

How to turn Parked Car notifications off (or back on) from iPhone



Go to *Settings* → *Maps* → *YOUR CAR* to toggle off *Show Parked Location* by tapping the white circle (it's off if the green background goes away).

Steps to Enable Parked Car Feature

1. Make Sure that your iPhone has been set up to connect with your car's Bluetooth. We recommend that you unpair the iPhone and redo the pairing process following any iOS update (for 10 and above.) While at it, Delete the old iPhone connection Info from the car and re-do it. On your iPhone, tap on **Settings > General > About > Name** and change the name of the device from iPhone to something new. Once you have renamed the device, try to pair it with your car's Bluetooth.
2. Turn on Location Services. Go to **Settings > Privacy > Location Services**
3. Significant Locations (also called Frequent Locations) setting needs to be turned on under **Settings > Privacy > Location Services > System Services > Significant Locations (also listed as Frequent Locations)**
4. You need to be using Apple Maps to get this functionality as you only see the parked car spot on your Apple Map. Please make sure that you turn on the notification settings for Maps. Tap on **Settings > Notifications > Maps** and make sure you have the setting enabled.
5. Turn on Show Parked Location. Go to **Settings > Maps > Show Parked Location**. Scroll down to find and enable "Show Parked Location" under Your Car

Steps three and four are critical for this feature to work. If you are still having issues in getting this functionality working try to do a Reset All Settings on your iPhone and then try to re-do the above steps to get the functionality working.



Three Important Buttons



Top one toggles to turn off ringer.

Bottom two control the volume up & down.

Either volume button will allow you to click the shutter button when in the camera app.

Volume down button will silence and call and send it to voice mail.



Force Reset or Restart My iPhone!

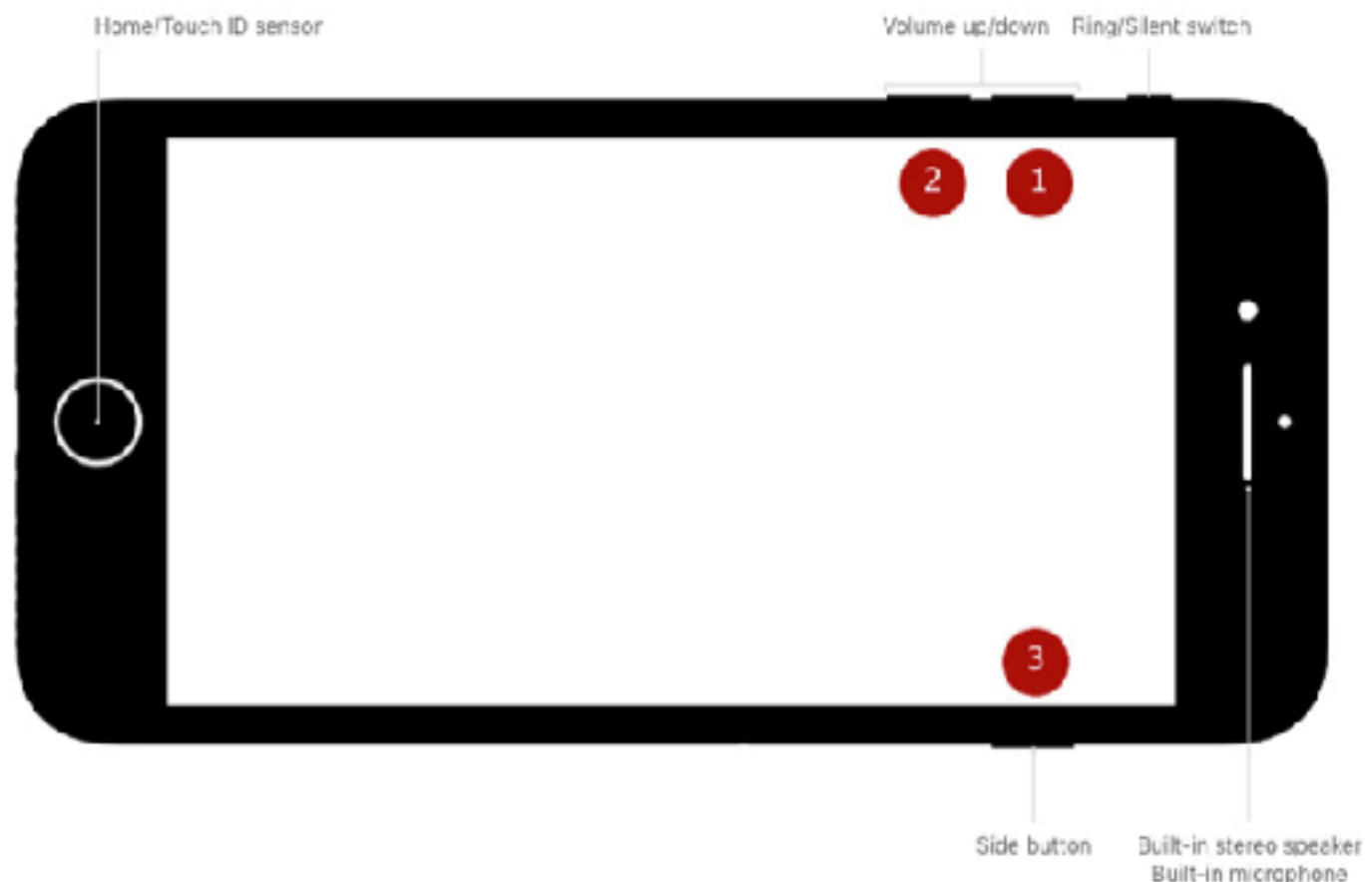

Reset is different than turning off you iPhone!

Use both volume buttons when restart your iPhone.

Restart is similar to rebooting.

How to Force Restart or Hard Reset the iPhone 8 and iPhone 8 Plus



- 1 Press and quickly release the **Volume Up** button.
- 2 Press and quickly release the **Volume Down** button.
- 3 Press and hold the **Side button** (aka power) until you see the Apple logo.

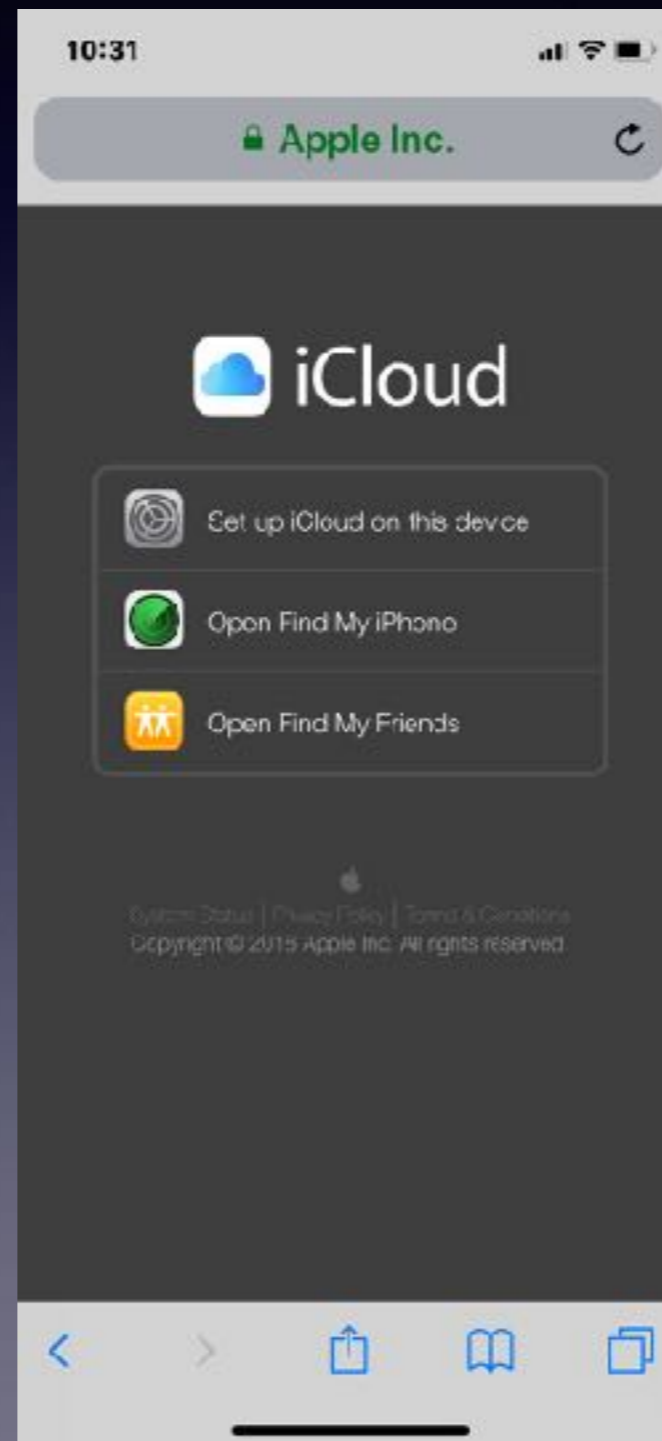


