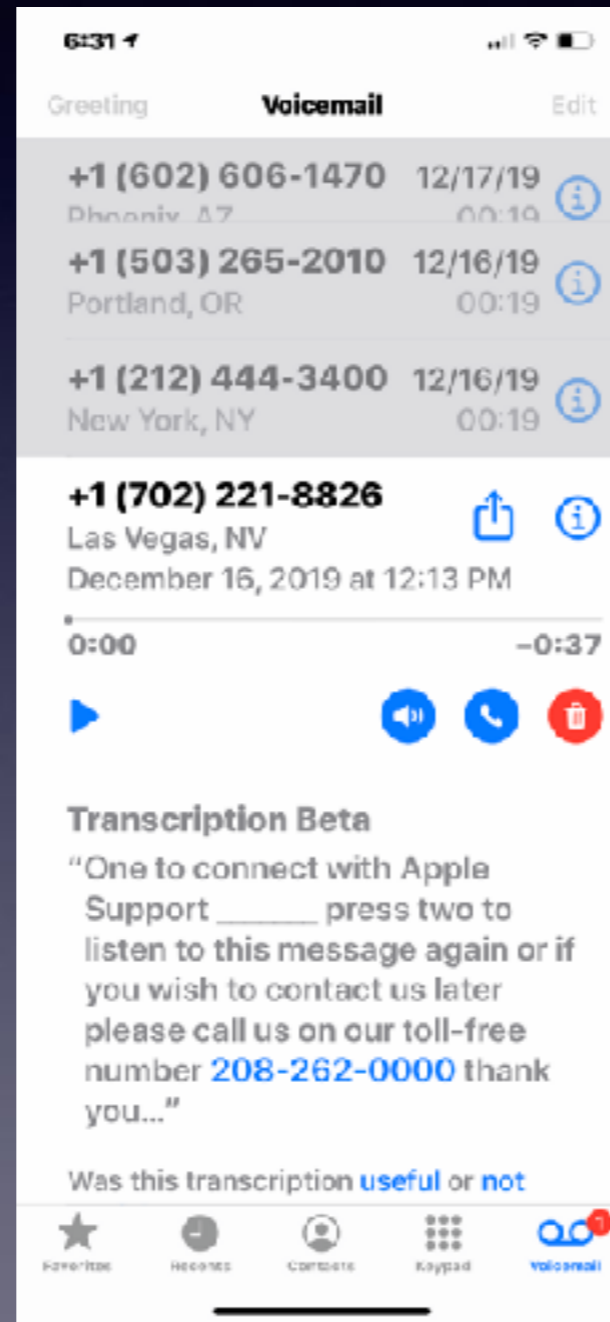
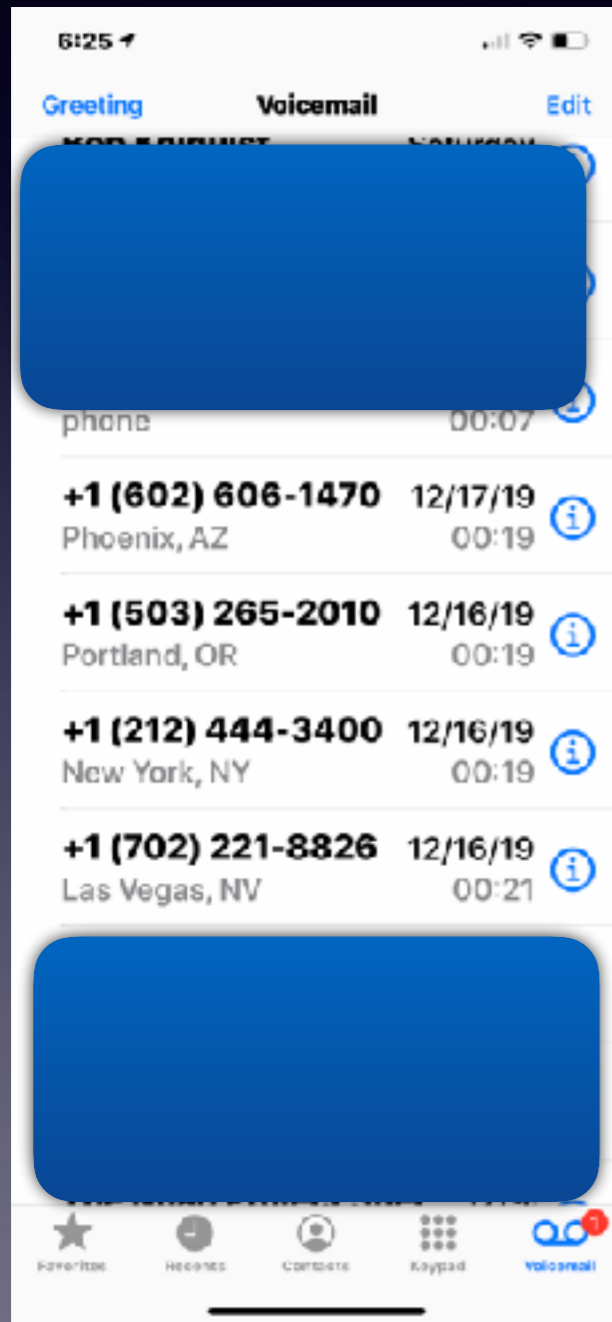
Don't Answer!

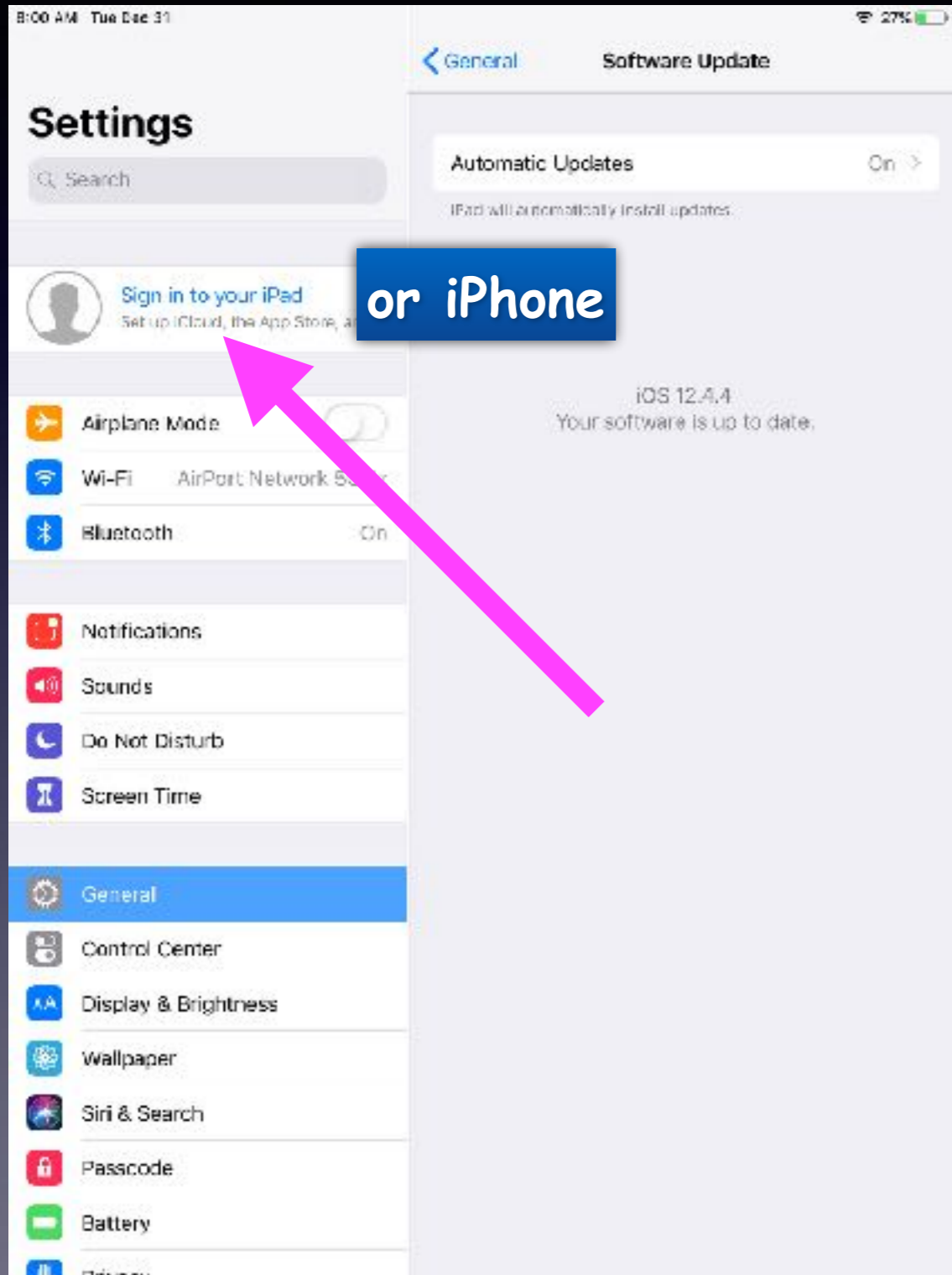

Can I Have A Good Experience Using My iPhone/iPad?



It starts with your Apple Id!
And An Apple Id password.

I get my apps.
I get backup to iCloud.
I communicate with FaceTime.
I get Messaging.
I get email.
What I do on one device is
shared among all my devices.

If I Have Not Used An iPhone, Where Do I Begin?

Open the box and unpack your iPhone or iPad!

Tap the Home Button on iPhone 8 or older.

Swipe up on iPhone 10 or newer.

Go to the "Settings" App.

Choose "Sign in to iPhone or iPad"!

You will need to create an Apple Account!

It will be your Apple ID.

Your Apple ID will be an email address.

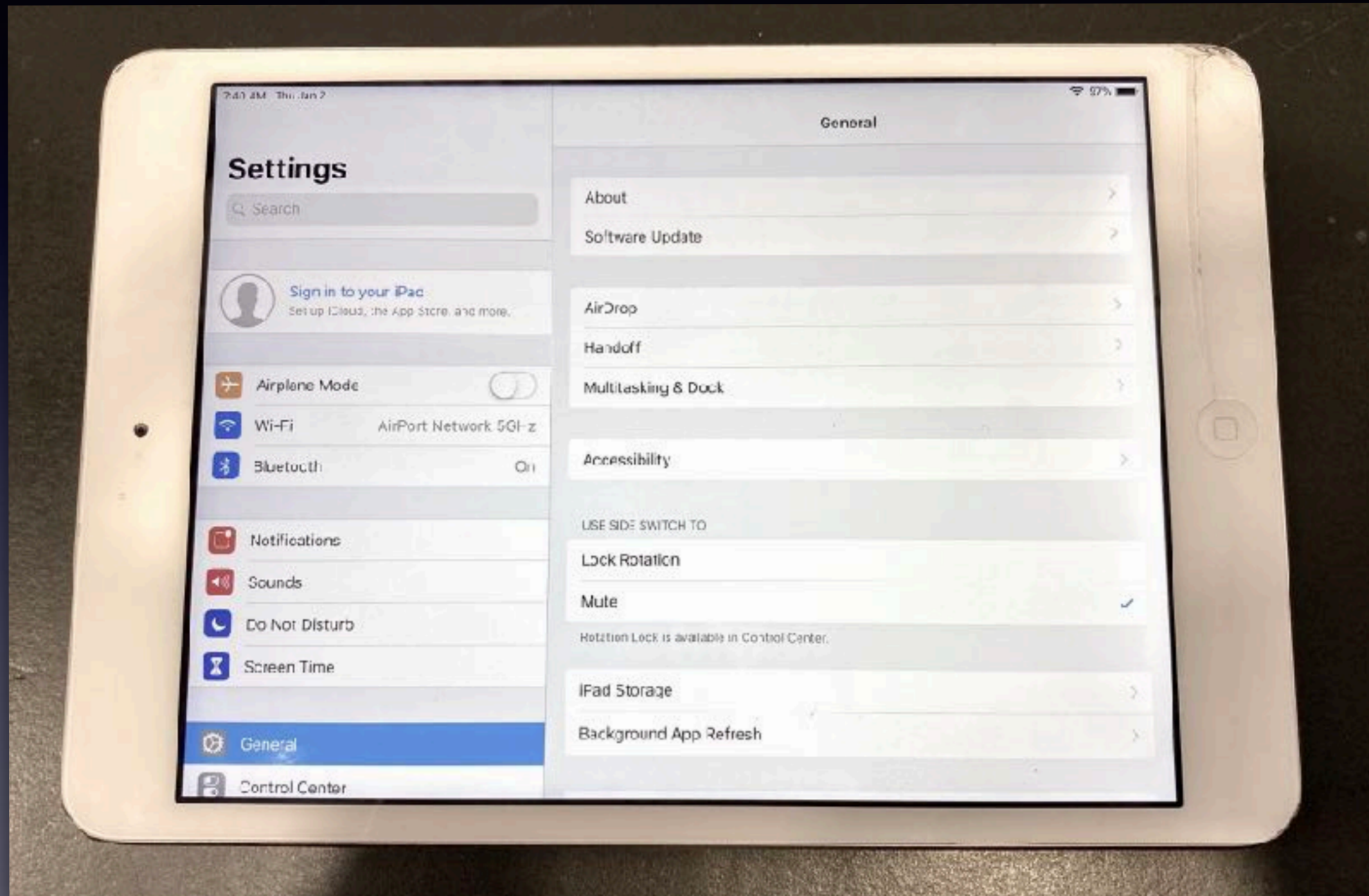
You will register that email address with Apple.

You will choose a password.

Minimum of 8 characters. Upper and lower case letters and a number.

When you registered, your Apple ID (email address) will appear in settings.

Use the volume slider to quickly increase or decrease the volume!



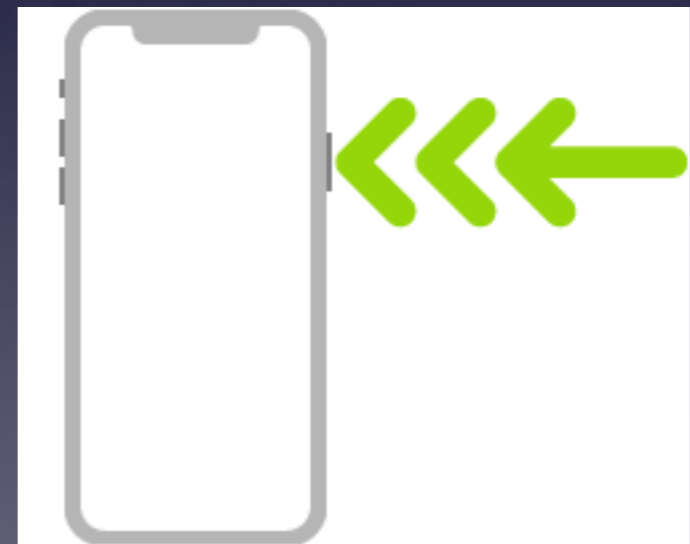
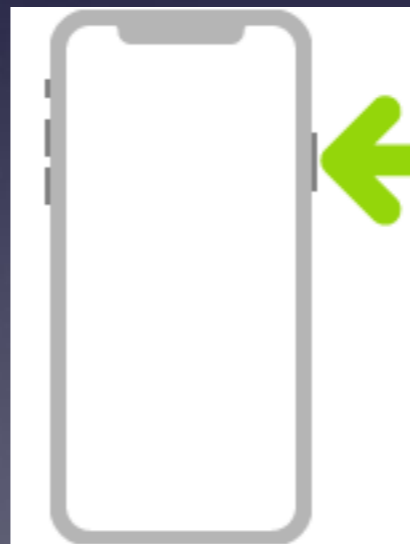
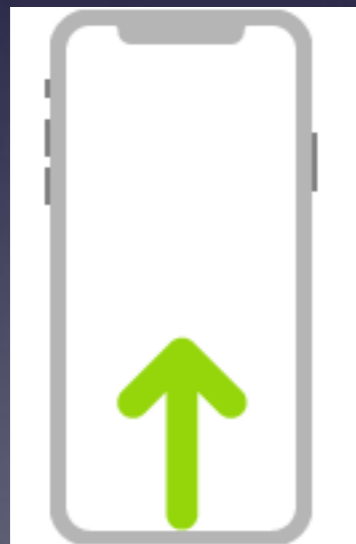
Use the slider to move quickly on a page!

Set A Timer! The “Fast” Way!

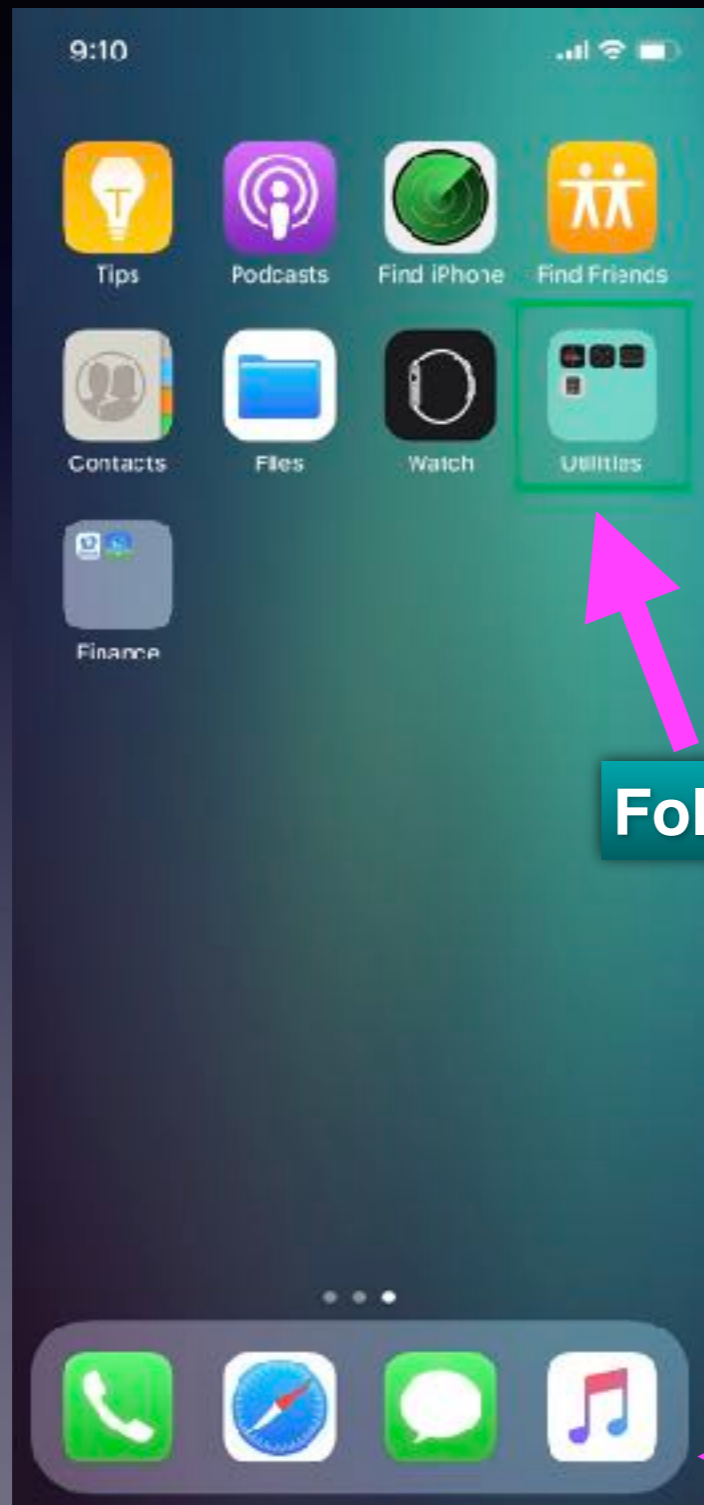


Swipe down on your screen to access the Control Center.

Apps And Folders




Folder

Use Your iPhone As A Level!

Open the Measure App!



Most people rarely use the Compass app that's preinstalled on their iPhone. Within the app is another tool you may not have known about: a spirit level. Here's how you easily access it:

- ▶ Open up the Measure app
- ▶ Tap Level at the bottom right
- ▶ Lay your phone flat against the surface you need to check levelness for

If you tap the screen, you can measure the difference between the two surfaces. The red margin shows how much the two angles vary.
