## Podcasts and Privacy

Protecting the privacy and security of your information is a priority for everyone at Apple. We work hard to collect only the data we need to make your experience better, and when we do collect data we believe it's important for you to know what we're collecting and why. We respect so you can make informed choices. Podcasts, like every Apple product, is designed with these principles in mind.

As described here, Apple collects information about your use of the Podcasts app to manage your subscriptions, to help improve the app, and to provide aggregated reporting to podcast providers.

As a convenience to you, Podcasts syncs your subscriptions and the play position of the podcast episodes you are listening to so that you can enjoy the same Podcasts experience from any of your devices. This information is stored in association with your Apple ID. You may disable this capability at any time in Settings.

Also, to help improve the app, we collect information about your interactions with the app, such as links you click on in the app. This information is also associated with your Apple ID.

We collect playback data in order to understand, and provide reports about, podcast listenership. Playback data includes information about the podcasts you listen to such as, how much of a podcast you listen to, and when you listen. We designed Podcasts so that playback data is not linked to other Apple services. This information is associated with a random unique identifier that is specific to Podcasts and not associated with your Apple ID. We use iCloud to sync the Identifier across your devices that are logged in to iCloud. To reset the Identifier included in playback data sent to Apple, go to Settings, tap Podcasts and select Reset Identifier.

We share data with podcast providers only in aggregate form. We do not share any of your individual data with third parties. Keep in mind, however, that when you pay or download podcast episodes from podcast providers, those providers may be able to collect information about your use of their podcasts, and that collection is governed by their privacy practices.

Apple may use information about your use of Podcasts to prevent or take action against activities that are, or may be, in breach of the iOS Software License Agreement or applicable law.
