You Don't Need "1" Before the Area Code When Dialing On An iPhone!

or mobile phone)!

"1" is an international country code. "1" means US.

If your contact has a "1" before the number, your iPhone will ignore when dialing.

Land lines still require an "1" before the area code.

Put a "+" and a "1" when dialing back to the US.

There can be exceptions to this rule.*

*Early on when cell (mobile) phones were introduced to the public, long distance numbers required a "1" before the 10 digits.
