Dear: TOM MILLER



How To Guard Your Identity?

Don't share your passwords.

Don't let your iPhone out of your hands.

Don't let your credit card out of your sight.

Monitor your bank and credit card statements.

Remove unnecessary cards and papers from purse or wallet.

Photograph everything in your wallet or purse.

Make sure the pictures of cards, license, insurance etc are in iCloud.

Use very secure passwords.

Change passwords regularly.

Be very careful what you say or do on Facebook.

Don't answer your phone if you don't recognize the number.

Let unknown calls go to voicemail.

Use the Notes app to store and save personal info.

Lock your iPhone, iPad and computer with a strong passcode.

Be sure to shred anything with your address or credit requests.

How To Spot A Scam

Scammer Doesn't Want You Tell Anyone

Money Is Involved

Immediacy Is Critical

A Threat: If you don't....

Foreign Accent: Is Difficult To Understand.

Poor Grammar and incorrect spelling.

Something seems "fishy".

It was a popup or unsolicited call, email, letter.

Take A Screen Shot

On an iPhone 8 or earlier is different from an iPhone X or later.
Screenshots go directly into your Photo library.



iPhone 8 and older use the Home Button and the power button simultaneously.






iPhone X and newer use the volume up button and the power button simultaneously.

You Can Delete “Most” Unwanted Apps!

Some apps on iPhones/iPads cannot be deleted.

Tap and hold gently until you see a jiggly X. Then tap on any X you want to delete.


Go to Settings, then to General Then to iPhone Storage Then scroll through all the apps. Delete the ones you don't need.



Deleting an app deletes the data that was created when you used that app. e.g. the Steps app.

Deleting Unwanted Apps On A Mac Is Not So Simple!

There is no "delete app" on a Mac!



An “Unemptied” Trash Basket Is Data Still On Your Computer!
