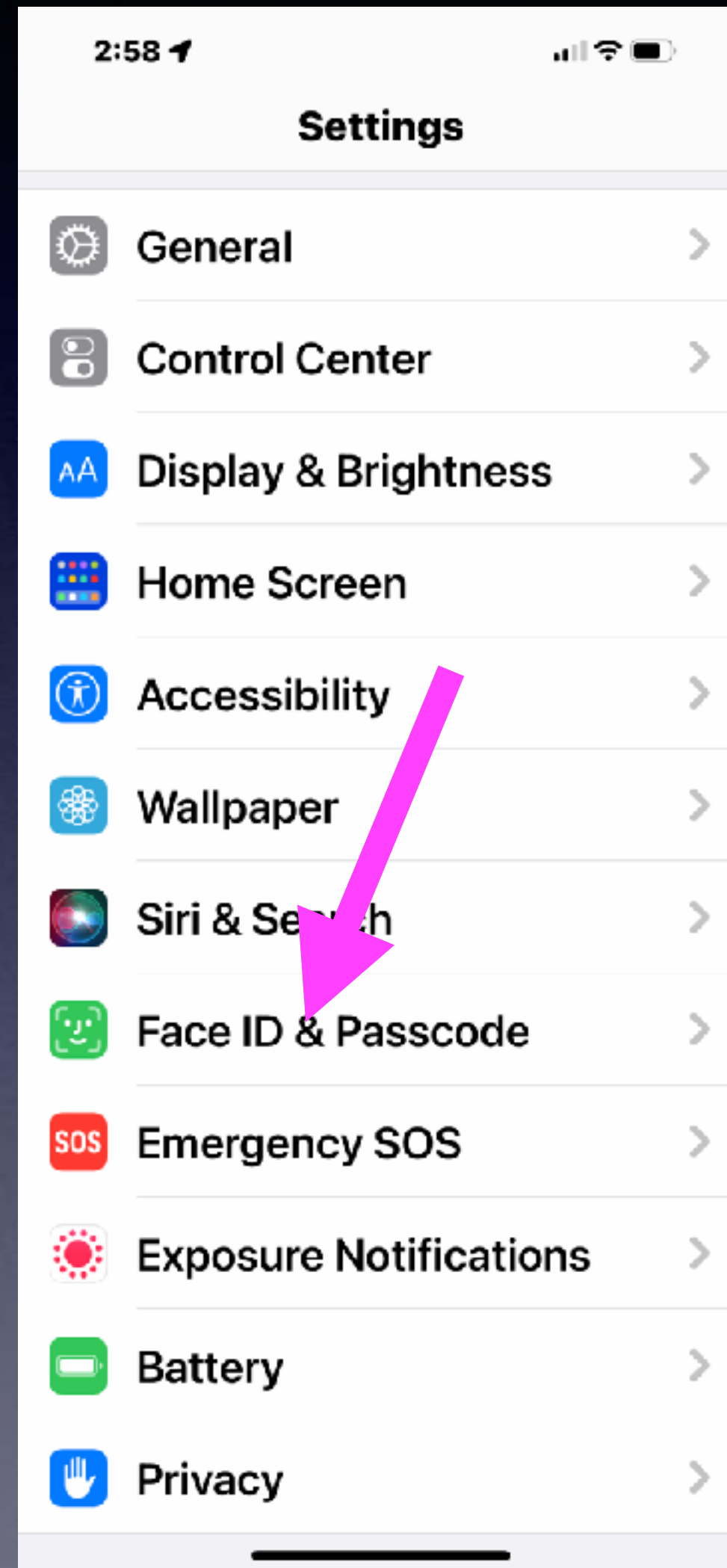

Call the bank or credit card company.

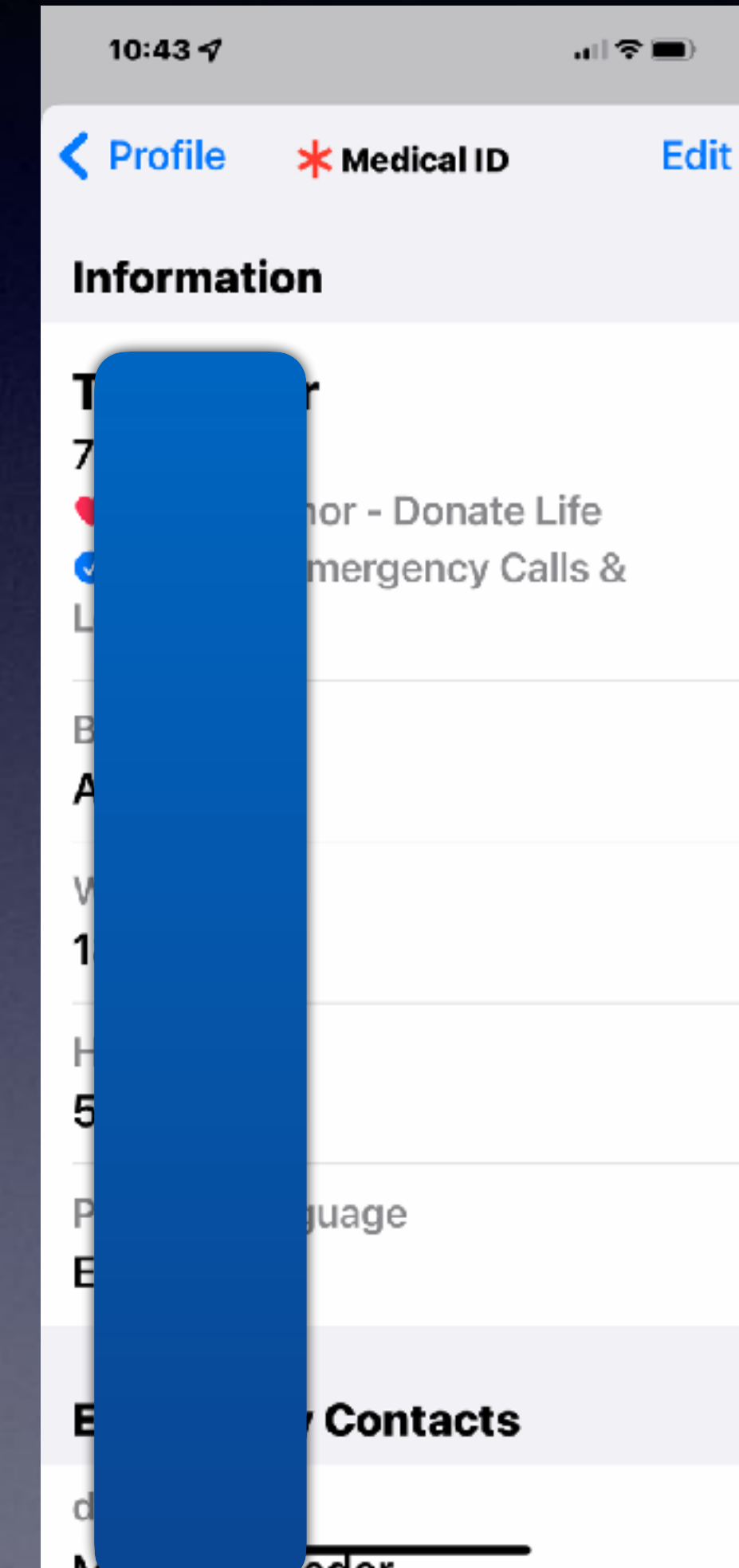
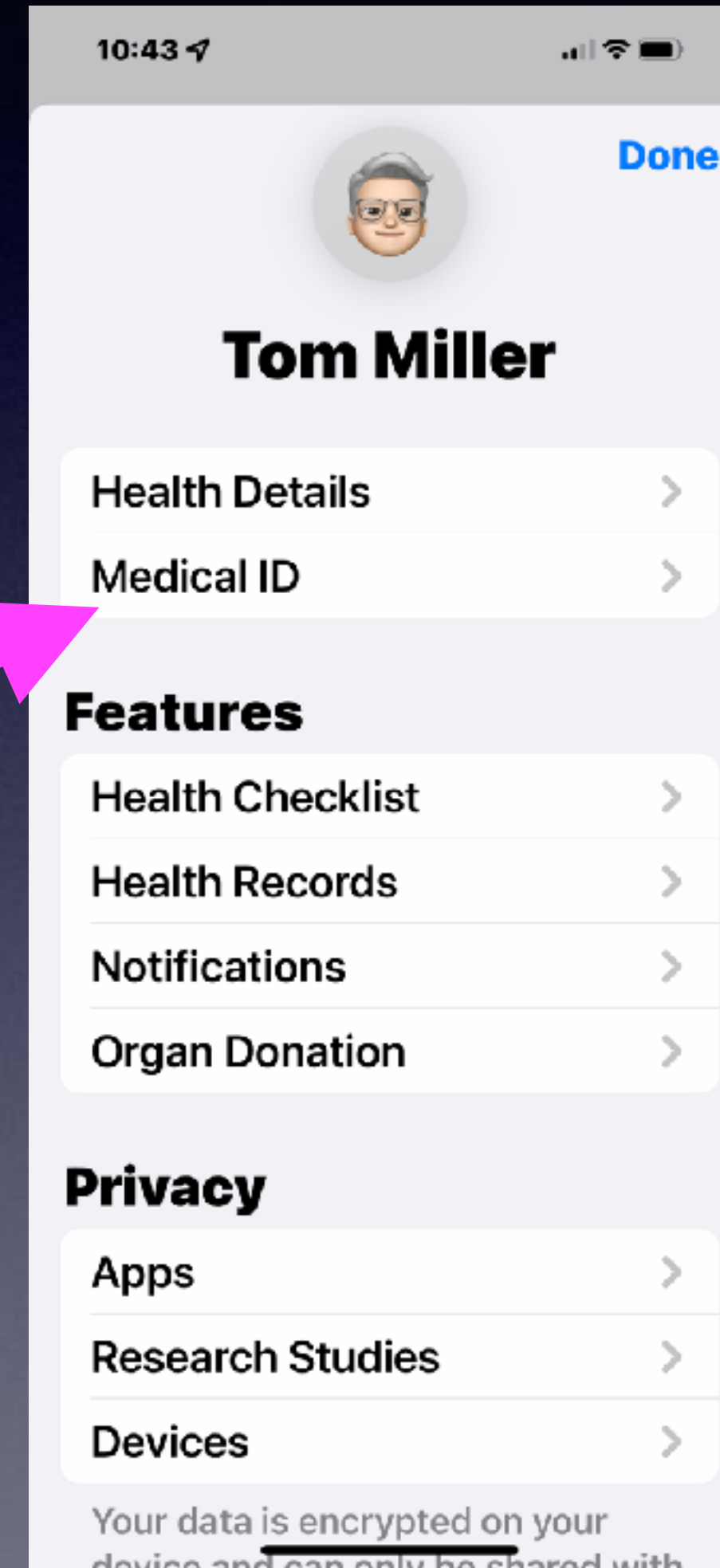
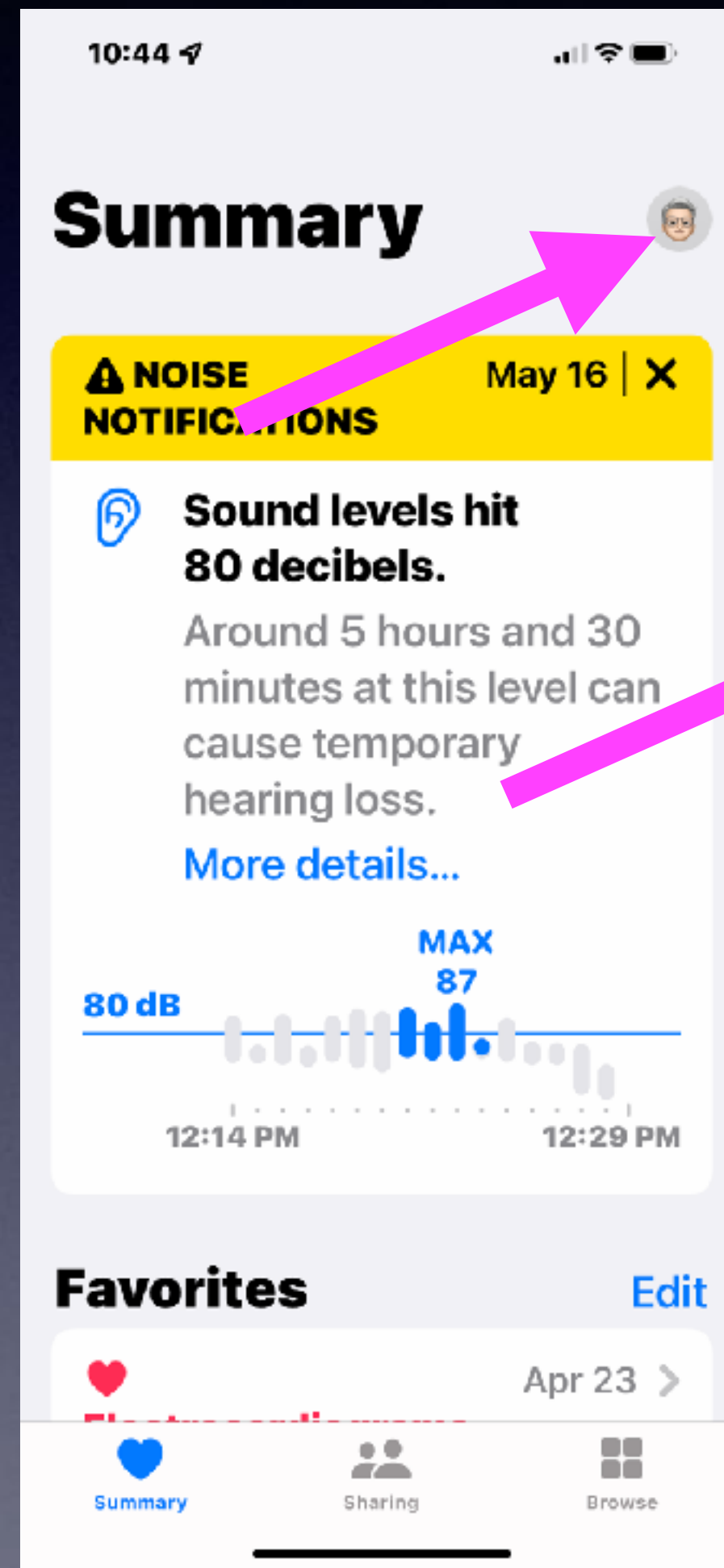
## 2. I Need To Keep My Health App Up To Date!

# 3. Prepare Your iPhone For Emergencies!

Set up your emergency contacts.

Set up "Share your location".

If possible, use an Apple Watch to detect falls.

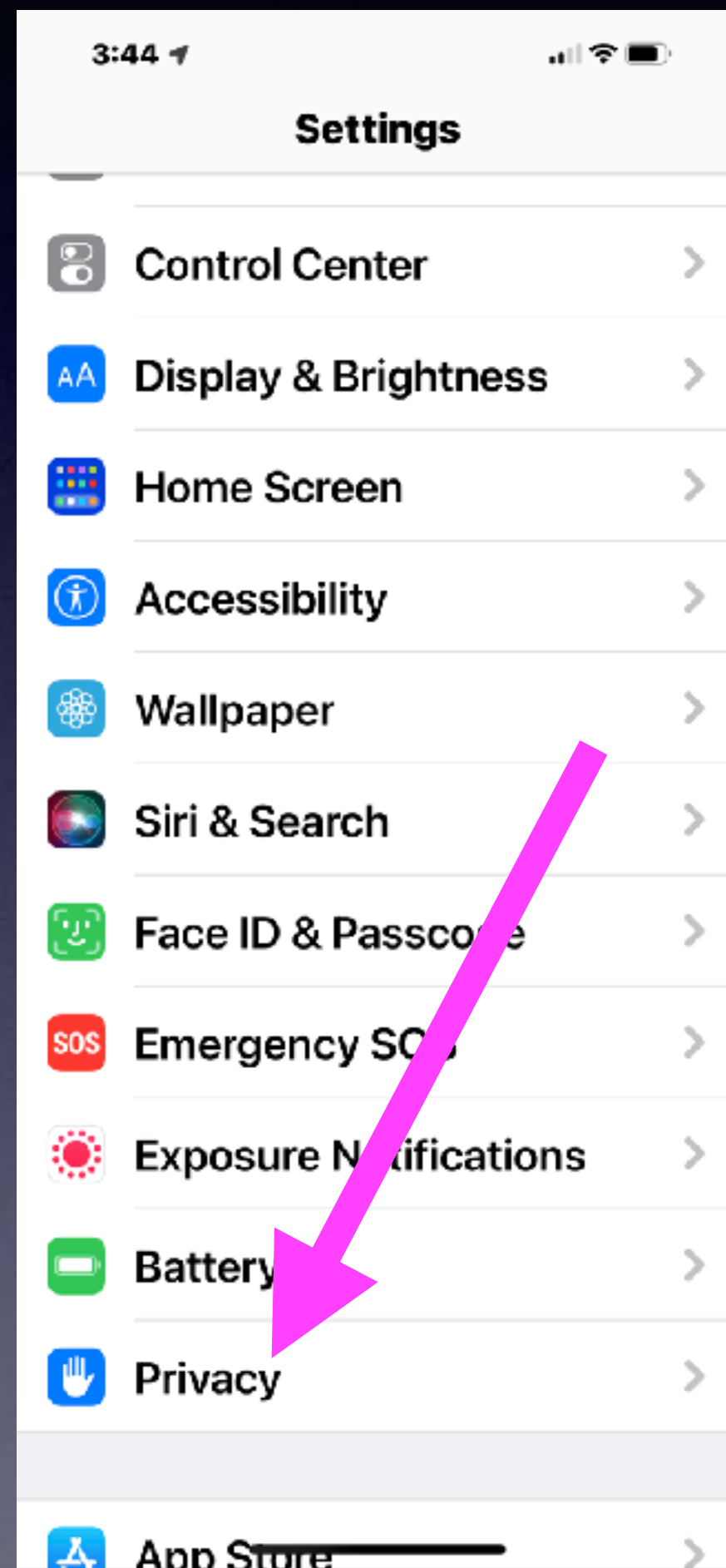
Keep your iPhone with you at all times.

# 4. Gain Control Of Your Privacy!

I don't want Apple or anyone else to know where I have been. (Significant locations)

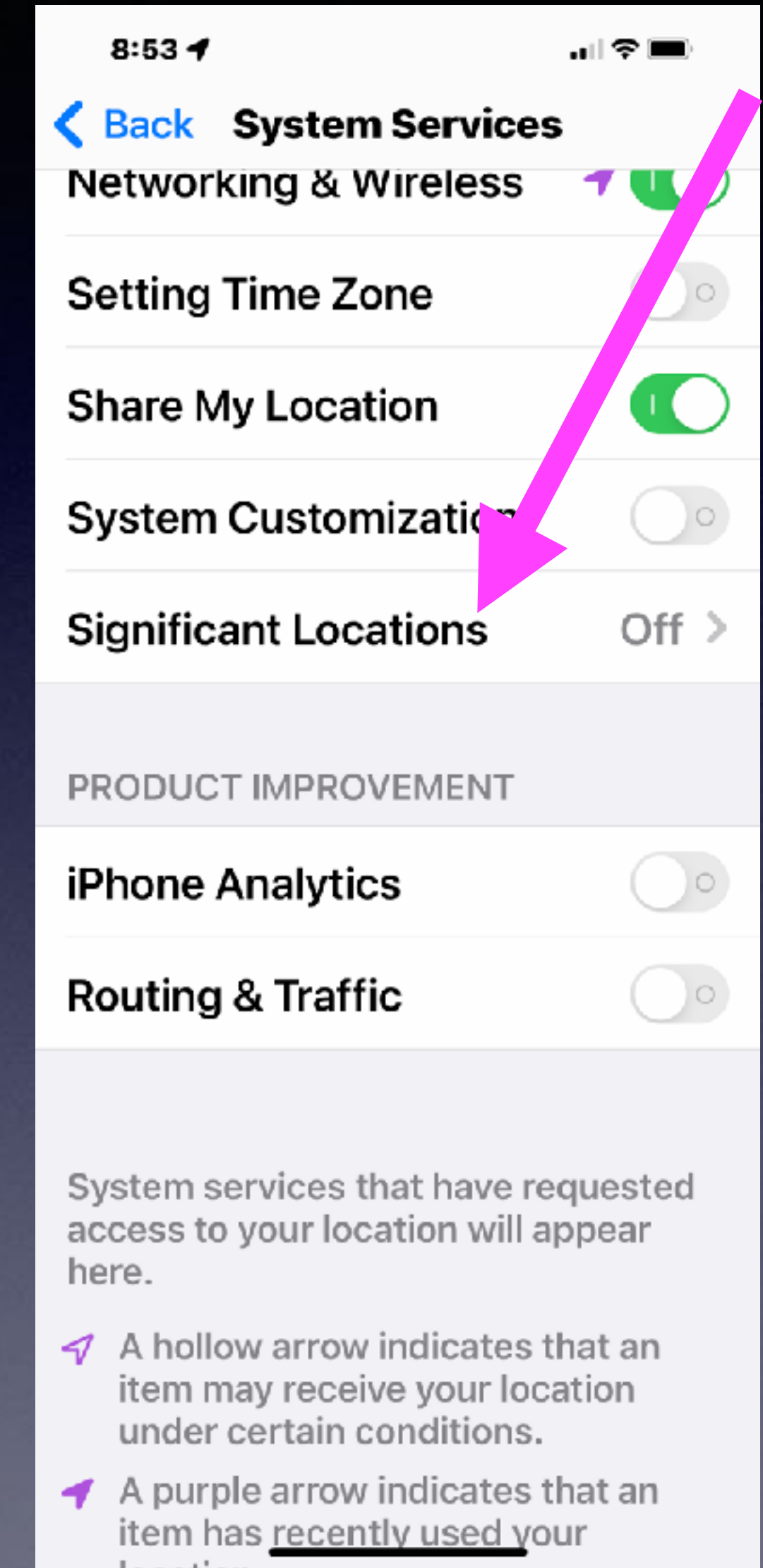
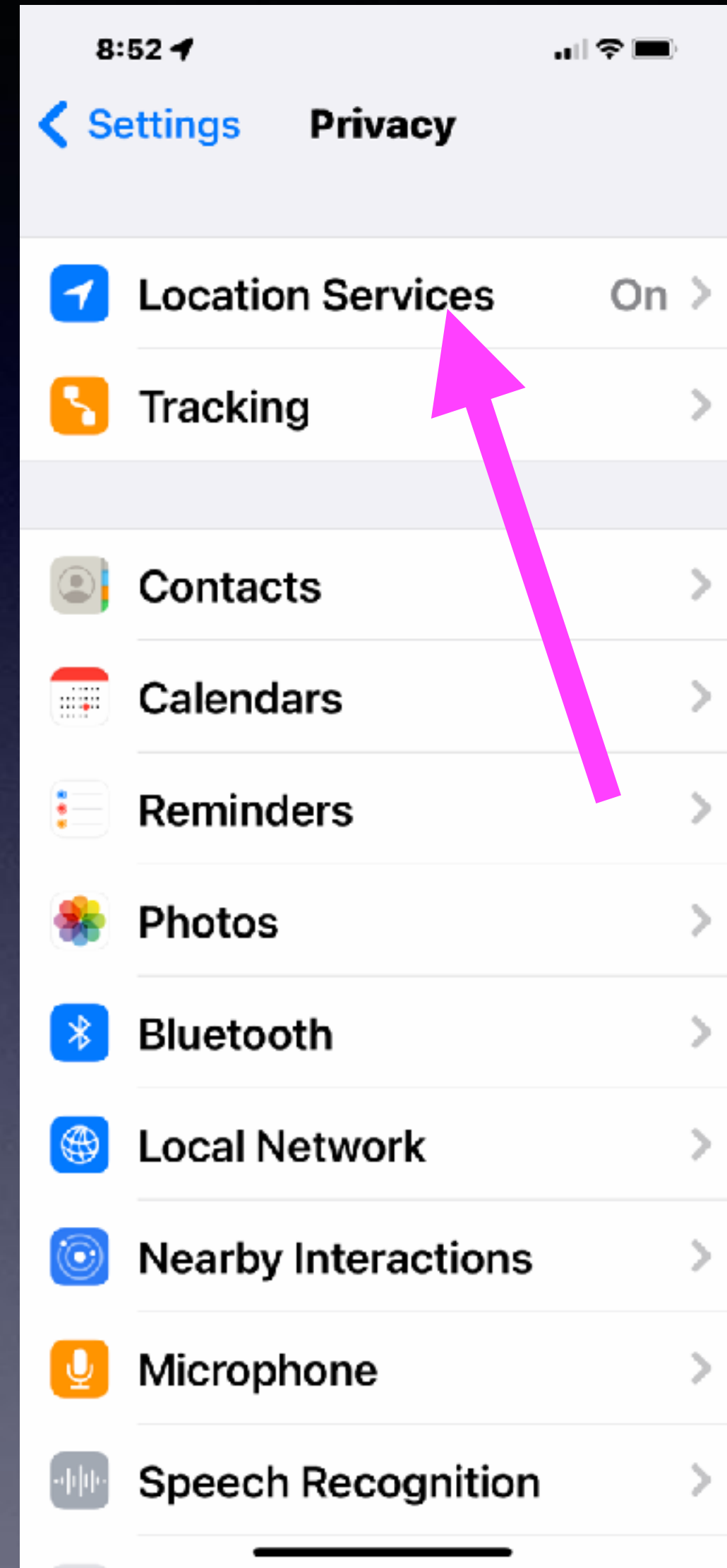
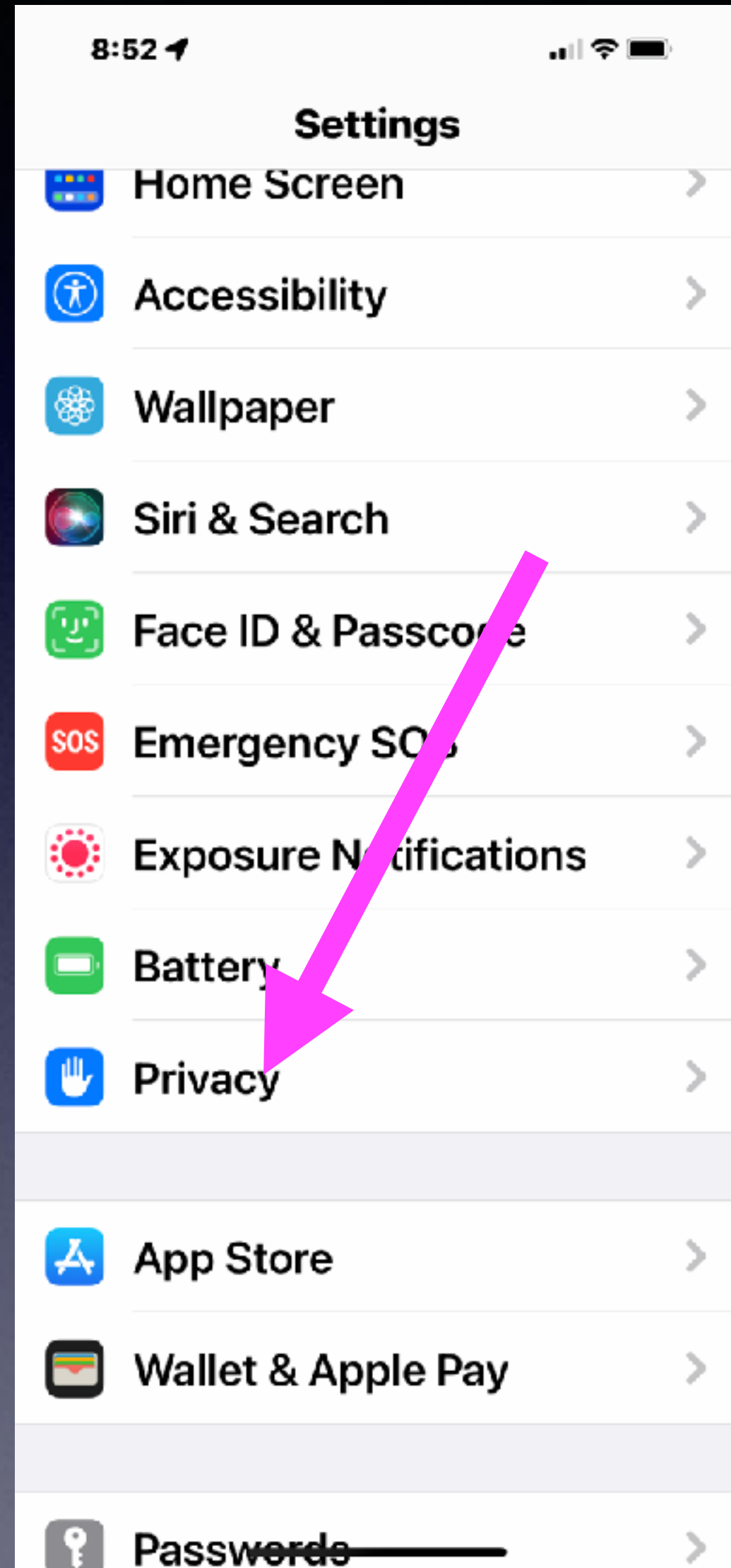
I don't want apps to track or collect my data.

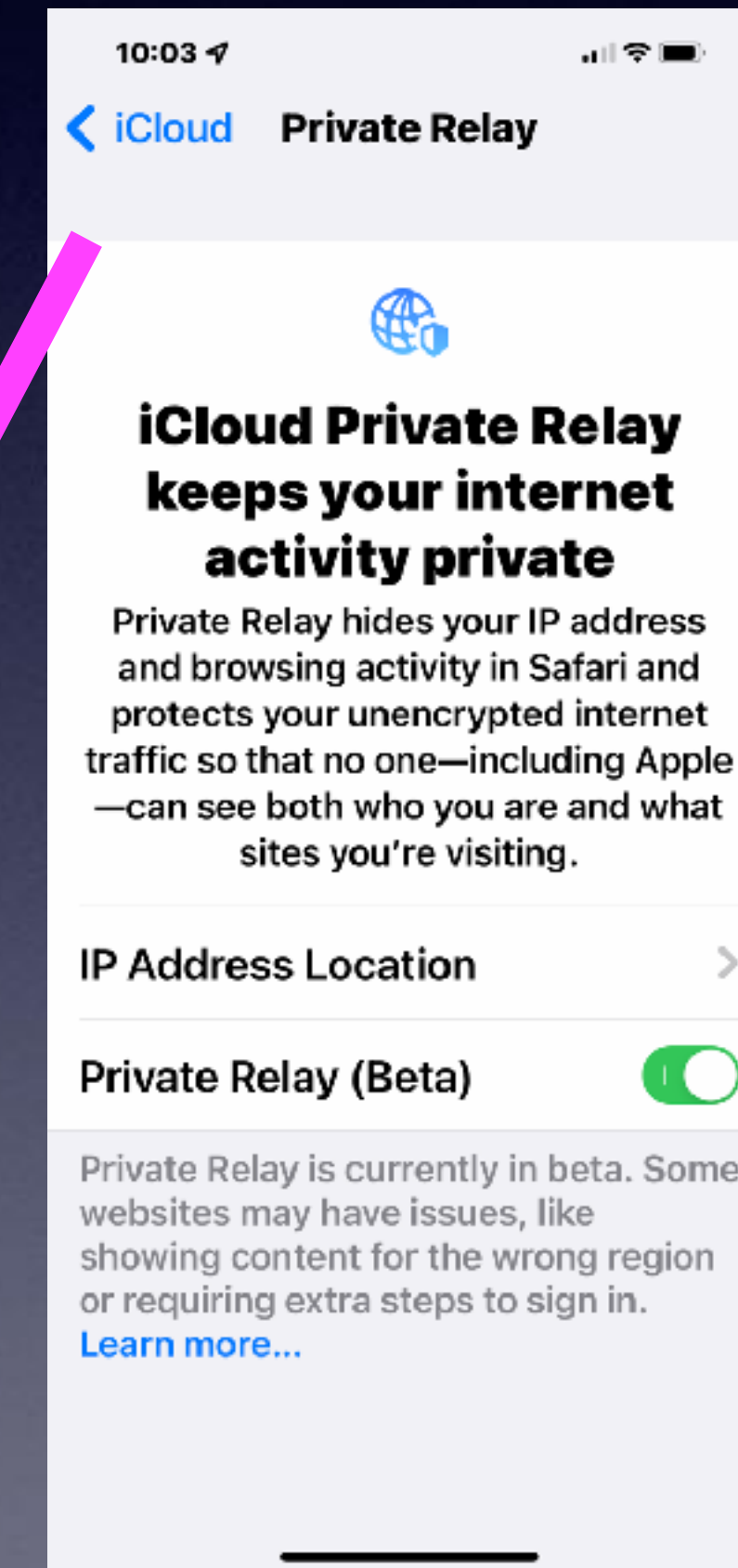
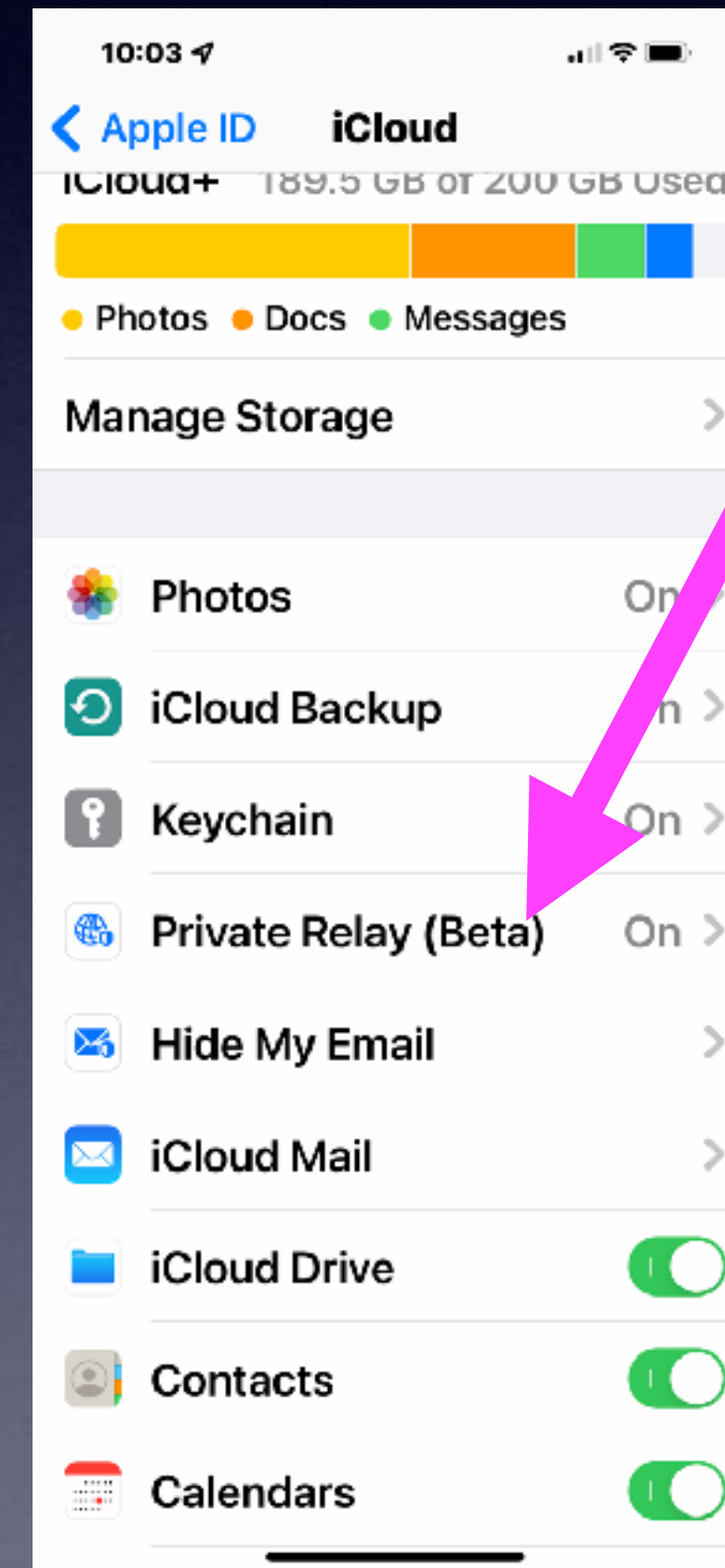
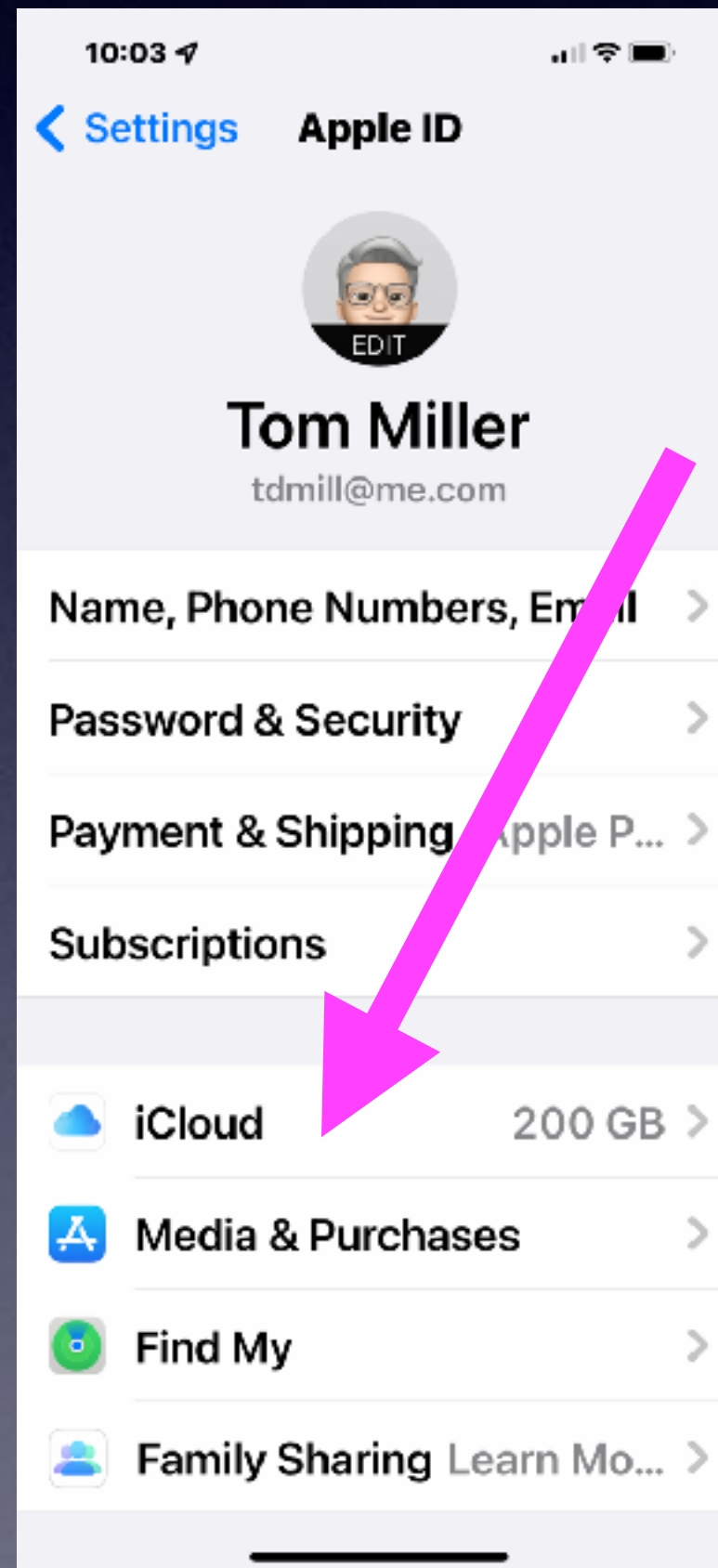
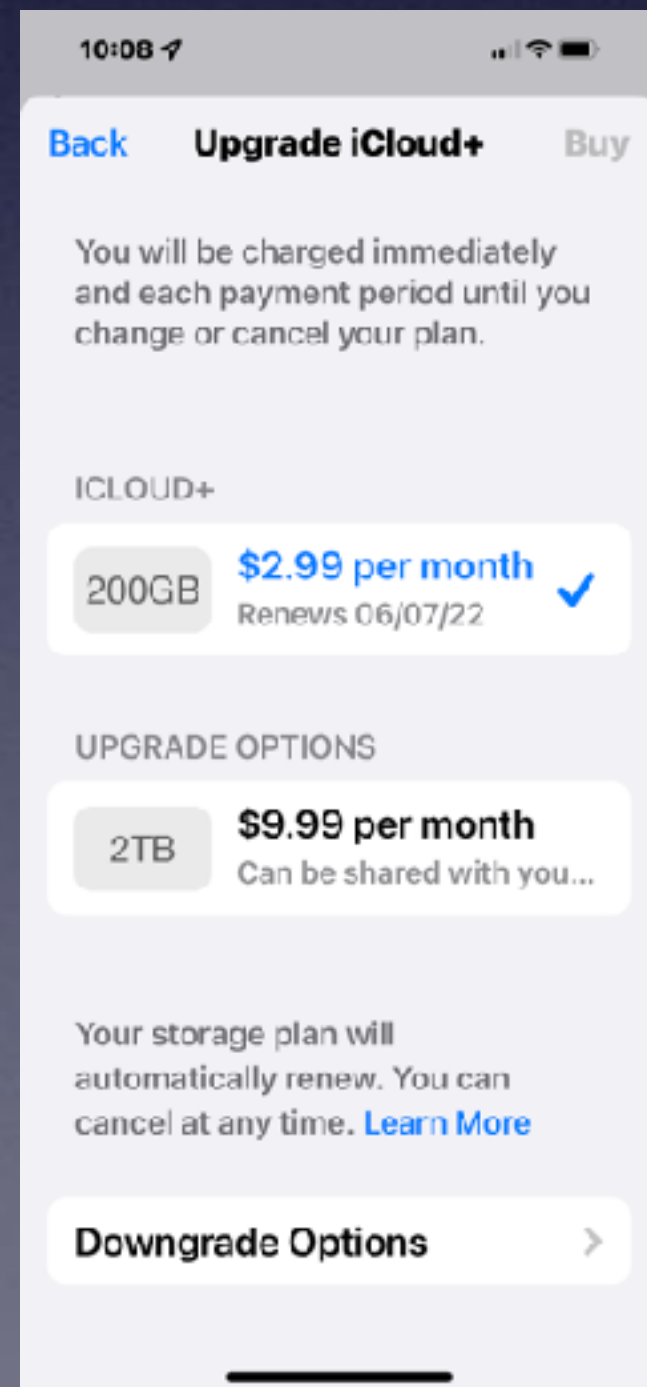
# 9. Hide Your IP Address!



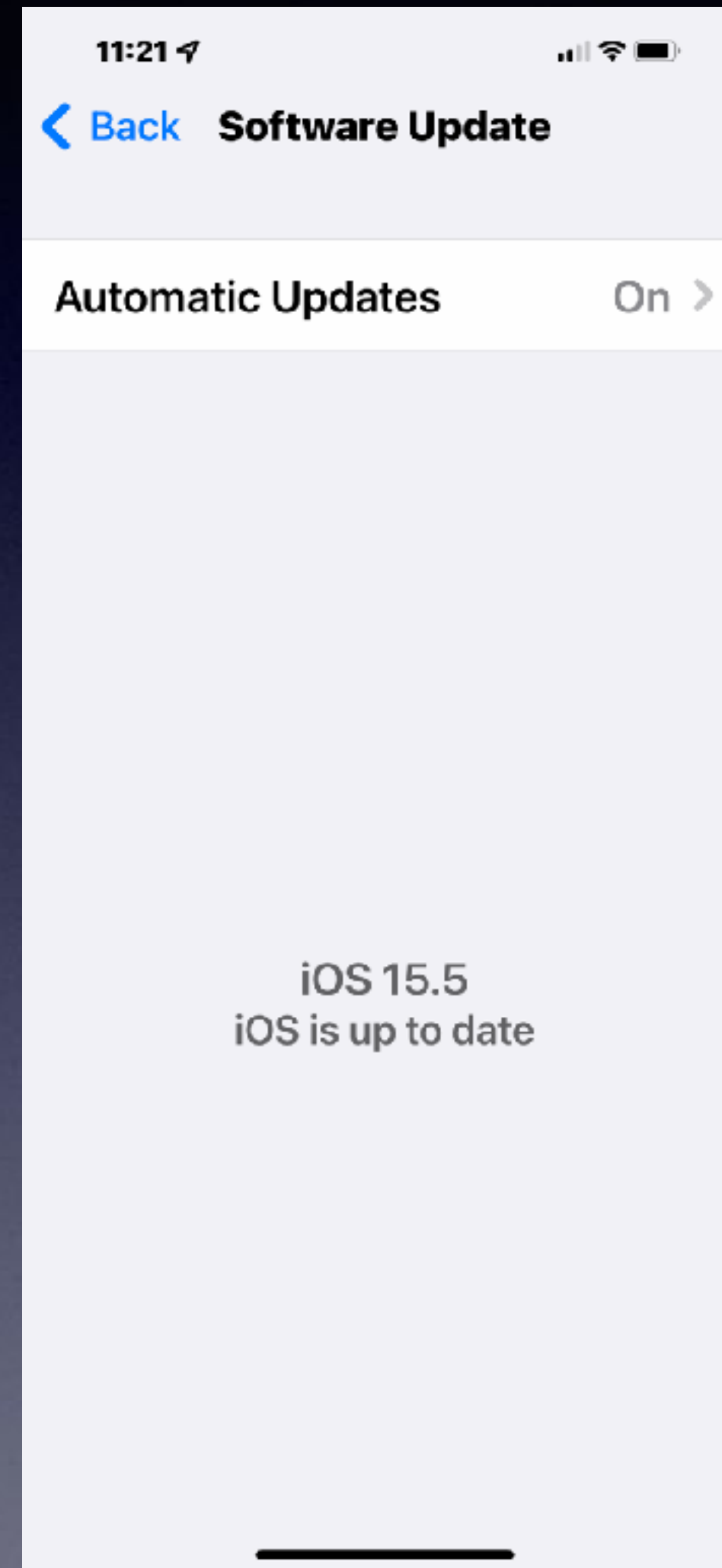
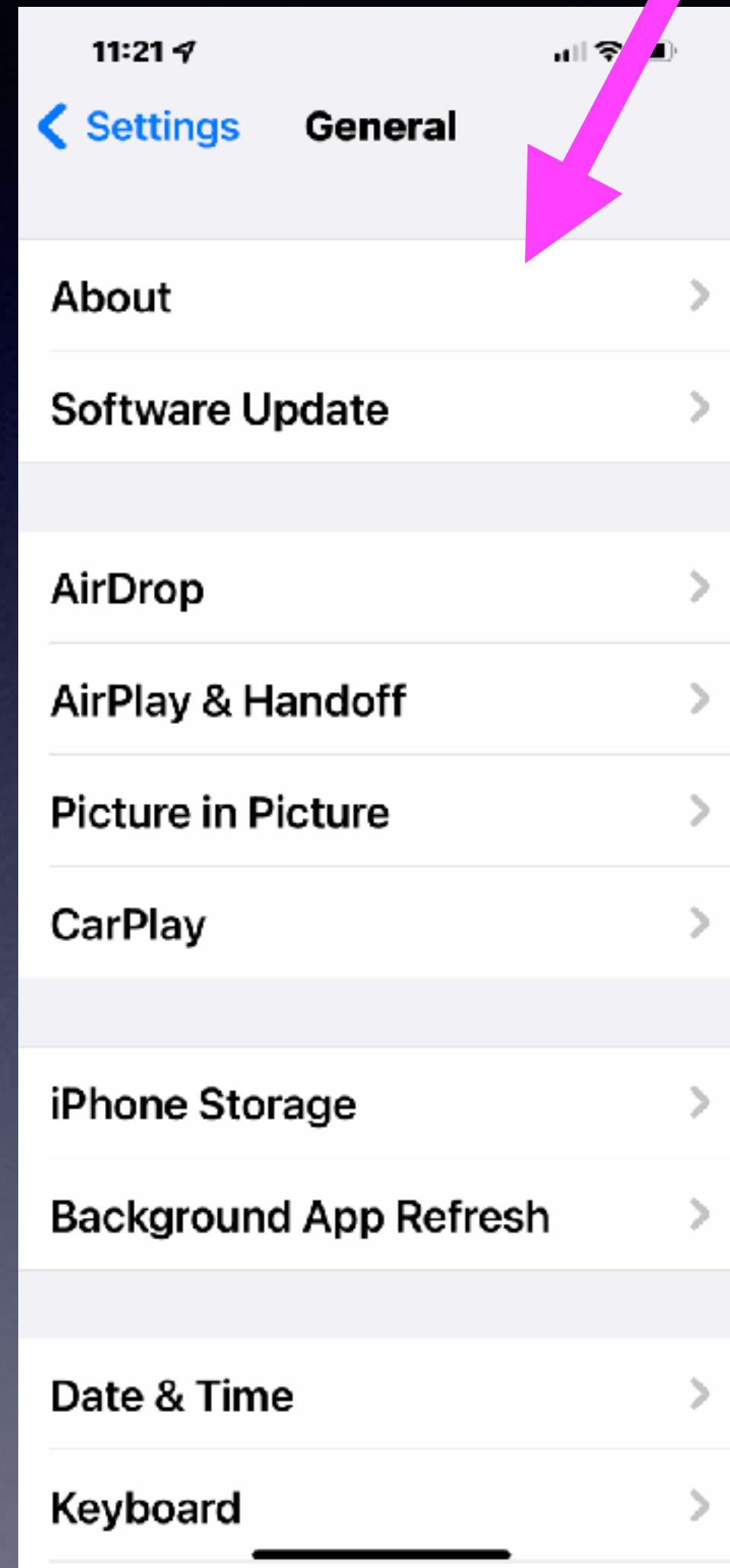
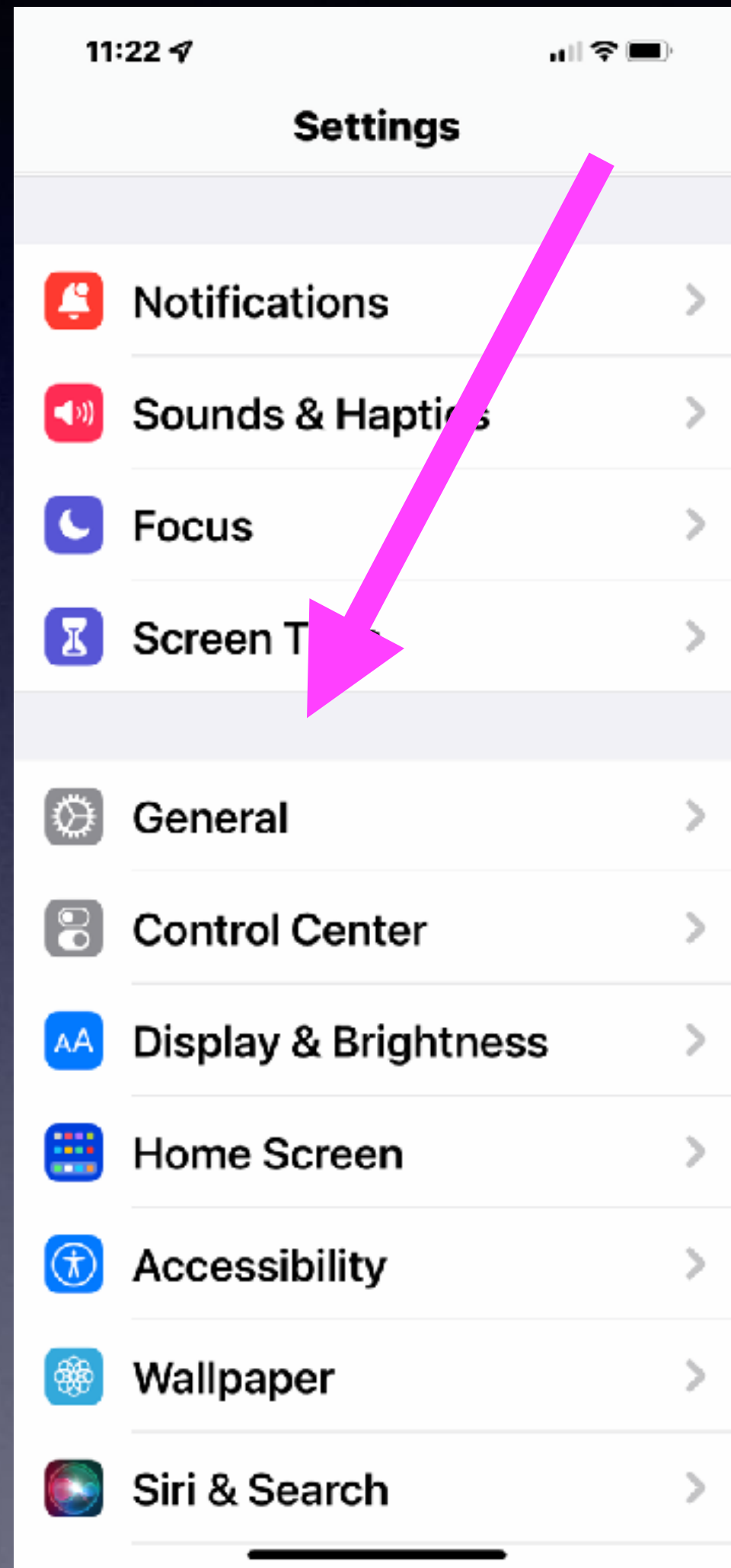
When you go on the Internet, you share your device's address. Your iPhone has an address. Thieves, merchants, scammers can get your address.

Apple is working diligently to secure our Internet experience.

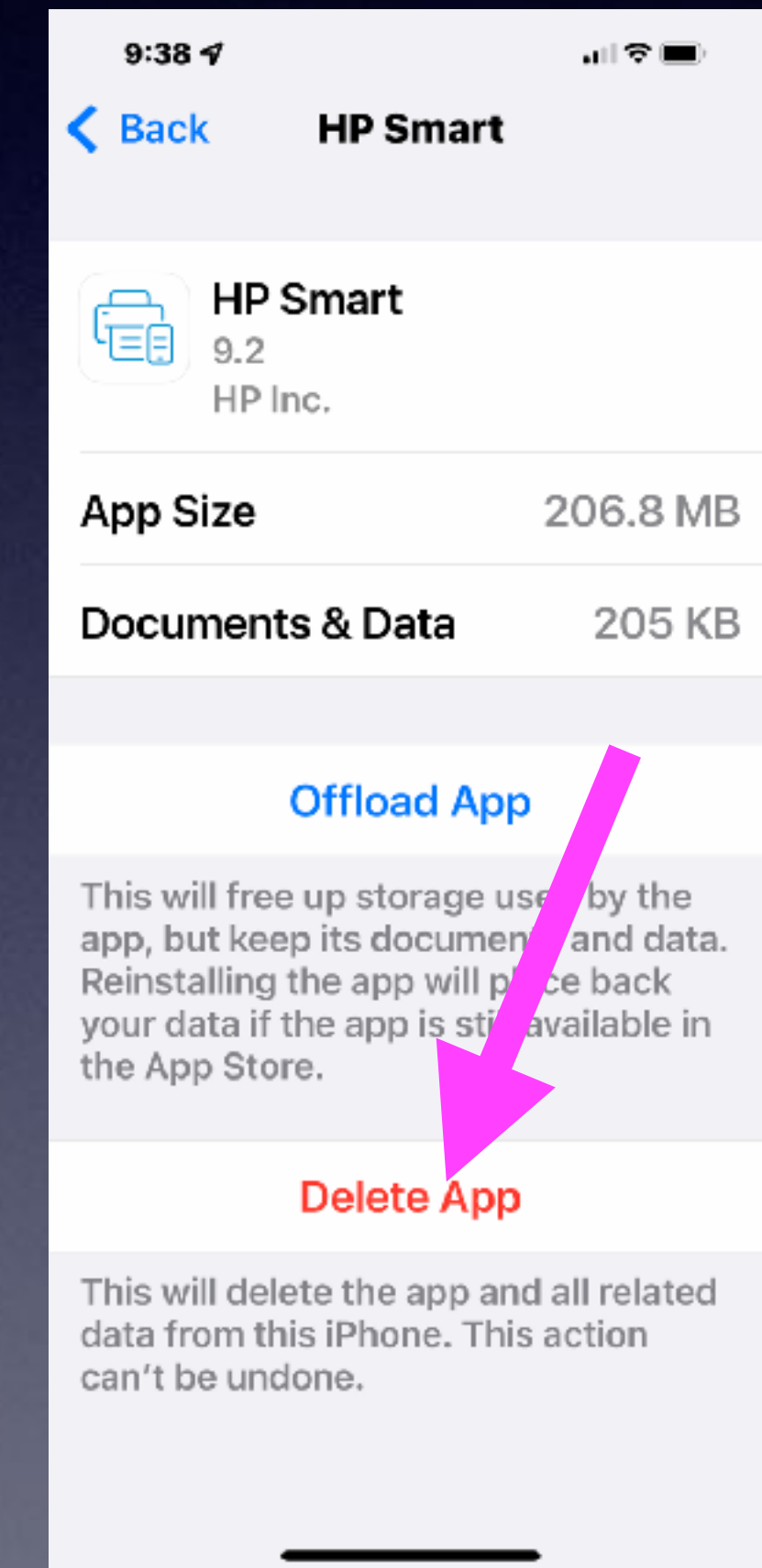
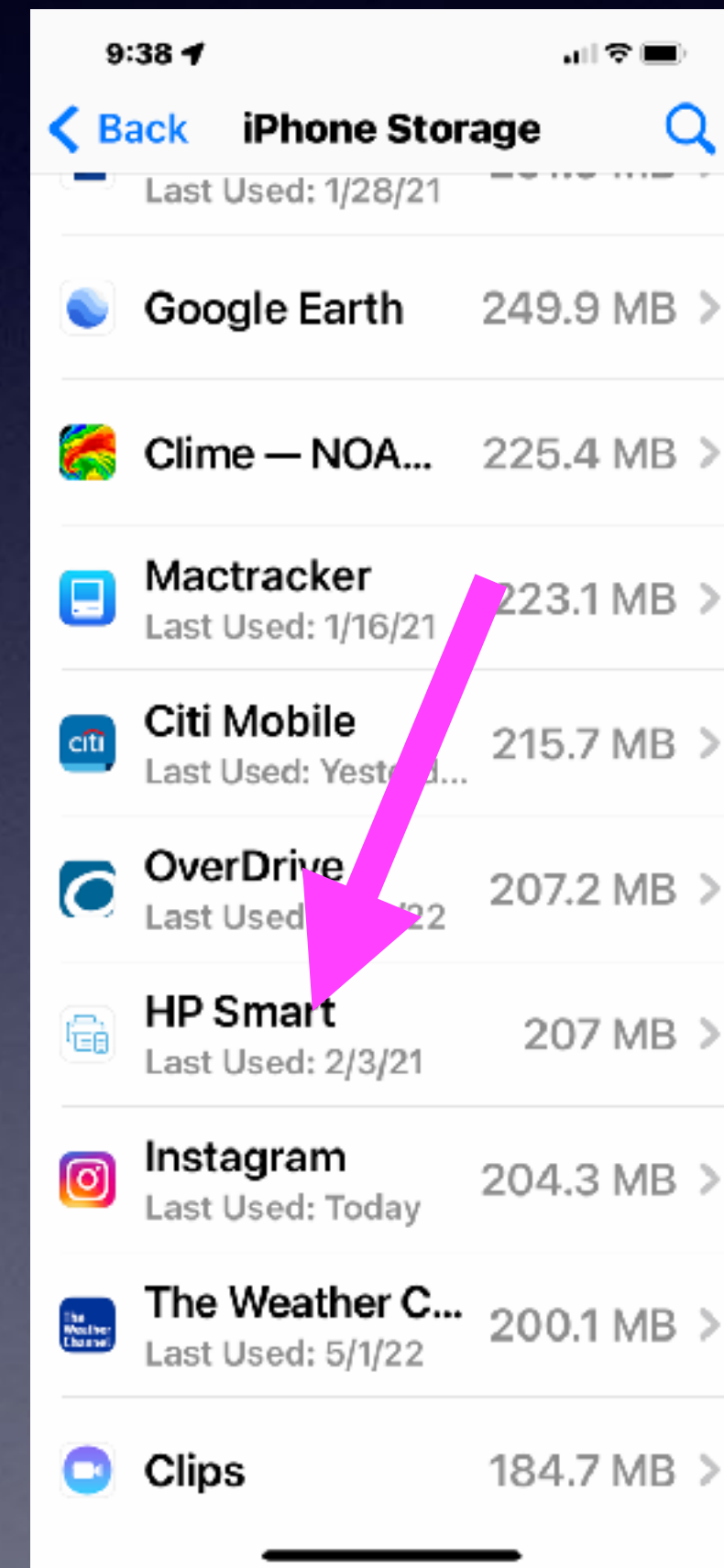
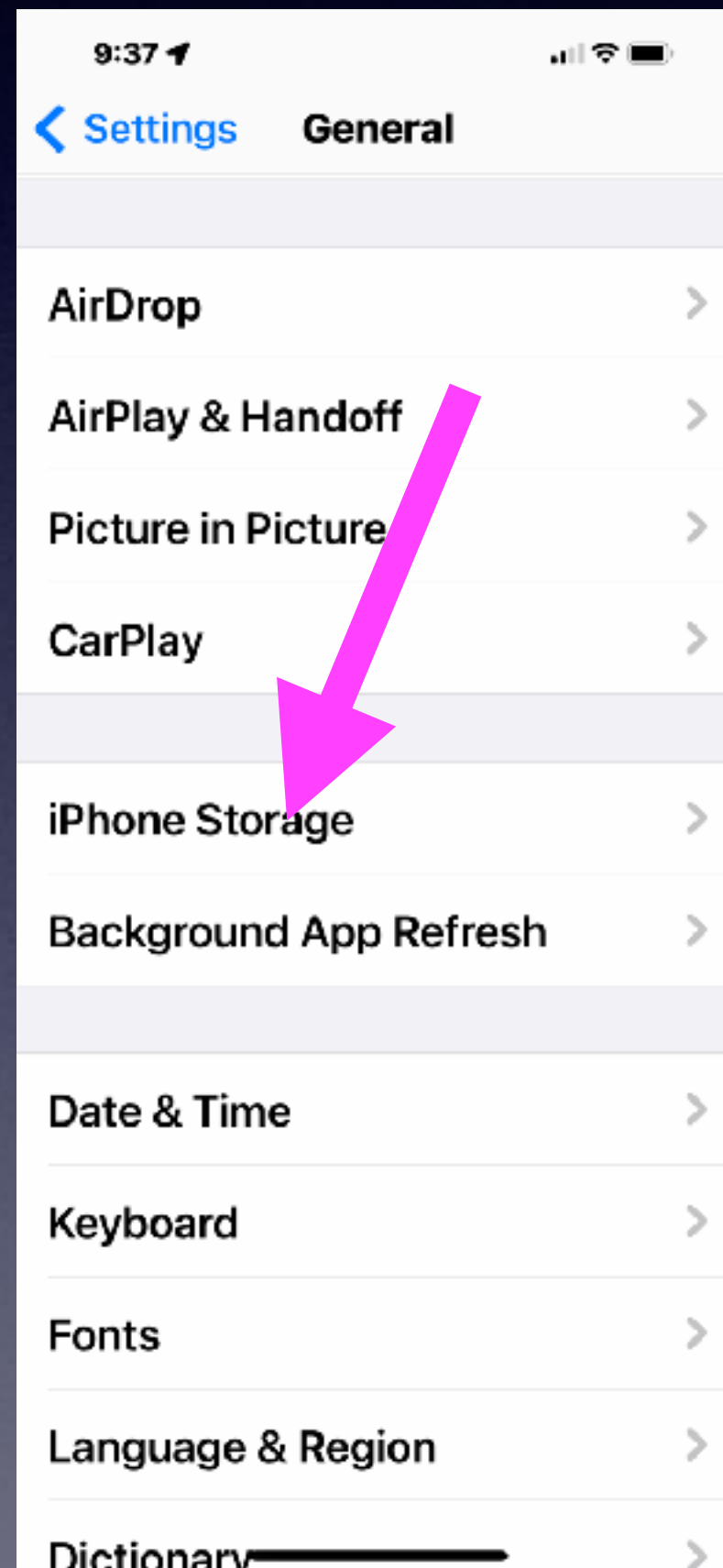
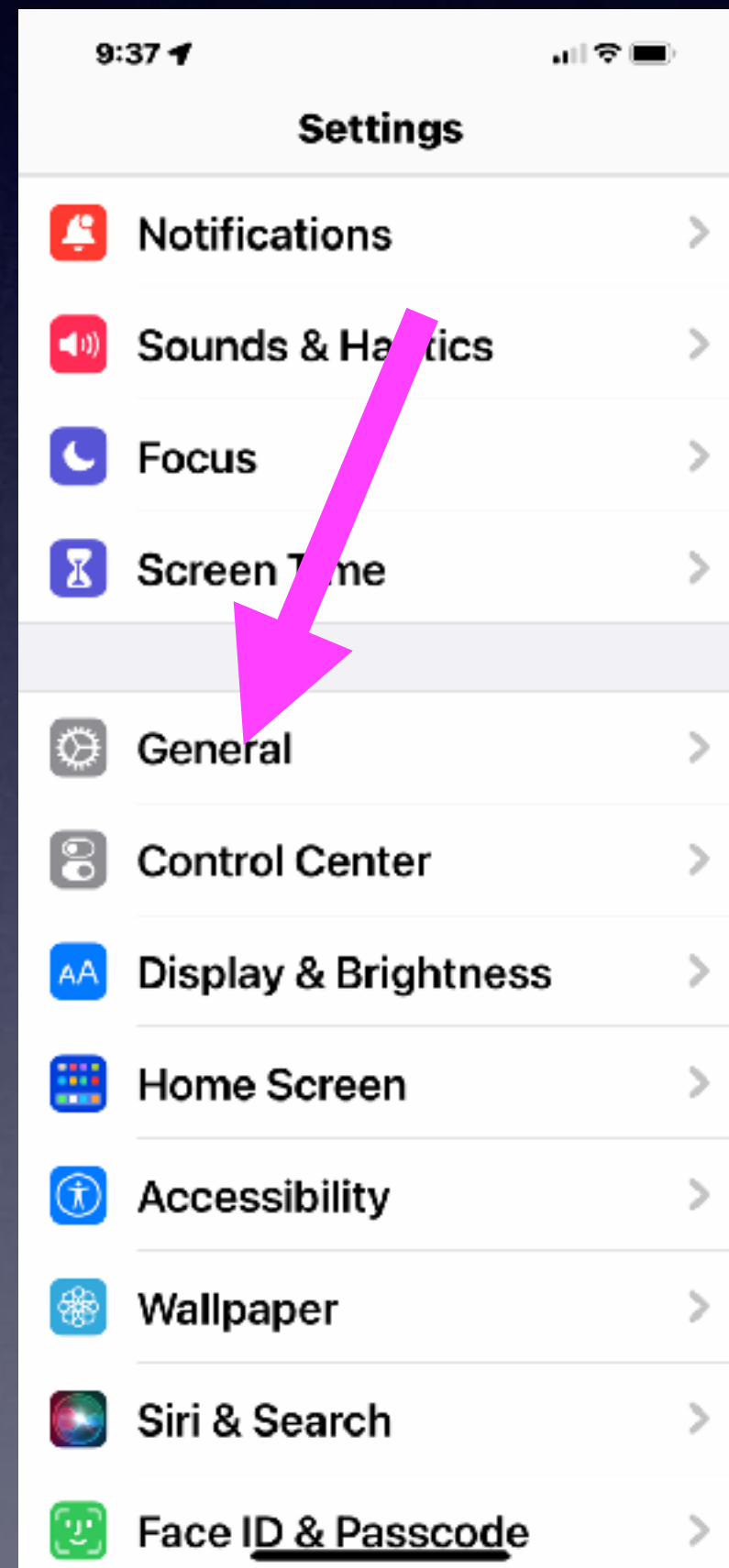

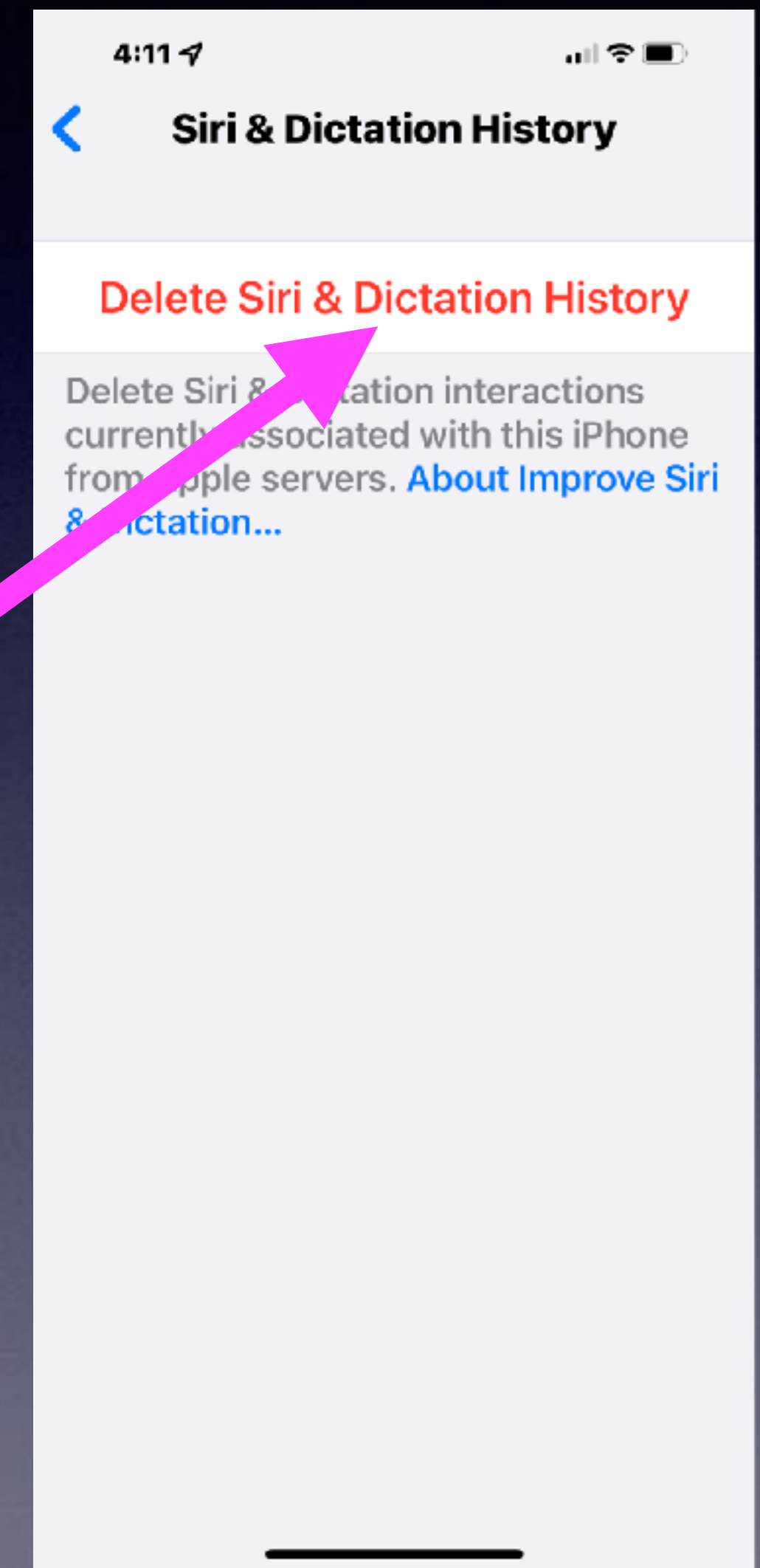
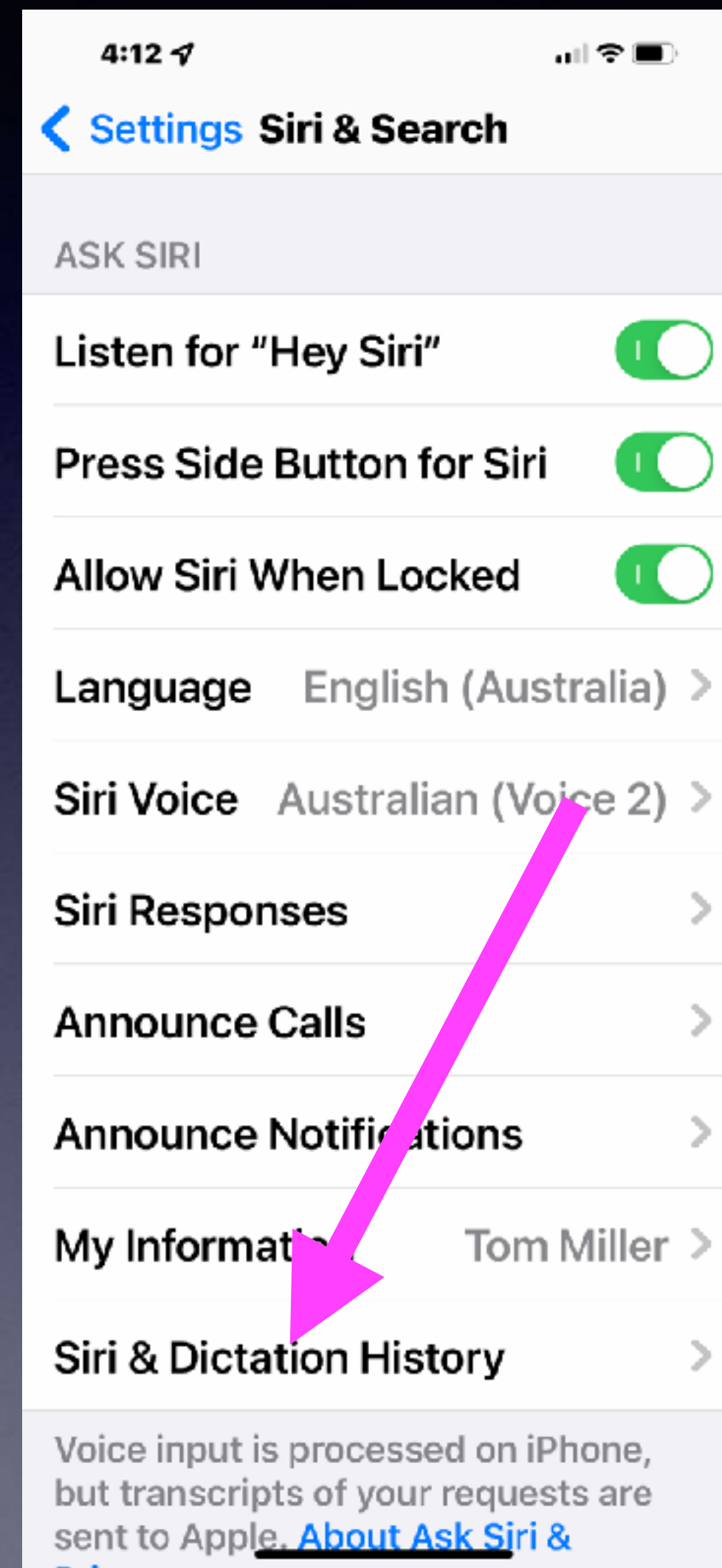
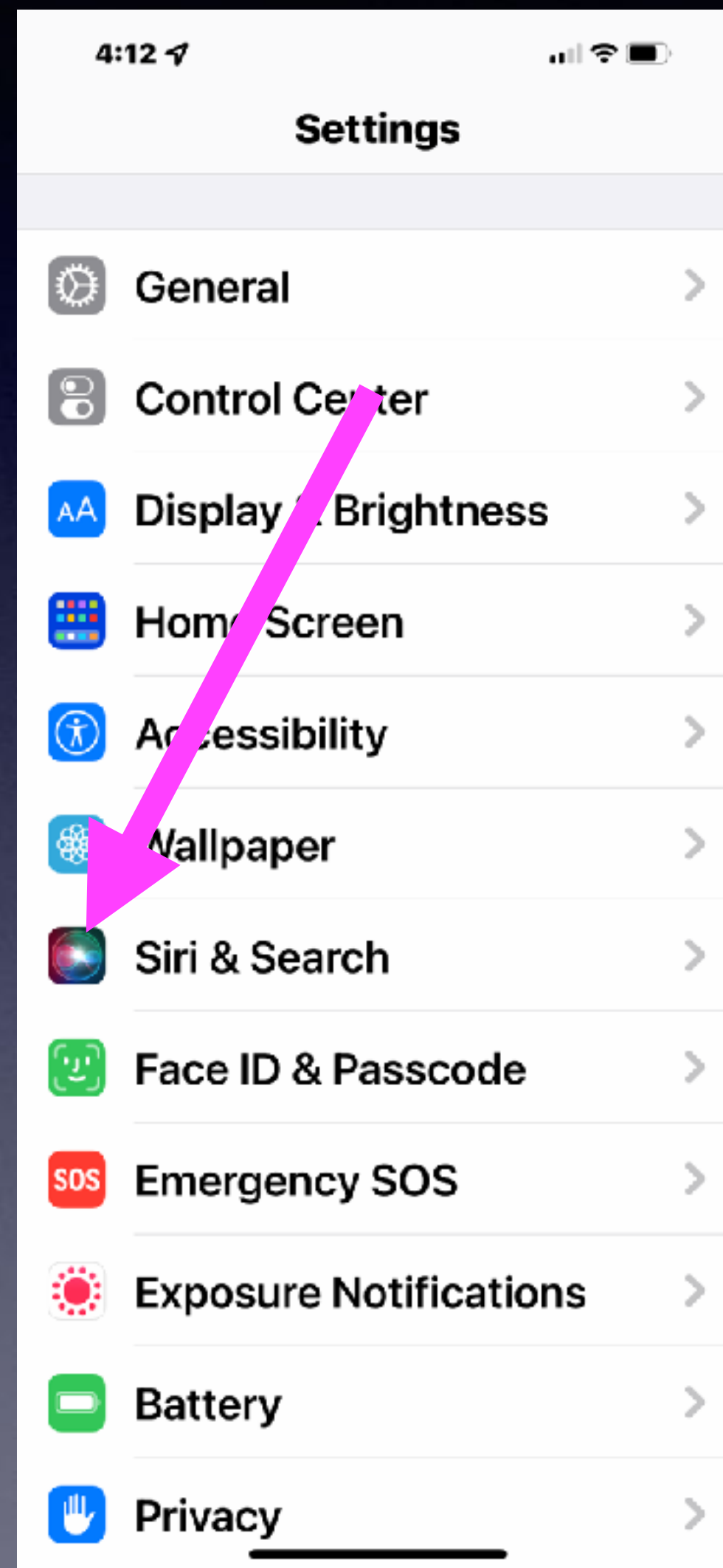
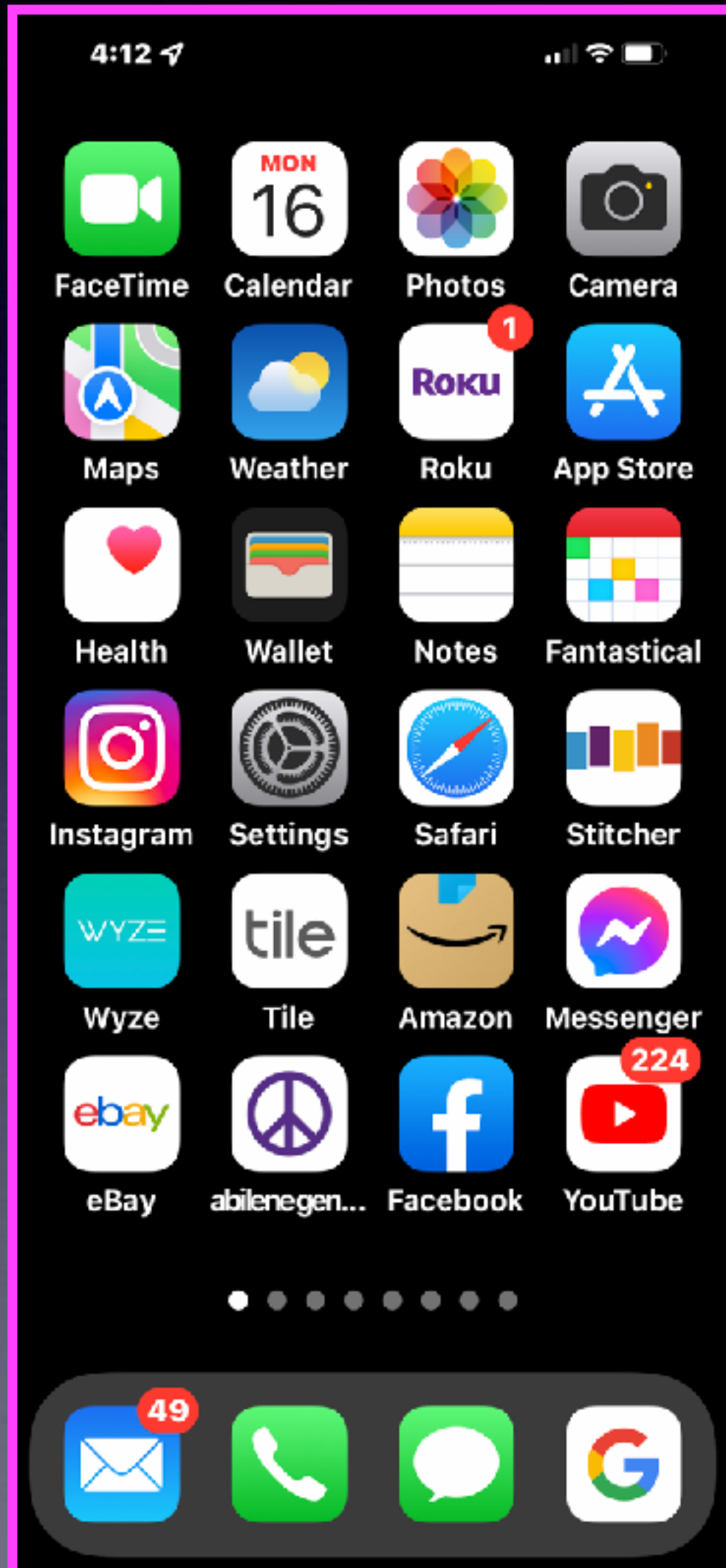


Be very careful when deleting anything!

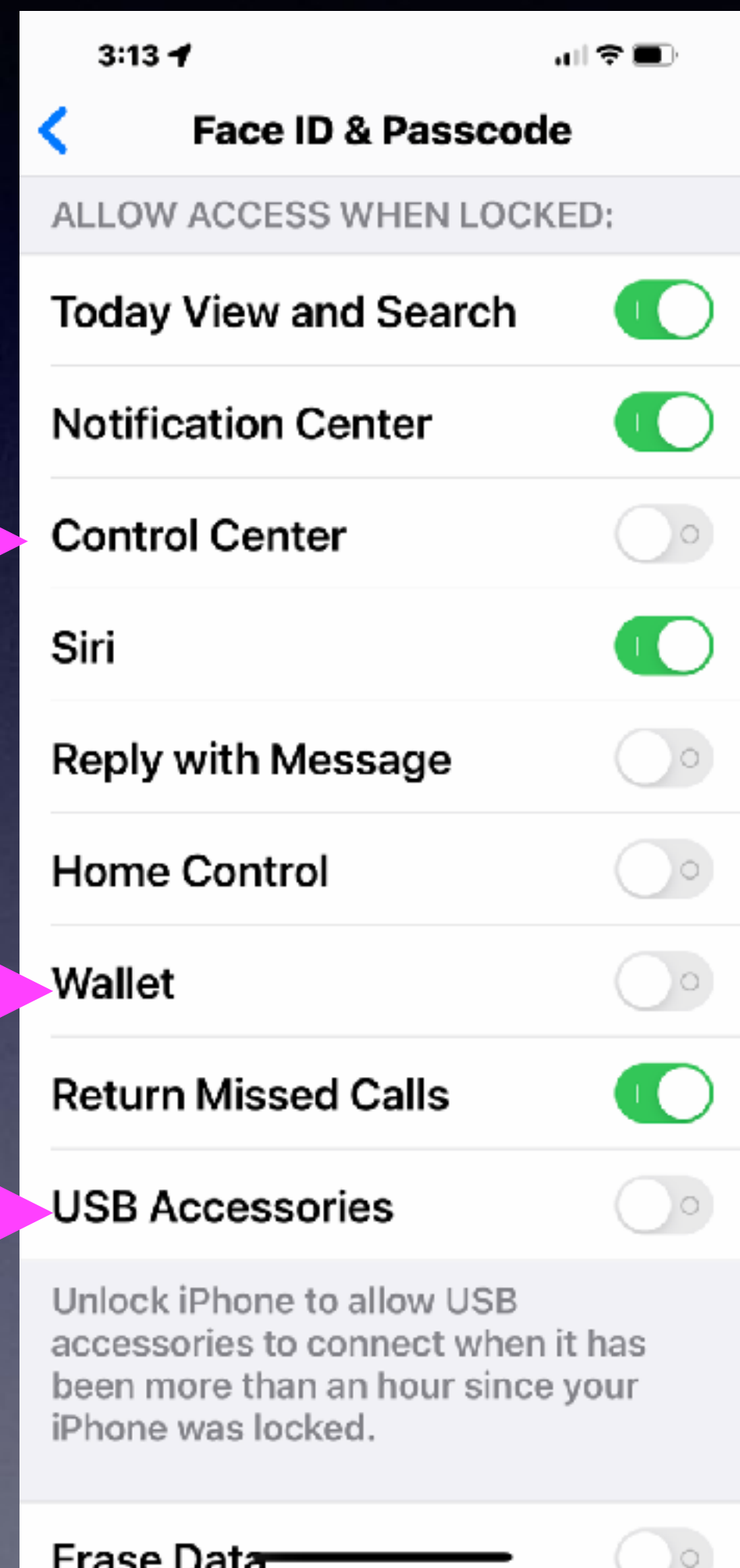
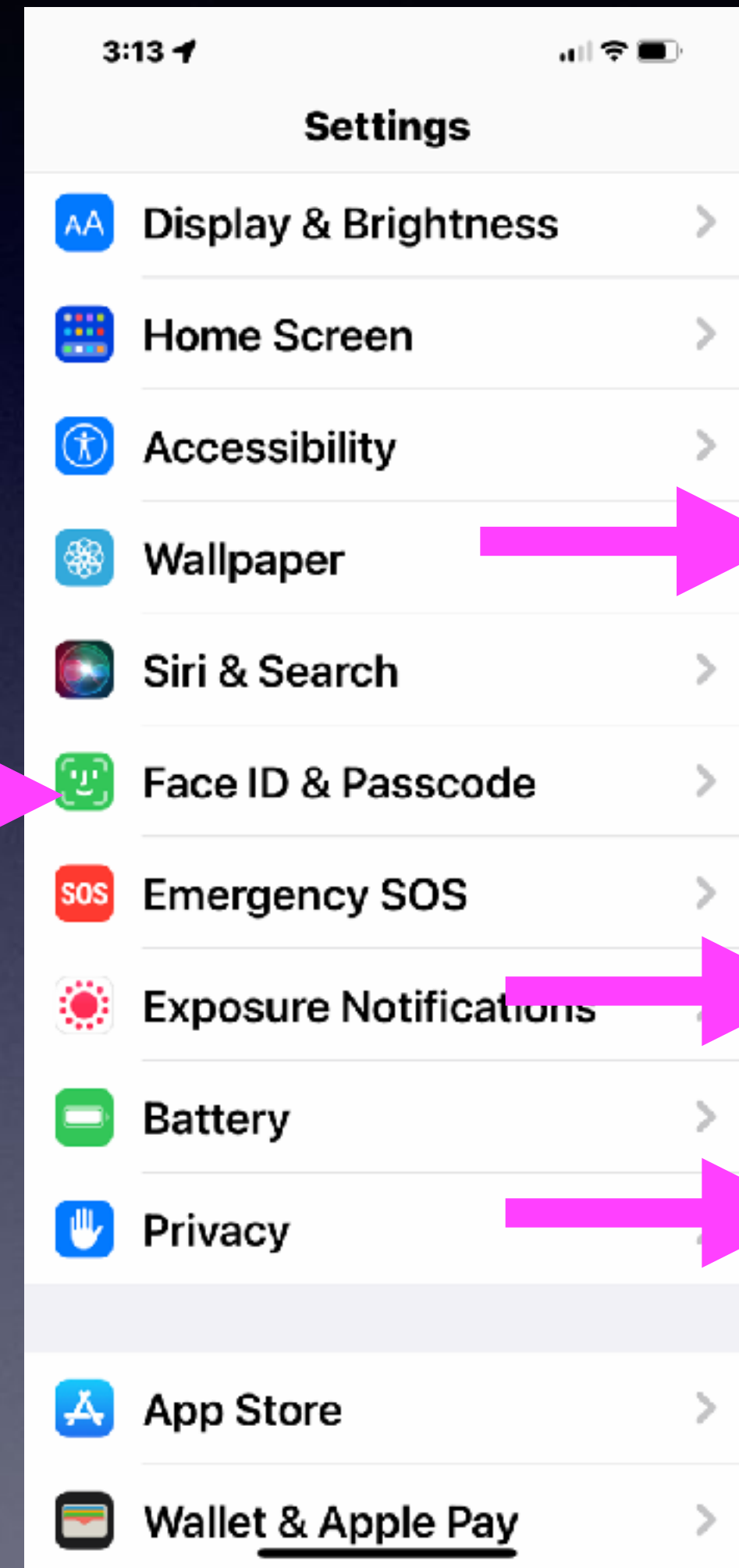
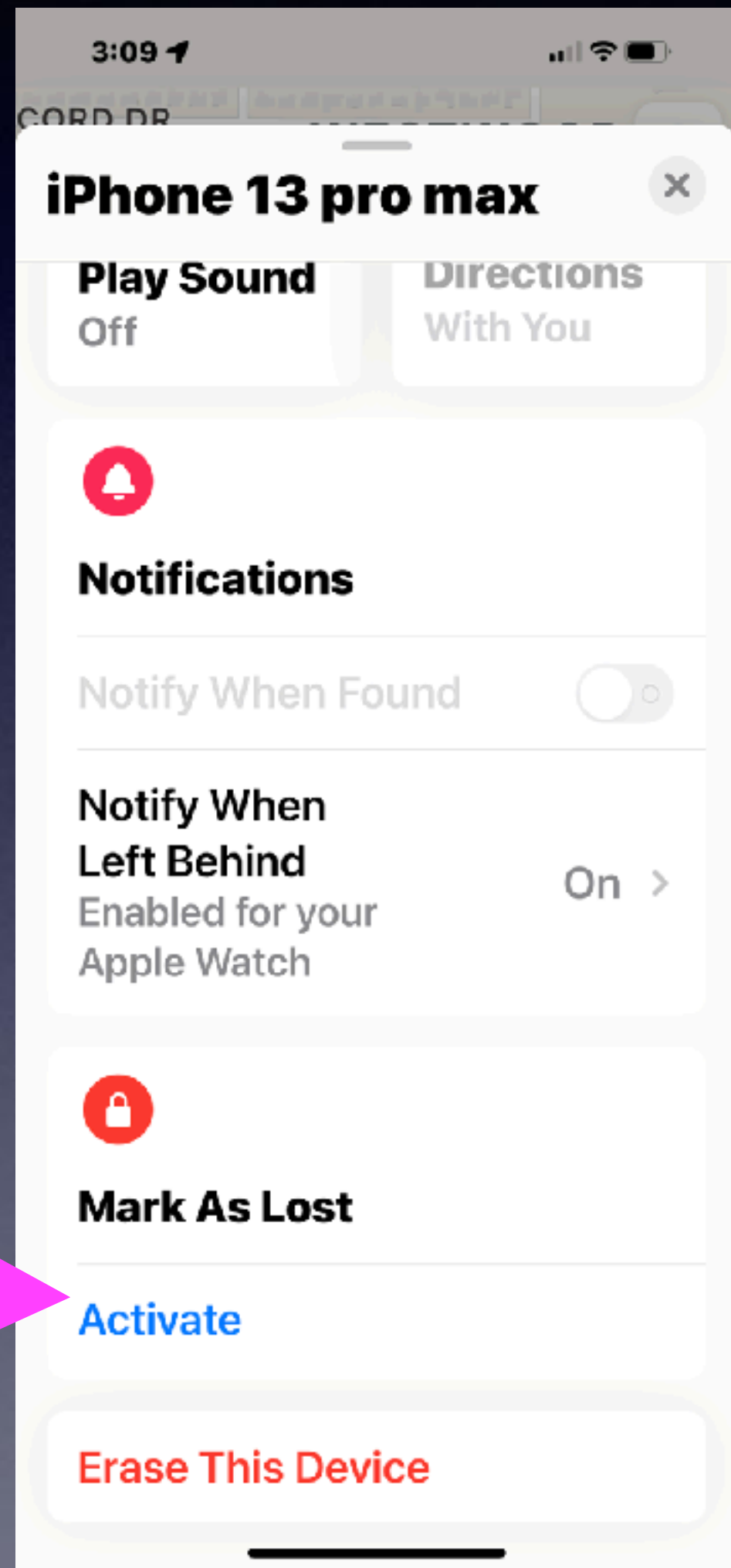
# If You Lose Your iPhone; There's A Good Chance You Can Get It Back!
