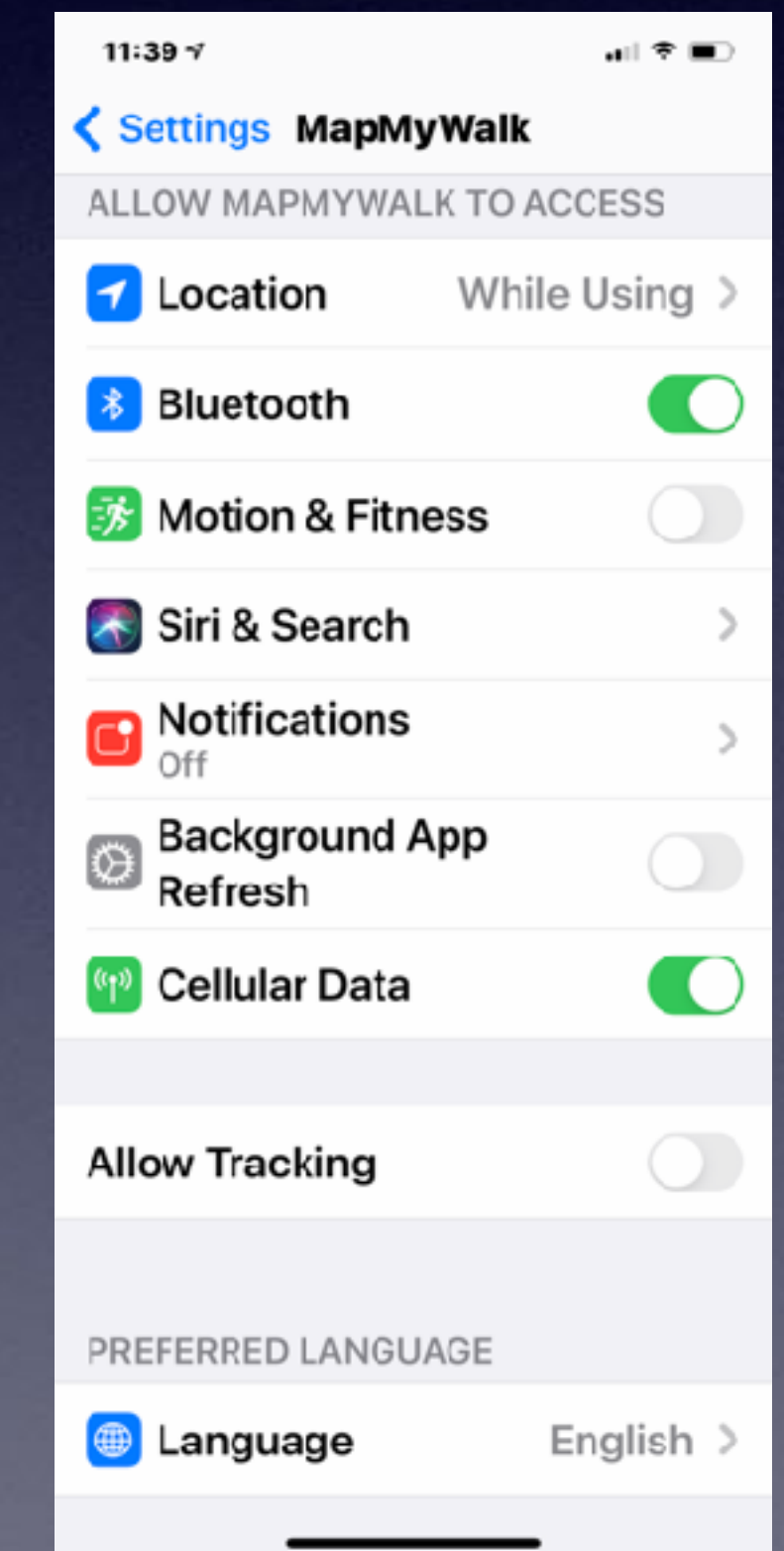
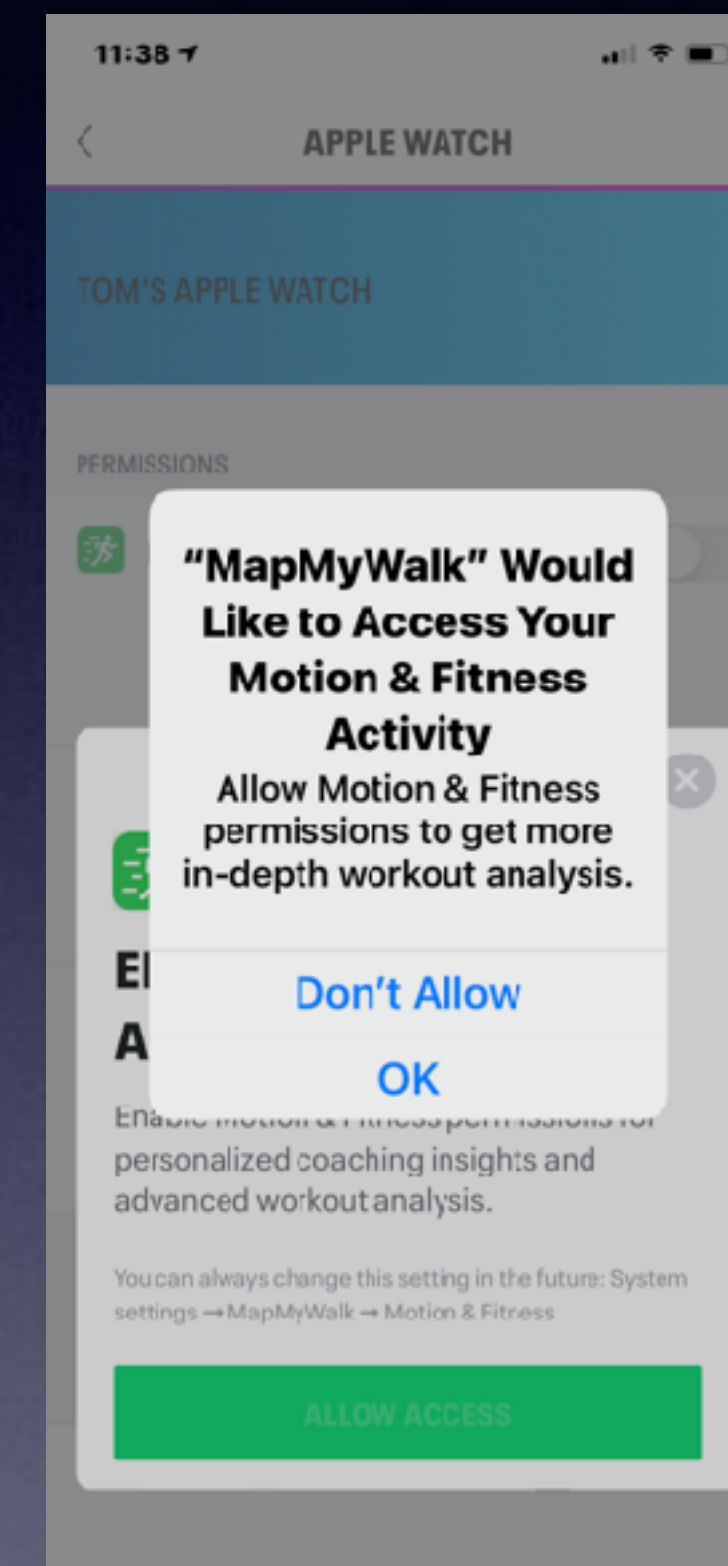
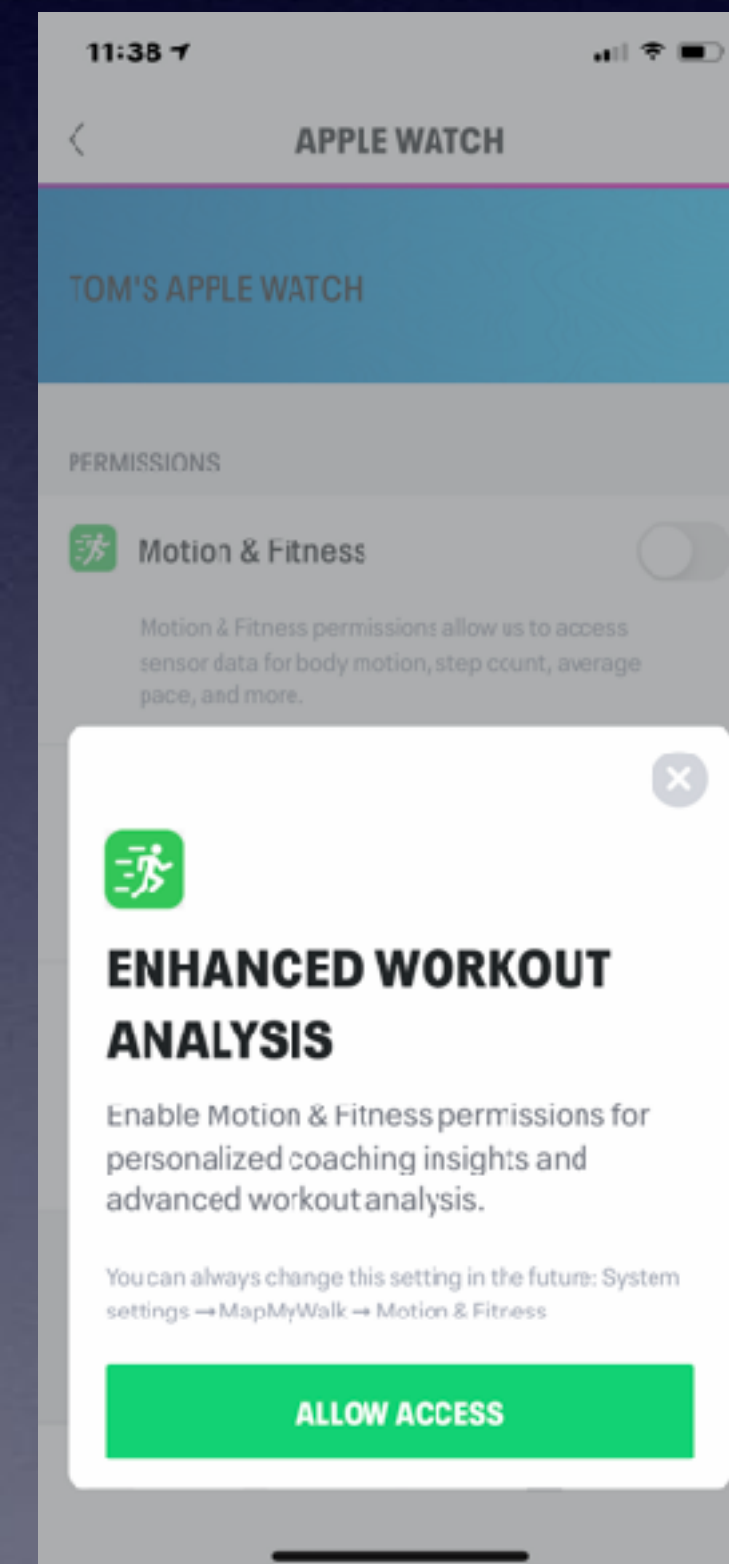
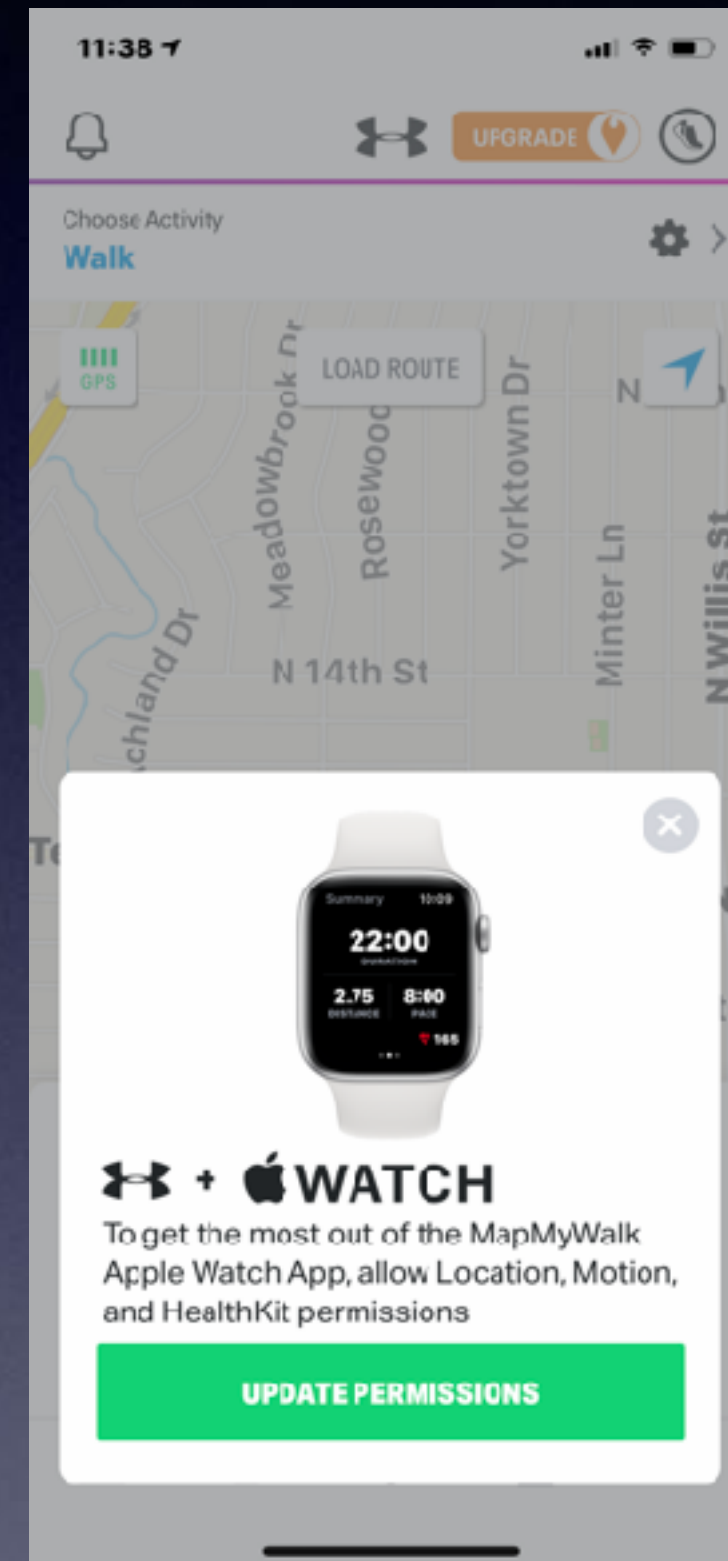
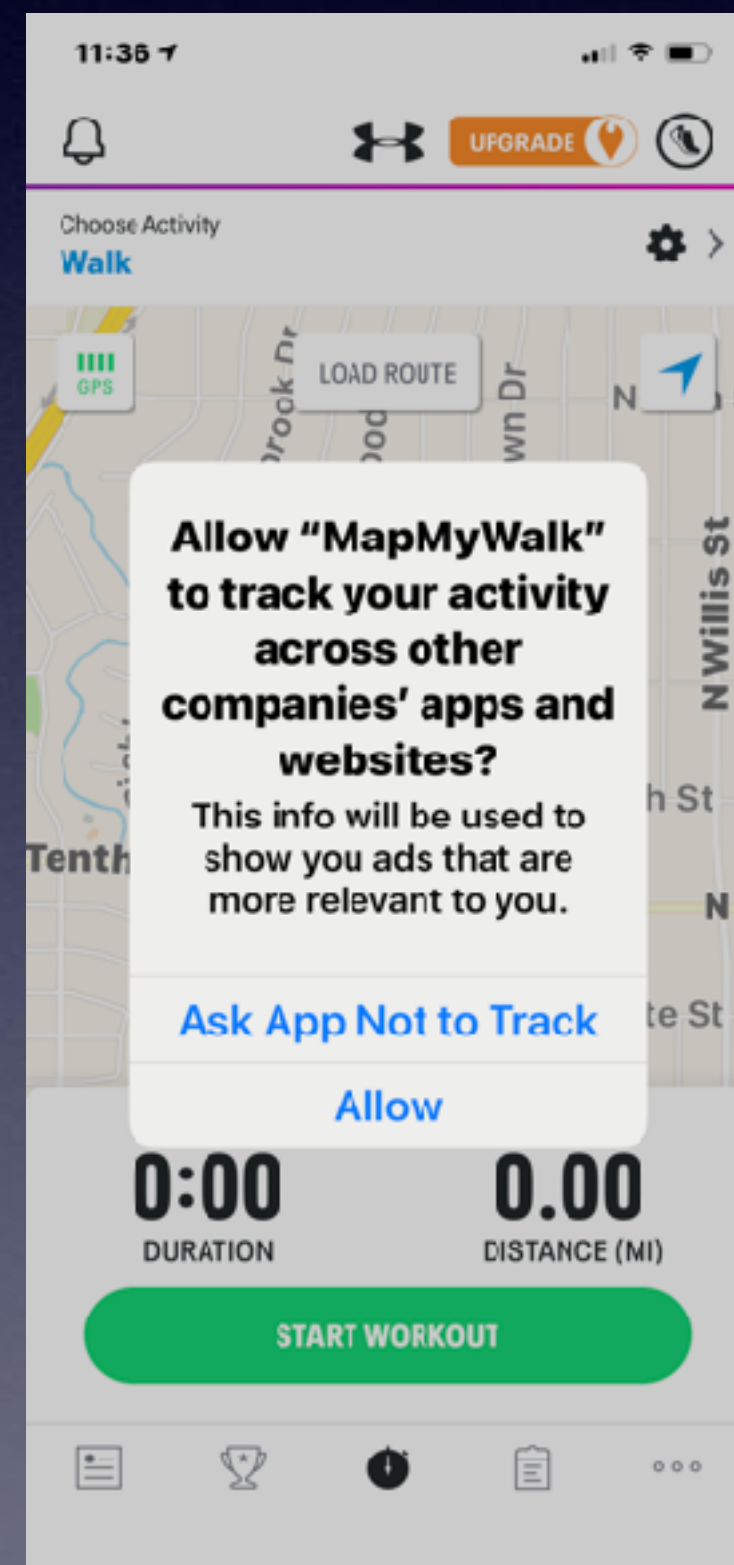
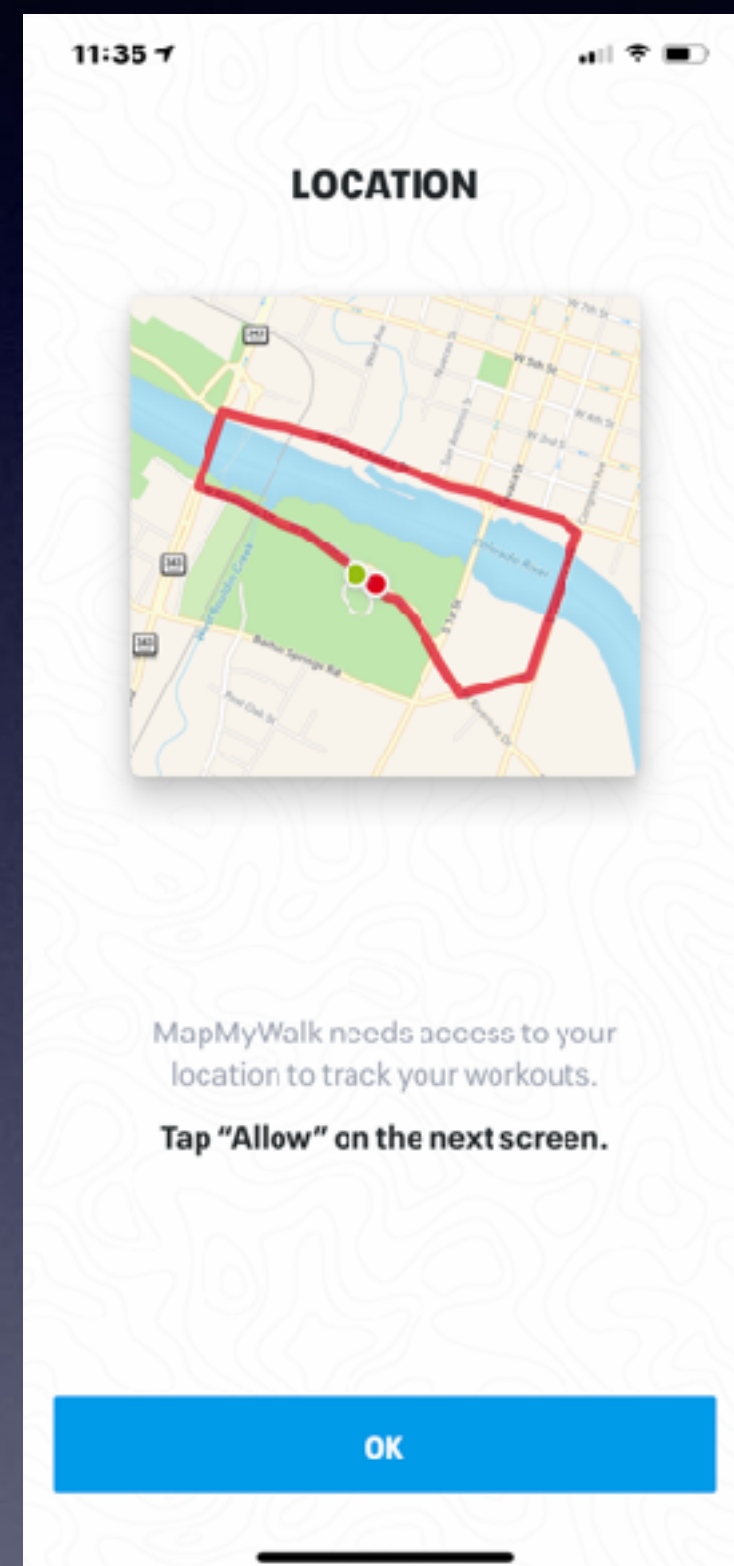
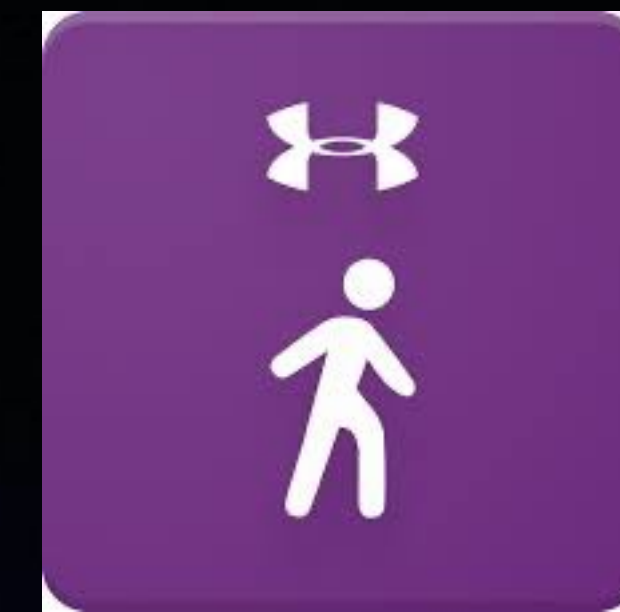
You can prevent an app tracking for the purpose of advertising and sharing with other data brokers!

App Tracking Transparency

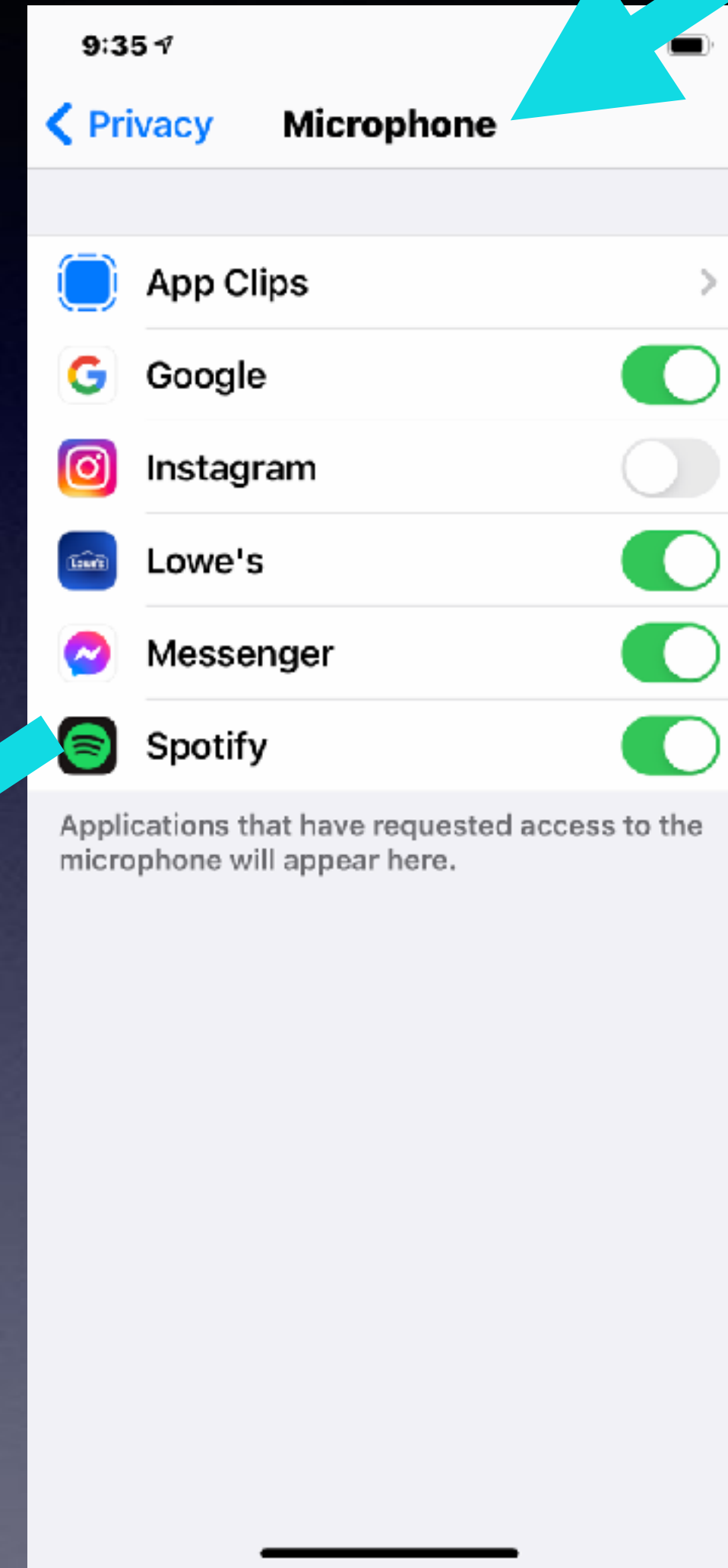
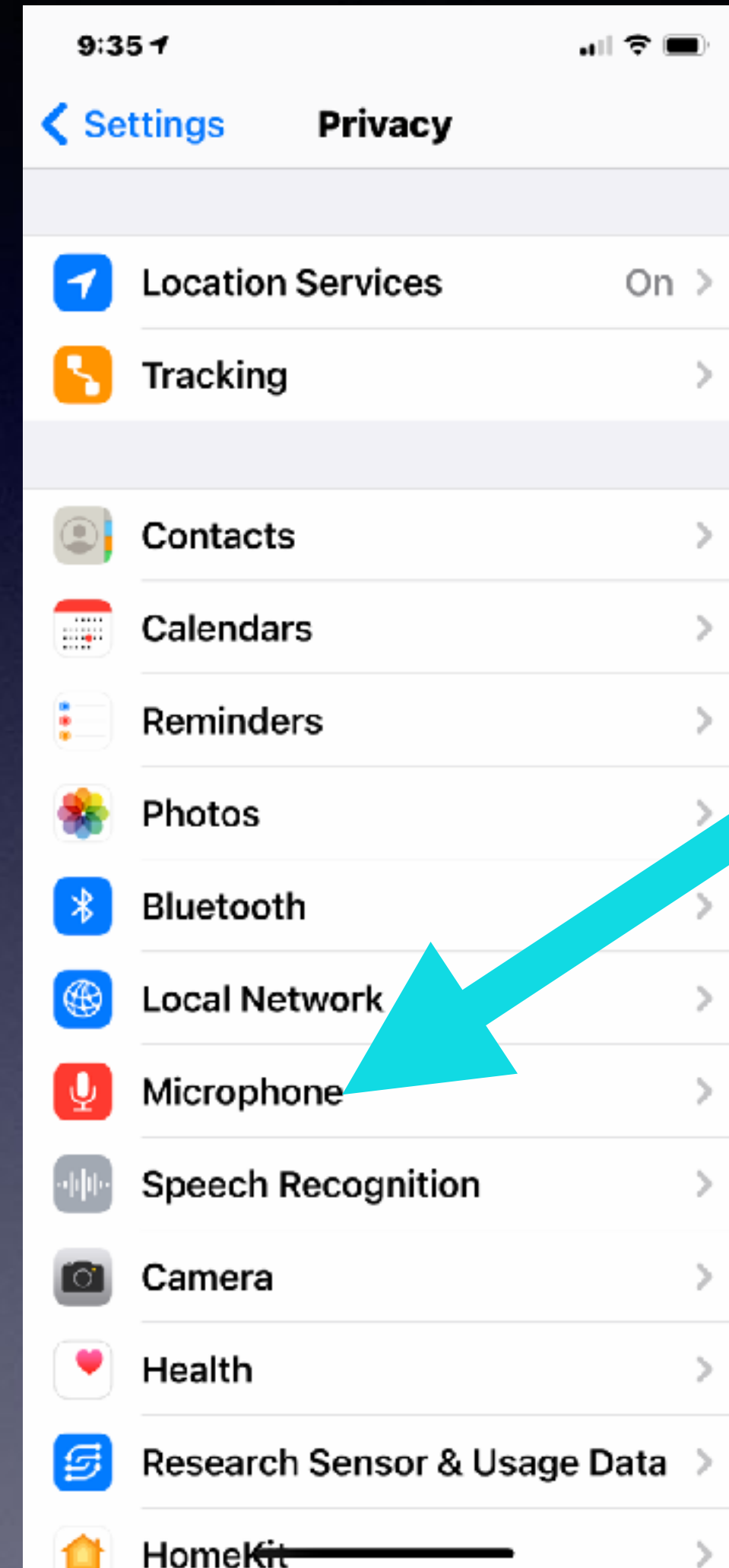
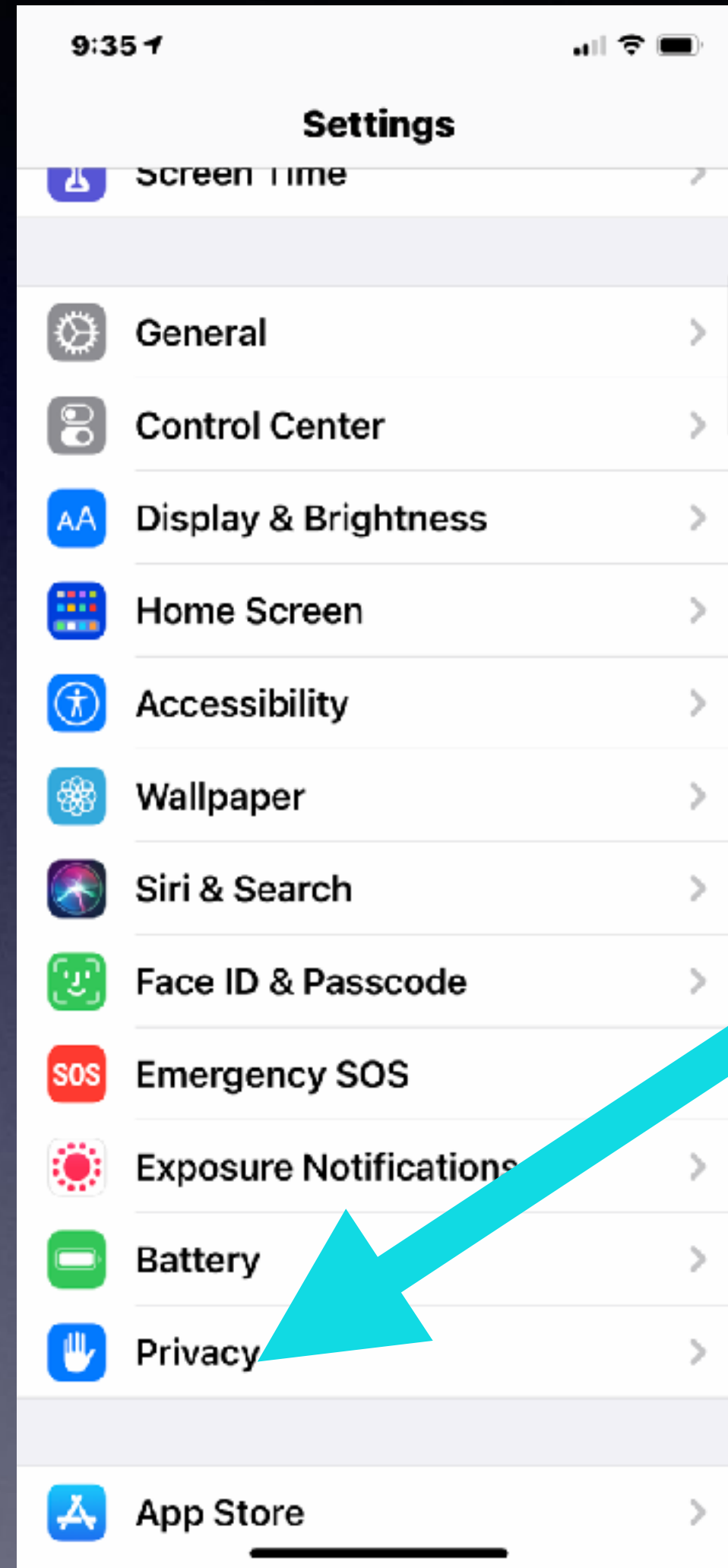
Your devices carry the story of your life. We believe you should have a choice in how apps track and share your data with other companies for advertising or with data brokers.

Starting with iOS 14.5 and iPadOS 14.5, apps are required to ask your permission when they want to track you across apps and websites owned by other companies. You'll be able to change your preference for any app or prevent apps from asking for permission entirely in Settings.

What Are App Clips?

(Pocket-lint) - Apple's [iOS 14 software](#) comes with a host of features, including App Clips, which are snippets or clips of an app that focus on the part of the app you need, making access to certain tasks easier.

Here we are explaining everything you need to know about App Clips and how they work.

What is an App Clip?

There is an App for pretty much everything you might want to do on your [iPhone](#), but there are often times when you don't have the app you need when you need it, such as a specific parking app when paying for parking. That's where App Clips come in.

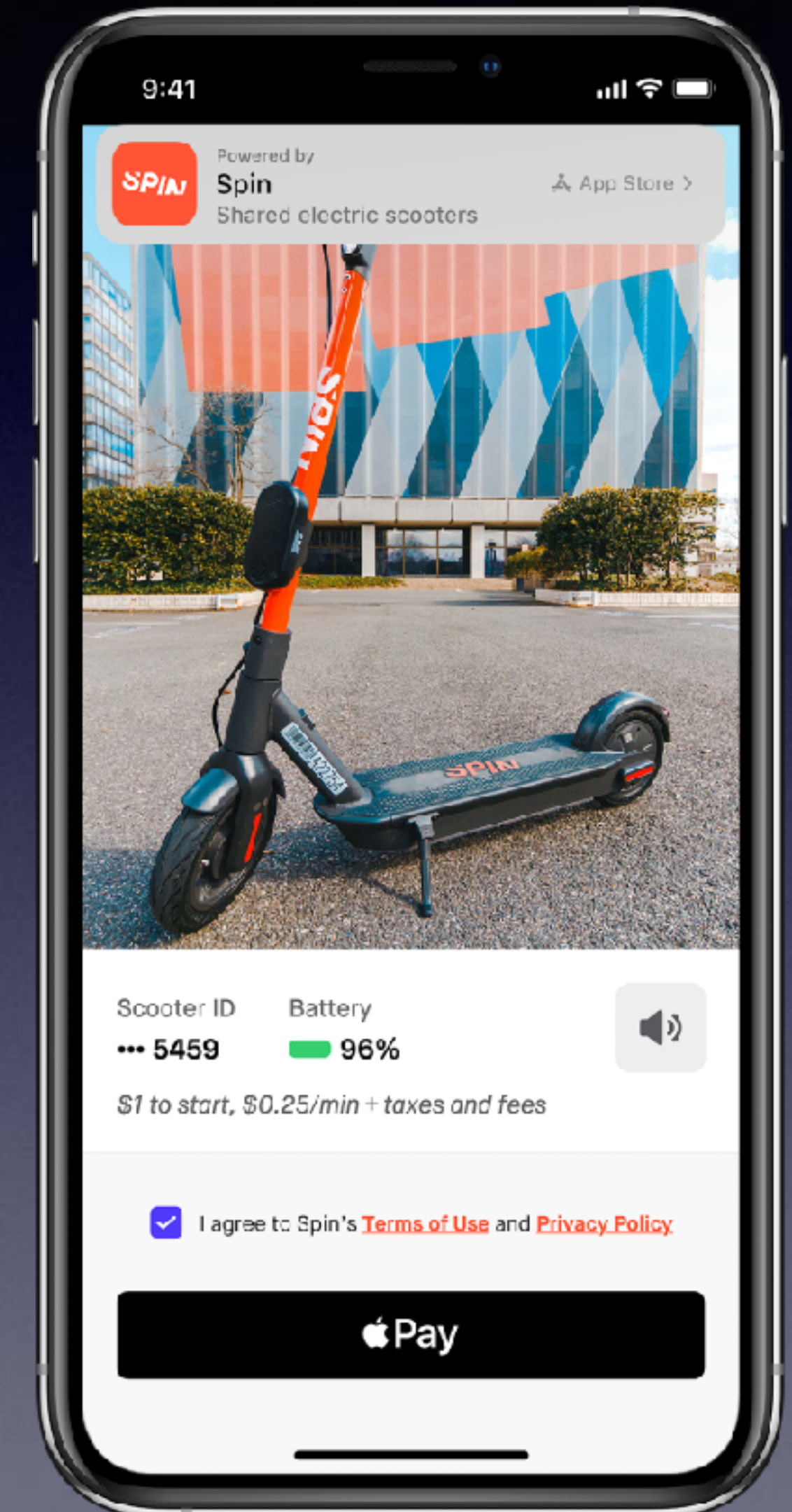
An App Clip is a small part of an app that is focused on a specific task and designed to appear as soon as you need it, like ordering a coffee or renting a scooter.

App Clips are small in size - under 10MB - launching within seconds at the bottom of your iPhone, and removing the need for you to either find the correct app on your iPhone or download it from the App Store, both of which take a lot longer than the App Clip launching will.

As the name suggests, App Clips are snippets or clips of an app that focus on the part of the app you need, like the parking payment page.

Mistakes iPhone & iPad Users Make!

Answering a "robo" call rather than letting "unknown" calls go to voicemail.

2. Opening email and messages from friends or unknown sender and clicking on links.

3. Sharing things you find interesting on Facebook.

4. Cleaning your iPhone. Not just the exterior but the charging port and the speakers (camera and flashlight).

5. The debate over the "App Switcher". Close all open apps.

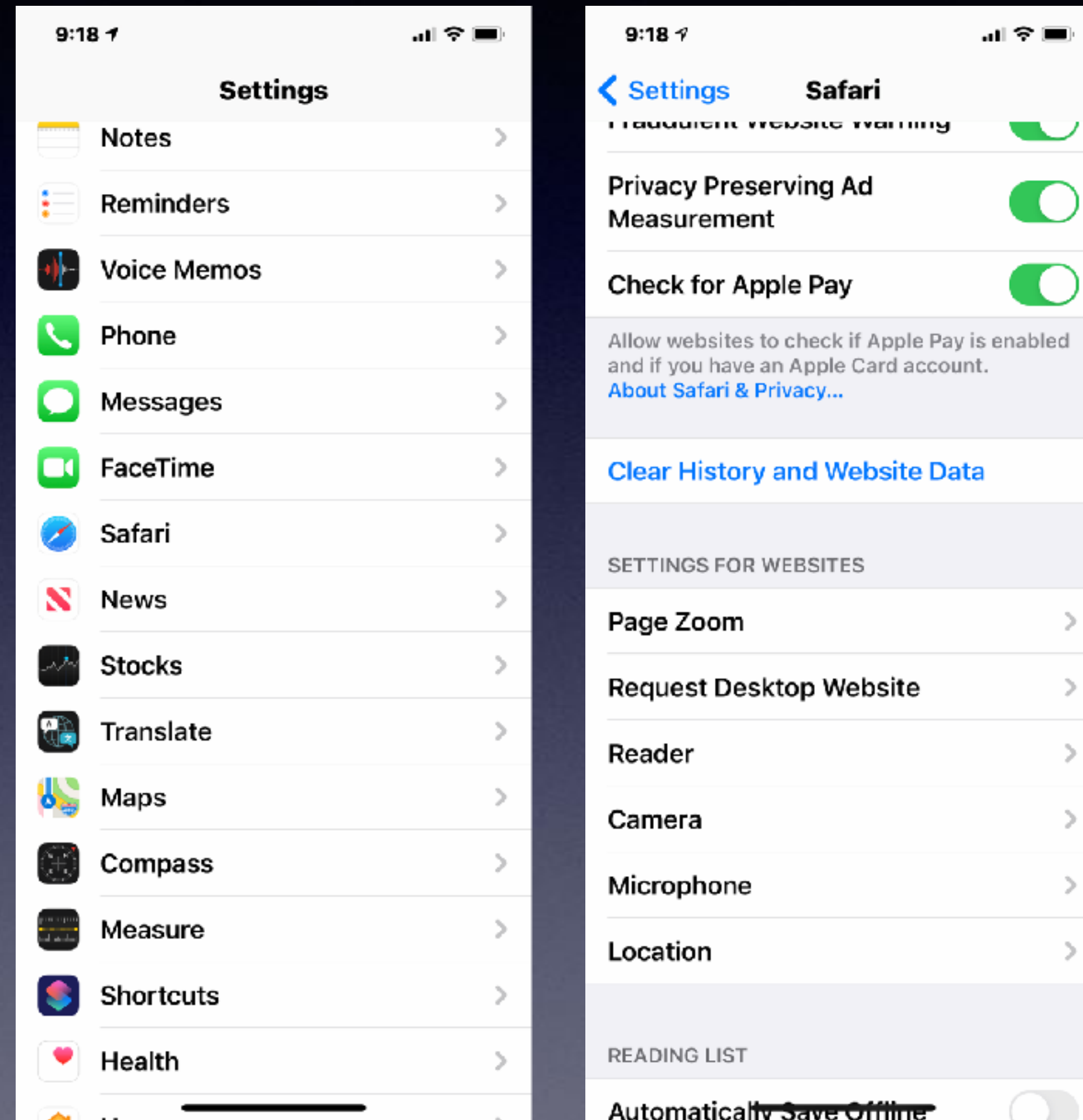
6. Too many apps refreshing in the background.

7. Offload or delete unused apps.

8. Forgetting to delete unused subscriptions.

9. Failure to clear "history and website data".

I would not recommend a wooden toothpick.



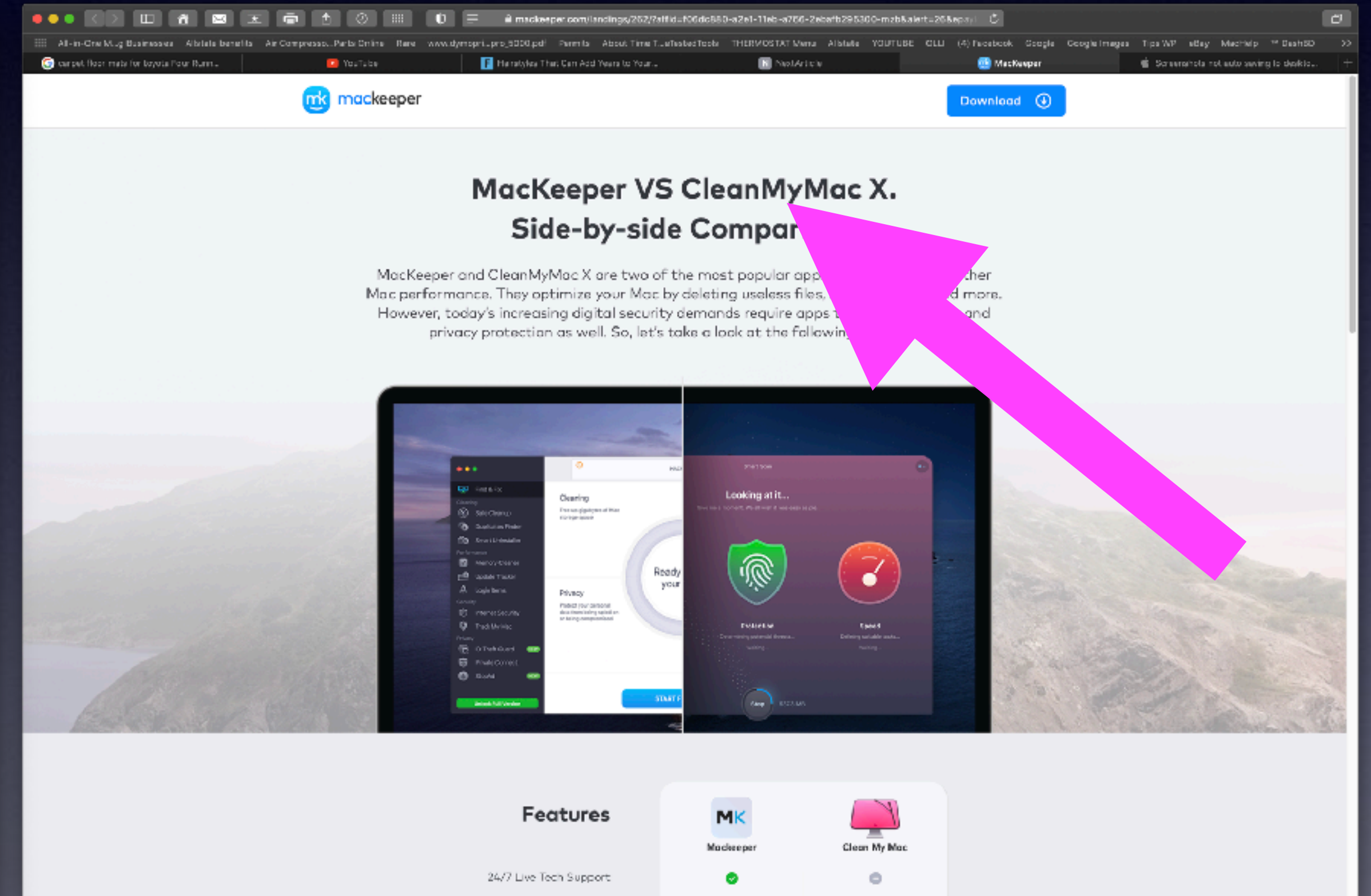
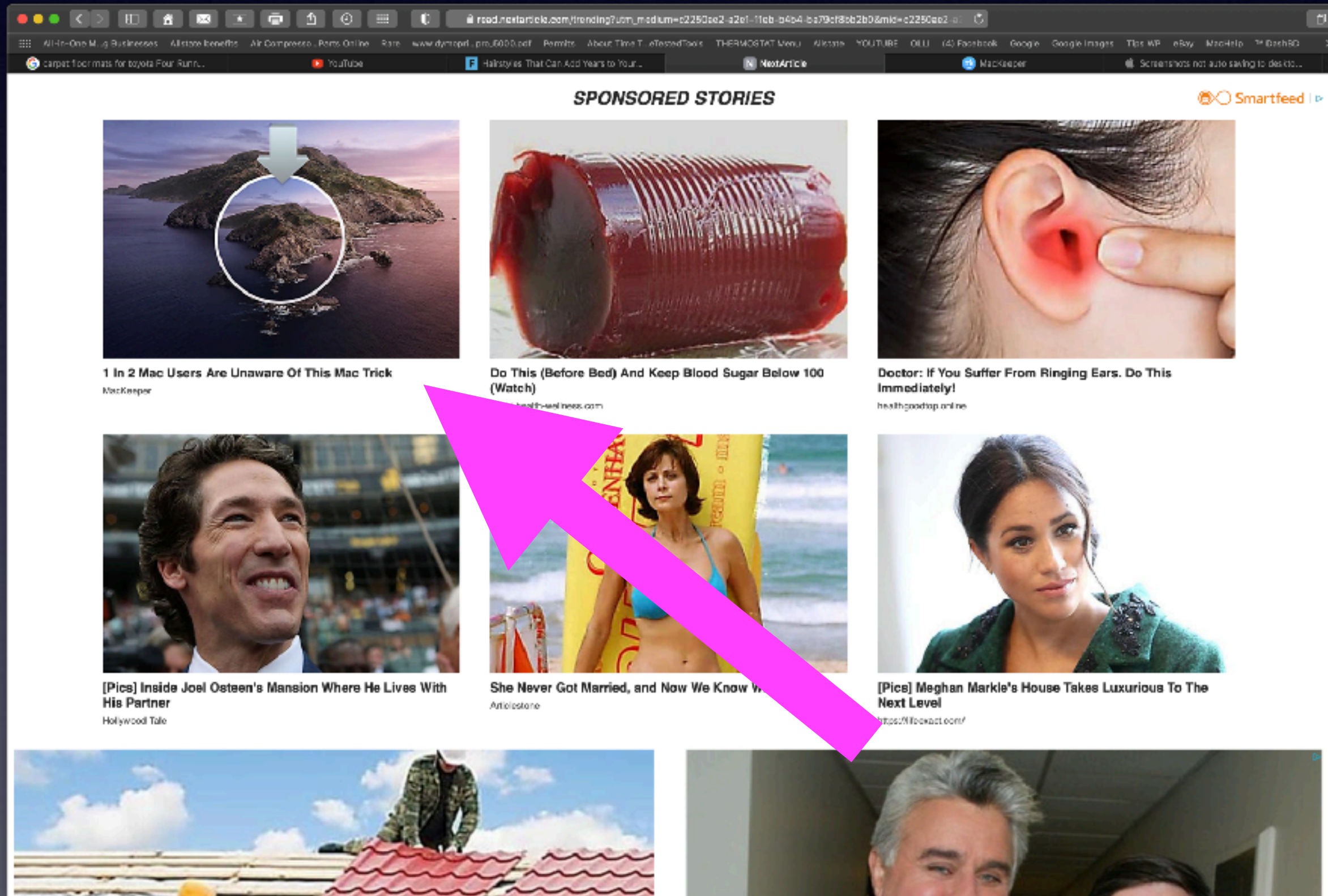
Social Security Scam!

Hard reset and hold until you see the Apple Logo.



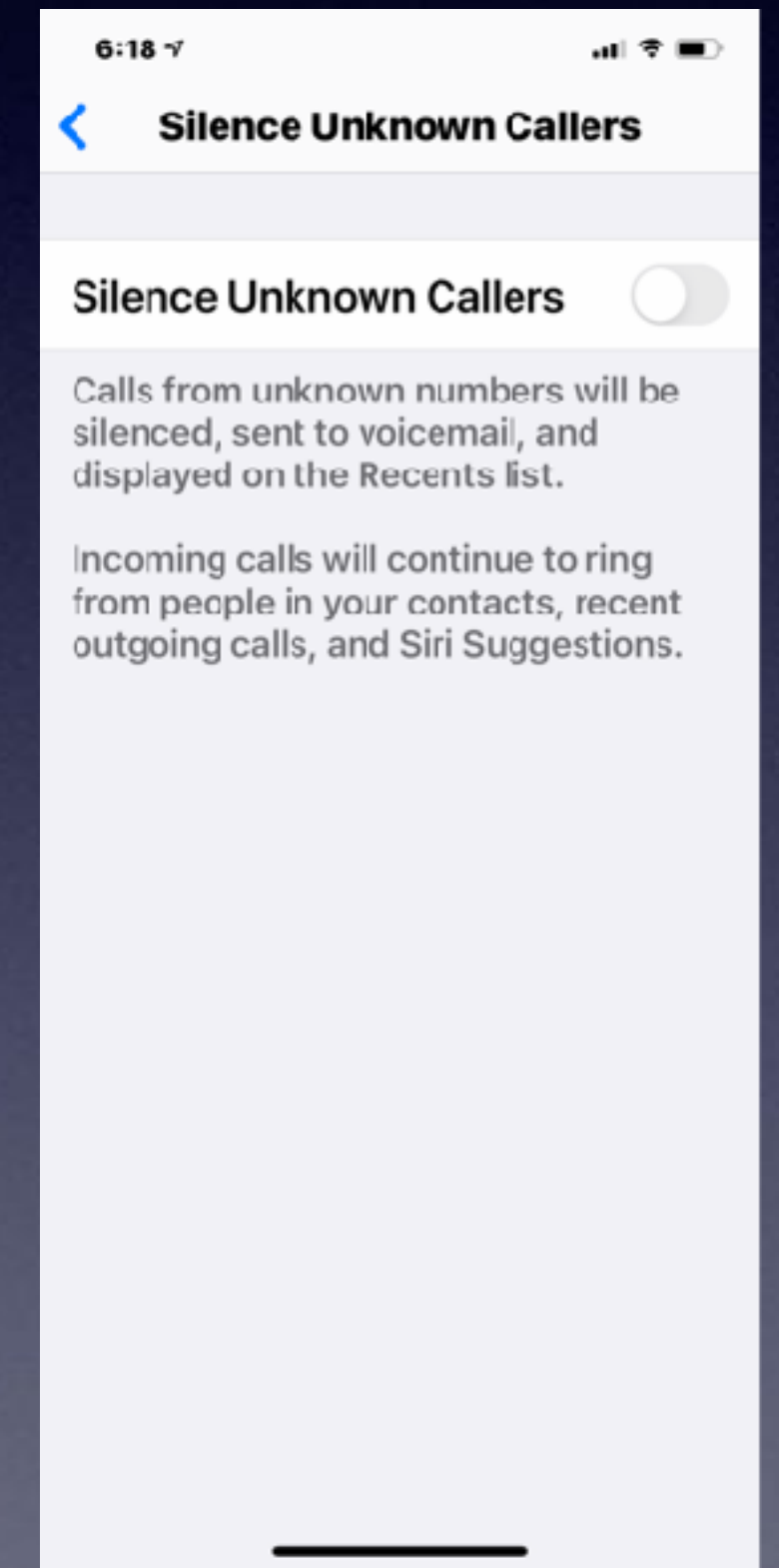
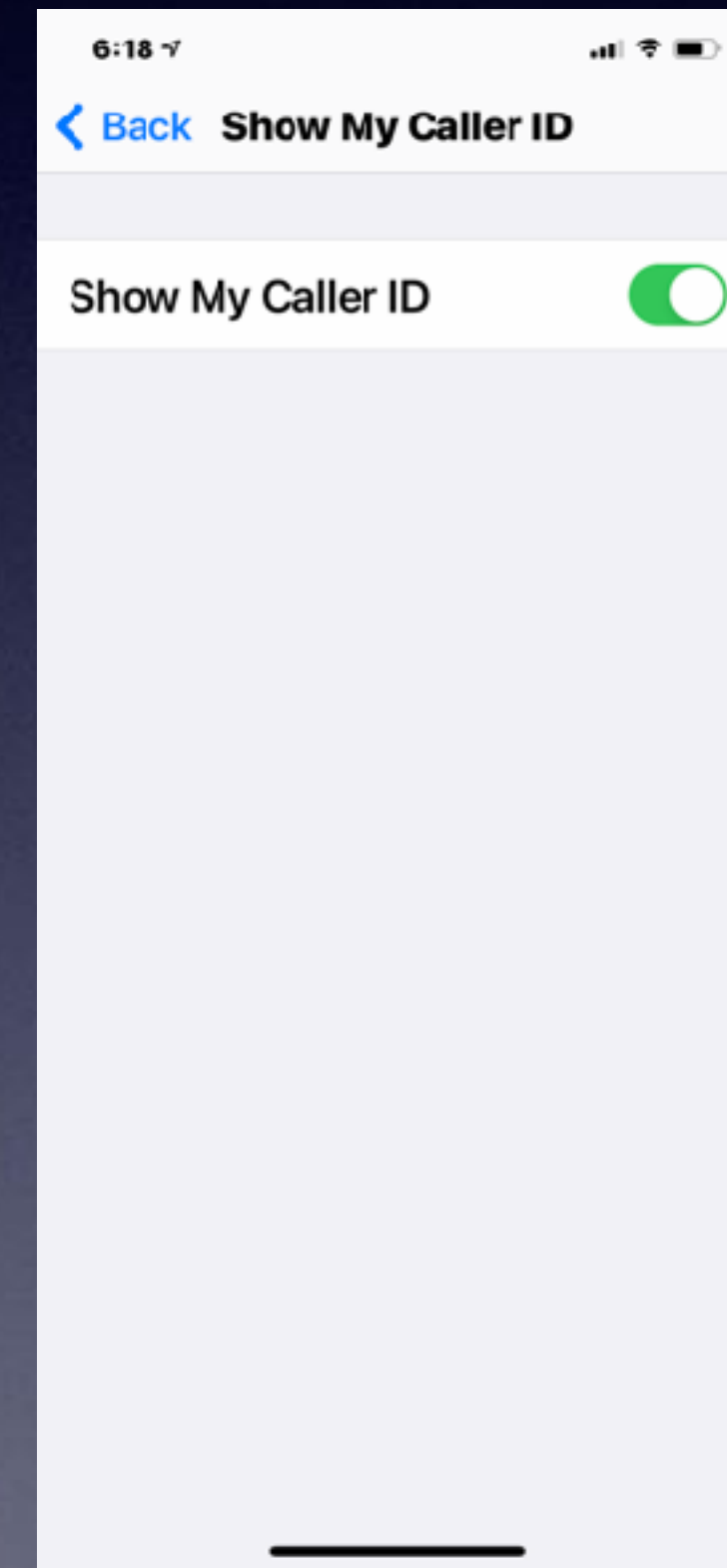
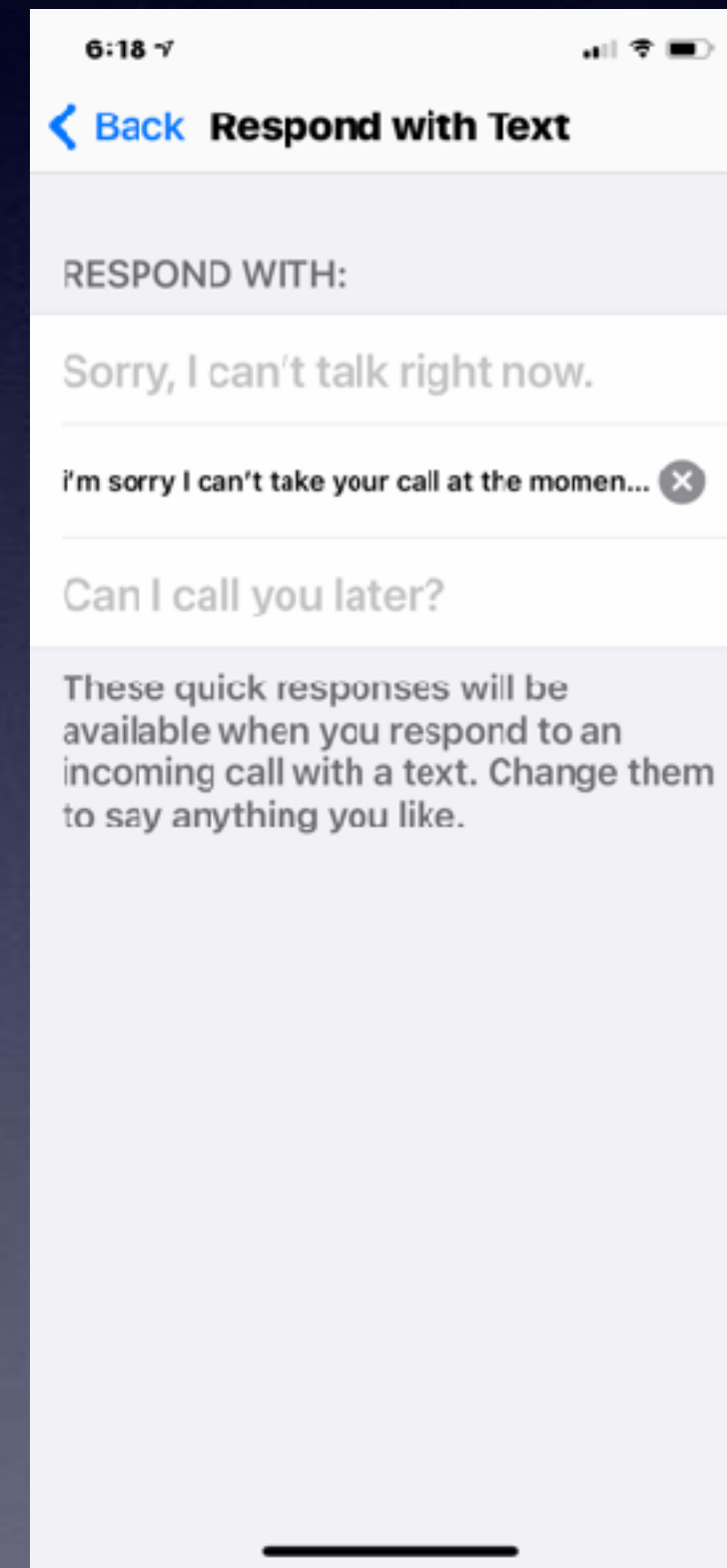
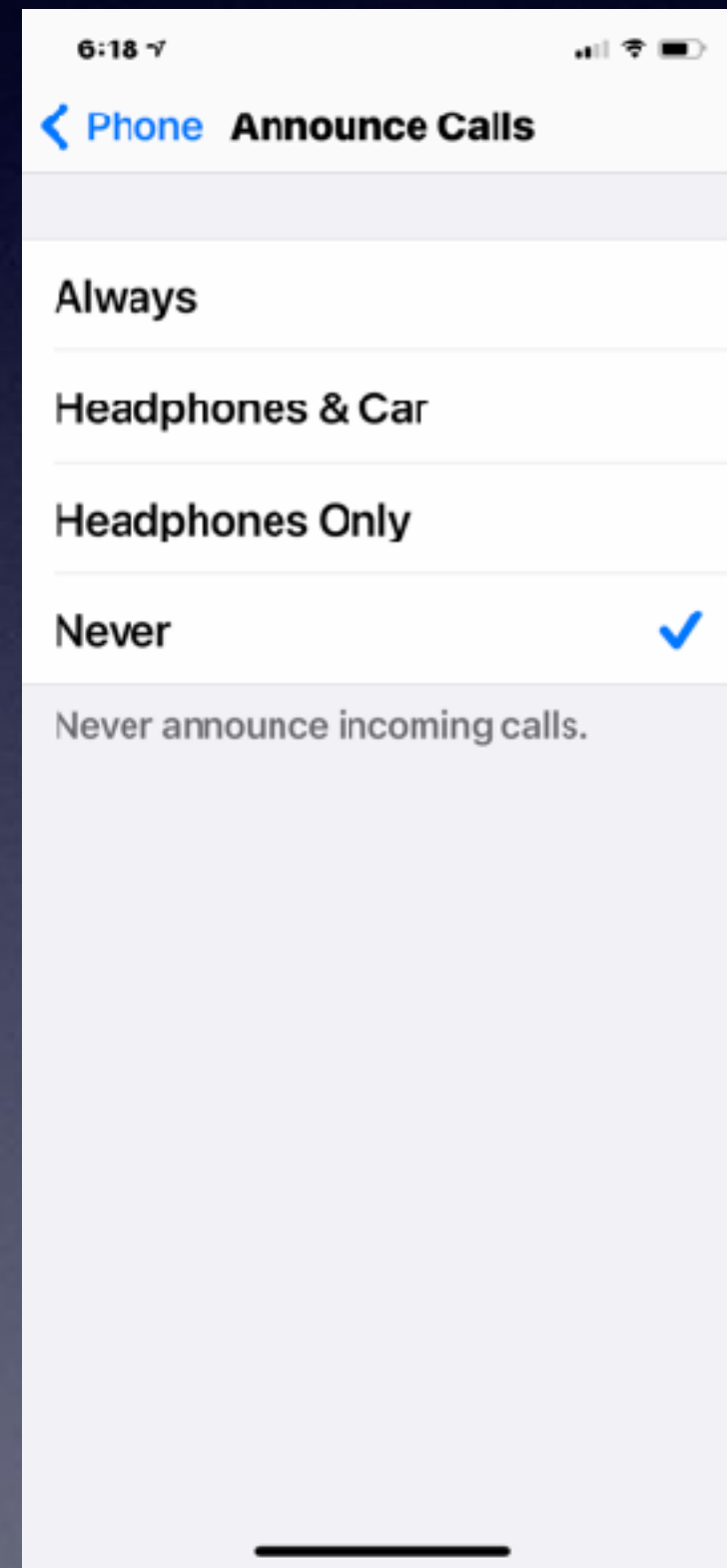
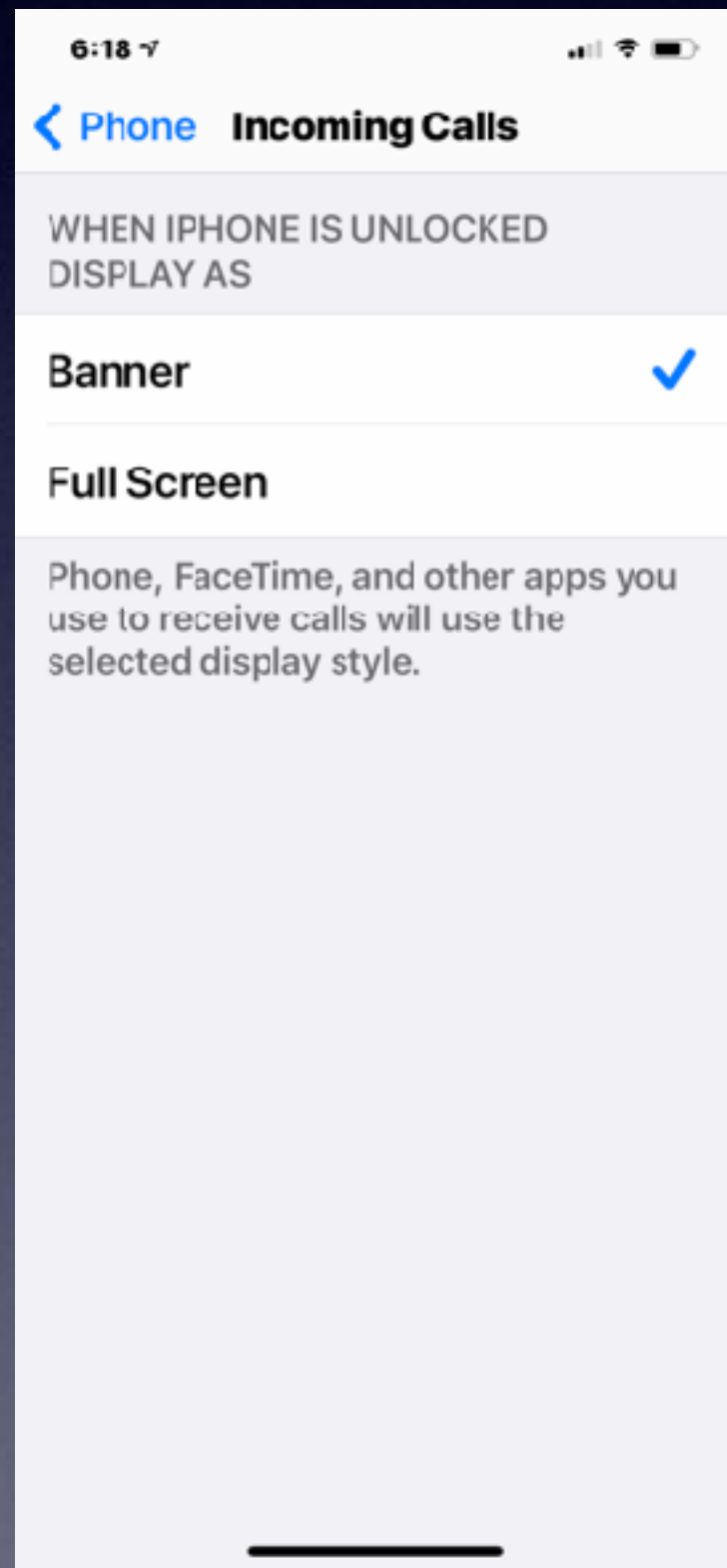
