


### Jesus At The Wedding!

Unconventional


The crowds were everywhere.

Three reasons why a man (an average looking man)
would not speak to a woman:
She was a woman.
She was a mixed race person, a Samaritan.
She was an immoral person.

The disciples were surprised to find Jesus talking with the woman but didn't say anything! John 4:4ff

Individuals who lose spouses tend to lose friends.






### A Friendship Style!
