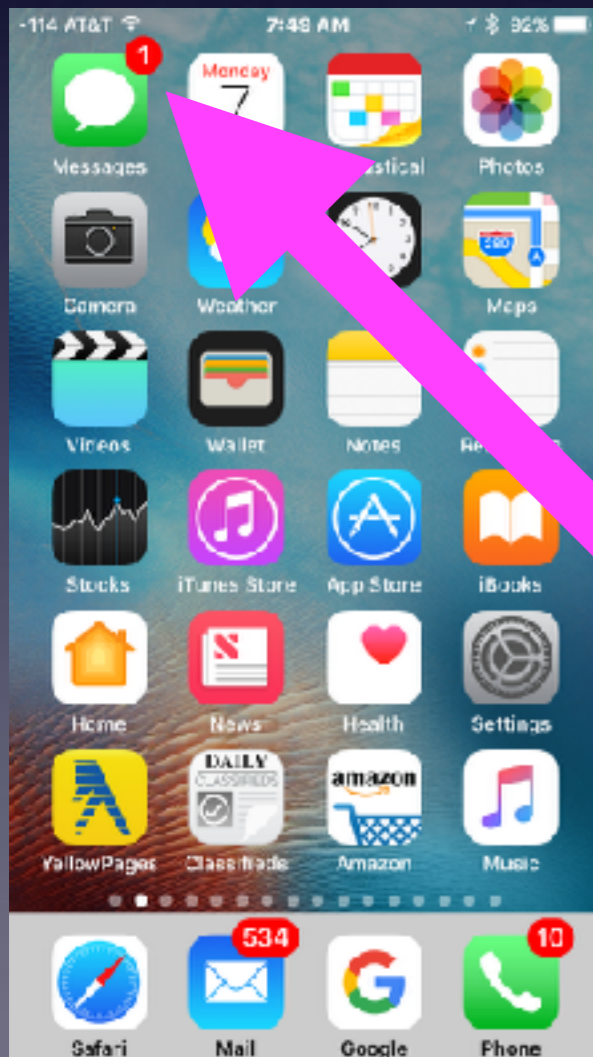


# What Are the Red Circles with Numbers?

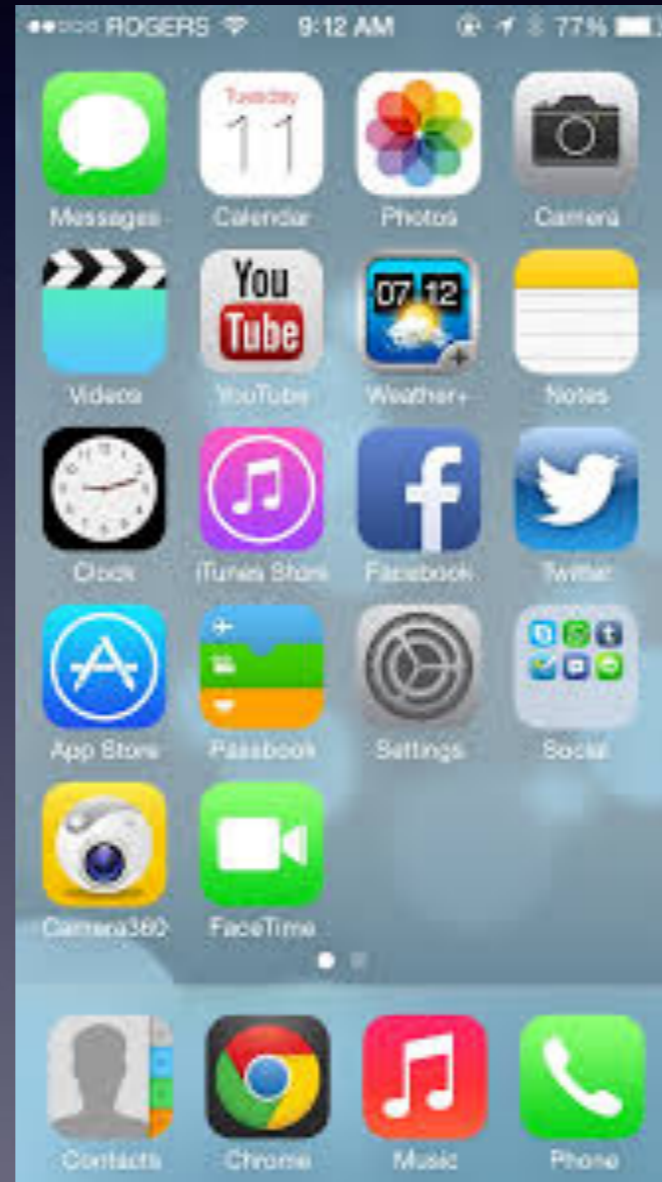
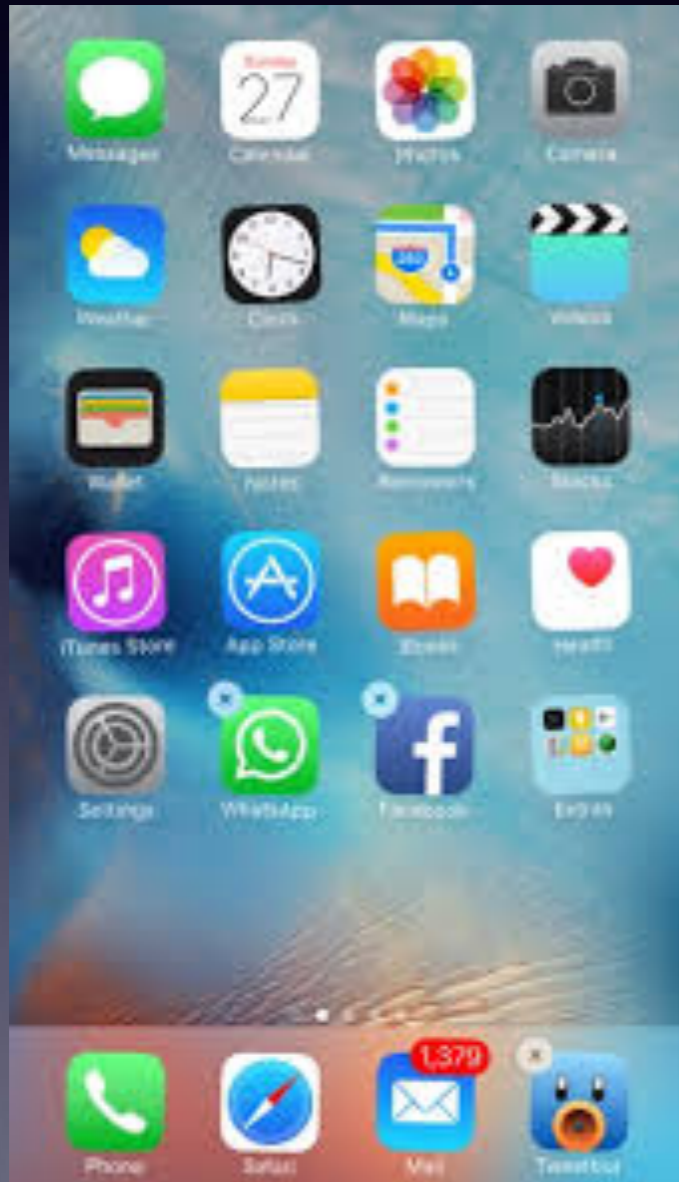
Red badge app icons!

# What Is The Lock Screen?

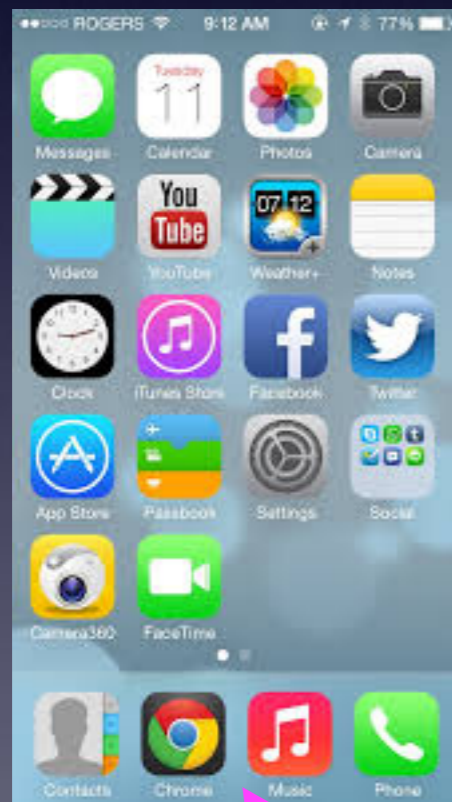
It is the black screen and/or the screen which asks you to “Press to unlock”.

# 6 Functions of the Home Button

Wake up and get ready to unlock iPad or iPhone.

Summon Siri. Long press.

Take me back to my main [first] Home Screen.

Unlock your iPhone or iPad with Touch ID & Fingerprint.

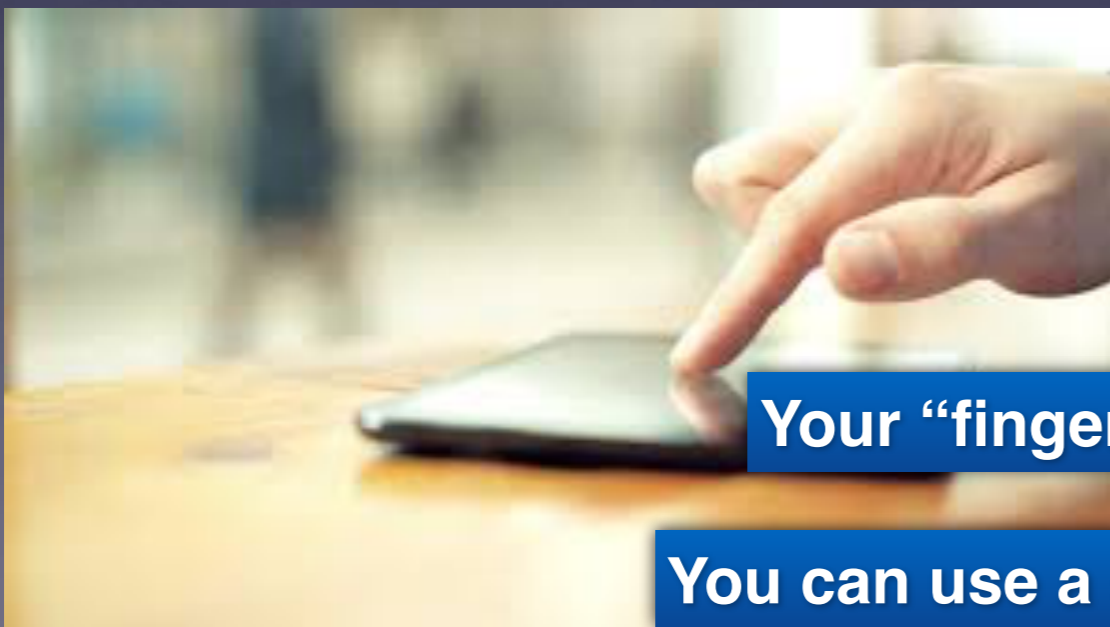
Two rapid presses opens the Task Switcher.

Three rapid presses opens the Magnifier.

# Can I Use A Mouse With My iPhone & iPad?



New iPad Pro uses a digital pencil!



Your "finger" is the mouse!

You can use a stylus as a mouse!





# Problems With Things Not Working!

Reset your iPhone and/or iPad. Perhaps Siri is not working! Perhaps the Camera app won't take a picture...!

Use the Sleep/Wake and the Volume Down button!



Let off the two buttons when you see the Apple Logo.

Not the Sleep/Wake & Home Button until you see the Apple logo!

Used to take a photo of the current display!



# When one App Is Not Working!

App not working is stuck on the Home Screen

Power off holding the Sleep/Wake button.

Notice the “Slide to power off” message.

Continue holding “slide to power off”...

Then press the Home Button

# “Stuck App” Cont.

Force quit an app on IOS device!

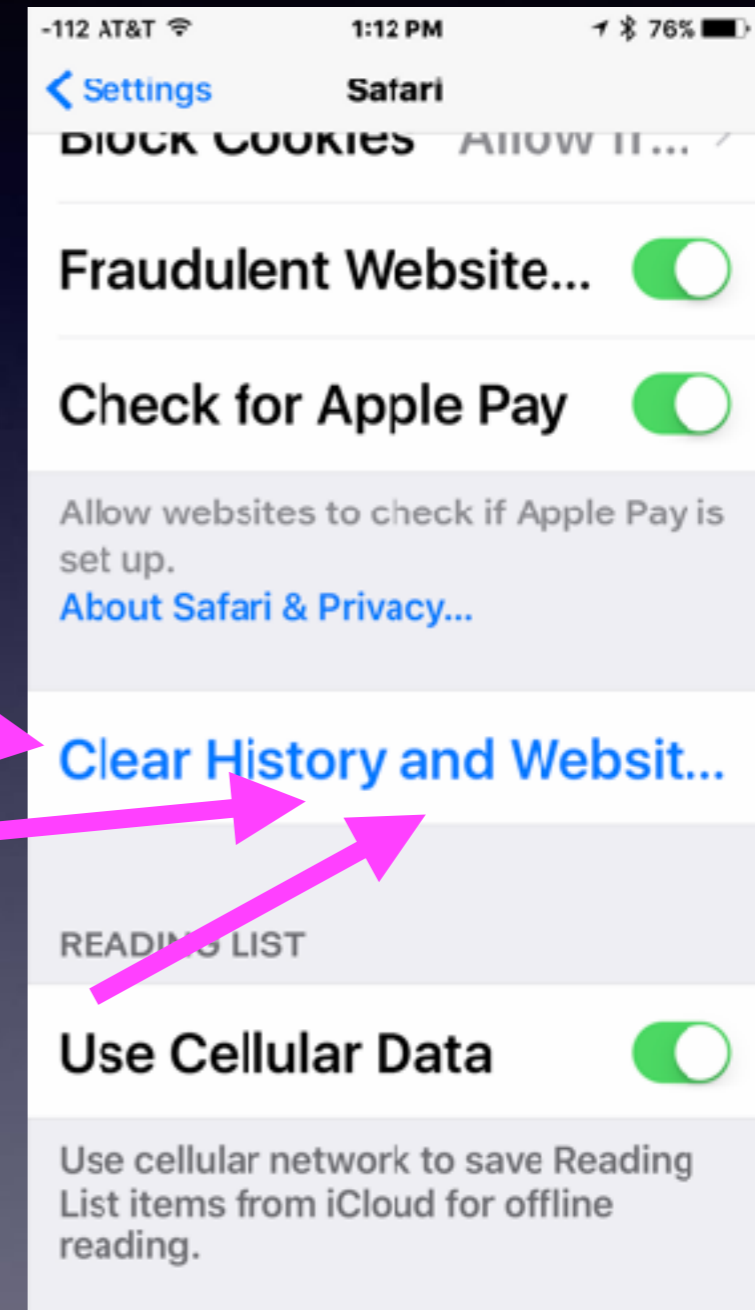
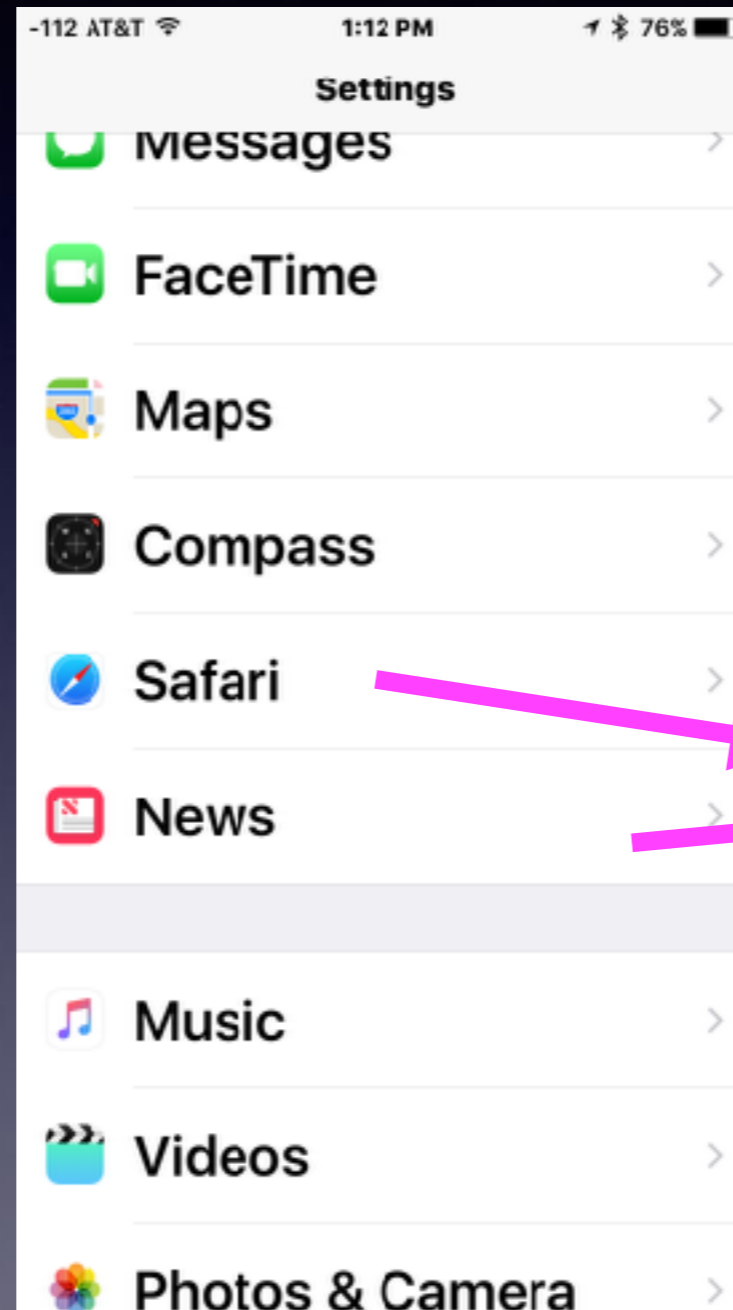
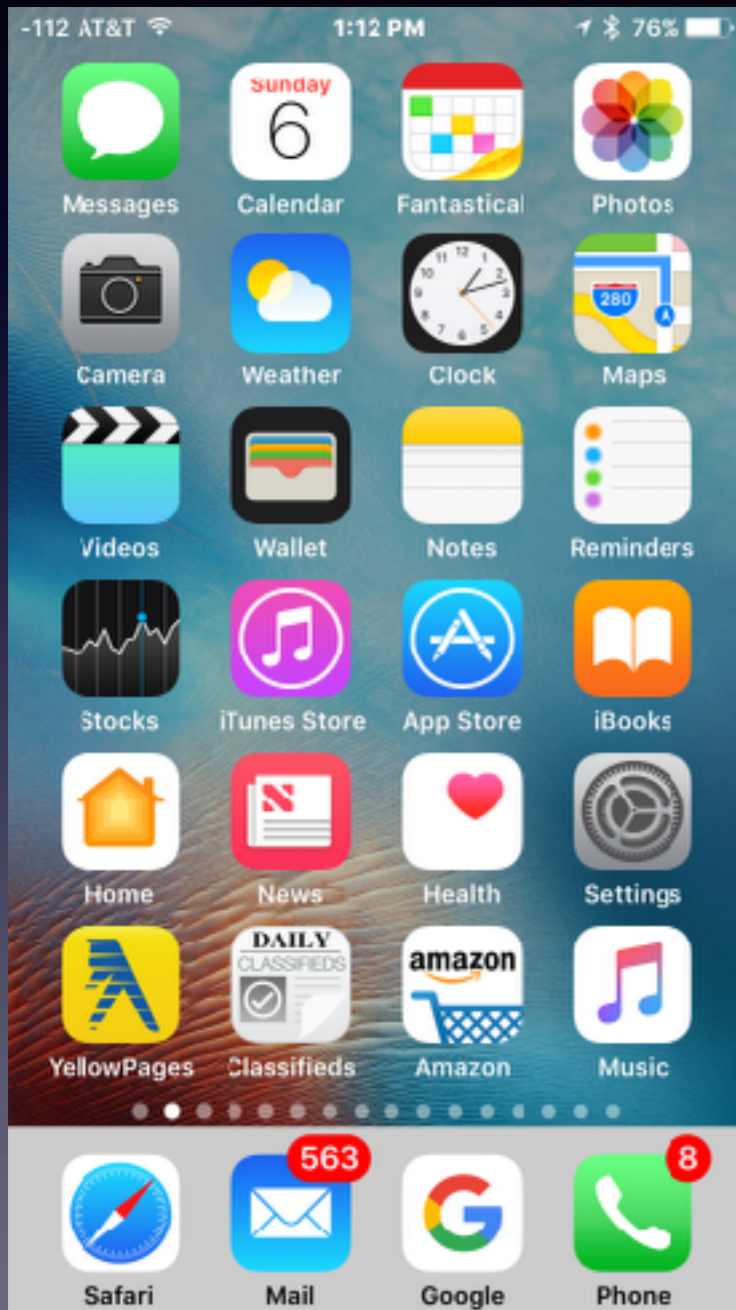

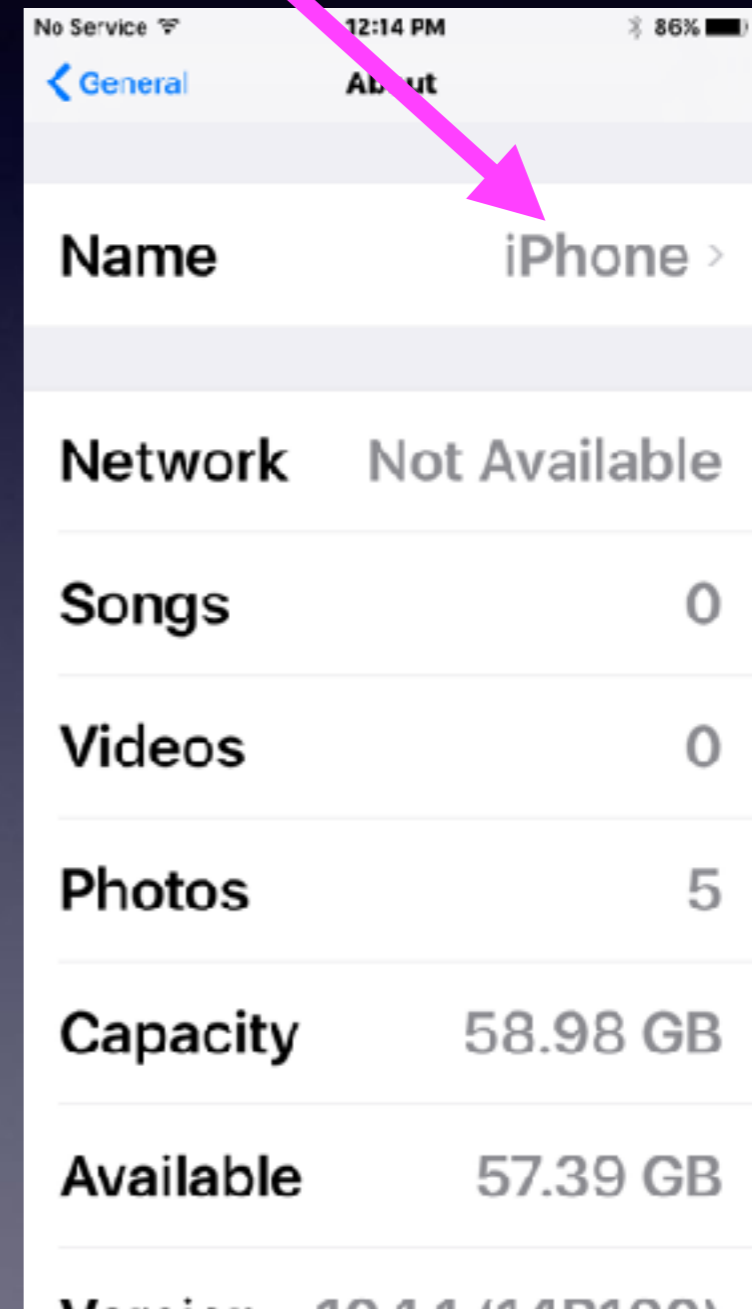
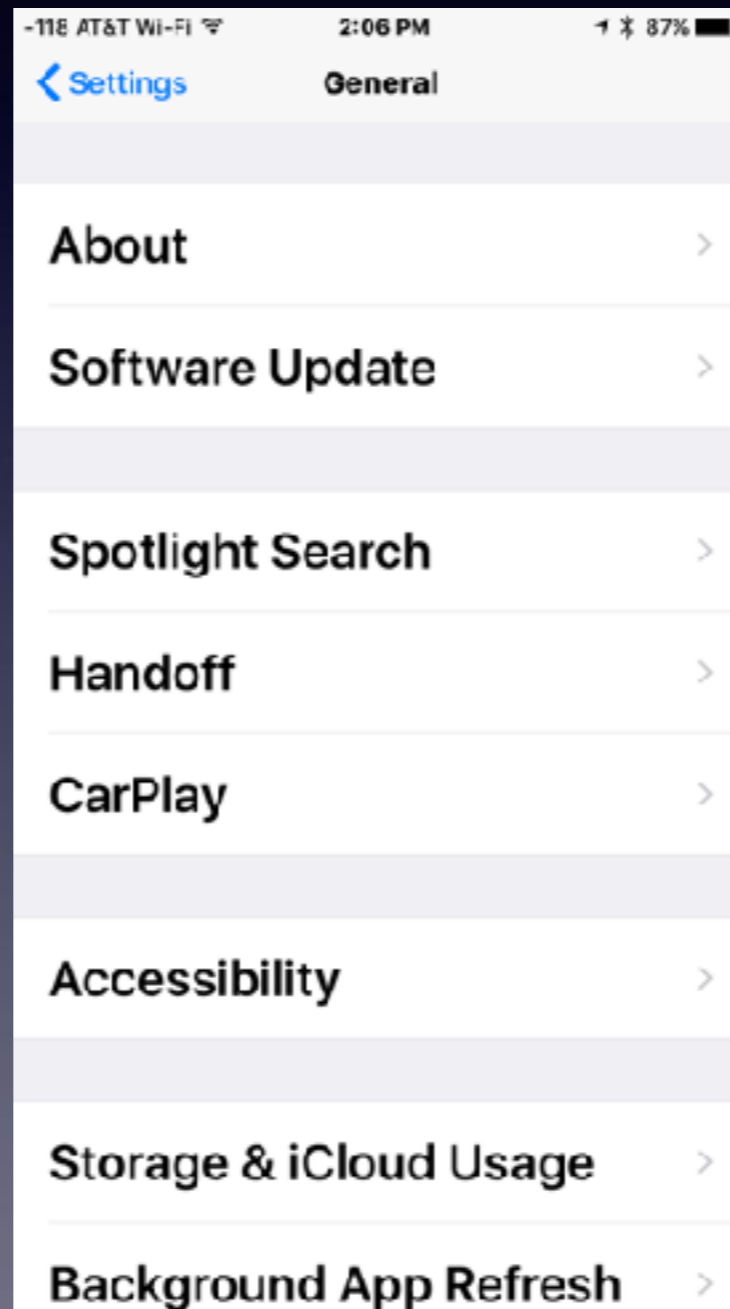
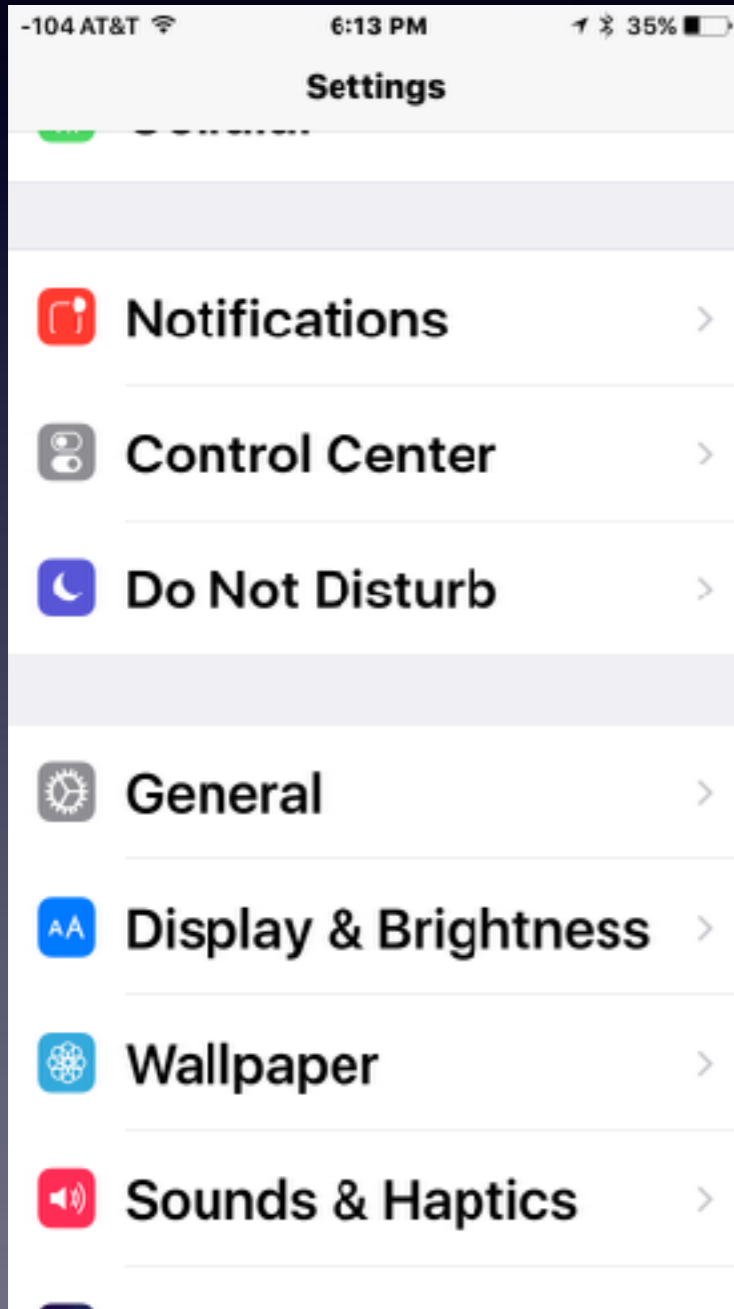


# Safari, Pinterest, News, etc. Not working!

The Internet comes to your device via a “pipe” which can clog!

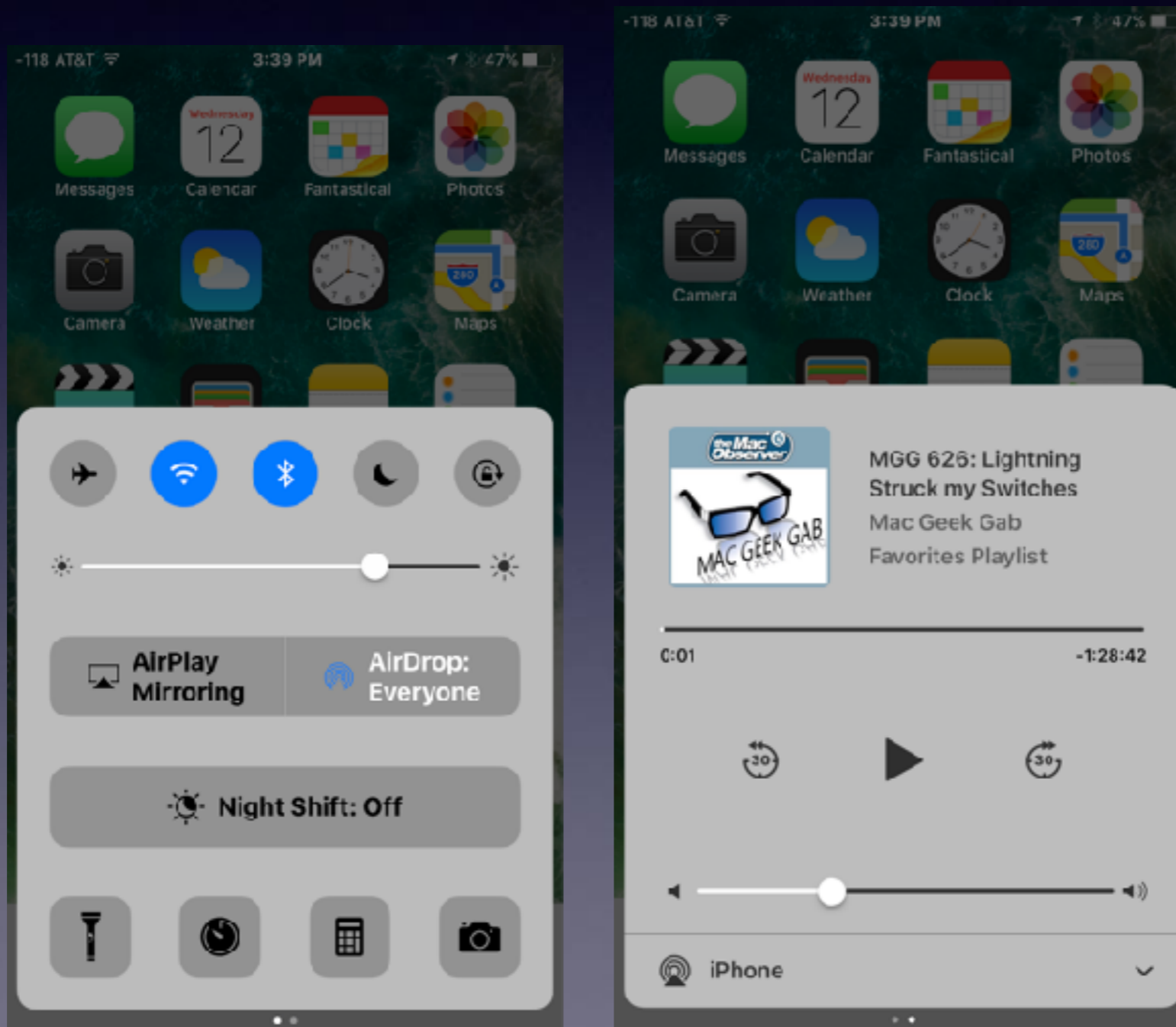

# What Is Airplane Mode?



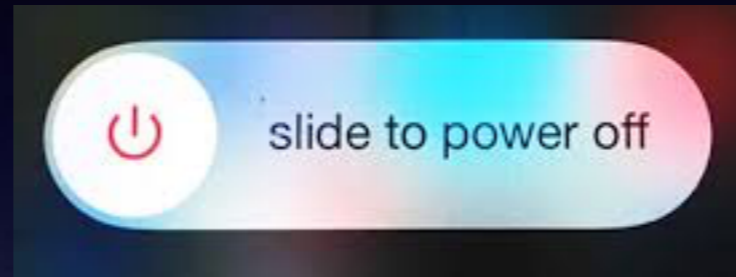
# I'm Not Flying. What Good Is Airplane Mode?

FAA is relaxing its restrictions and Airplane Mode may not be around much longer!

1. Saves battery while allowing you to take pictures and play your music.
2. Speeds up charging. Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, GPS and location services are turned off. These things use battery power and drain energy.
3. It allows one to avoid distractions. Next best thing to putting your iPhone in the trunk. i.e. S 11th and Oldham Lane.



# The “Power Off” Button!



This button has two names: “power off” and “sleep/wake”.

One long press = Slide to power off.

One quick press = black “lock” screen!

# Sleep / Wake Button

Sometimes the Power Off Button is called the Sleep/Wake Button!

Depress briefly to “Lock Screen.”

Hold down until “Slide to power off.!”



# How Do I Take A Picture Of What Is On The Screen?

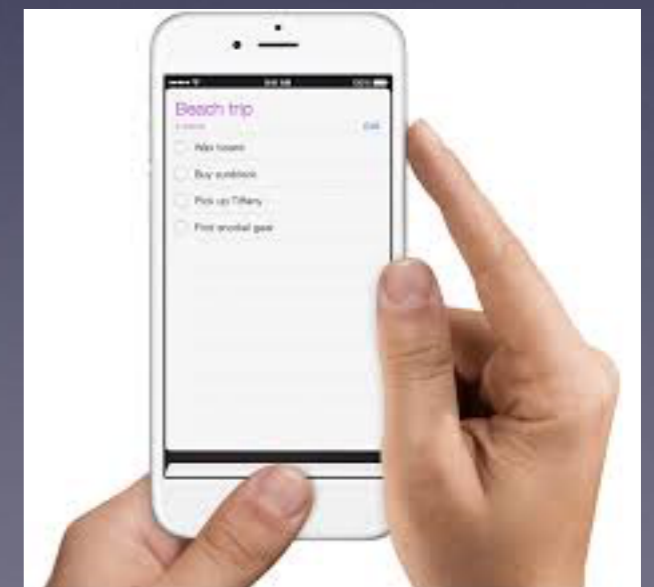
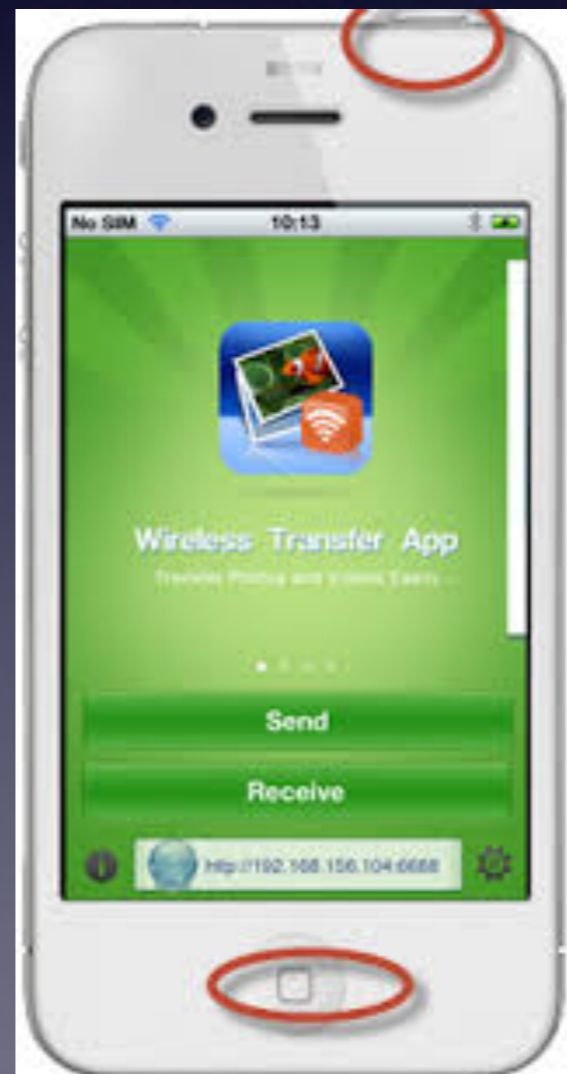
Pictures you take of the screen automatically go into Photos.



Most often this is called a “Screen Shot”.



Hold the **Home button** and the **sleep/wake** button down at the same time and do it rapidly.





# What [Where] Is The Share Button?

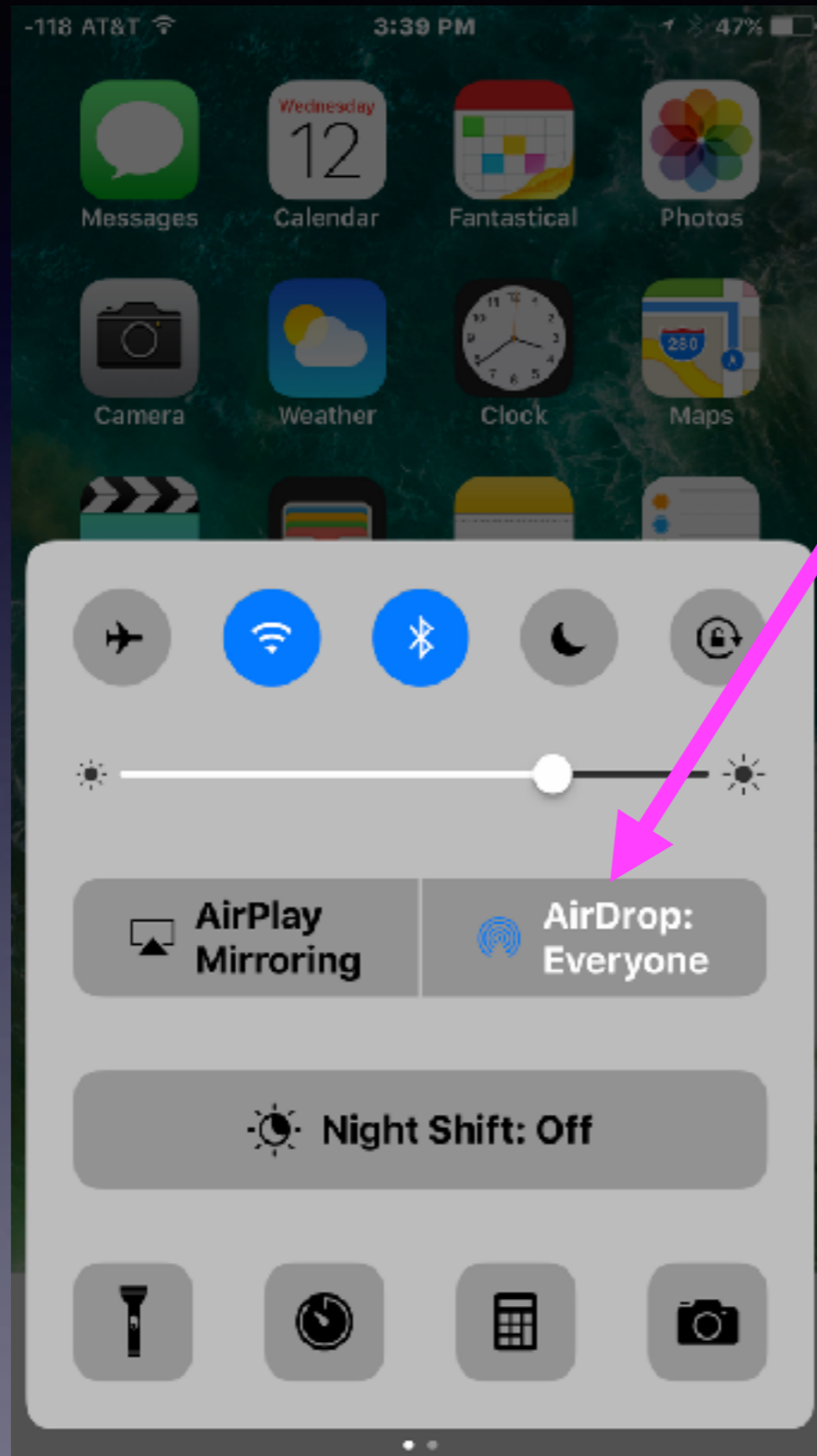
The “Share” button allows you to email, message, print, AirDrop, etc. a picture or other data.



Look for this button everywhere.



# What Is AirDrop & AirPlay Mirroring?



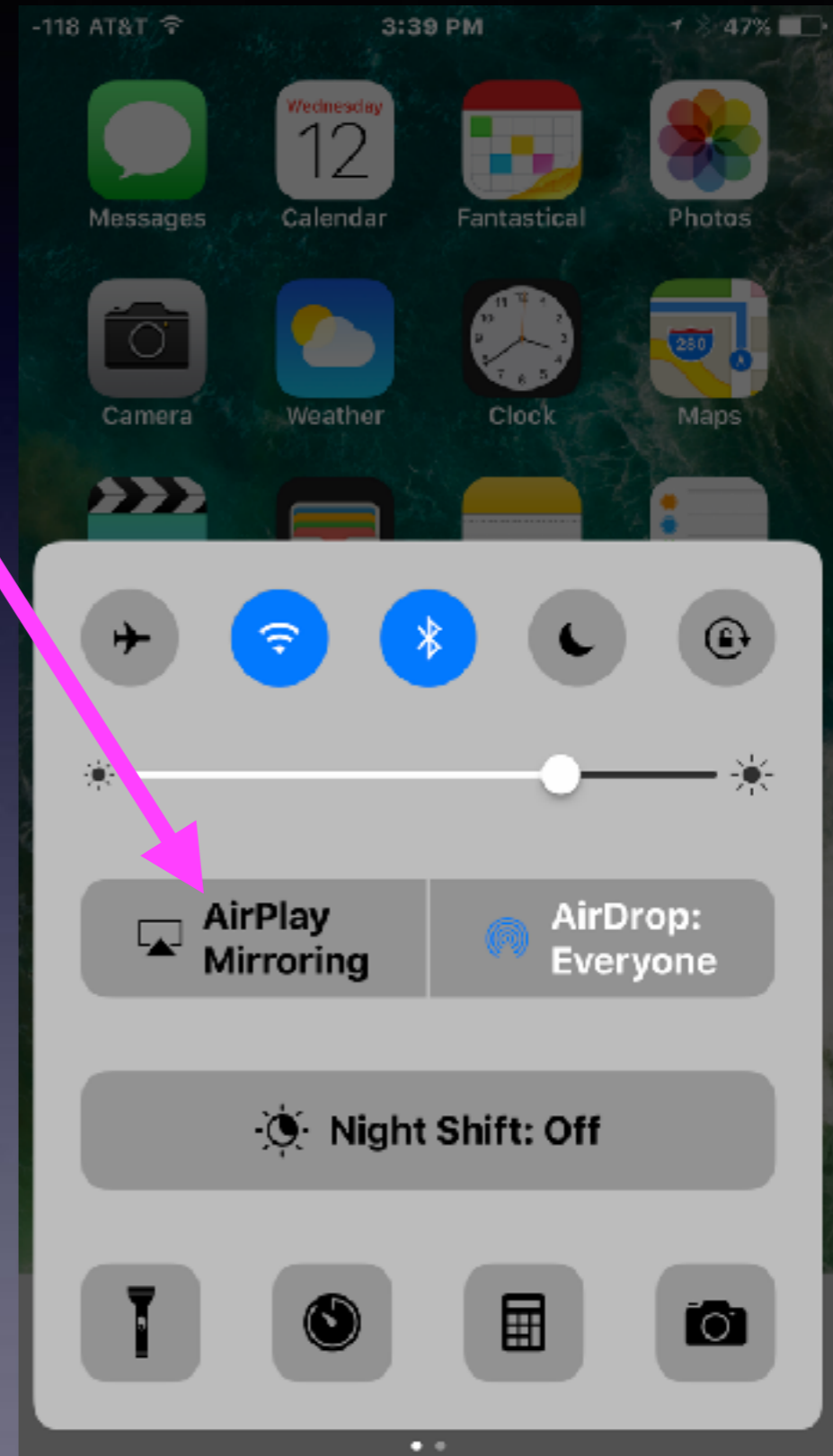
## What is AirDrop?

AirDrop is a method of transferring and/or sharing data among Apple devices over Wi-Fi and Bluetooth without using email or any kind of storage device.

Both devices have to be signed into an iCloud account and be within 30 feet of each other.

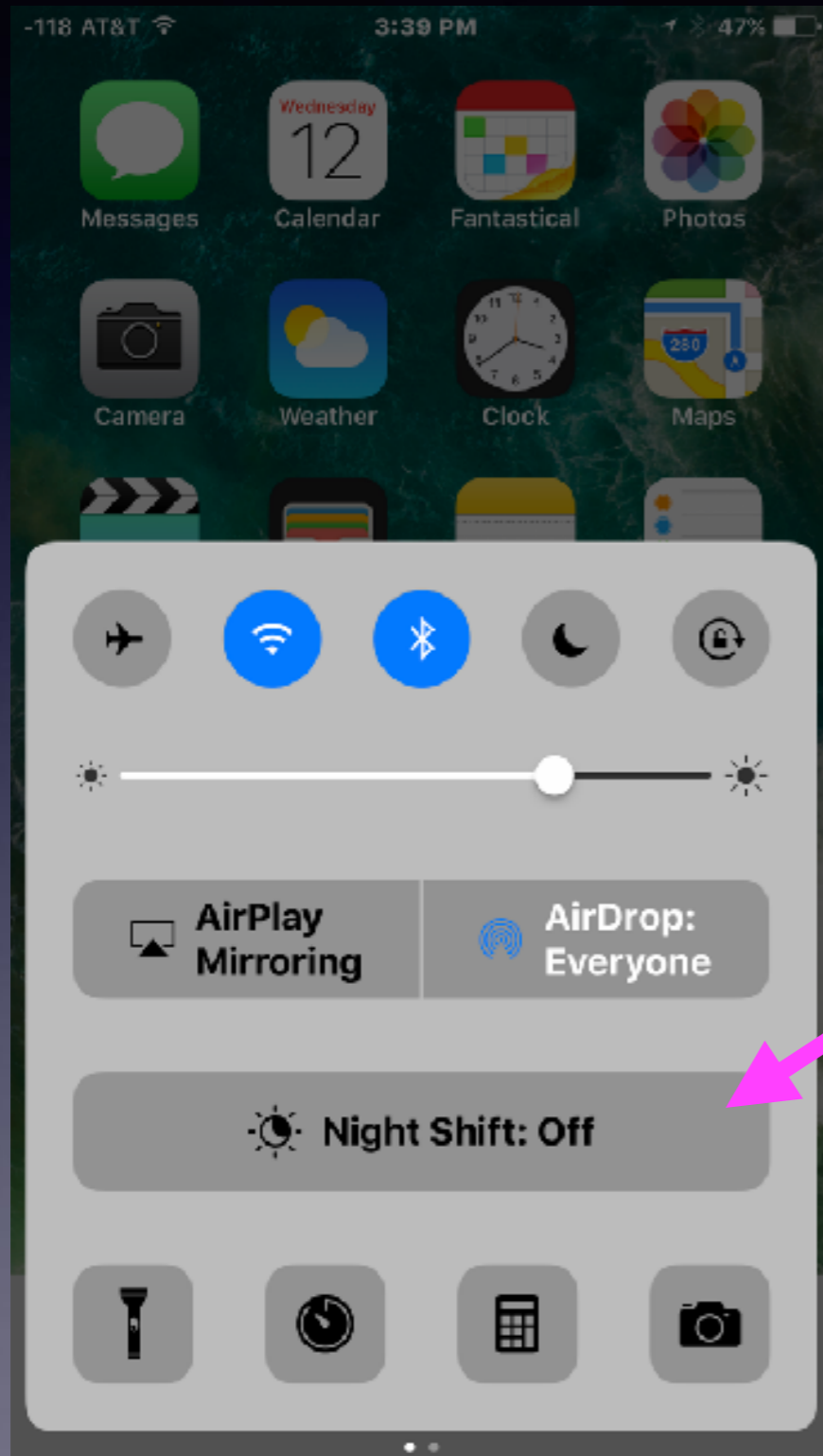

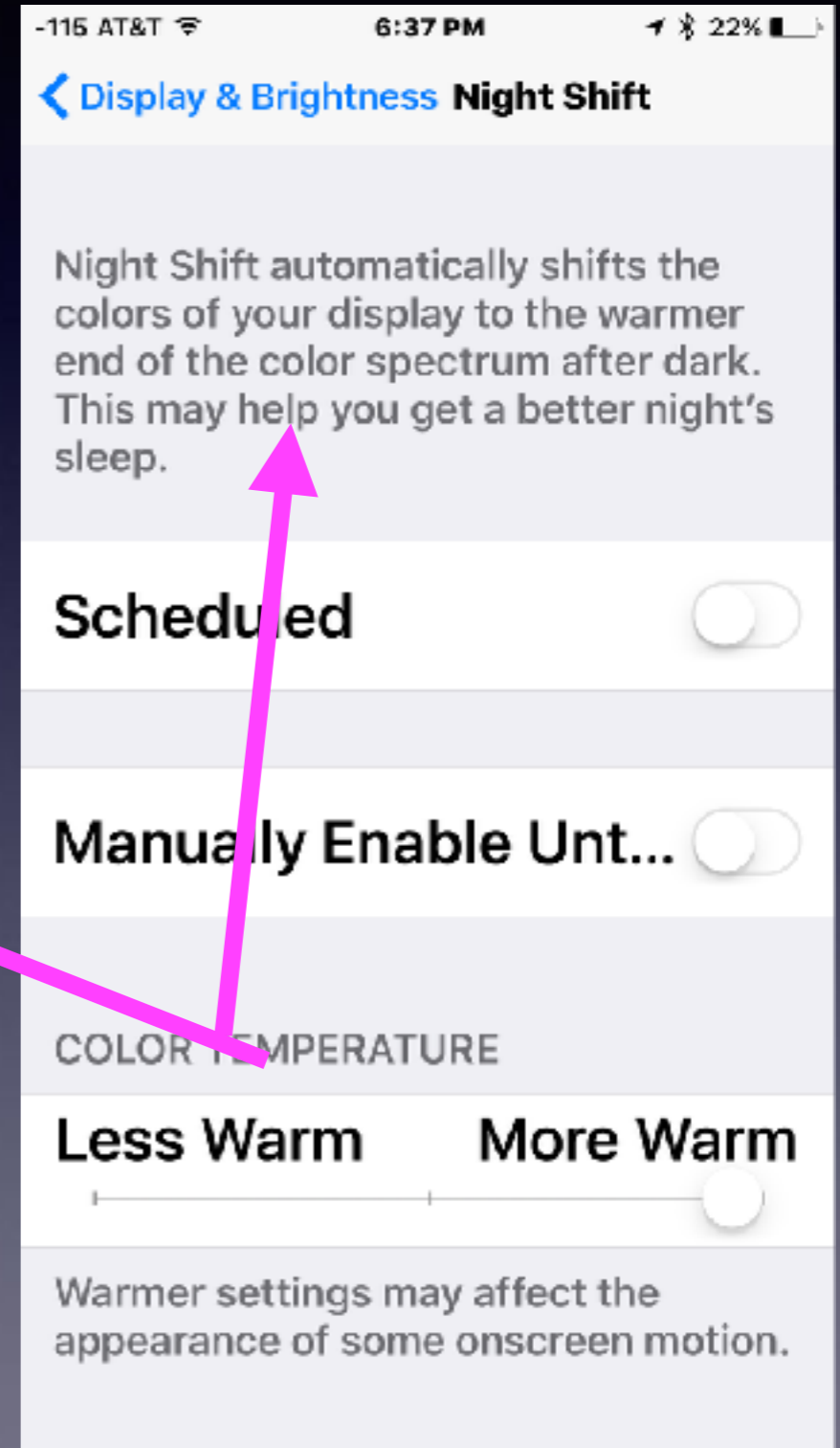
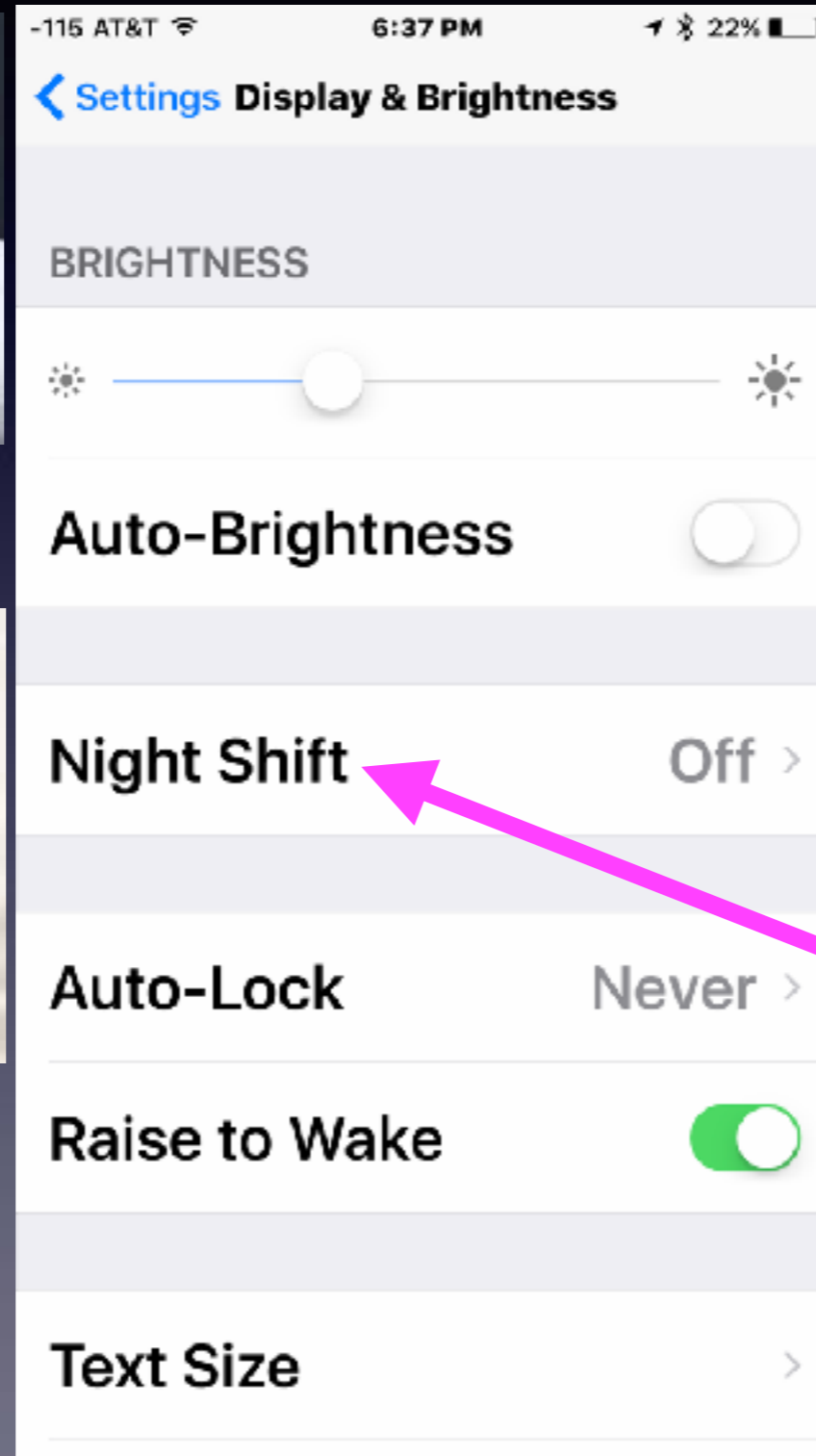
