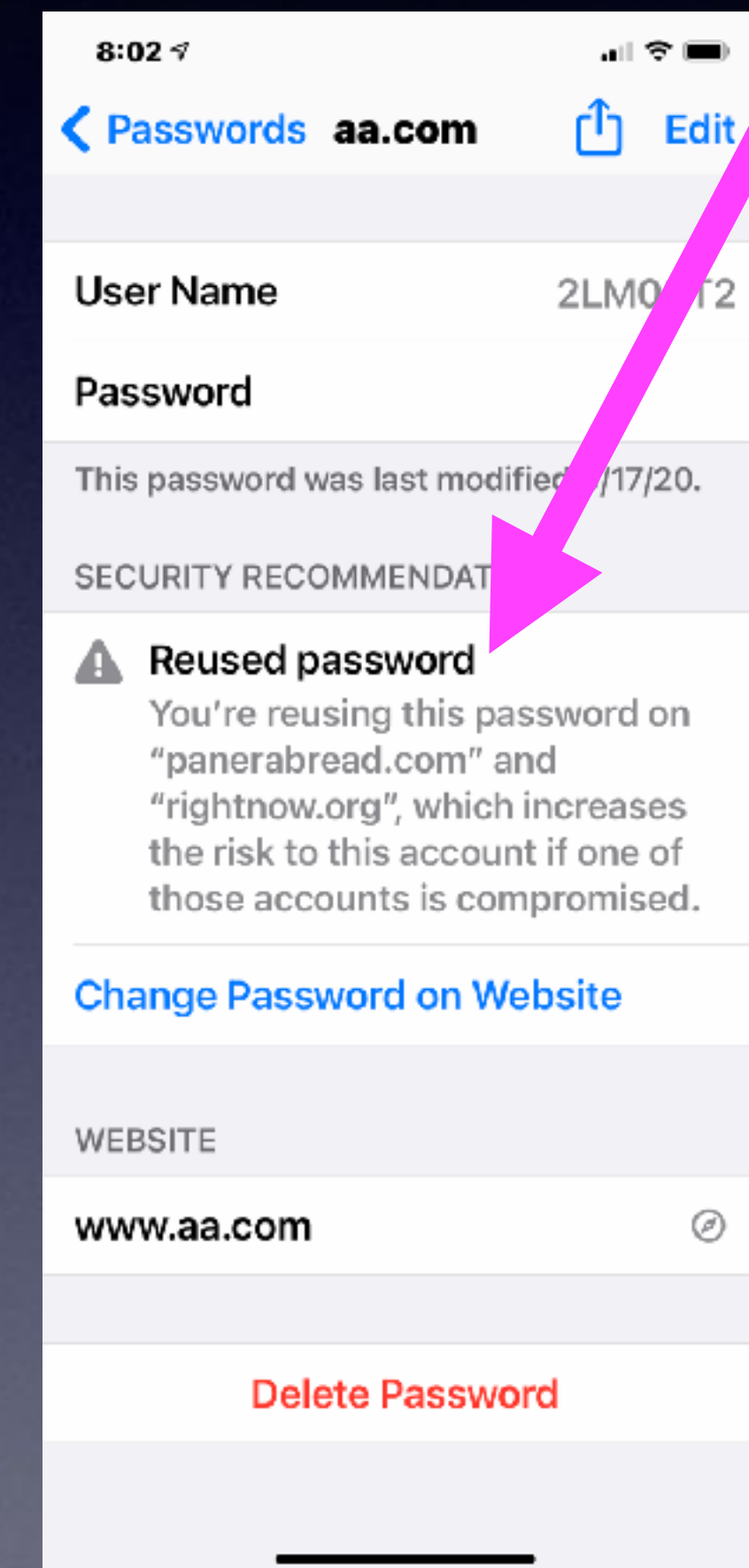
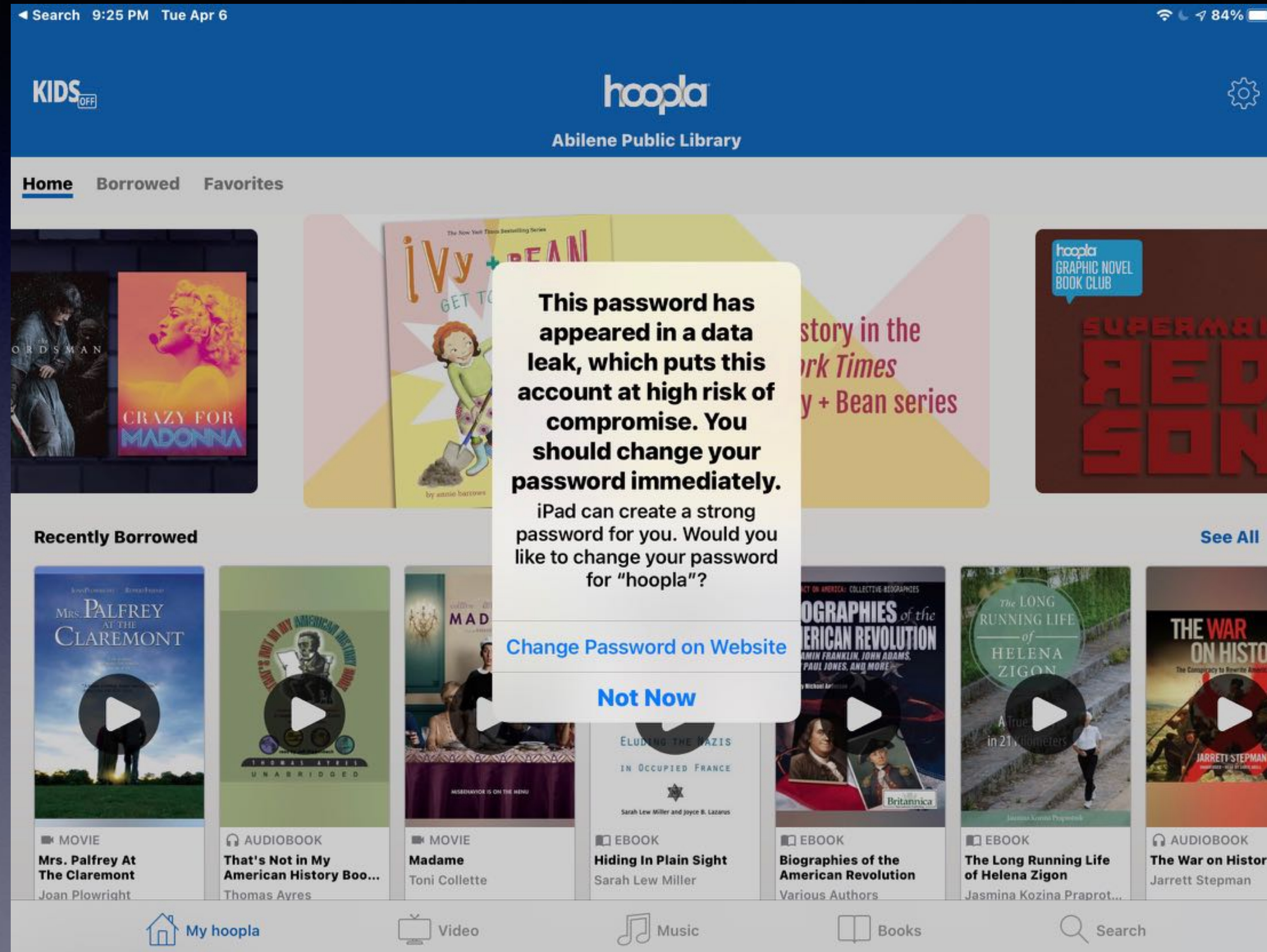
Will Face ID Work With A Mask?

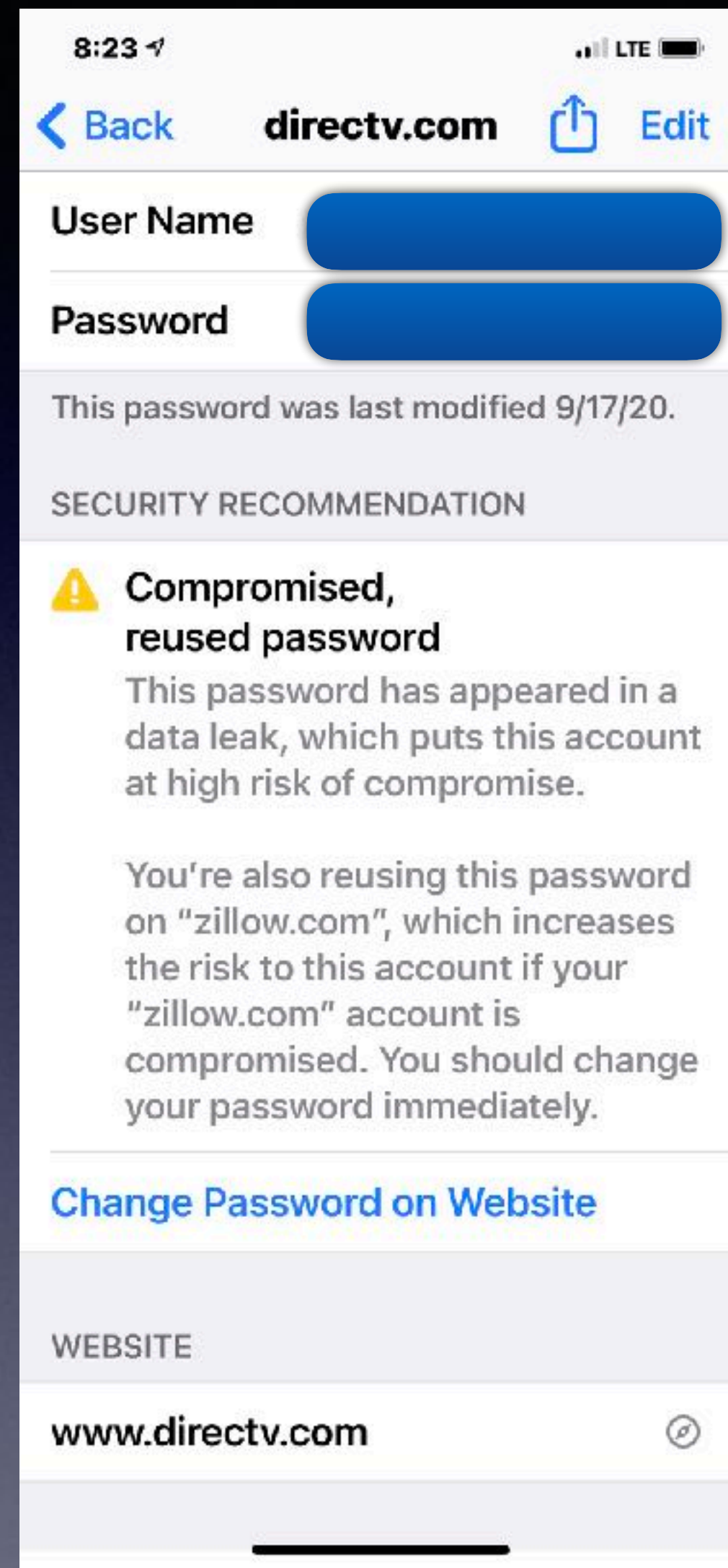
1. Head to **Settings > Face ID & Passcode**
2. You can either try to do the first step as an **Alternate Appearance** or choose to **Reset Face ID**
3. Once you've picked **Set up Face ID** or **Set Up Alternate Appearance**, fold your mask in half and hold it up to your face
4. If your iPhone says "Face Obstructed" move your mask slowly away from the center of your face until it asks you to "Move your head slowly to complete the circle" (Xuanwu Lab recommends covering just the tip of your nose; cover too much and you'll get an error)
5. Complete two scans of your face with the mask folded in the same orientation
6. You should see "Face ID is now set up"
7. Put your mask on, covering your whole face, test out if it works to unlock your iPhone

Does Your Voicemail work?

Voicemail is not set up or the mailbox is full!



Apple iPhone - Set Up Voicemail

For more info on Apple® iPhone® Voicemail or if you experience issues, visit [iPhone Voicemail Support](#).

1. From a Home screen, navigate: **Phone app** > **Voicemail** (lower-right).
→ If switching to an iPhone, you could be directed to the automated Voicemail system. If so, follow the voice prompts. If unsuccessful, you can dial *86 to manually set up.
2. Tap **Set Up Now**.
→ If the 'Set Up Now' pop-up doesn't appear, your Voicemail has already been set up. Simply tap **Greeting** in the upper-left of the Voicemail screen and begin at step 6.
3. Enter a password then tap **Done**.
→ The password must be between 4-6 digits in length.
4. Re-enter the password then tap **Done**.
5. Tap **Custom** to record a greeting.
→ To use a Verizon default greeting, tap (check) **Default**.
6. Tap **Record** to begin.
7. When finished, tap **Stop**.
8. To complete, tap 'Done' or 'Save'.

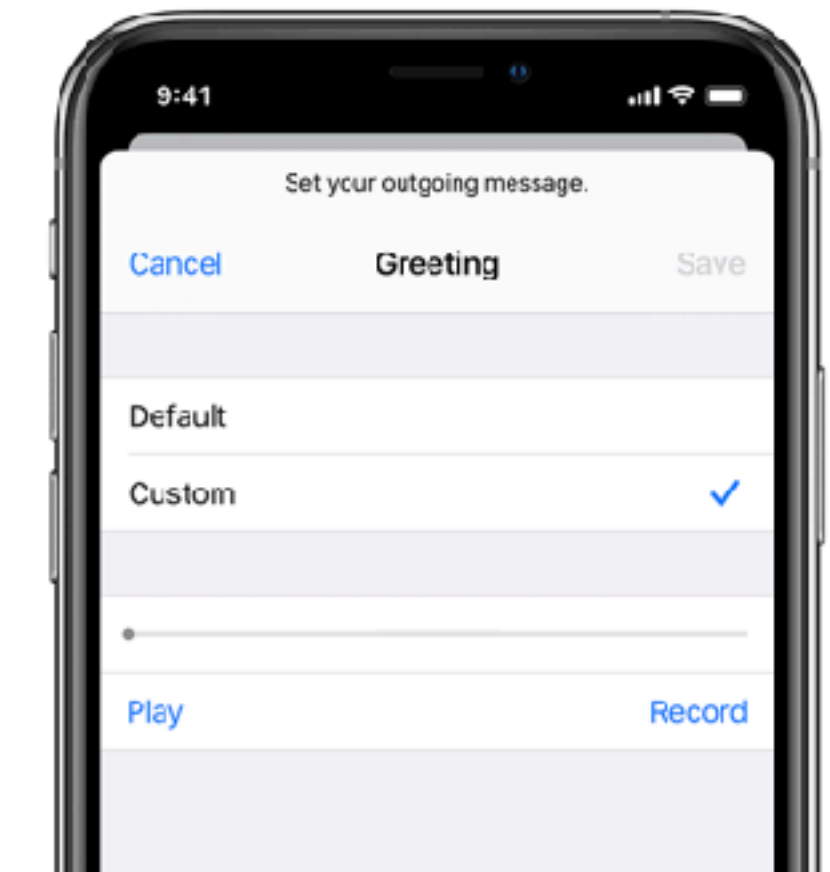
Set up Visual Voicemail on your iPhone

With Visual Voicemail, you can see a list of your messages and choose which ones to listen to or delete. Learn how to set up and transfer your existing voicemail.

Set up Visual Voicemail

If your carrier supports Visual Voicemail, you can set it up with these steps:

1. Go to the Phone app, then tap the Voicemail tab.
2. Tap Set Up Now.
3. Create a voicemail password, then tap Done.
4. Enter your password again to confirm it, then tap Done.
5. Select Custom or Default. If you choose Custom, you can record a new greeting.



6. Tap Save.
