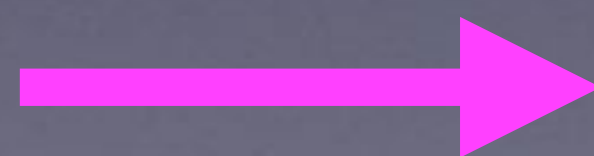

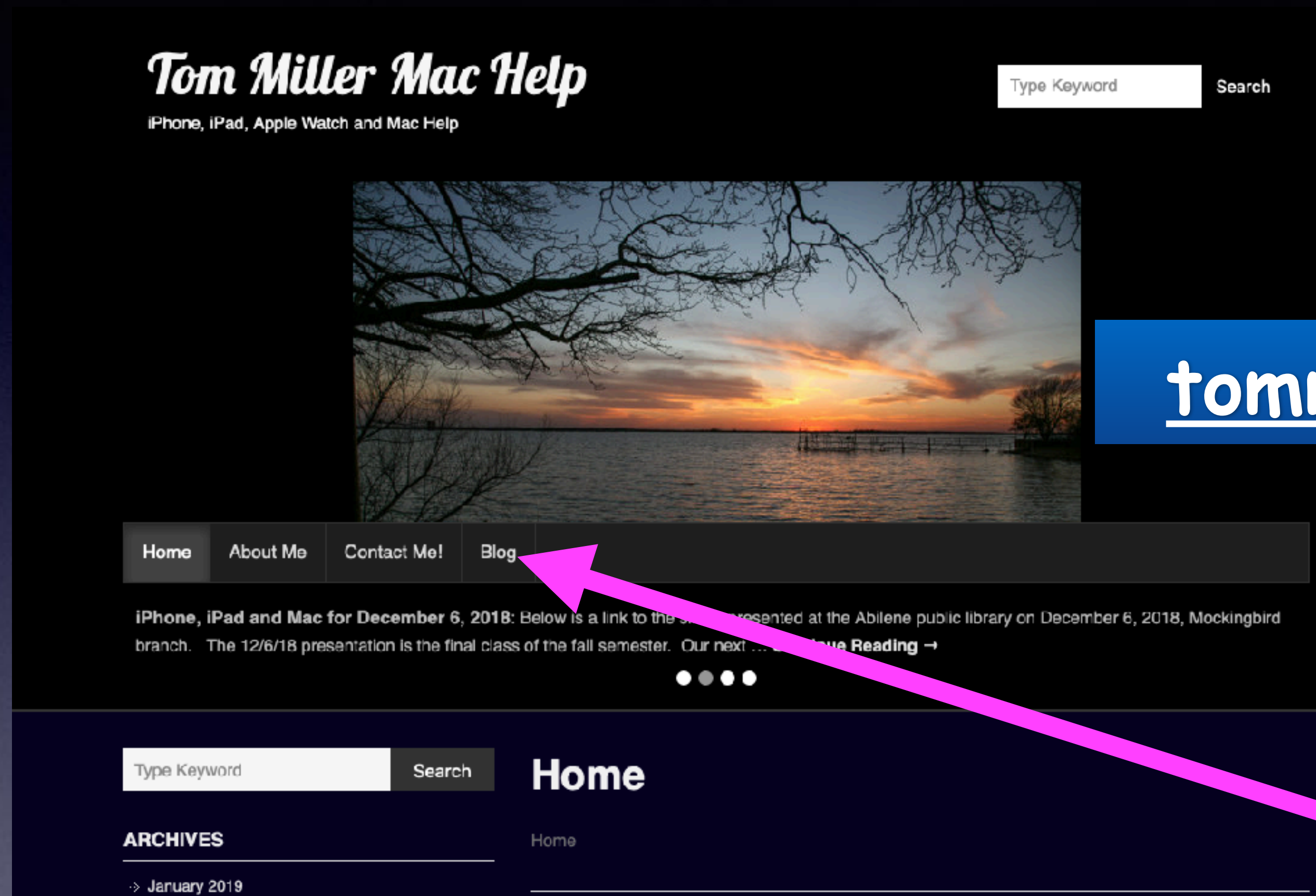

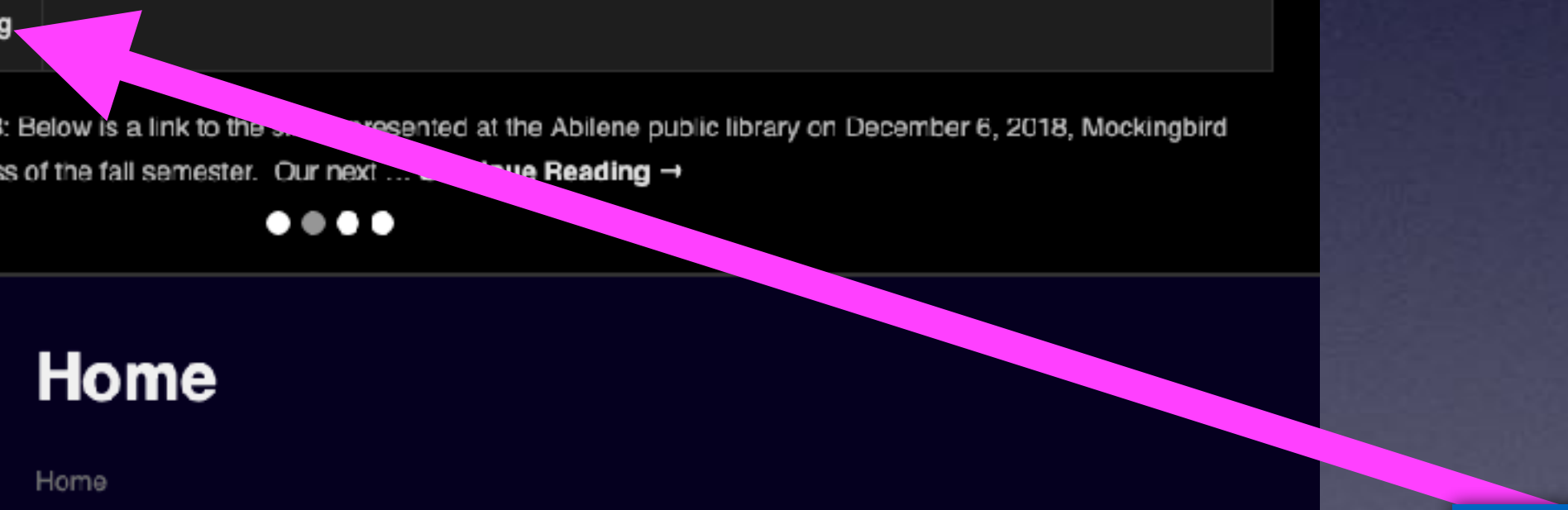

The list of iPhone features that make it competitive

The main reasons should actually be:

1. **Reliable battery life** – I can exert way more control on how I spend it, than I could on my Android. You just always know how much juice is left. (since this article is written, the reliability of iPhone's battery life staggeringly deteriorated)
2. **Stability of the operating system** – it almost never crashes, even jailbroken.
3. **Integration into your existing ecosystem** (for Mac users)
4. **Content** – iTunes is the biggest media library on the planet, with free and paid content.
5. **The best touch technology** – smoothness and responsiveness that I haven't seen anywhere else.
6. Still **the very best display** out there on the market. Retina with 360-pixel density is unmatched like two years after it's debut. And still not conquered.
7. **Ease of use** – don't worry if you are not a nerd; you won't have problems using it.
8. **User experience** – all the app developers are putting a lot of attention to the details! They make it intuitive and easy. I feel good when I am using those apps.
9. **Updates** – there is no fragmentation. Devices have been getting updates for at least three years. In comparison with some Android devices that I had, they never got an update to begin with.
10. **The best MP3 player I have ever had.** It holds my library of 6000 songs in my pocket. (and today infinite amounts of songs with Apple Music)

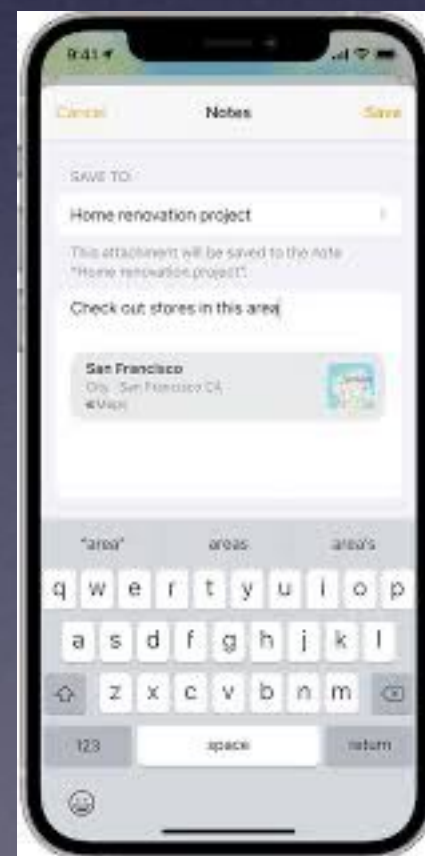
Apple Knows You Can't Remember Things Very Well!

Combination code for my lock.

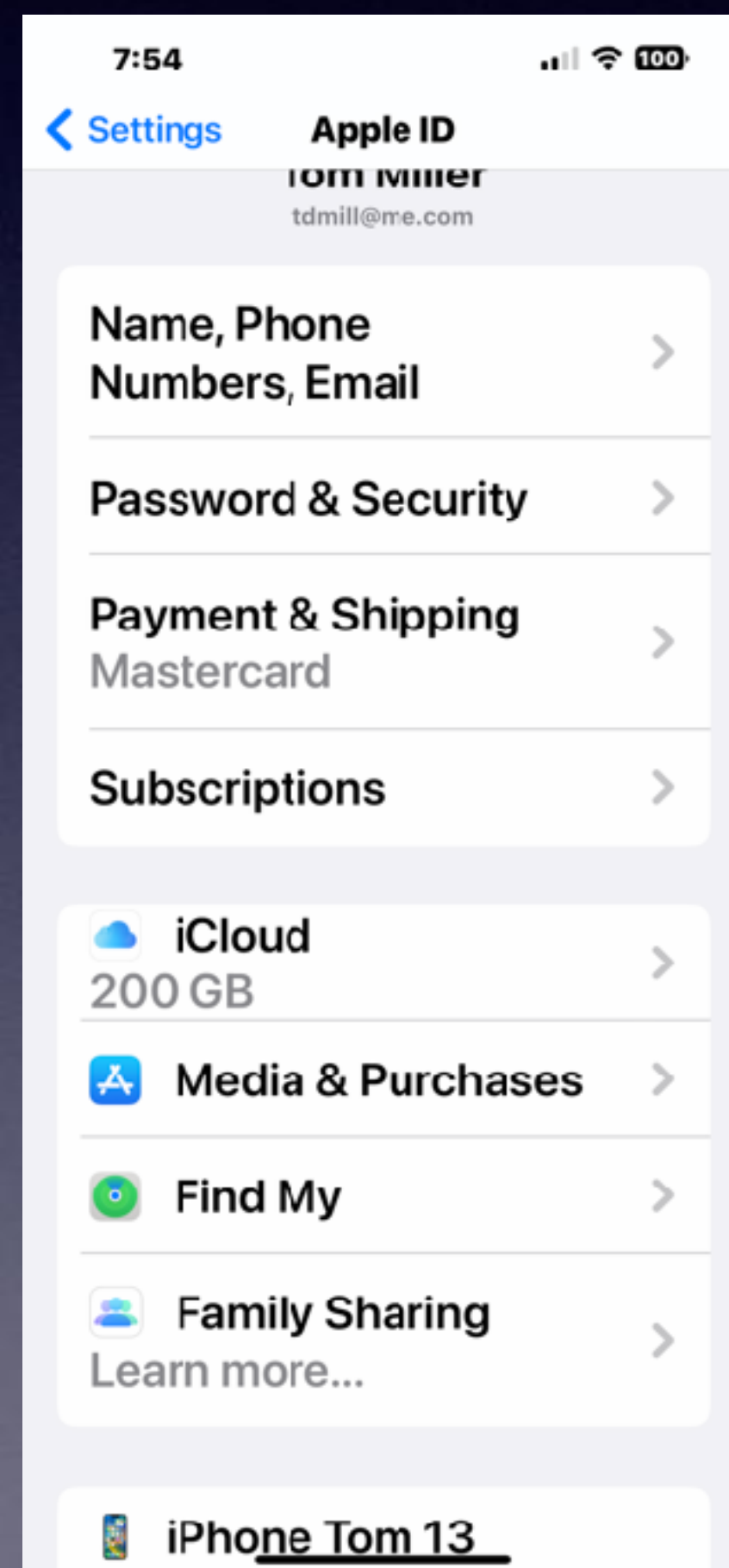
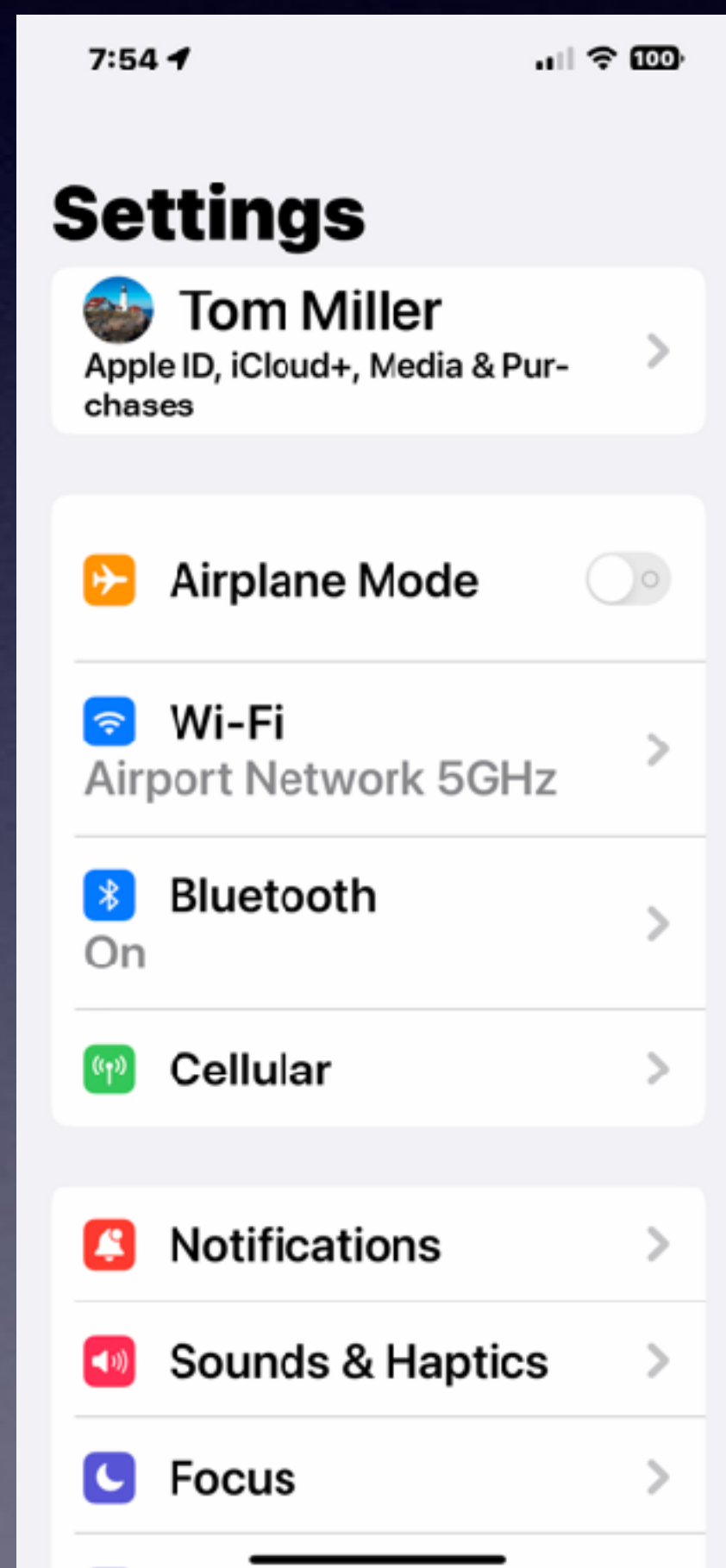

Apple Remembers My Passwords...So I don't Have To!

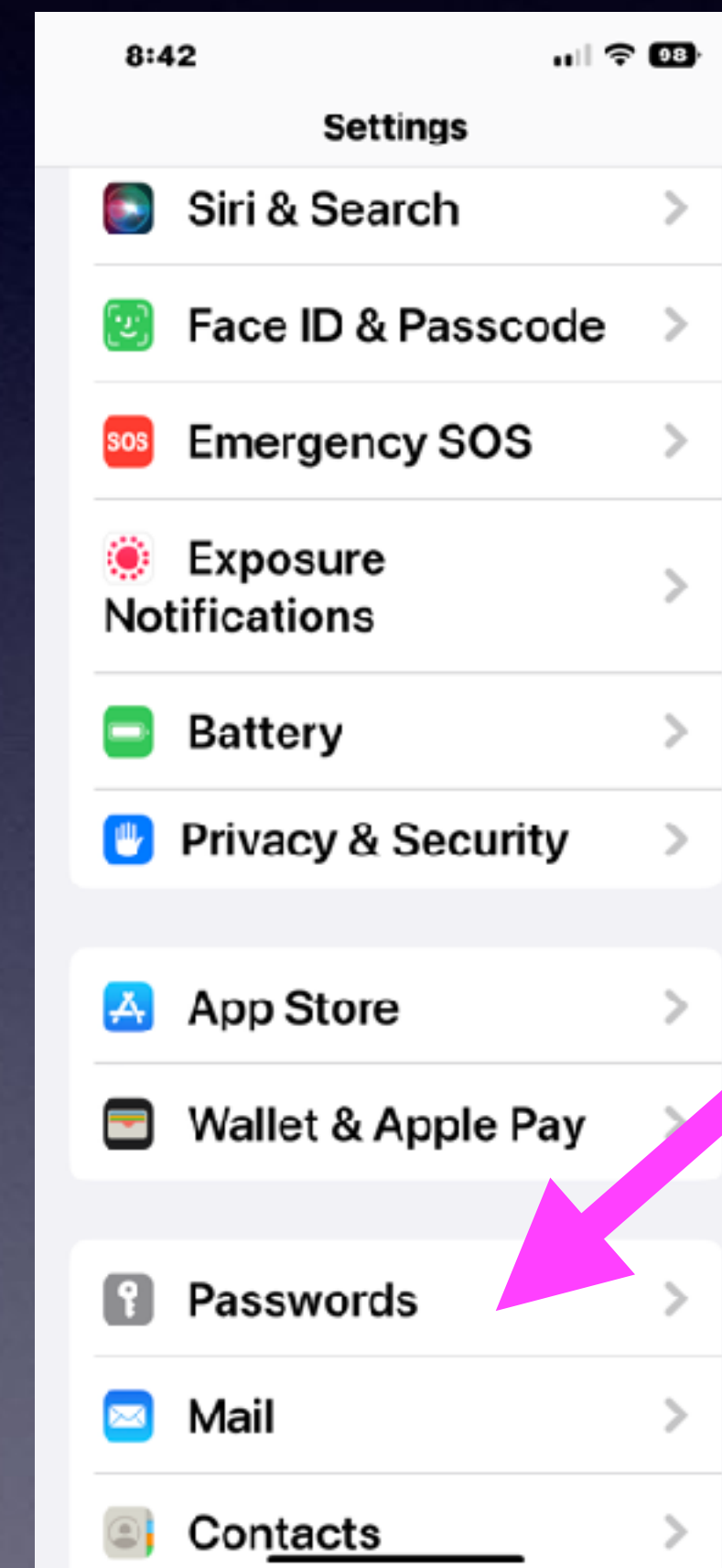
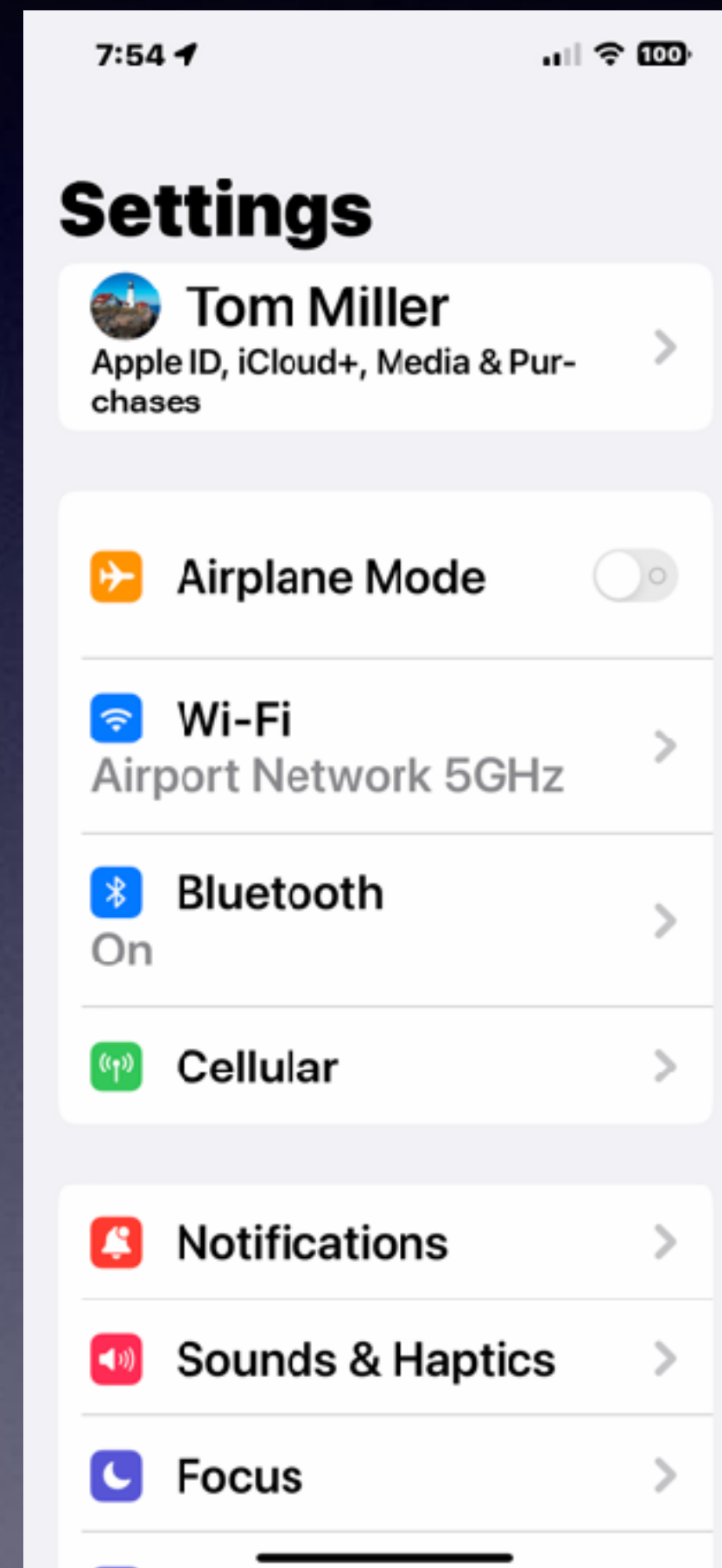
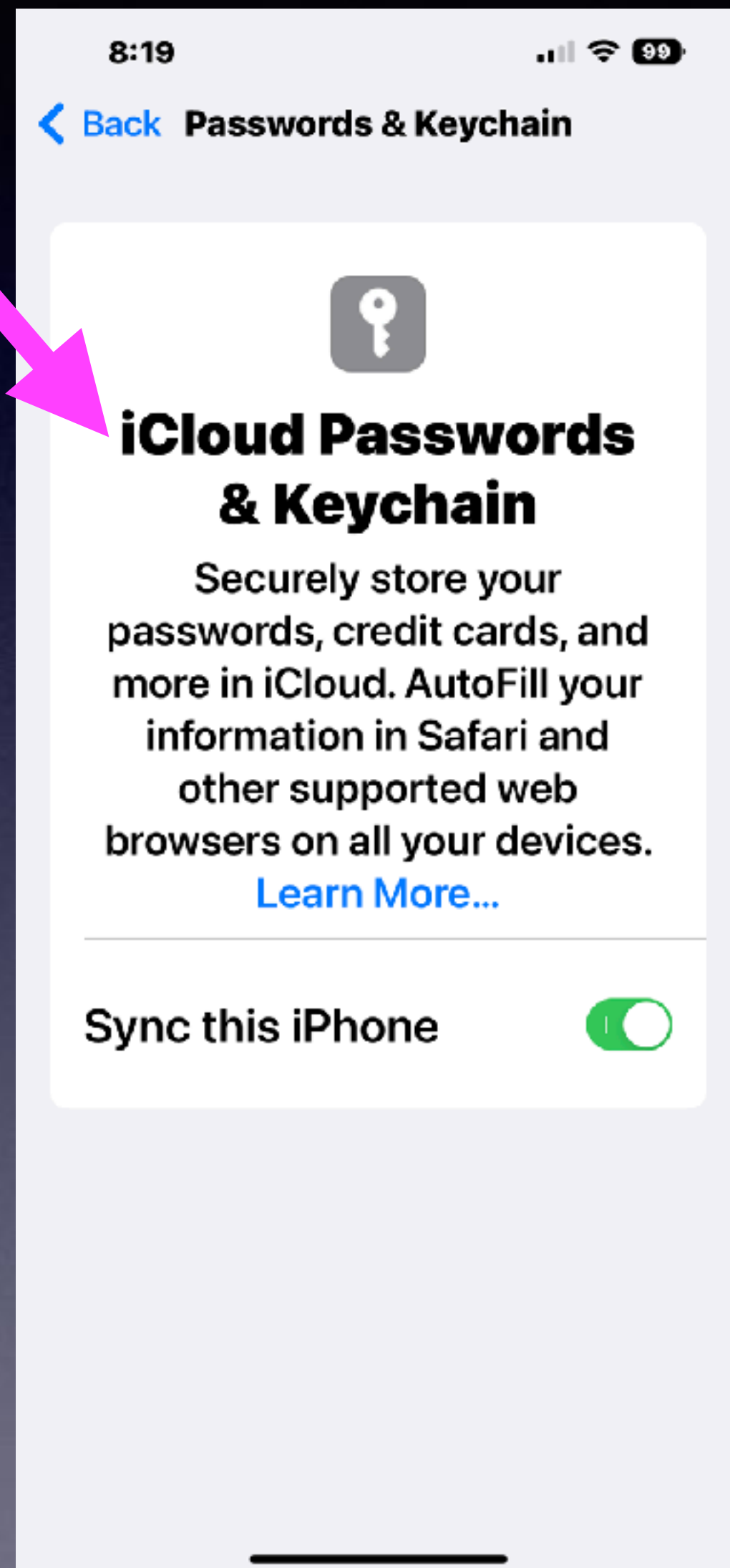
Apple includes a password manager.

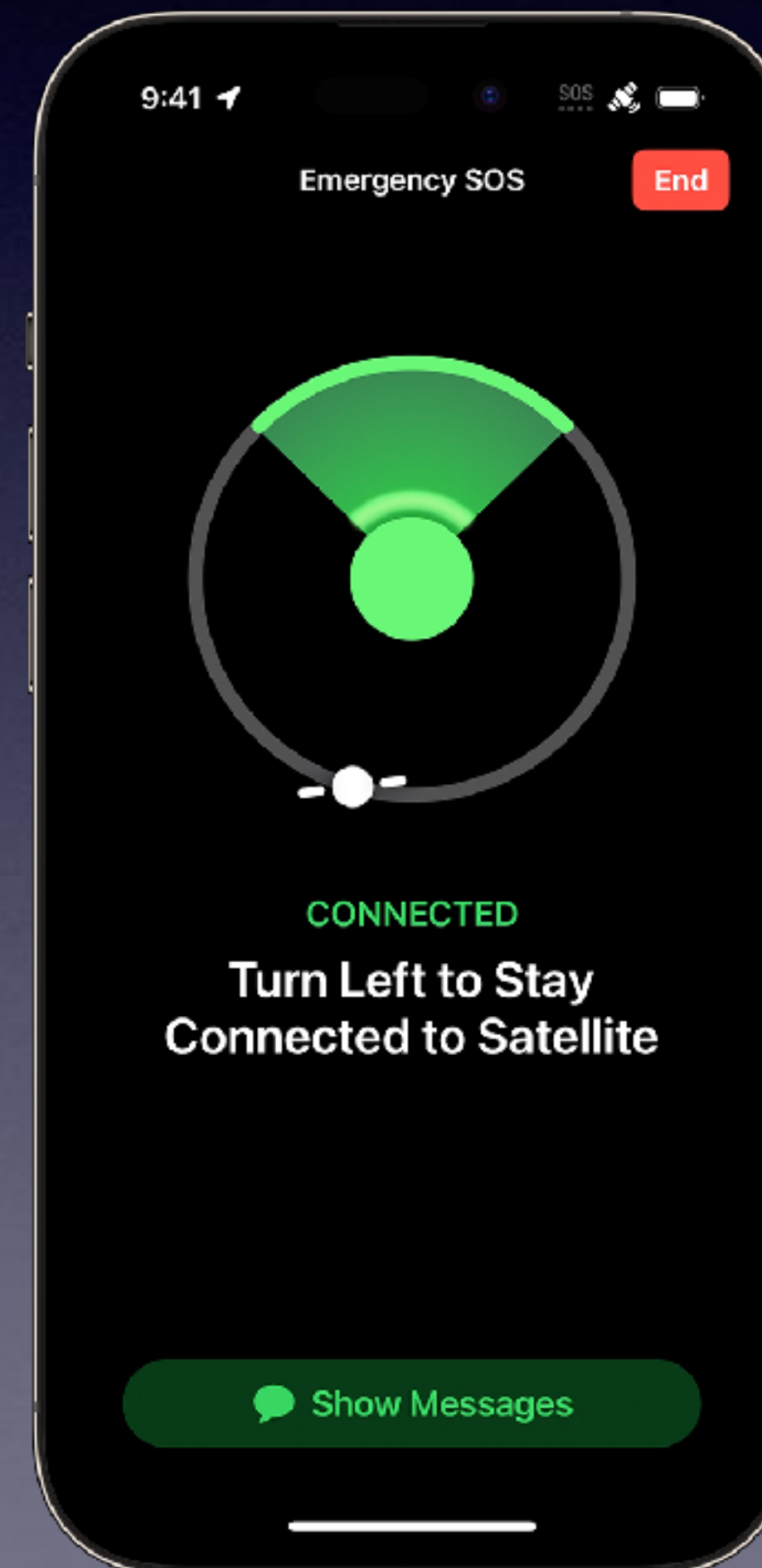
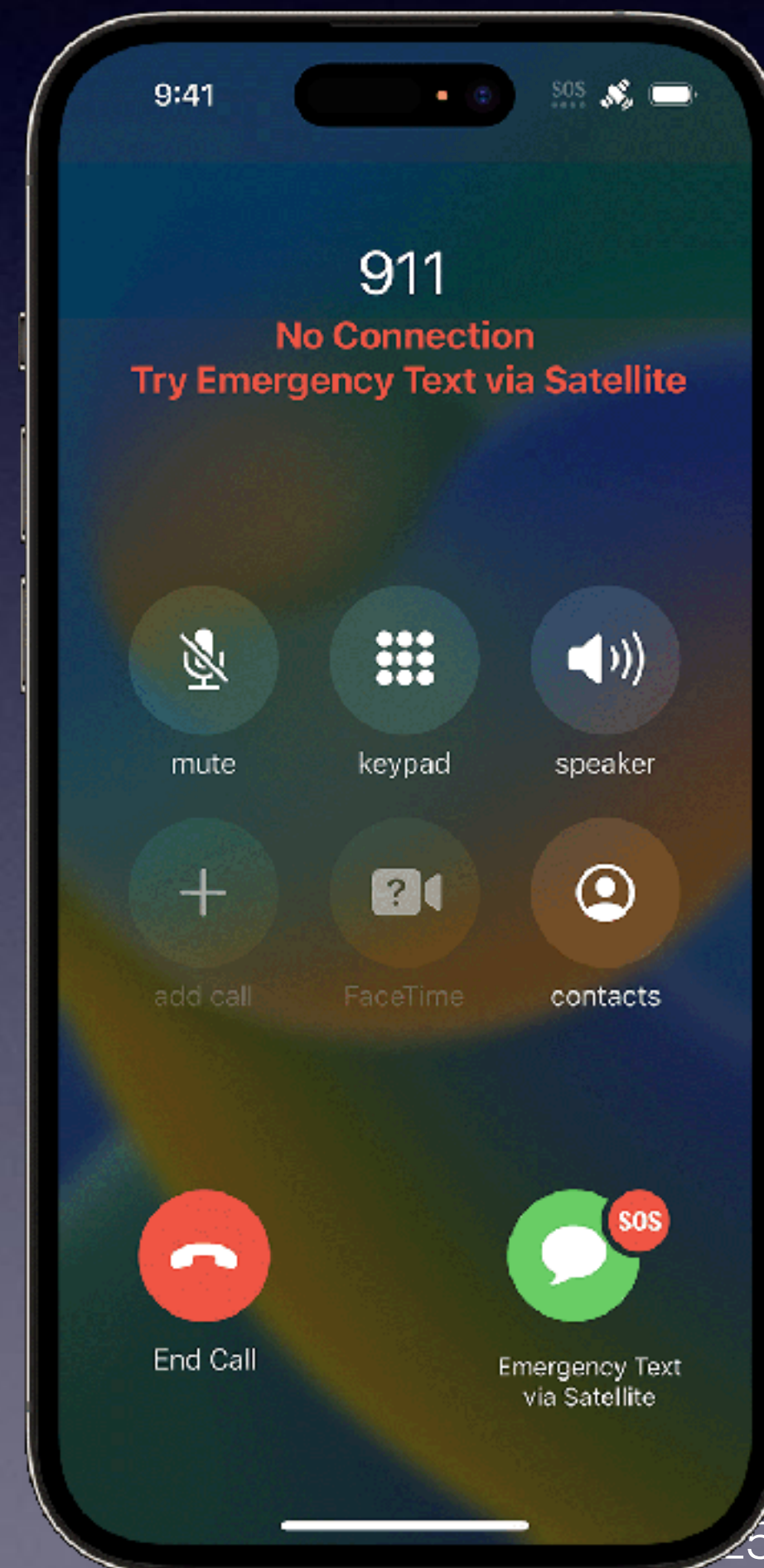


Emergency SOS via Satellite Is A New Feature With iOS 16 and iPhone 14!

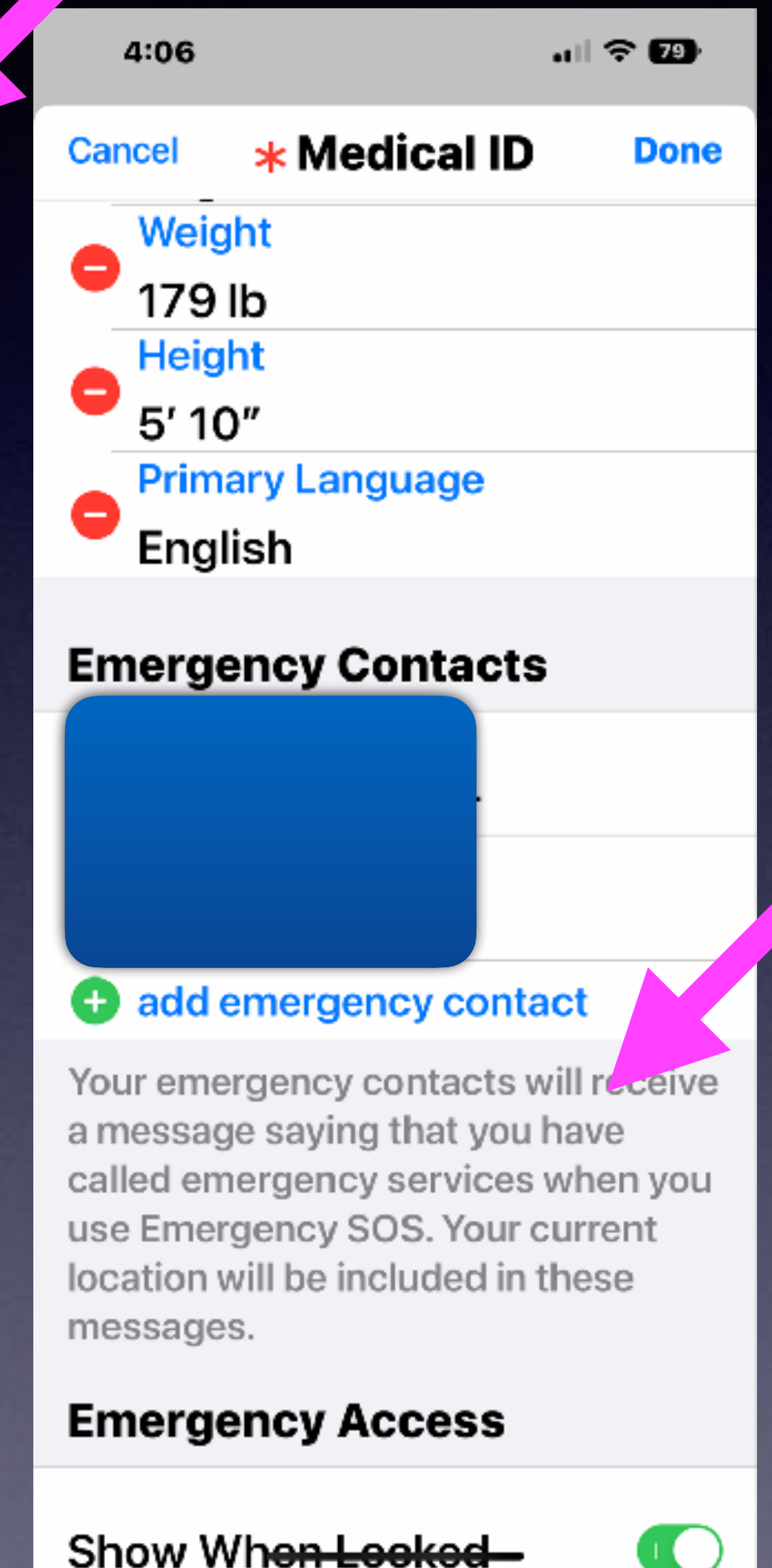
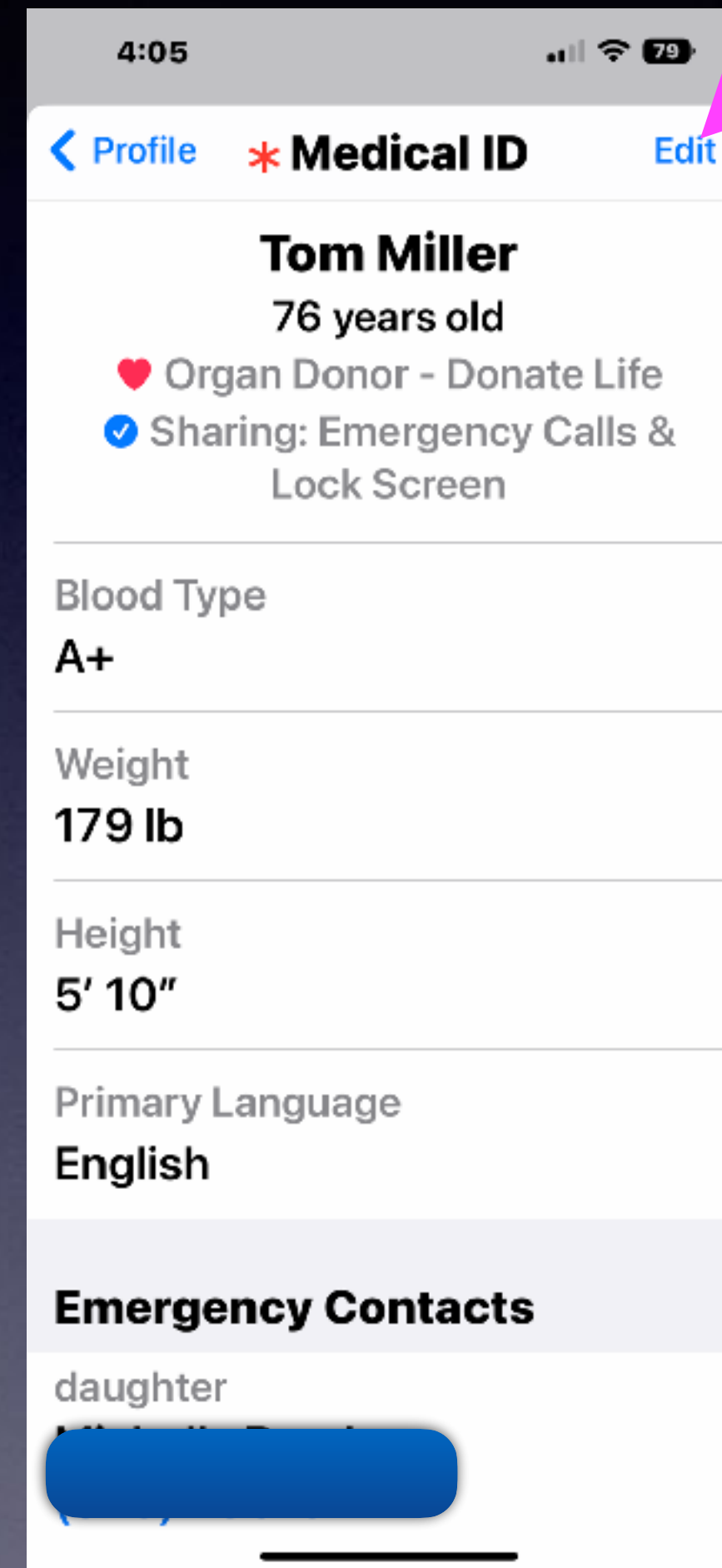
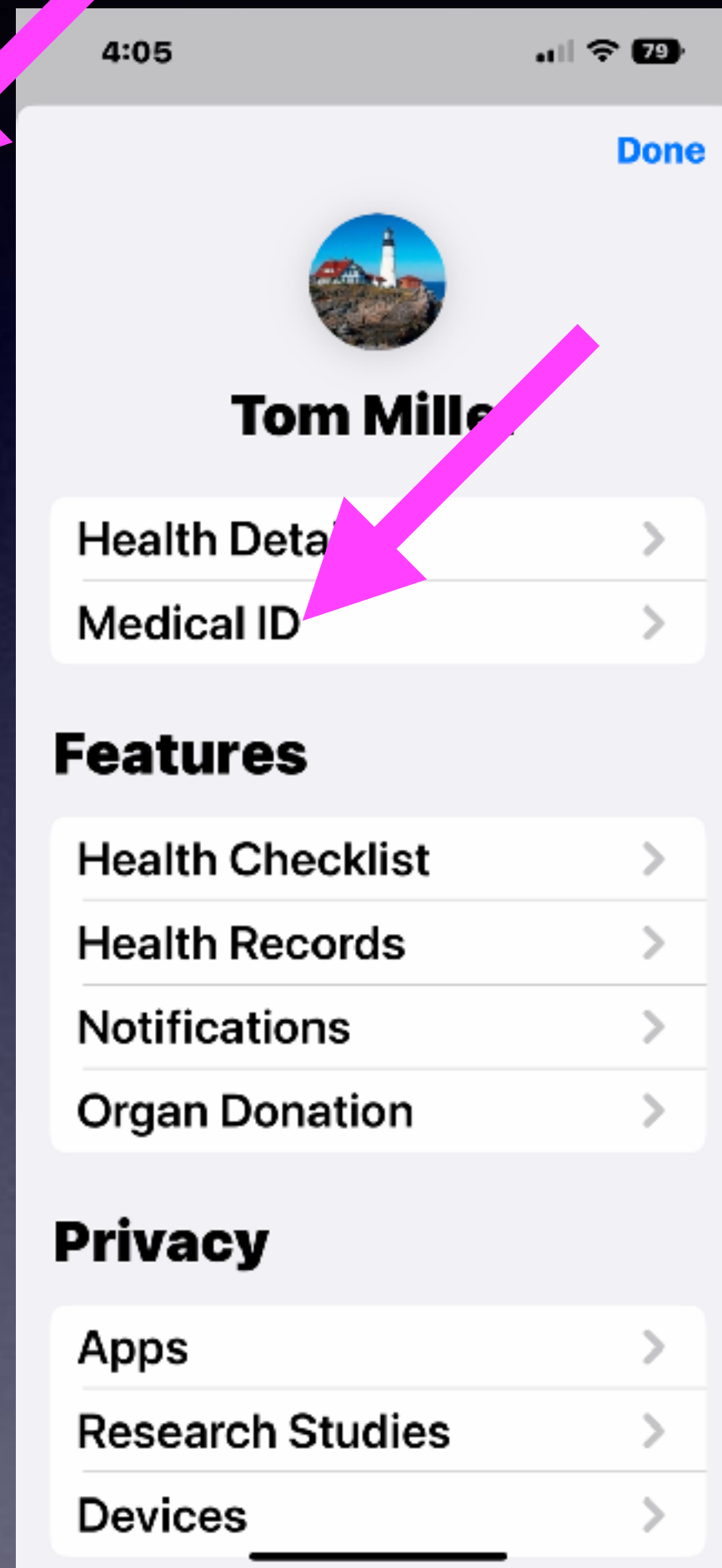
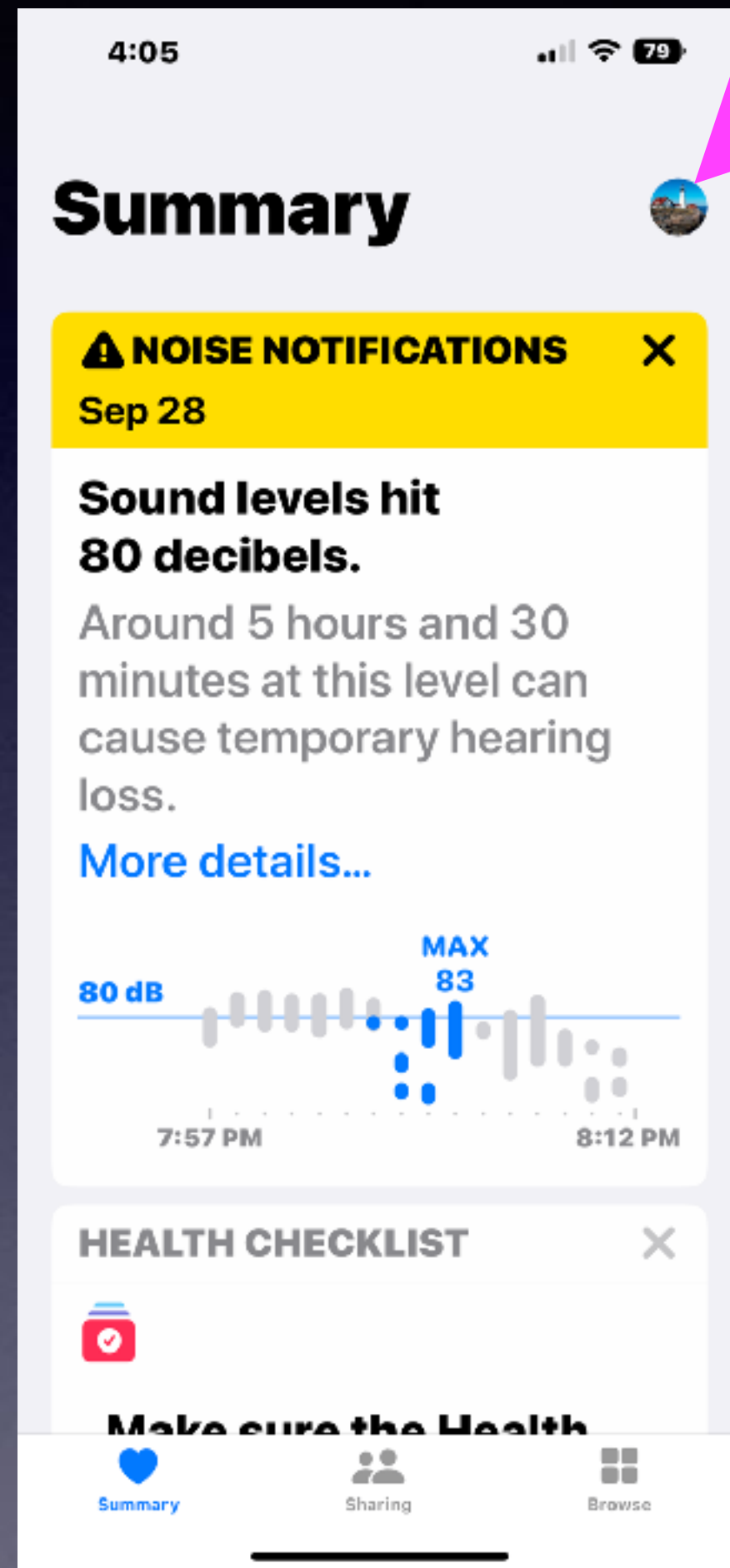
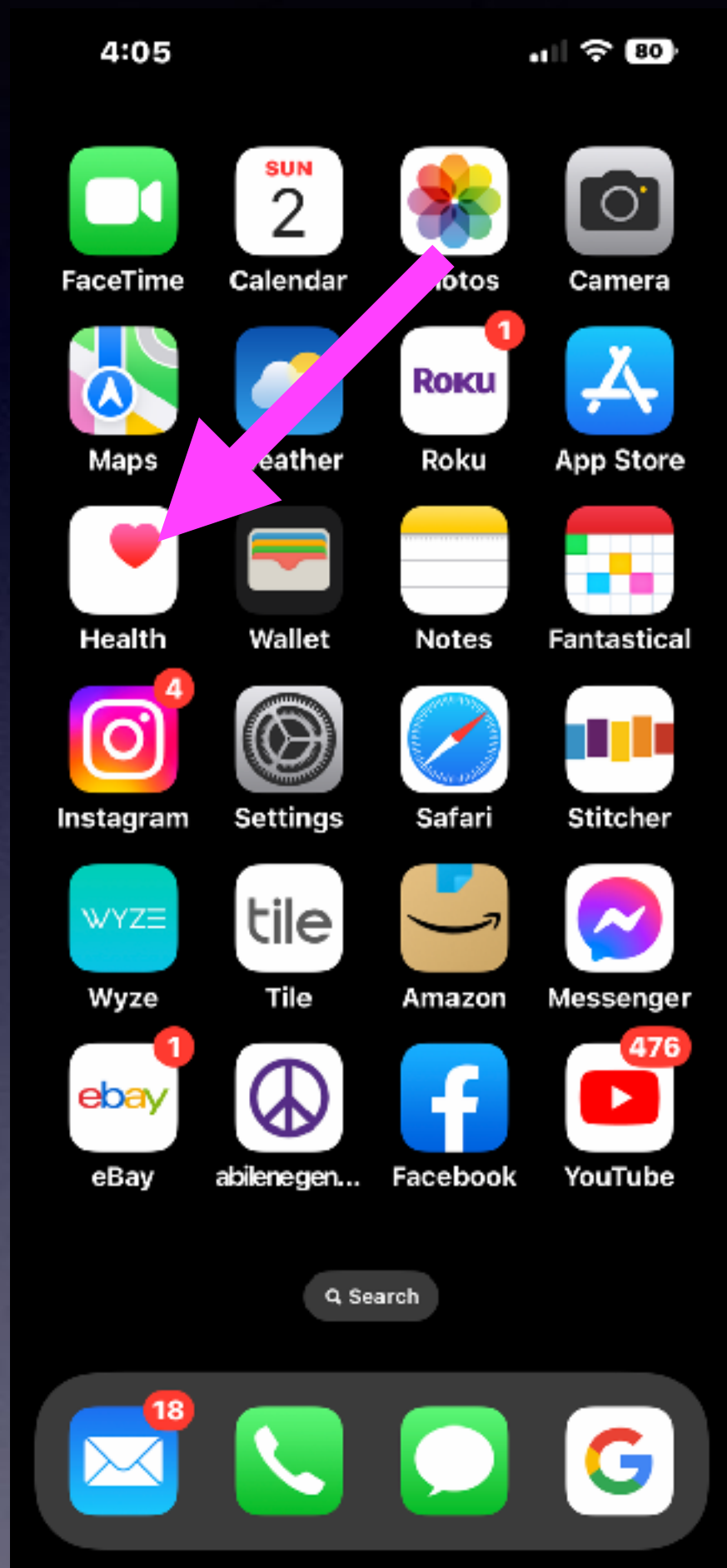


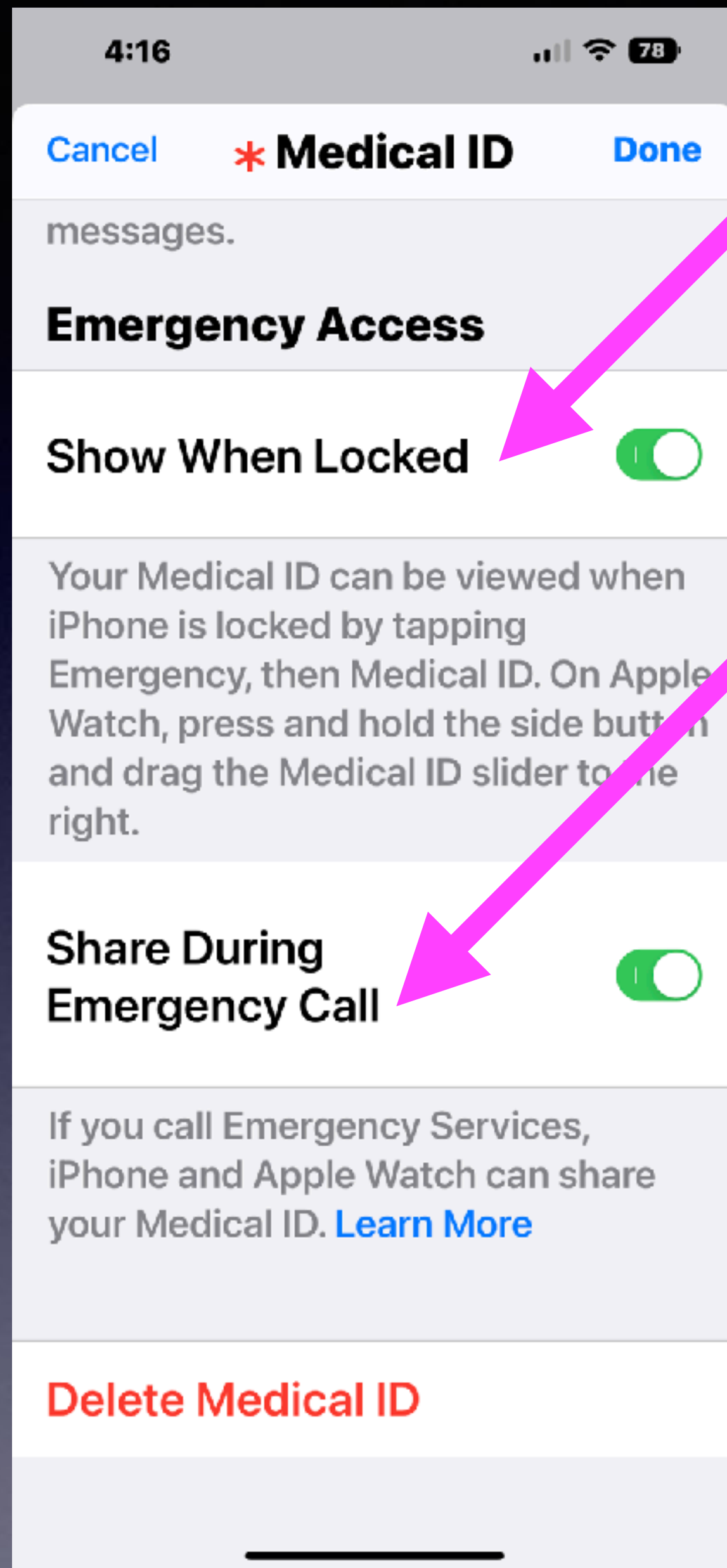
1. Your iPhone automatically calls the local emergency number!

How to set up your Medical ID

Open the Health app and tap the Summary tab.

Tap your profile picture in the upper-right corner.

Under your profile picture, tap Medical ID.

Tap Edit in the upper-right corner.

To make your Medical ID available from the Lock screen on your iPhone, turn on Show When Locked.

Sign Up To Be An Organ Donor.

Open the Health app and tap the Summary tab.

Tap your profile picture in the upper-right corner.

Under Features, tap Organ Donation.

Tap Sign Up with Donate Life.

Fill out the registration form, then tap Continue.

Confirm your registration, then tap Complete Registration with Donate Life.
Tap Done.

You can edit your information with Donate Life at any time.

Open the Health app and tap the Summary tab.

Tap your profile picture in the upper-right corner.

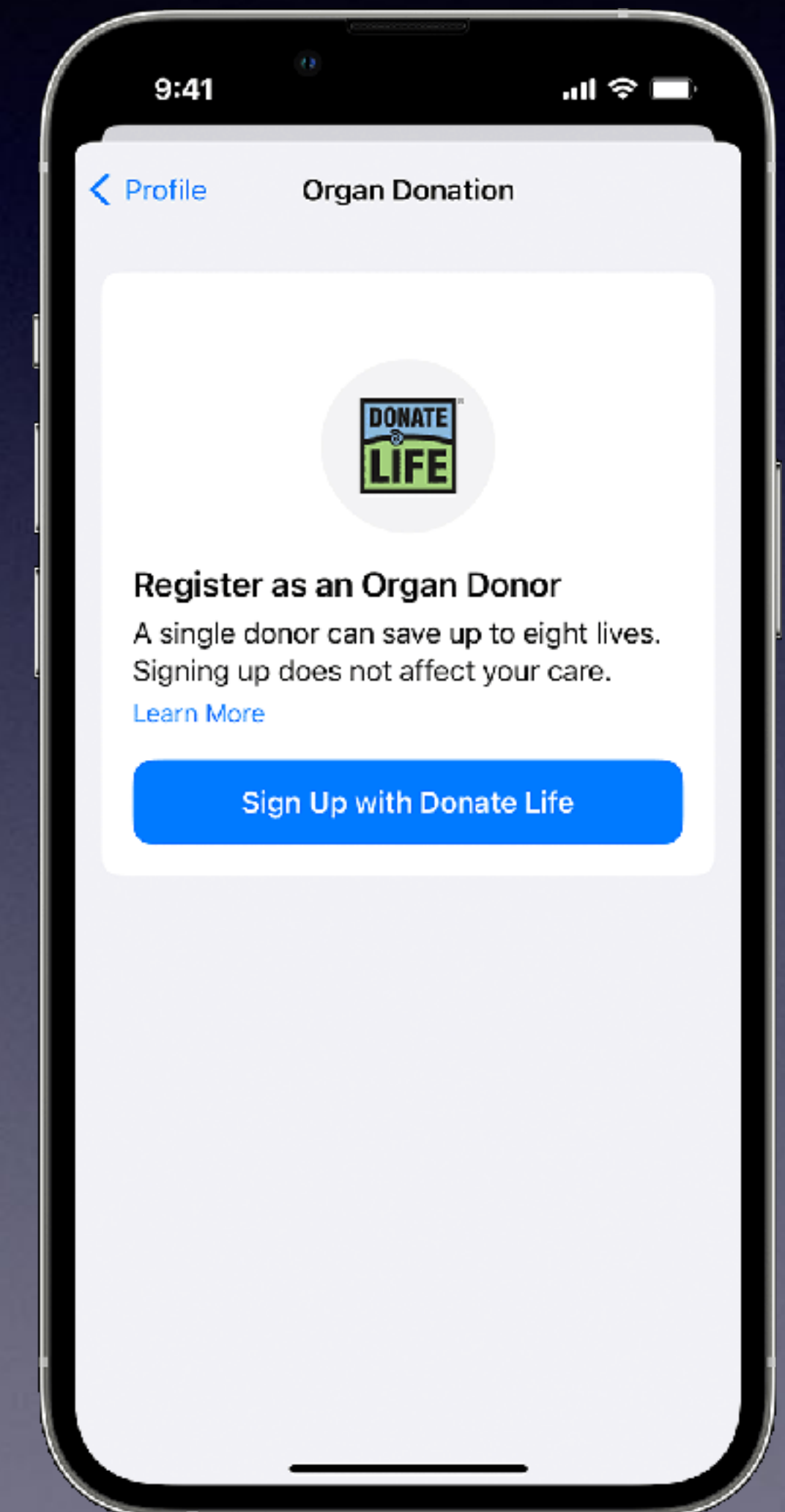
Under Features, tap Organ Donation.

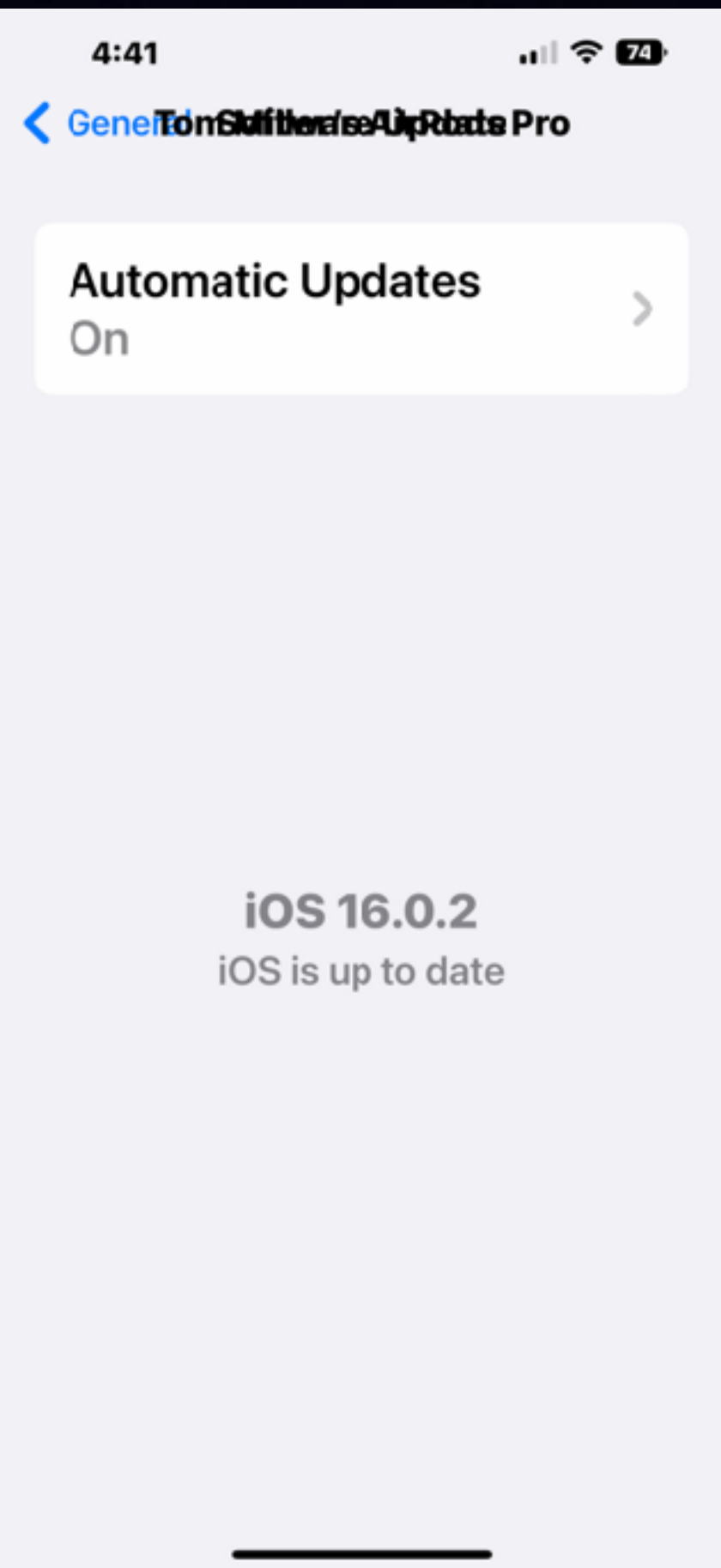
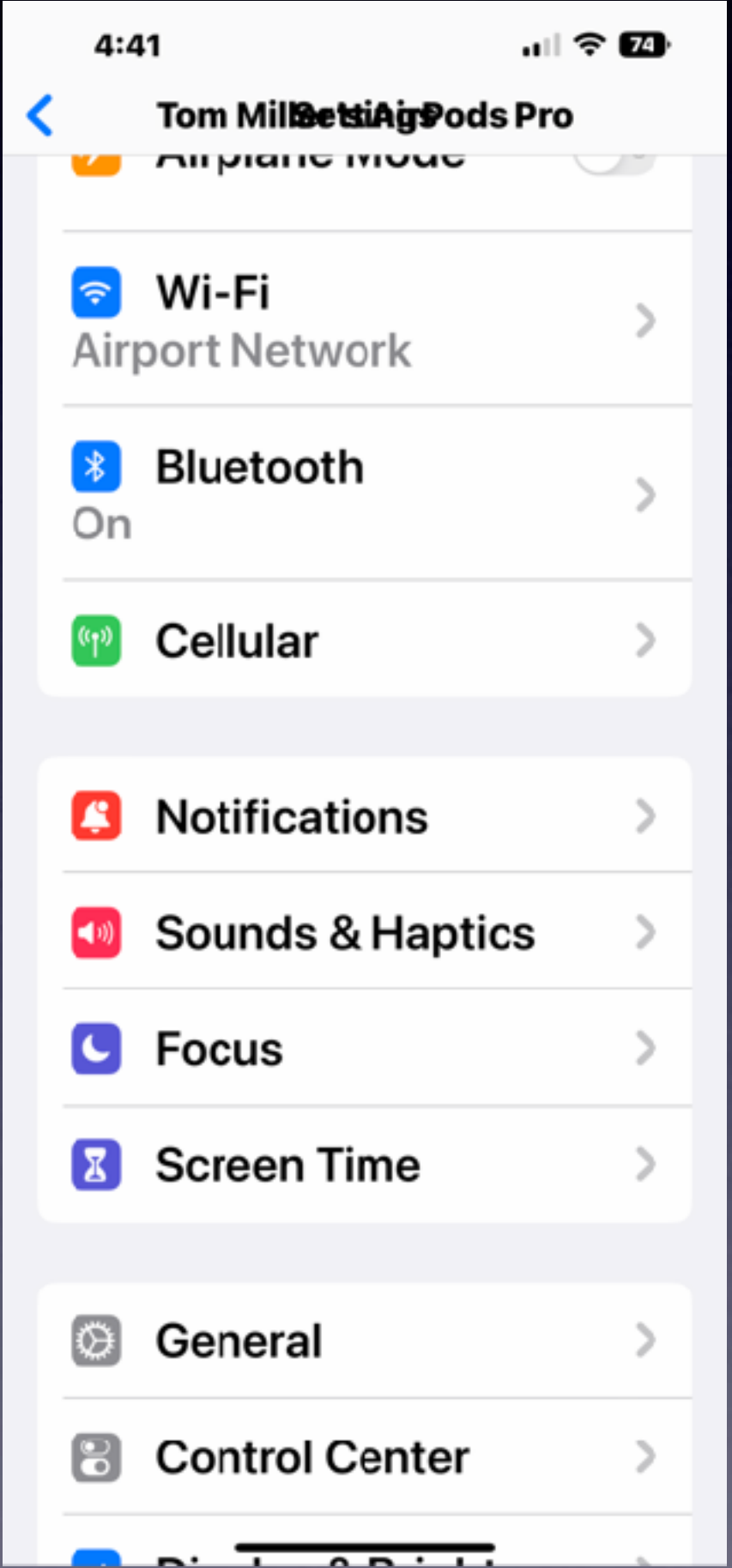


Add Medications

It's Very Critical!



If your iPhone is up to date and does not have iOS 16 your health may be in jeopardy.



Add a medication using your camera!

Must be an iPhone XR or newer

Open the Health app.

On lower right, tap Browse.

Then tap Medications.

Then "Add Medication".

Tap the camera icon.

Then tap "Get Started".

Allow the Health app to access camera.

Position the medication label in the camera frame.

Then tap "Next".

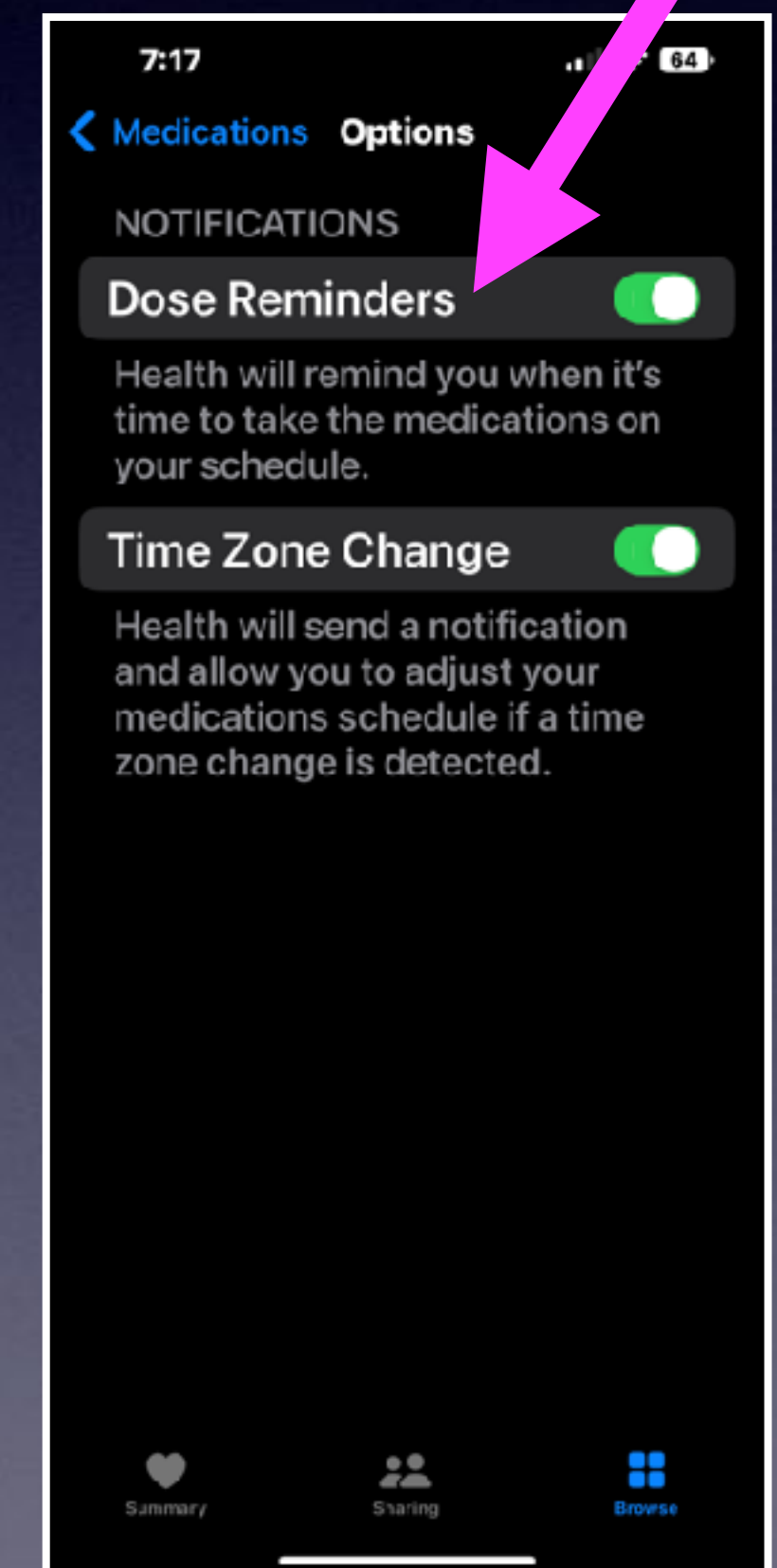
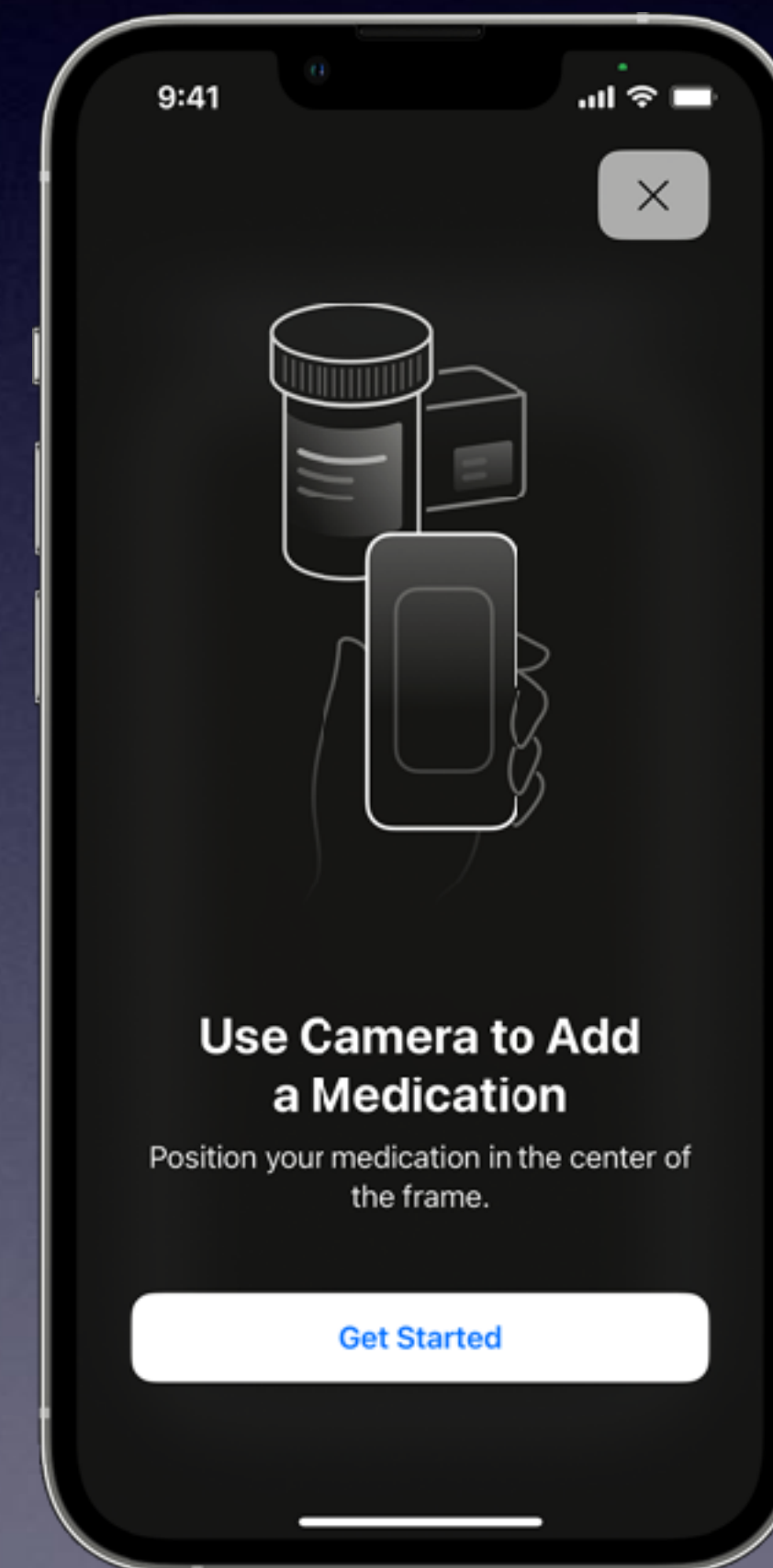
Then tap "Frequency".

Then Add a time you take the medication.

Then choose the shape of the medication.
