
## Kindness At Marye's Heights!

Records indicate the the Union soldiers saluted Lee as he left on Traveller.





#### **Displaying Kindness In The Classroom!**

As a teacher, have you ever bumped up the grade of a student due to unusual circumstances?

Yes. I bumped up the grade of one student from an F to an A.

I taught at a college that had, at the time, a problem that vexed nearly every college. Students who performed well in class, throughout the semester, obviously had a very high average. The final exam was often worth very little (less than 10% of the overall grade).

So, even failing the final with a zero left the student with an A or, at worst, a B. For certain classes where the student didn't care about the actual grade as long as he or she passed, students often didn't turn up for the final exam. To counter this, my college came up with the idea of making the final exam worth 40% of the grade. The minimum passing grade was 60% and 60%=D and, to move up to the next class, you normally needed at least a C. So, even in the unlikely event that you averaged 100% on every other assignment, you would still need to at least turn up for the final. I had a student who was polite & diligent. He came to every class. He was on time every time. Class began at 8:00 a.m. He turned in work on time every time. He averaged a little over 90% on 9 different assignments, without requiring extra credit, tutoring, etc.

He didn't turn up for the final exam. He didn't call. He didn't send a message. This was before there was e-mail, never mind cell-phones.

I felt that this was very unusual for this particular student. I turned in all other grades, the day after the final, though I had two weeks to turn in all grades for the entire class but held off for this student. Eventually, a week after the final, the guy turned up. I asked him why he hadn't turned up for the final. He said that this father had been in hospital all semester. He had taken the 8:00 a.m. class so he could spend all day with his father, after class. At 4:00 a.m. on the day of the final, his father had passed away. He had come only to apologize to me for his rudeness in not informing me that he wouldn't be able to take the final! He knew he had failed. He knew the policy. He wasn't asking me to change his grade.

I went to my department chair. I knew there was a process whereby I could give the student an I (Incomplete) and allow him to take his final a few weeks later. But I didn't want to do that. I told her so and

explained the circumstances. She told me to do whatever I liked. I didn't give the student an I.

I gave him an A.
