An App Can Lock Your iPhone / iPad!

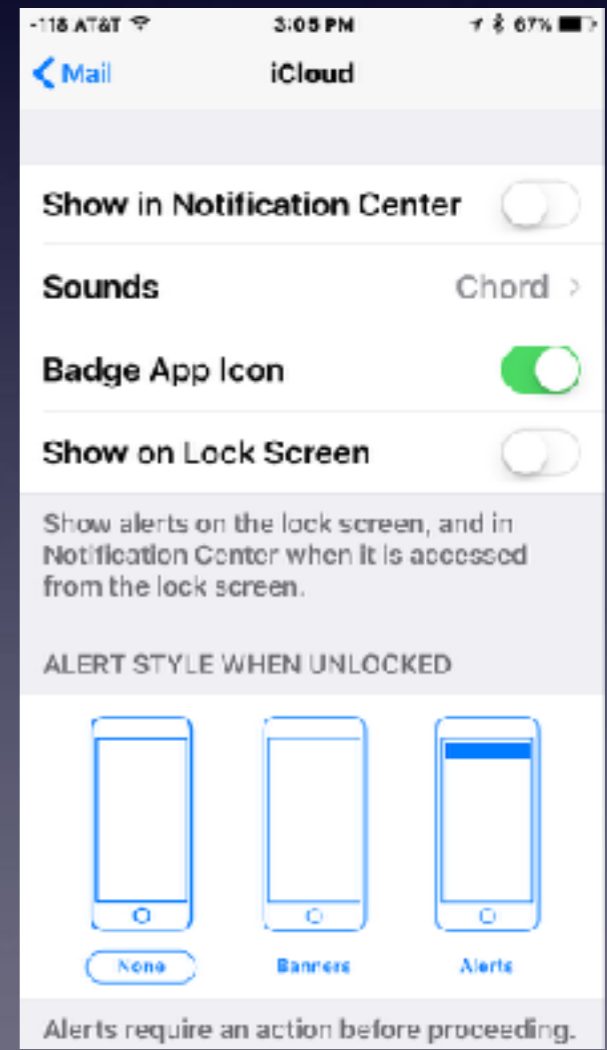
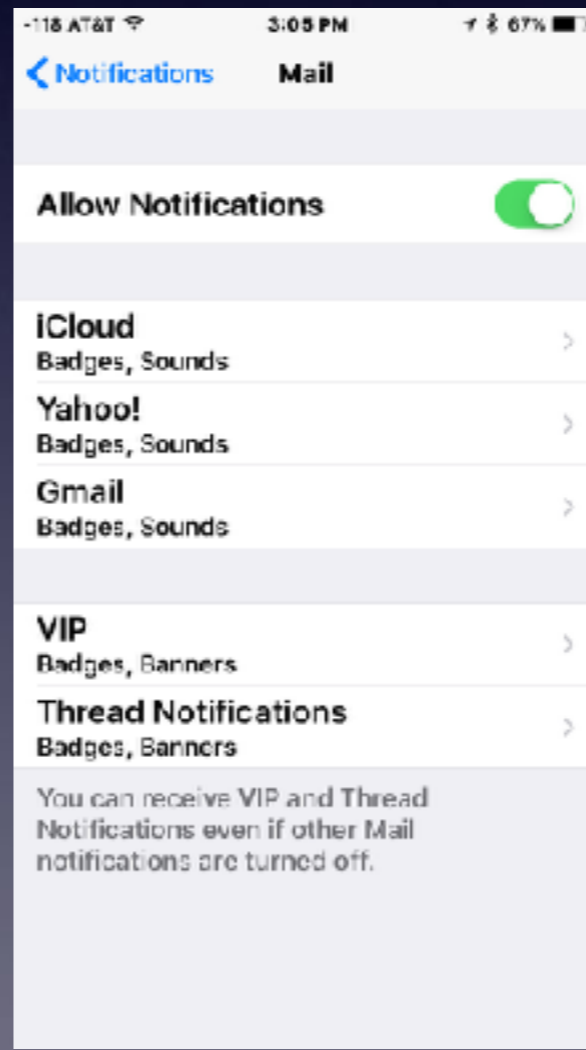
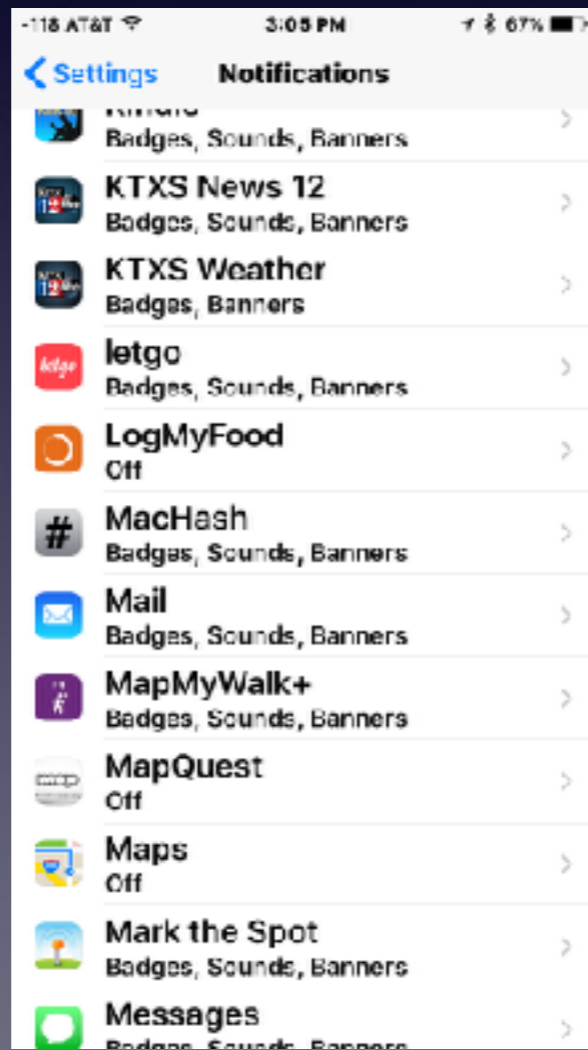
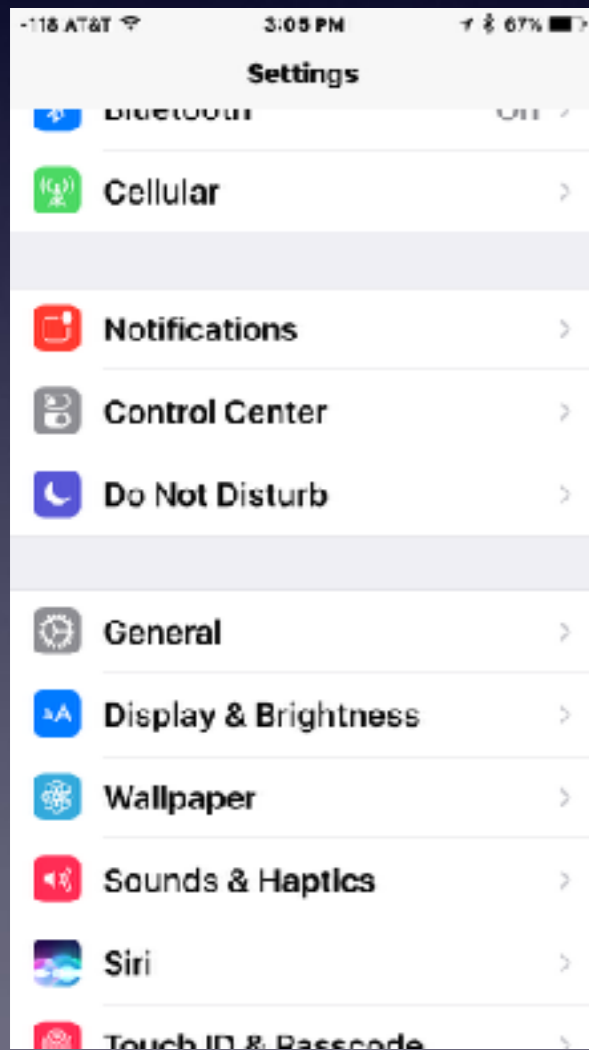
Slide to power off-after seeing slide to power off-then press the home button. iPhone will restart!



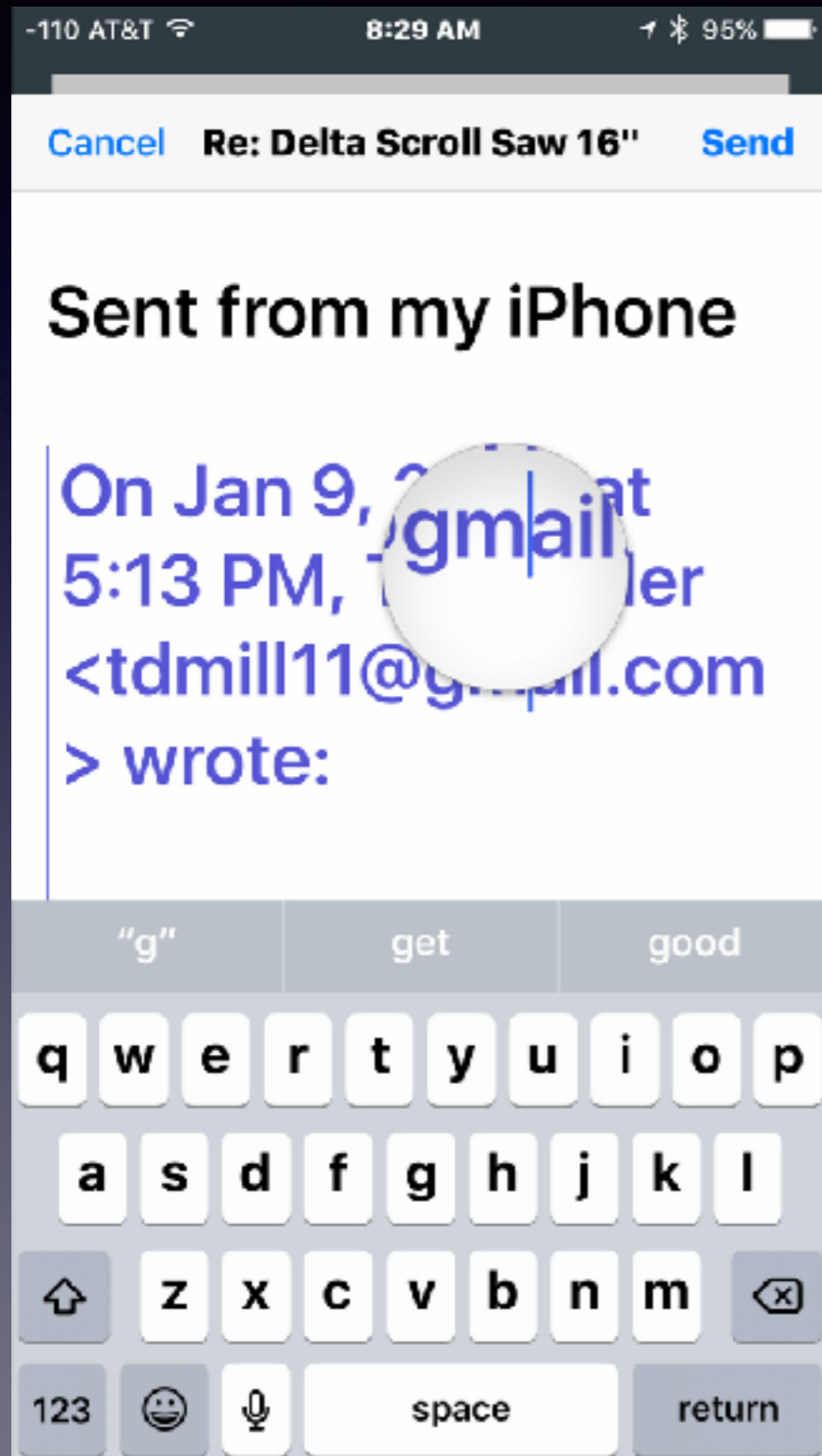
Choose A Sound Notification!

Turn Keyboard Into a Trackpad!

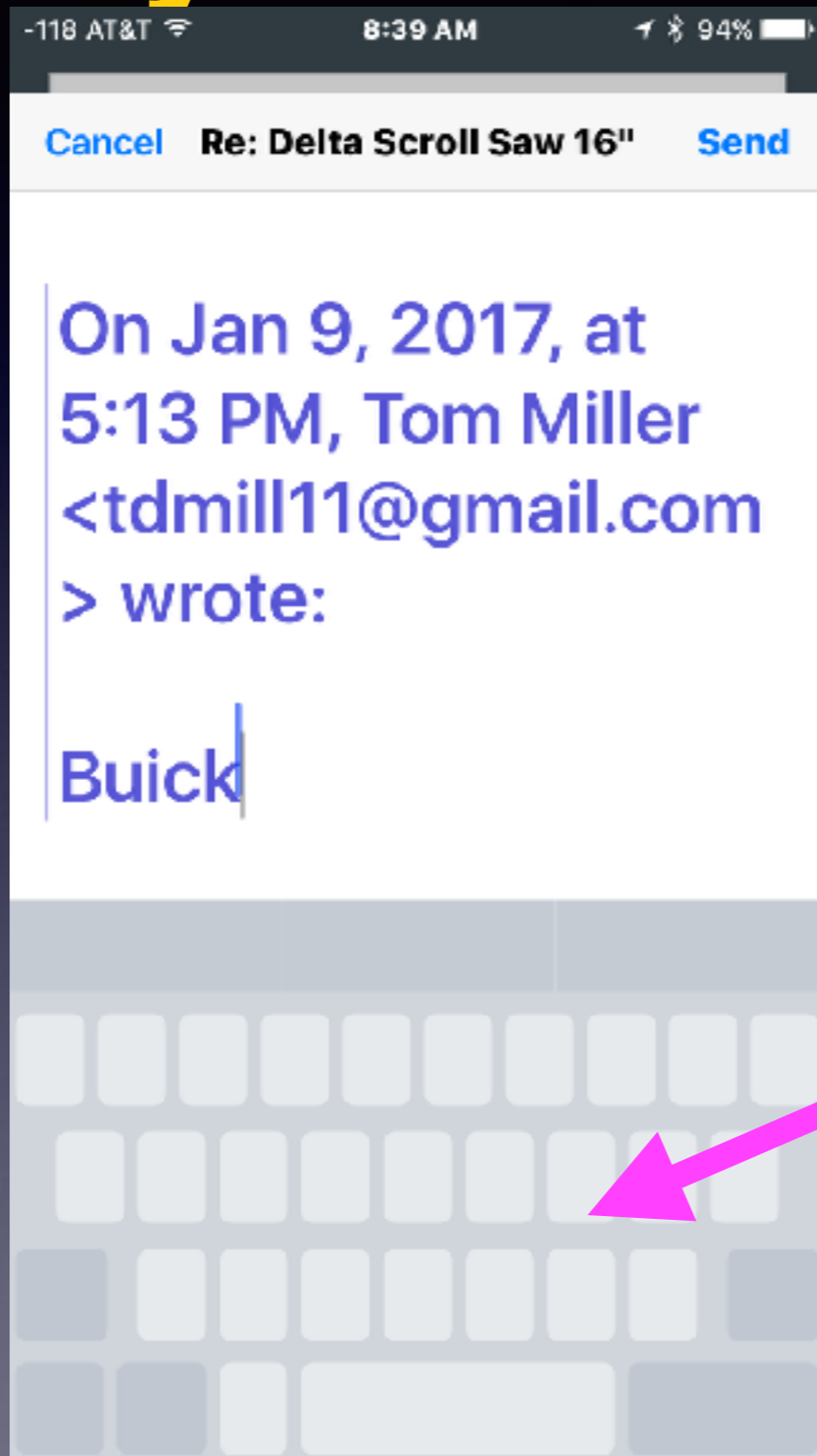


Press on screen to activate the magnifying glass to edit text.

But it is difficult to know where your cursor actually is!

iPhone 6s and iPhone 7 allow for 3D touch and if you press the keyboard; key will dim and you can move the cursor.

Keyboard as Trackpad!

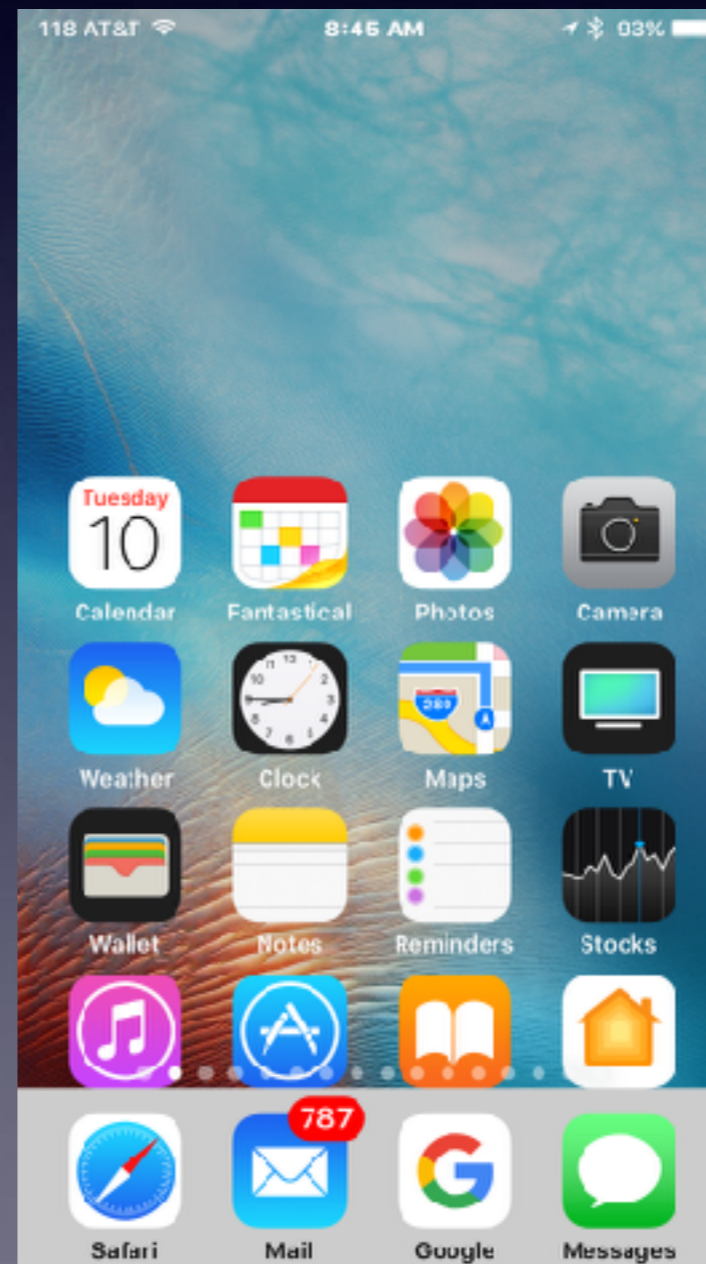
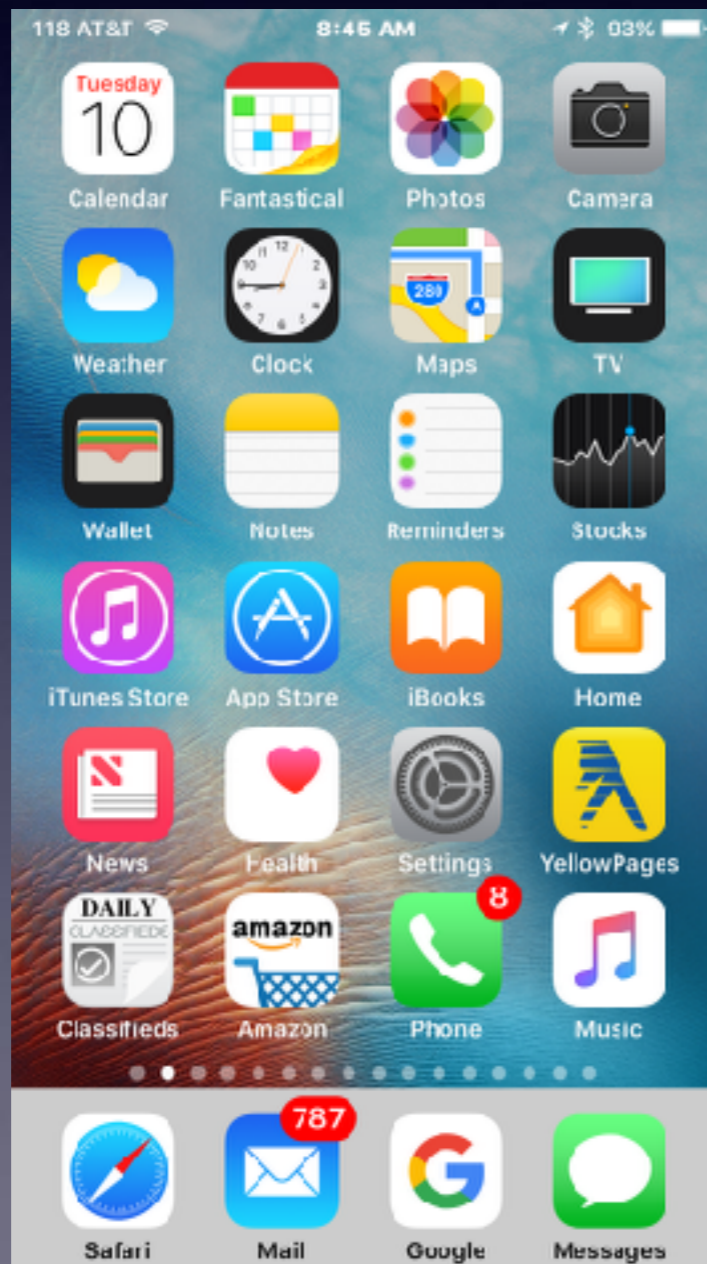


Press the keyboard until keys fade away then move your finger as you would a mouse!

iPhones Are Getting Bigger!

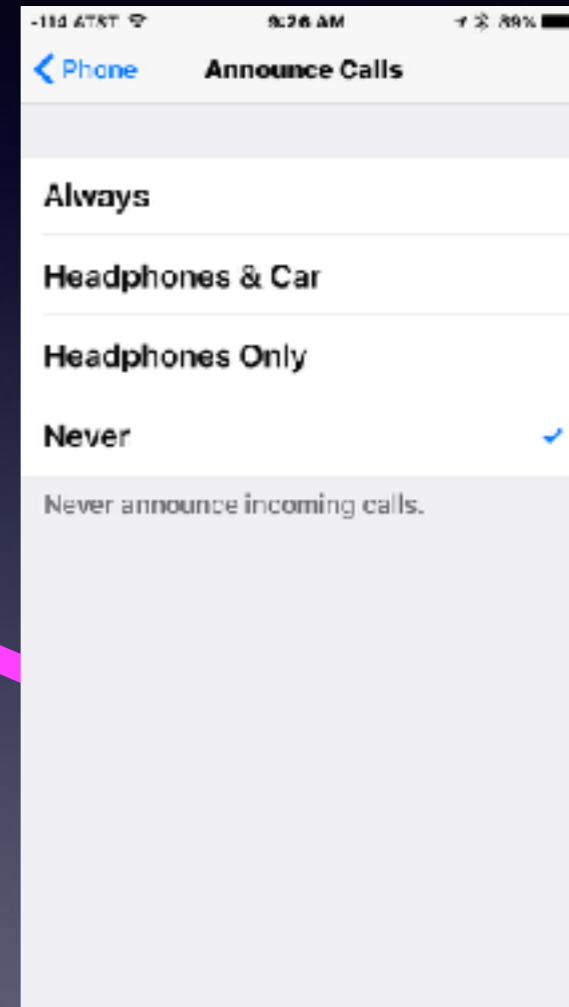
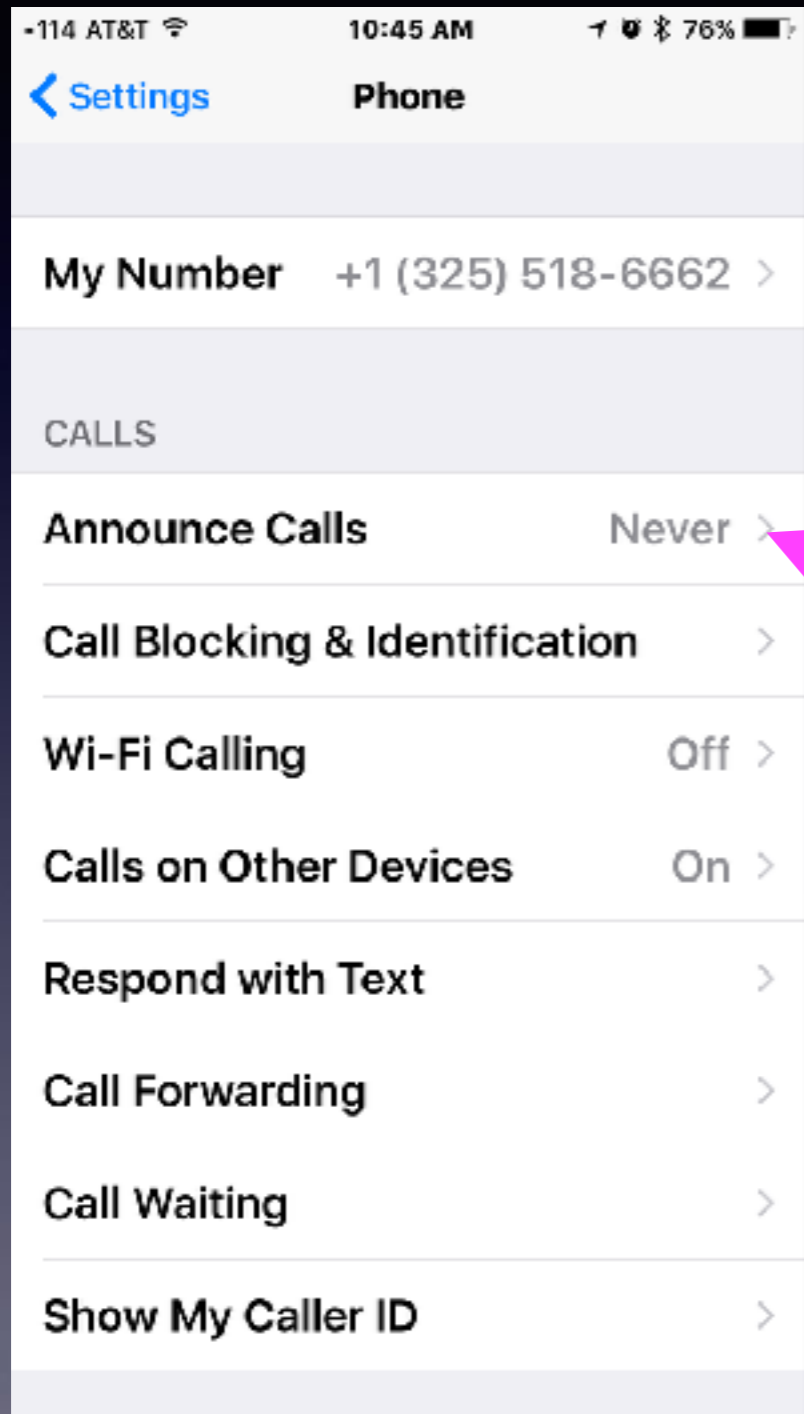
Use the “Reachability” feature!

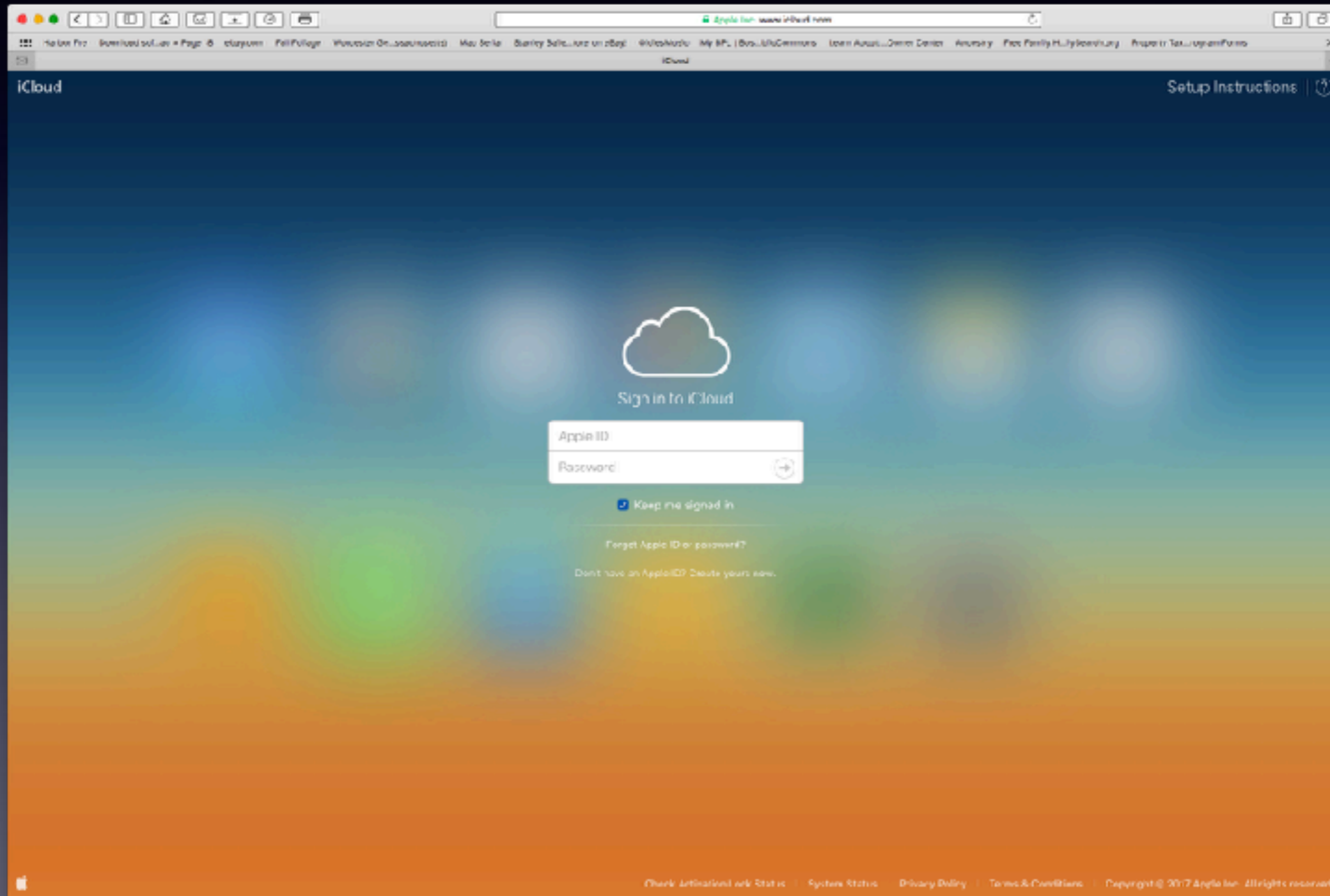


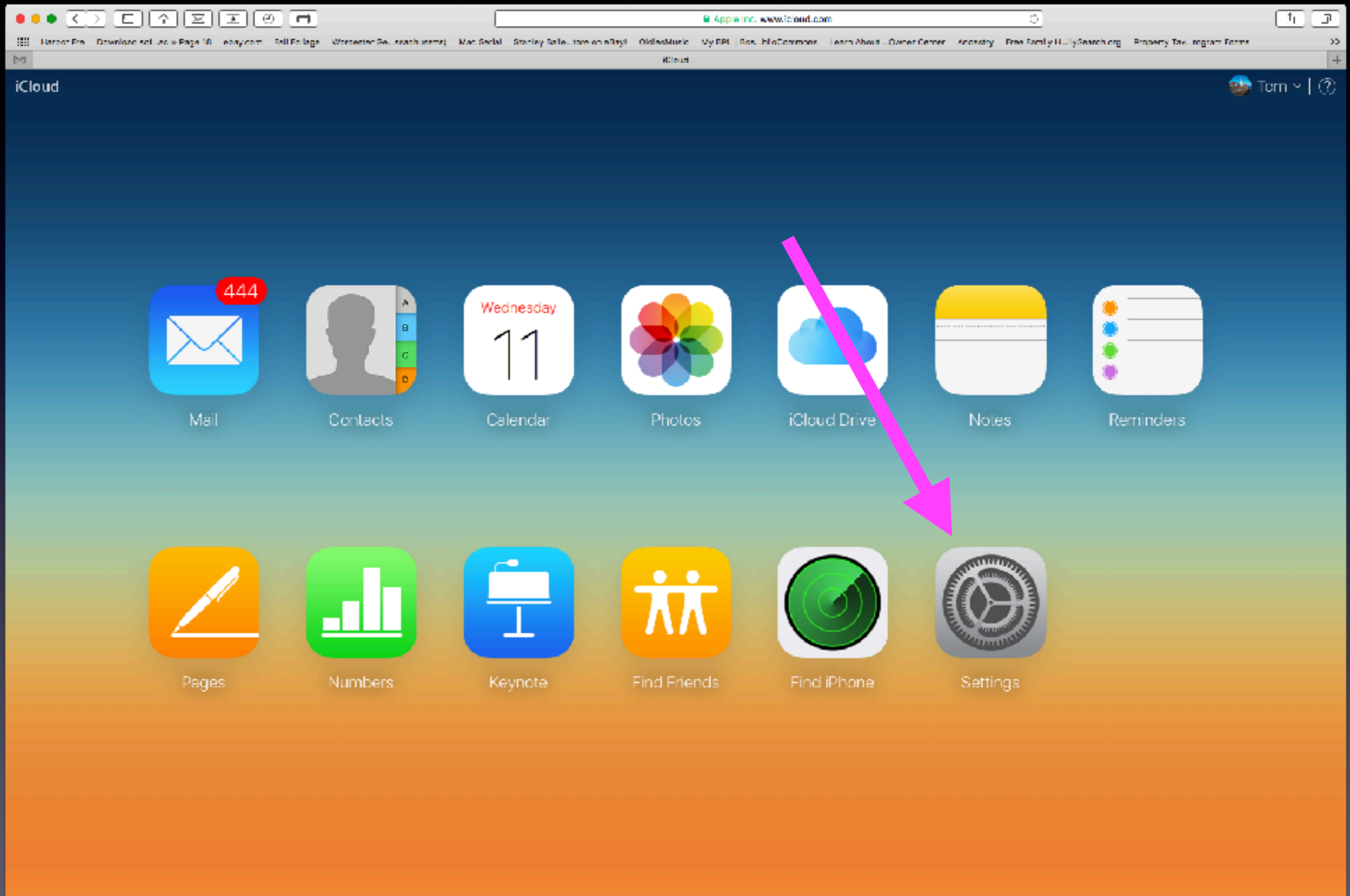
How to Find Your Phone
