Fake News Expert On How False Stories Spread And Why People Believe Them

Craig Silverman of *BuzzFeed News* has spent years studying media inaccuracy. He explains how false stories during the presidential campaign were spread on Facebook and monetized by Google AdSense.

Transcript

DAVE DAVIES, HOST:

This is **FRESH AIR**. I'm Dave Davies in for Terry Gross. So do you remember reading that Hillary Clinton paid Jay Z and Beyonce \$62 million dollars for performing at a rally in Cleveland before the election? You might have, but the story is false, one of many posted on hyper-partisan websites and spread by aggressive social media campaigns during the presidential election.

Our guest, Craig Silverman, has spent much of his career as a journalist writing about issues of accuracy in media. He wrote a column for the Poynter Institute called *Regret the Error* and later a book of the same name on the harm done by erroneous reporting. He also launched a web-based startup called *Emergent* devoted to crowdsourcing the fact-checking of fake news.

He's now the media editor for the website *BuzzFeed*, and he spent much of this year writing about fake news, rumors and conspiracy theories that gained currency in the presidential campaign - where they came from, why they got so much engagement on social media and what should be done to reduce their impact on public discourse. I spoke to Craig Silverman yesterday.

Apple Releases macOS Sierra 10.12.5 With Headphones Audio Fix and Enhanced Mac App Store Compatibility

Apple today released [macOS Sierra 10.12.5](#), the fifth update to the macOS Sierra operating system that [first launched](#) in September of 2016. macOS Sierra 10.12.5 comes more than one month after the release of [macOS Sierra 10.12.4](#), an update that introduced [Night Shift](#) for Mac. Five betas of macOS Sierra 10.12.5 were seeded to developers and public beta testers ahead of the update's release.

macOS Sierra 10.12.5 is a free update for all customers who have a compatible machine. The update can be downloaded using the [Software Update](#) function in the [Mac App Store](#).



No feature additions, bug fixes, or other changes were found in macOS Sierra 10.12.5 during the beta testing process, and developers and public beta testers were only told that the update "improves the stability, compatibility, and security of your Mac." According to Apple's release notes, the following bug fixes and enhancements are included:

- 🔧 - Fixes an issue where audio may stutter when played through USB headphones
- Enhances compatibility of the Mac app Store with future software updates
- Adds support for media-free installation of Windows 10 Creators Update using Boot Camp

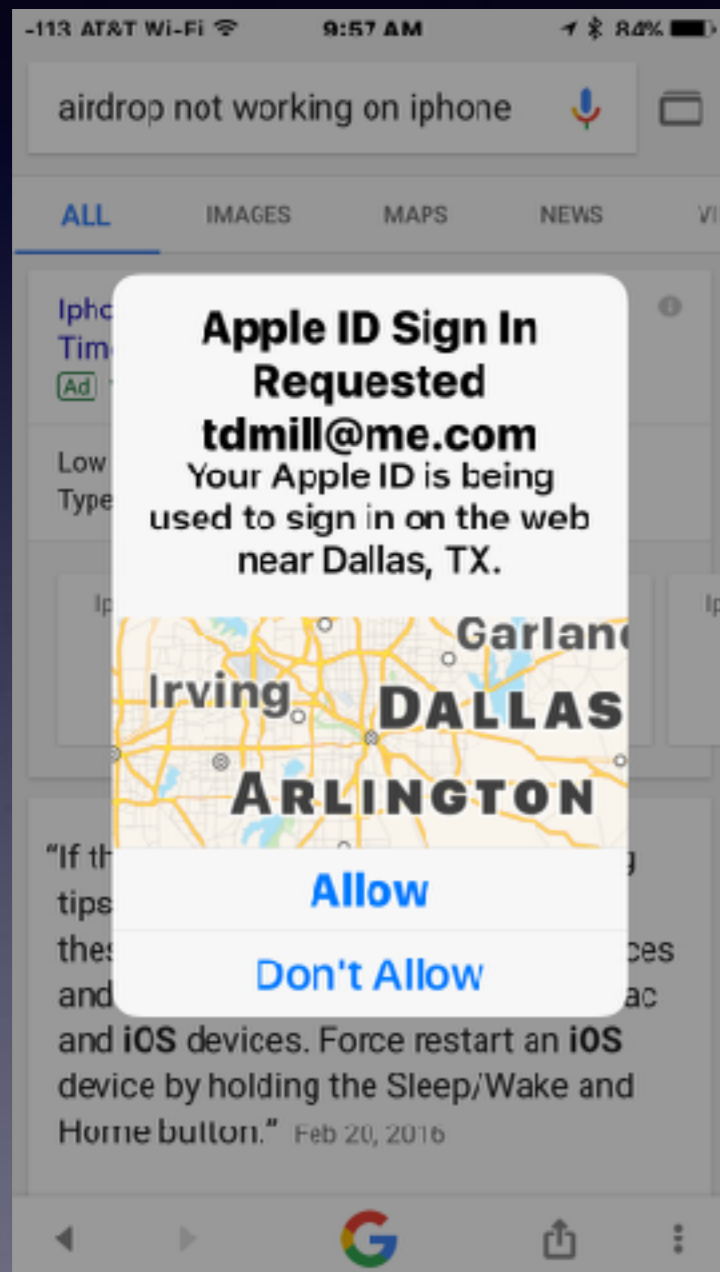
macOS Sierra 10.12.5 will soon be followed by a new version of macOS, which we expect to see introduced at Apple's June [Worldwide Developers Conference](#). The new version of macOS will be in testing for several months, however, so Apple is likely to continue updating macOS Sierra.

It's the \$64,000 question. The ultimate question of life, the universe, and everything. (And no, the answer isn't 42.) Whenever someone begins their search for online security, they ultimately discover there are two major types of protection: antivirus and anti-malware. Which leads them to the inevitable query:

What's the difference between antivirus and anti-malware?

Virus vs. malware

Before we can answer that, we need to first unveil what, exactly, are viruses and malware. A virus is a piece of code that is capable of copying itself in order to do damage to your computer, including corrupting your system or destroying data. Malware, on the other hand, is an umbrella term that stands for a variety of malicious software, including Trojans, spyware, worms, adware, ransomware, and yes, viruses. So the logic follows: all viruses are malware. Not all malware are viruses. Ya dig?
