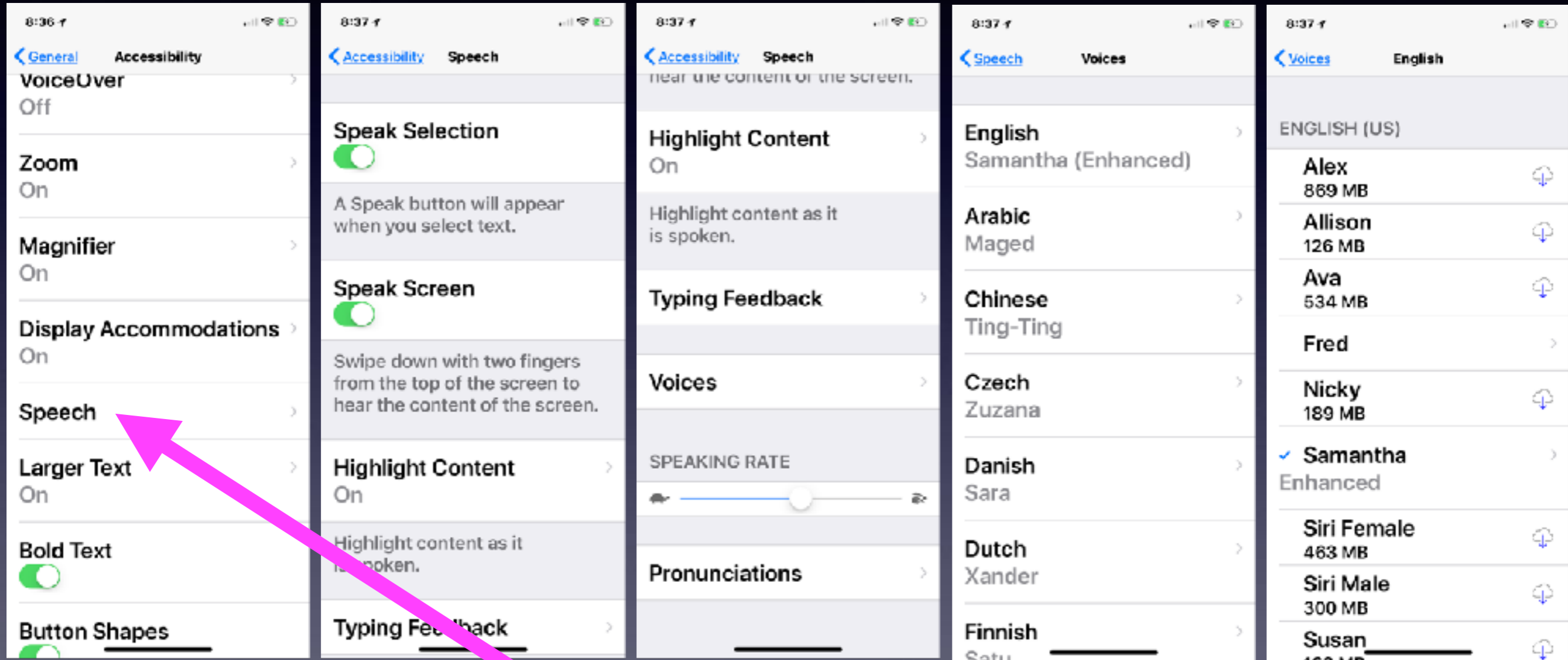
*Dear Apple,*
