## Texting Vs. Talking While Driving: Debate Continues

Texting or dialing while driving is much riskier than just talking on your cellphone, according to a new study.

Drivers who take their eyes off the road to send a text message or dial a phone number significantly raise their chances of causing a crash, according to a new study from the Virginia Tech Transportation Institute. The study, which compiled real-world data, delivered some results that differ from those of earlier studies, especially with respect to talking and driving.

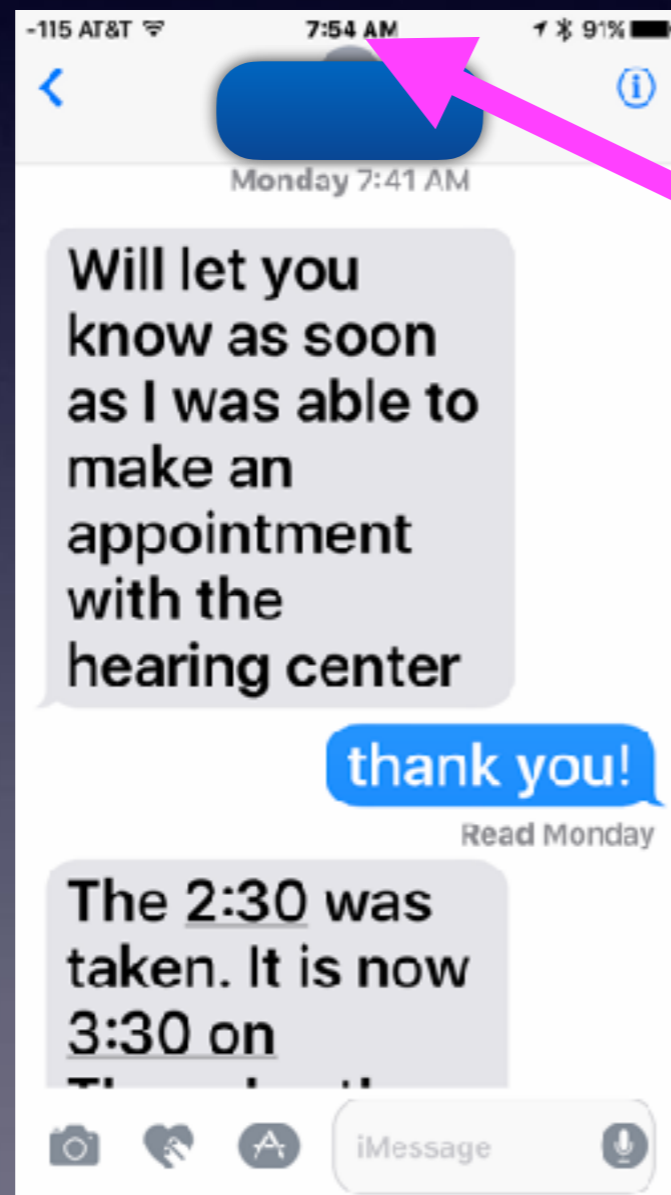
University of Utah scientist David Strayer, who has performed his own research on the dangers of cellphone use behind the wheel, told the Associated Press the idea that talking on a phone while driving poses no risk is "completely at odds with what we found." Strayer also pointed out weaknesses with how the study gauged distractions. For example, the video cameras may show drivers' wandering eyes, but they don't account for cognitive distraction. "You don't swerve so much when you're talking on a cellphone; you just might run through a red light," Strayer pointed out.

# Reset / Add Voicemail

If I call you and you do not answer, will my call go to voicemail?

## Reset voicemail password from AT&T's automated system

- 1 Call 611 or 800-331-0500.
- 2 Enter the wireless number starting with area code.
- 3 **Press 3** to "get help with voicemail."
- 4 **Press 3** to reset your VM password.
- 5 Enter the Billing Zip code for the account.
- 6 Shortly, iPhone will display "Password Incorrect - Enter Voicemail Password."
- 7 Enter the last seven digits of the wireless phone number and tap **OK**.

## Change voicemail password from the voicemail box

- 1 Press the **Home** key.
- 2 Tap the **Phone** icon.
- 3 Tap the **Keypad** icon.
- 4 Tap and hold the "1" key.
- 5 Enter the current voicemail password.
- 6 Tap "4", "2", "1" to change the voicemail password.
- 7 Shortly, iPhone will display "Password Incorrect - Enter Voicemail Password."
- 8 Enter the new password and tap **OK**.

## Two-factor authentication for Apple ID

Two-factor authentication is an extra layer of security for your Apple ID designed to ensure that you're the only person who can access your account, even if someone knows your password.



# Two-step Verification Is Not Two-Factor Authentication!

## Turn on two-factor authentication for your Apple ID

Two-factor authentication is currently available to iCloud users with at least one device that's using iOS 9 or OS X El Capitan or later. [Learn more.](#)

You can follow the steps below to turn on two-factor authentication.

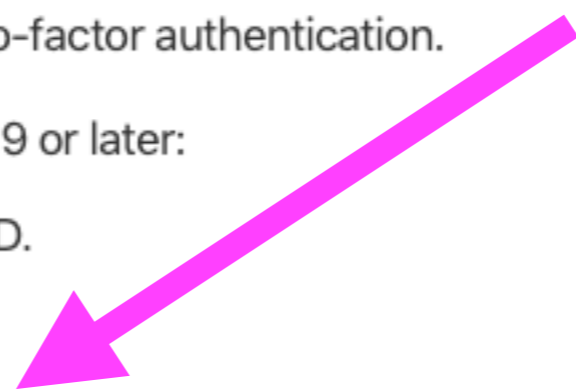
On your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch with iOS 9 or later:

1. Go to Settings > iCloud > tap your Apple ID.
2. Tap Password & Security.
3. Tap Turn on Two-Factor Authentication.

On your Mac with OS X El Capitan or later:

1. Go to Apple (🍏) menu > System Preferences > iCloud > Account Details.
2. Click Security.
3. Click Turn on Two-Factor Authentication.

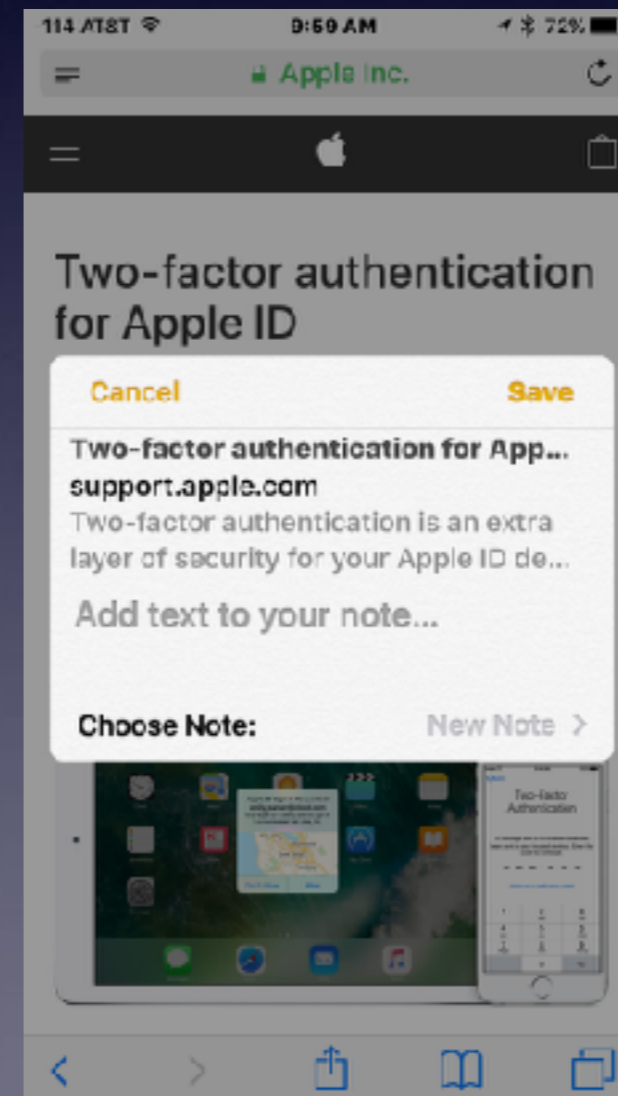
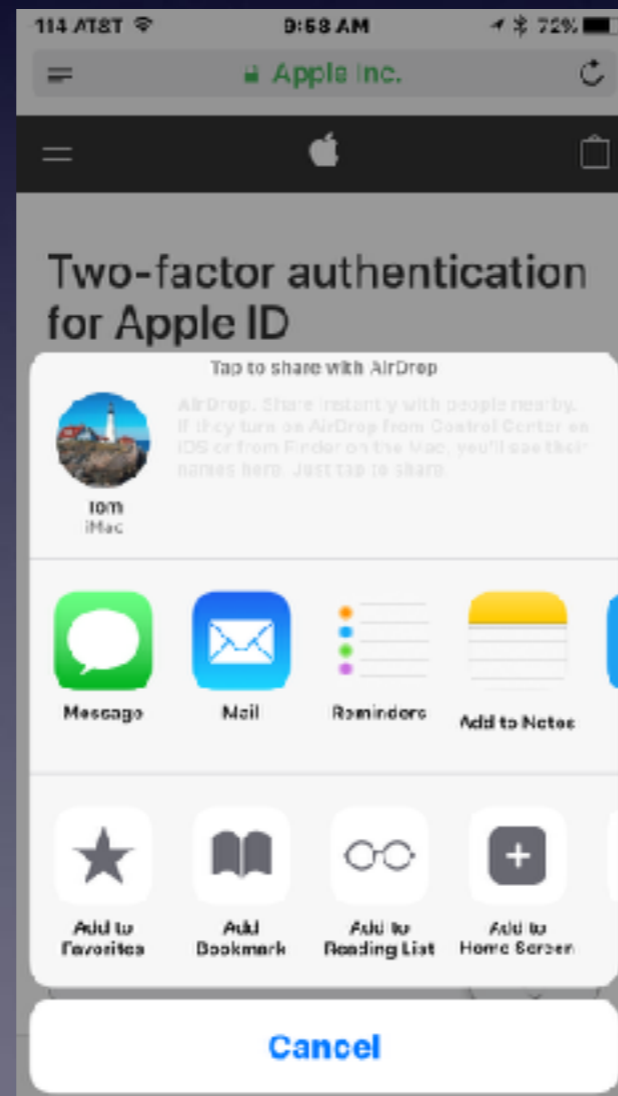

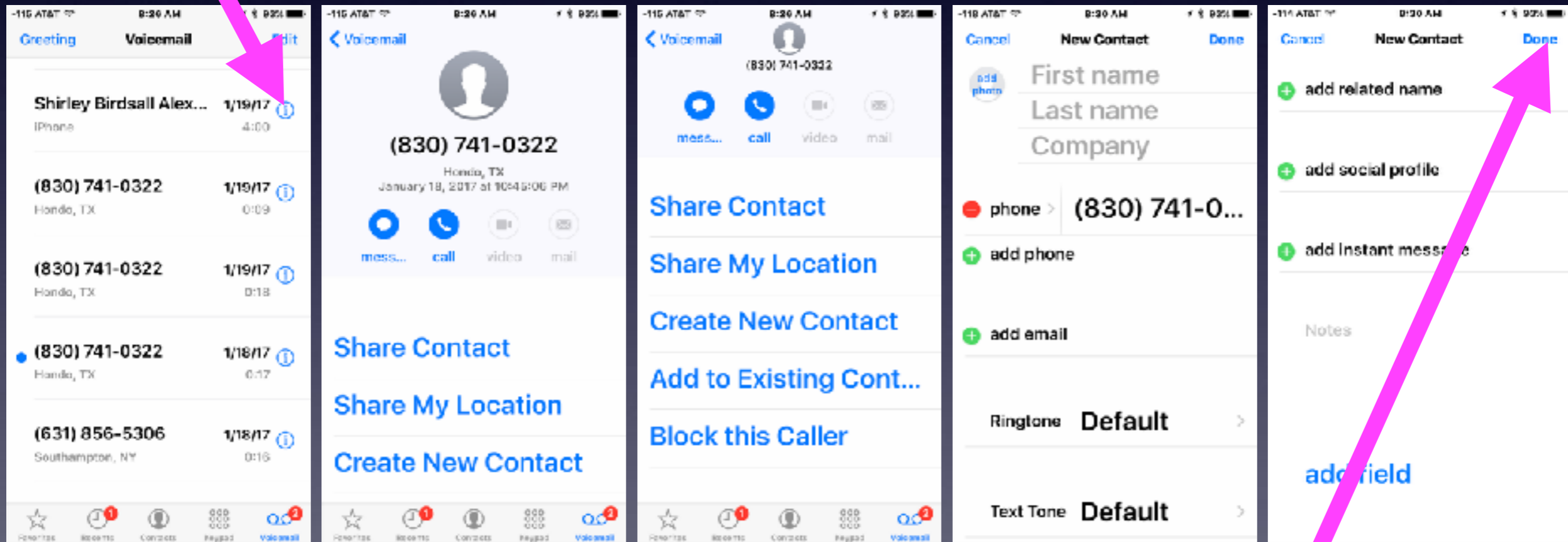

**Apple Removes Tool to Check if an iPhone or iPad is Activation Locked**

Apple has removed its [Activation Lock status checker](#) on iCloud.com at some point in the past few days. The tool enabled users to enter the serial number or IMEI of an iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch and find out if the device is secured with Activation Lock, helping buyers avoid purchasing a device locked to another user.





## Check Activation Lock Status
