Some Things You May Not Know About Your iPhone! & iPad

Germ Carrying and disease spreading device.

It is a computer more powerful than the one that put a man on the moon.

Driving and talking is more dangerous than you think!

This device can save your life!

It (the iPhone / iPad) won't come "easy" to seniors!

Your iPhone may do more things than mine. (Newer iPhones have new features.)

The iPad and iPhone are almost identical.

You may not be able to upgrade to the latest IOS. (It may be too old.)

Keeps track of where you have been.

Sends & saves data when using apps.

Contains personal info, pictures, addresses.

Without a Passcode lock, my info is accessible.

My iPhone can be found with "Find My Phone" app.

You can sell your iPhone; you can buy a used iPhone.

You can connect the iPhone & iPad to a monitor and keyboard.

You don't have to worry about losing or destroying your iPhone if you have iCloud backup turned on!

The iPhone is a tool not a toy!

What can this device do for me!

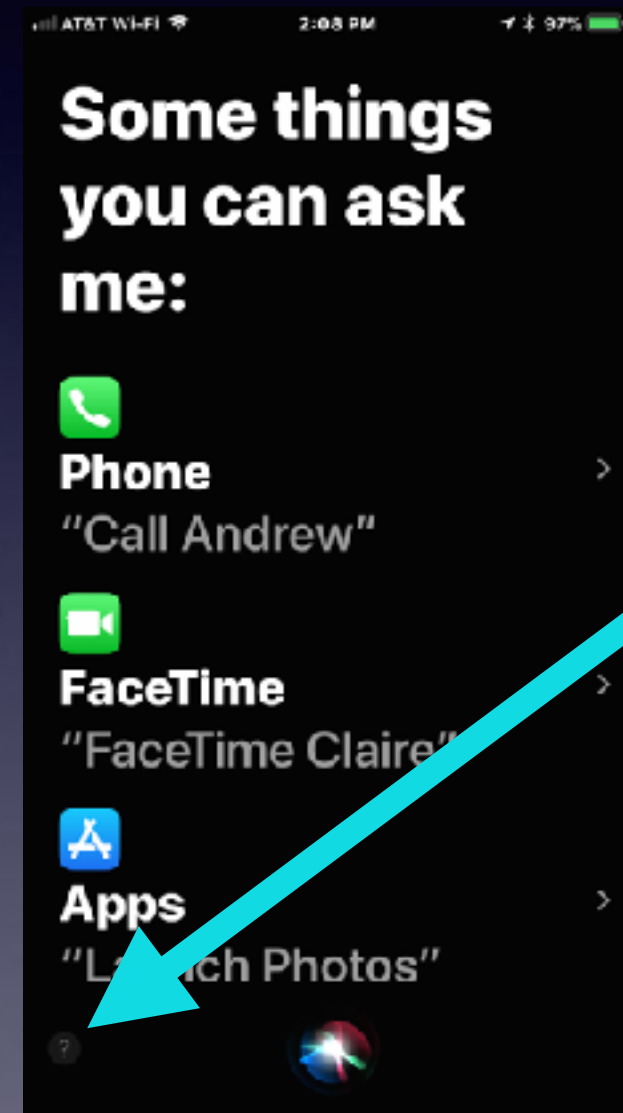
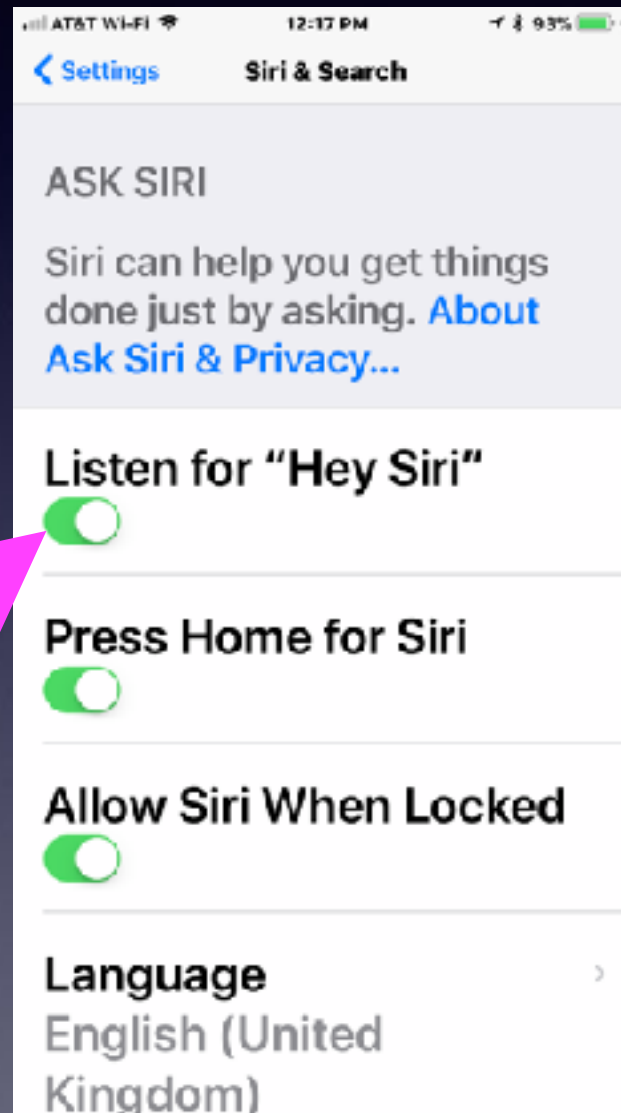
“Hey Siri!”

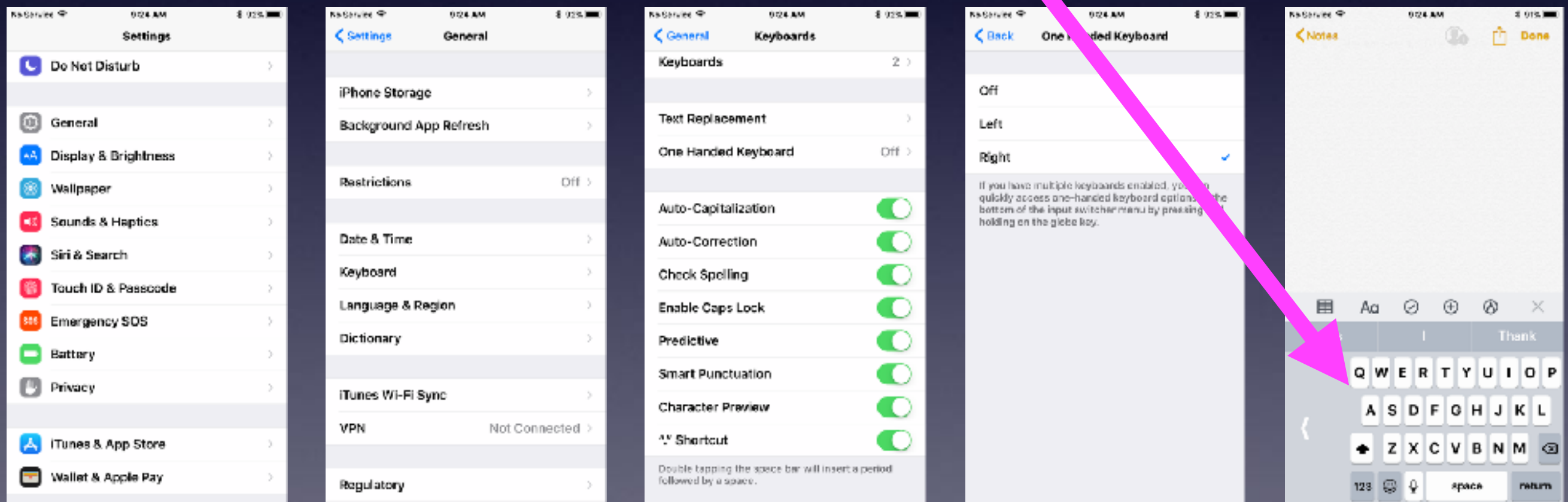

One Handed Keyboard

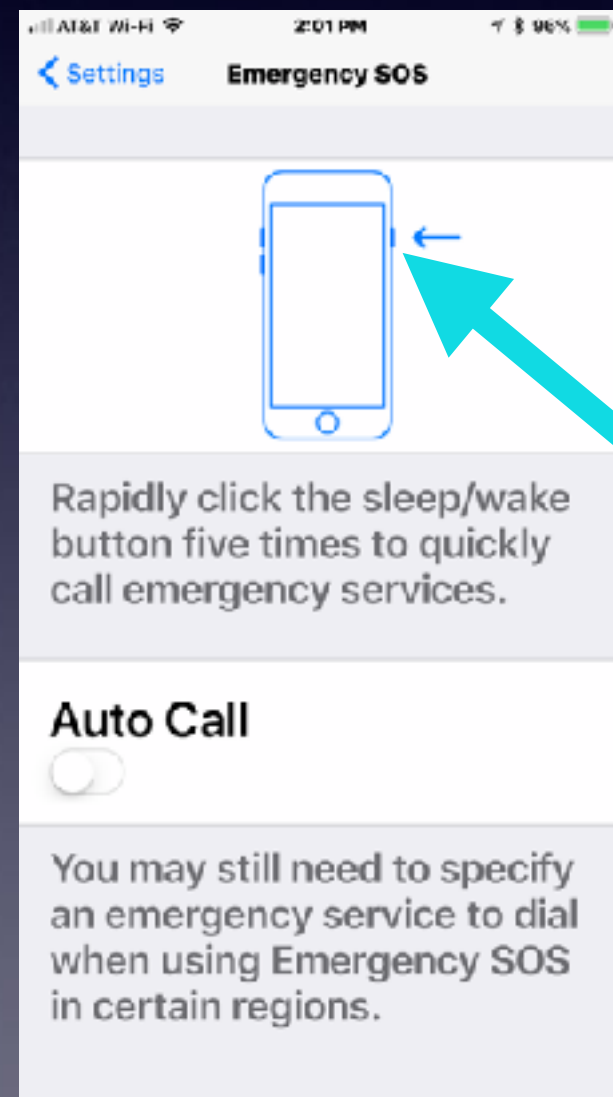
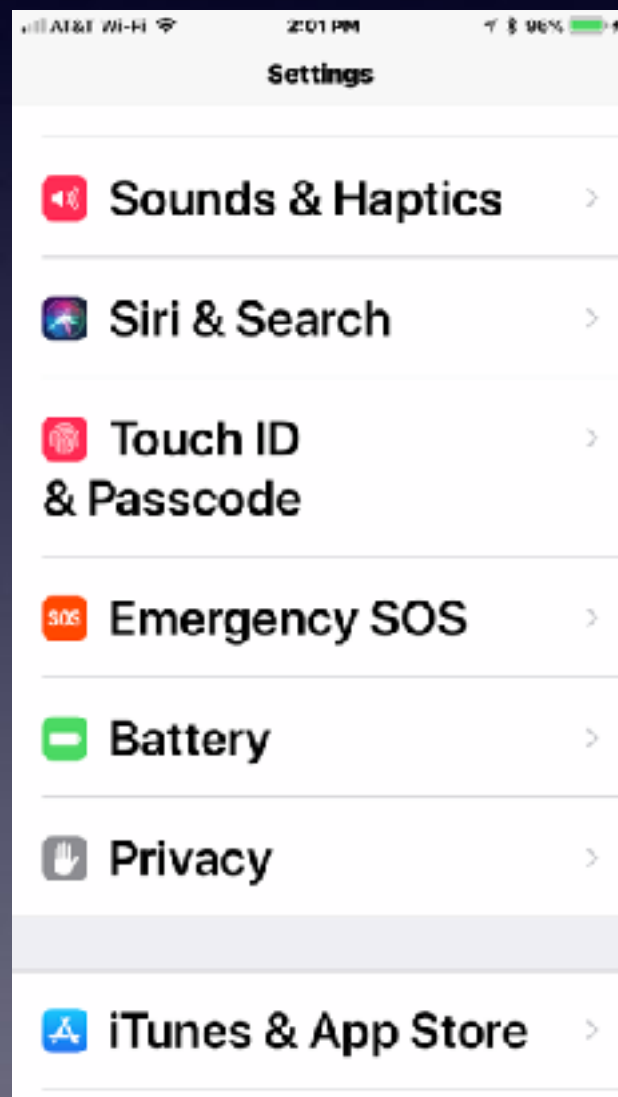
If you have an iPhone 7 or 8 plus, you can reduce the size of the keyboard. You can use the keyboard “one handed”!

Keyboard is on the right side!

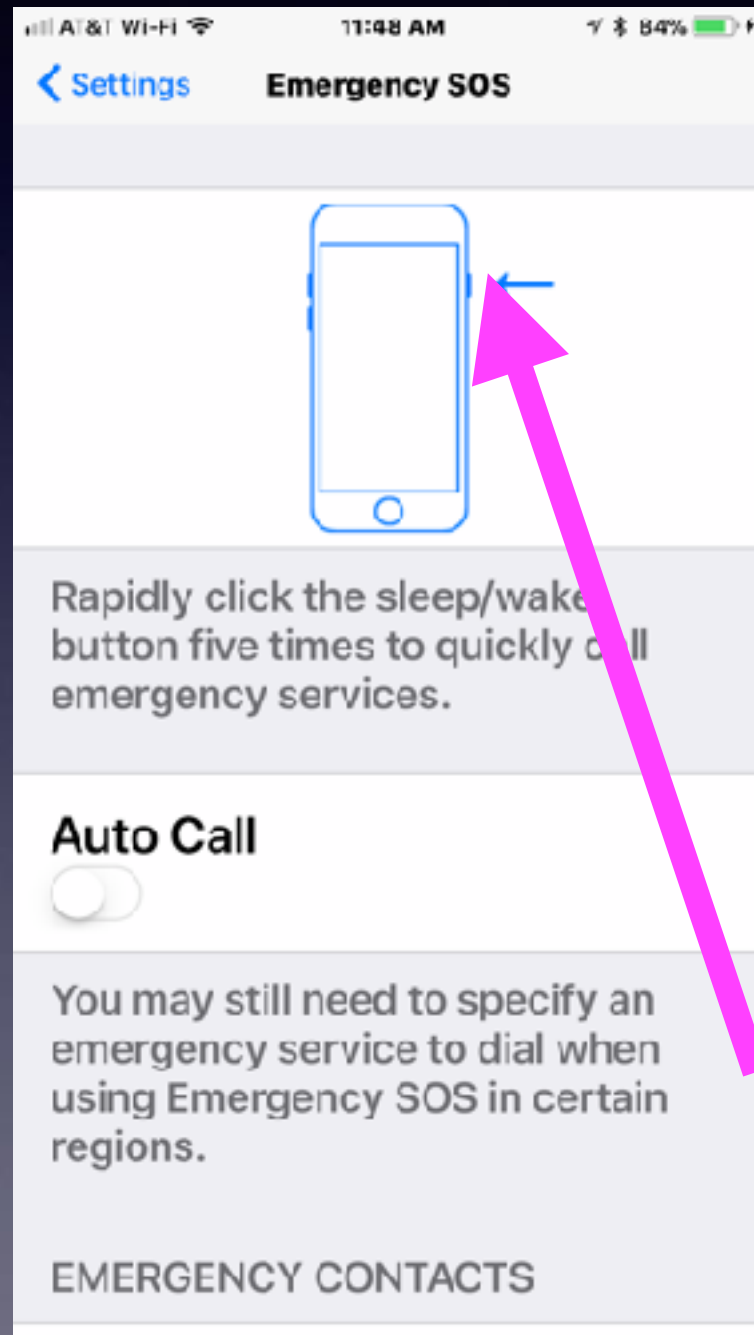


Emergency SOS

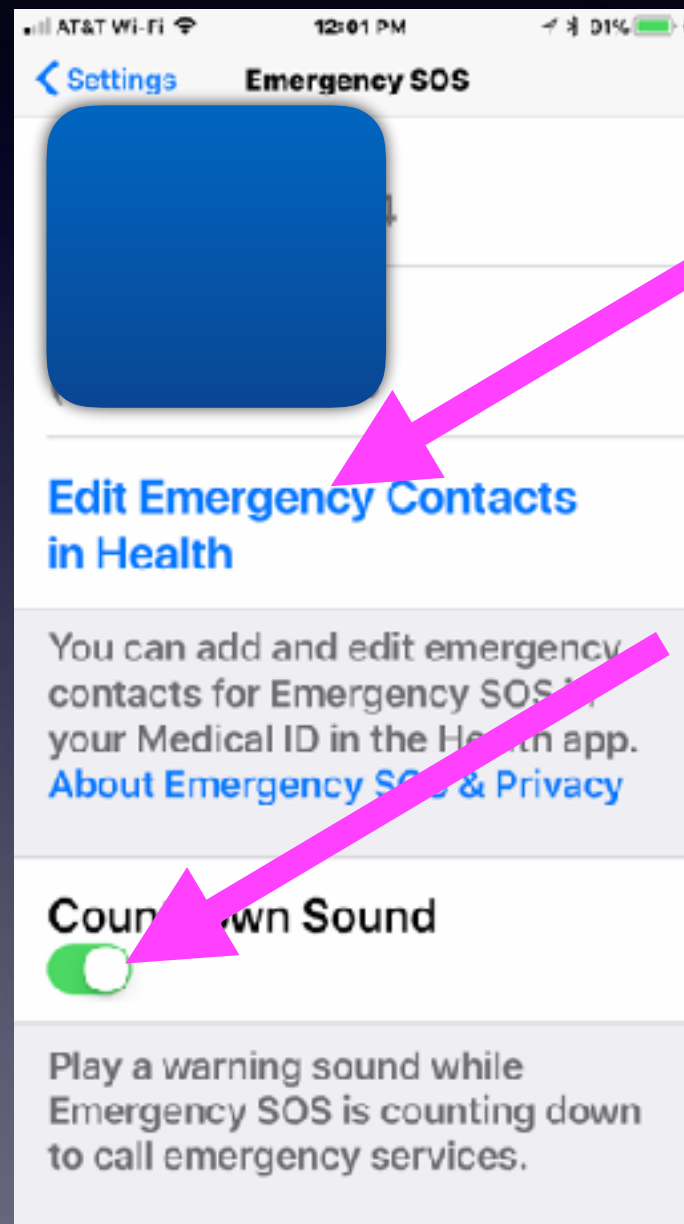
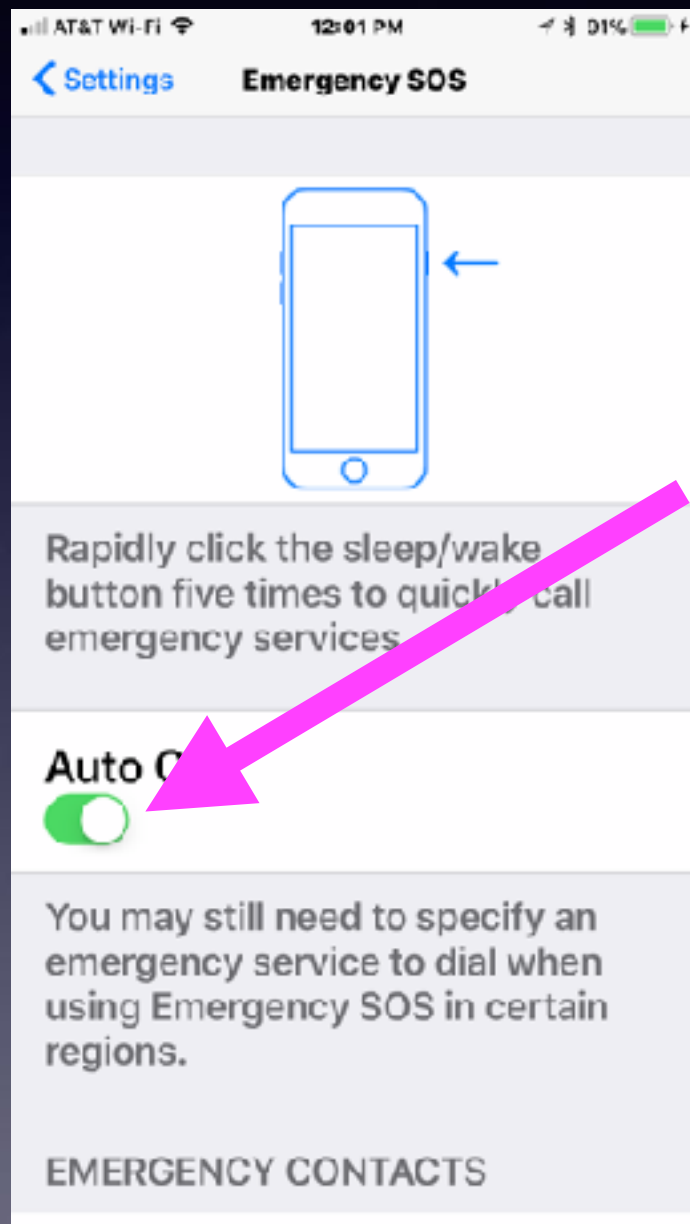
Tap Sleep / Wake / Power Button five times and

Problems With My Passwords!

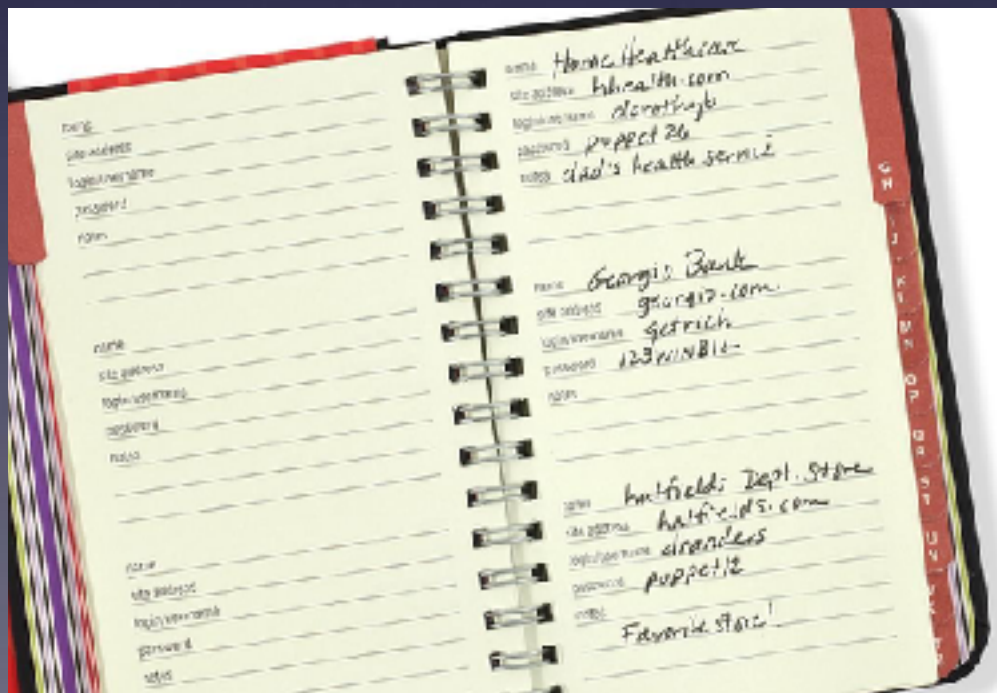
Security and passwords are probably some of the most important things today when operating a computer! (If not the MOST important thing!)
