





Don't answer calls from telephone numbers you don't recognize!









Tap the "i" to view the telephone number. Then "Block Contact".













Apple lets you pass on your iCloud data when you die! You can designate up to five people to have access to your iCloud data including photos, documents and even purchases.



Turn On The Hand washing App!




Turn on Handwashing and Handwashing Reminders


Before you turn on Handwashing, make sure your iPhone is on the latest version of iOS and your Apple Watch is on the latest version of watchOS.


- 1. Open the My Watch app on your iPhone and tap Handwashing.
- Tap Handwashing Timer to have your watch automatically detect when you're washing your hands and start a 20-second timer.
- Tap Handwashing Reminders to have your watch remind you to wash your hands after returning home.

You can also turn these settings on and off on your Apple Watch under Handwashing in the Settings app.











Verify Your "My Card" In Contacts.
